QUICK HITS

- Alabama State was picked to win the East Division this season on a vote by the league's head coaches and sports information directors, following a year in which they on the East Division over Jackson State.
- Alabama State had five players named Preseason All-Conference by the SWAC this season, including a pair of returning players who were named All-Conference in their previous season of playing - Darrius Wright (last season) and Eriq White (2017).
- Joining the pair in being named All-SWAC were Noel Cheneau (outfield), Cristopher DeGuzman (shortstop) and Terrell McCall (relief pitcher).
- The Hornets played in back-to-back SWAC championship games, winning the championship in 2016 and advancing to the NCAA Regionals. Last season, the Hornets fell to Texas Southern in the title game - one day after putting up a seasonbest 25 runs in semifinal win over Prairie View A6M.
- Jose' Vazquez was recently identified by Baseball America as one of the top head coaches in the country, according to the publication. Vazquez spent 14 seasons as an assistant coach under Mervyl Melendez, who made the top 10 under 40 in 2013, and took over at Alabama State after Melendez was hired away by Florida International.
- Santiago Garcia was named to the Buster Posey Watch List this month.

HEAD COACH JOSE' VAZQUEZ



Jose' Vazquez was named Alabama State head baseball coach on July 13, 2016, and is entering his third season at the helm of the Hornets as the 2018 season gets underway.

In his first season as the head coach of the Hornets, Vazquez led Alabama State to the SWAC championship game and finished second in the East Division of the conference. He also had seven selections on the SWAC all-conference teams at the end of the season last year, including three major awards. The Hornets had the SWAC Freshman of the Year in

Cage Cox, the SWAC Relief Pitcher of the Year in Austin Bizzle and the Pitcher of the Year in Tyler Howe. The Hornets had one player drafted in Bizzle (Minnesota Twins), and one who signed in Howe (Los Angeles Dodgers) at the conclusion of the season. After having Cox named to multiple All-America teams last season, the Hornets have seven players who were selected to the Preseason All-SWAC teams this season under the direction of Vazquez.

Last season, Vazquez led the Hornets to the East Division title and another 30-win season at the helm. Several players were selected All-Conference and Ray Hernandez was drafted in the 29th round.

Vazquez has spent 14 seasons as an assistant baseball coach, the last six as Associate Head Coach, including five seasons at Alabama State. In addition to the day-to-day duties of the Alabama State baseball program, Vazquez has coached Hornet hitters and outfielders and is widely regarded as one of the top recruiters in the nation.

Vazquez, named the 2013 Assistant Coach of the Year by the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association, has helped Alabama State post a Top 60 recruiting class each year, as rated by Perfect Game, the largest amateur baseball scouting service in the nation.

He has played in an integral role in the rise of Alabama State base-ball into a championship program. Vazquez helped the Hornets land C Richard Gonzalez and OF Richard Amion in the 2011 signing class, both of whom would go on to earn Freshman All-America accolades in 2012. Those two players, along with another 2011 signee in SS Emmanuel Marrero, would prove to be cornerstone pieces of the ASU program, leading the team to 89 wins from 2012-14. All three players were selected in the 2014 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

In 2015, two other freshmen from the initial signing class, RHPs Armando Ruiz and Michael Estevez, along with 2012 signing class pitcher Jorge Pantoja, were drafted for signed to pro contracts.

Two seasons ago, RHP Angel Alicea was drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays, and three-time SWAC Pitcher of the Year Joseph Camacho signed a free agent contract with the Oakland A's. Alabama State has had nine players earn a chance to play professional baseball, with six players drafted, all in the last three seasons.

In 2016, the Hornets set a school record with 64 home runs as Alabama State baseball won a school record 38 games, including an unprecedented 24-0 record in Southwestern Athletic Conference play, in winning the first SWAC Championship in program history and earning ASU first berth to the Division I NCAA Baseball Tournament.

Under Vazquez' guidance, the Hornets have become a more potent offensive team each season. In 2012, with 18 true freshmen on the roster, the Hornets hit .247 (7th SWAC) with no .300 hitters and 14 home runs as the team won 20 games for the first time since 2002. ASU improved in 2013 to hit .282 (second in SWAC) with four .300 hitters and 26 home runs (1st in SWAC), and last season hit .292 with four .300 hitters and 35 home runs. The Hornets led the SWAC in all major batting categories in 2014, including batting average, on-base

percentage, slugging percentage, runs scored, hits, RBI, triples and home runs. In 2015 the Hornets were first in on-base percentage and slugging percentage, second in batting average, runs scored, home runs and RBI, and third in hits.

Prior to Alabama State, Vazquez spent the previous nine seasons as assistant coach at Bethune-Cookman, with 2011 his first as Associate Head Coach. Vazquez played a prominent role in the programs' success, bringing in players that posted a staggering 100-4 MEAC record over the final six seasons, all ending in conference titles and NCAA Tournament appearances.

Playing under former ASU head coach Mervyl Melendez at B-CU, Vazquez earned all-conference honors as a catcher in his only season with the Wildcats, transferring there for his senior season in 2002. As a starter, Vazquez helped post the best record in school history (39-22), including the programs' only NCAA Regional victory over Florida International. Vazquez then joined the coaching ranks, first as a student in 2003 and, upon graduating, a full-time assistant.

A native of Bayamon, Puerto Rico, Vazquez is married to the former Jana Swanson. The couple has two daughters, Liana and Elaisa.

ASSISTANT COACHES



DREW CLARK ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

Drew Clark enters his eighth season on the Alabama State baseball staff, his third as Associate Head Coach/Recruiting Coordinator under Head Coach Jose Vazquez. Clark's responsibilities include recruiting and working with the Hornet hitters.

Clark has tutored six Louisville Slugger Freshman All-Americans over the past six seasons including Richard Amion (OF, 2012), Richard Gonzalez (C, 2012), Dillon Cooper (OF, 2013), Diandre Amion (OF, 2016) and Eriq White (2B, 2016). The Hornet offense has also found itself ranked in the top two of the league in batting average, home runs, and runs batted in four of the past five seasons. Under his guidance, the 2016 offense ranked first in the country in runs scored per game at 8.6.

Last season, Ray Hernandez was drafted in the 29th round by the Atlanta Braves after being selected all-conference. In 2014, three Hornet position players saw their names called during the MLB draft. The draftees included Shortstop Emmanuel Marrero was selected by the (Philadelphia Phillies, 7th Round), Outfielder Richard Amion (San Francisco Giants, 19th Round), and Richard Gonzalez (Houston Astros, 29th Round). After the 2014 season, Clark was recognized by the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association as the Assistant Coach of the Year.

During his seven seasons at Alabama State, Clark has tutored several award winning offensive players including 2017 Freshman of the Year Cage Cox, 2016 Player/Hitter of the Year Carlos Ocasio, 2016 Freshman of the Year Eriq White, 2016 ALABCA Player of the Year Carlos Ocasio, 2015 Player of the Year Emmanuel Marrero and 2013 Freshman of the Year Dillon Cooper. He has also coached 21 All-SWAC performers.

Clark joined the coaching ranks in 2010 after a four-year career playing catcher at Bethune-Cookman, winning more than 150 games, four Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference championships and four appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

Clark is married to the former Carrie D'Ippolito, a native of Ormond Beach, Fla.



MATT CRANE ASSISTANT COACH (PITCHING)

Matt Crane is in his eighth season on the Alabama State baseball staff, his third as an assistant coach under Head Coach Jose Vazquez. Among his responsibilities, Crane is in charge of the Hornets' pitching staff, scheduling and serves as director of all Alabama State Baseball Camps.

He has helped produce four consecutive Southwestern Athletic Conference Pitchers of the Year in T.J. Renda (2013) and Joseph Camacho (2014, 2015, 2016). Over his seven seasons, Crane has tutored eight pitchers that have gone on to play professional baseball including Dexter Price (2013, Arizona Diamondbacks, FA), Armando Ruiz (2015, Oakland A's, 29th Round), Jorge Pantoja (2015, Washington Nationals, 30th round), Michael Estevez (2015, Toronto Blue Jays, FA), Angel Alicea (2016, Toronto Blue Jays, 20th Round), Joseph Camacho (2016, Oakland A's, FA), Austin Bizzle (2017, Minnesota Twins, 40th Round) and Tyler Howe (2017, Detroit Tigers, FA).

Under Crane, Alabama State has ranked in the top three in the SWAC in earned run average and first in strikeouts for the past five seasons. Despite a staff of eight true freshmen and only two upper classmen in 2012, the Hornets ranked fourth in ERA at 5.02 and were third in strikeouts with 350. In 2013, Hornet pitchers were second in ERA at 4.38 and lead the SWAC with 435 strikeouts. In 2014 ASU's ERA improved to 4.25 (3rd in SWAC) while once again leading the league in strikeouts (373). In 2016, the Hornets were again third in the league in ERA (4.87), and were first in strikeouts (446) for the third straight year. In 2016, it would be the best year on the mound for the Hornets under Crane. They led the league in nearly every pitching category including ERA (3.82) and strikeouts (481). Last season, the Hornets led in nearly every pitching category for the fifth straight season.

In 2017, Crane tutored his fifth straight SWAC Conference Pitcher of the Year and several First Team All-SWAC Performers including Joseph Camacho (SWAC Pitcher of the Year 3 Times, 2014, 2015, 2016; First Team All-SWAC Starting Pitcher 3 Times, 2014, 2015, 2016; 2016 Louisville Slugger Pre-Season All-American Third Team; 2016 Louisville Slugger All-American Third Team; 2016 National College Baseball Writers Association Second Team-All American; 2015 American Baseball Coaches Association/Rawlings South Central All-Region Second Team), Tyler Howe (SWAC Pitcher of the Year, 2017; First Team All-SWAC, 2017; 2016 First Team All-SWAC Starting Pitcher; 2016 SWAC All-Tournament Team; 2016 8th in the Nation for ERA), T.J. - Eriq White was named the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) Hitter of the Week for his performance during the first week of conference play.
- The redshirt junior hit .500 over five games three against conference opponent Mississippi Valley State - collected 11 hits in 22 official at-bats, scoring nine runs and knocking in another seven runs. He also collected a pair of doubles and walked three times. He finished the week accounting for 16 runs, having a slugging percentage of .591 and an on-base percentage of .560.

- Alabama State senior right handed pitcher Darren Kelly was the named the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) Pitcher of the Week for his performance against Jackson State.
- Kelly (3-0, 0.87 ERA) recorded his longest outing of the season as he went 8.0 innings in a 9-1 victory over Jackson State Saturday afternoon. The senior allowed just one run (earned) off four hits, while walking just one batter and striking out seven.
- This season, he has walked just seven and struck 34
 batters in 31.0 innings pitched (six starts) following
 Tommy John surgery last season. Kelly has allowed just
 five total runs, three of which have been earned on 16 hits;
 while opponents are hitting just .144 against him on the
 year.

GARCIA NAMED TO BUSTER POSEY WATCH LIST

- Alabama State sophomore catcher Santiago Garcia was named to the Buster Posey Award Watch List, announced by the Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission.
- Garcia has caught each of the first 27 games of the 2019 season for Alabama State, hitting .294 with 35 hits thus far this season. He has collected 10 extra base hits and is tied for the team lead in home runs with four, while scoring 11 runs. He is also second on the team in runs batted in with 29, while slugging .445. The sophomore has struck out just six times in 136 plate appearances this season, and is the lone catcher from the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) on the list.

KELLY WINS SECOND SWAC PITCHER OF THE WEEK AWARD IN THREE WEEKS

- Alabama State senior right handed pitcher Darren Kelly was the named the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) Pitcher of the Week for his performance against Mississippi Valley State.
- Kelly (4-0, 1.18 EÑA) recorded a win in a run-rule victory over Mississippi Valley State, going 7.0 innings and allowing just one hit. He allowed a pair of runs, but struck out seven in picking up his fourth win of the season; and his second Pitcher of the Week honor.
- At that point in the season, he has walked just 10 and struck 41 batters in 38.0 innings pitched (seven starts) following Tommy John surgery last season. Kelly has allowed just seven total runs, five of which have been earned on 17 hits; while opponents are hitting just .130 against him on the year.

PAGAN NAMED SWAC HITTER OF THE WEEK AND COLLEGIATE BASEBALL NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK AFTER PERFORMANCE AGAINST ALCORN

- Yamil Pagan earned a pair of awards this week for his performance in six games, and more importantly in four conference games against Alcorn State.
- The senior outfielder finished the weekend hitting .563 against Alcorn State in four games, as he finished the

- weekend 9-of-16. He also scored 10 runs and drove in 11 more from his lead off position, including picking up a triple and three home runs. He connected on a pair of home runs in the doubleheader Saturday for the Hornets, who scored 71 runs in the conference series as a team. He also slugged 1.250 in four conference games, while walking six times (hit once) and recording an on-base percentage of .696.
- For the week, Pagan finished at .423 (11-for-26) with 13 runs scored. He finished the week slugging .846 and recording an on-base percentage of .545. His best game of the week came against Alcorn State on Friday (4/12/19) when he finished 3-for-4 with three runs scored and five runs batted, and he followed that up by going 3-for-4 in the opener on Saturday (4/13/19) with a 3-for-4 game with three runs scored and five runs batted in.

PAGAN AND KELLY LE THE NATION IN MID-APRIL STATISTICALLY. REMAIN IN TOP 10

- Alabama State seniors Yamil Pagan and Darren Kelly each led the nation in mid-April in a pair of statisical categories.
- Pagan was tied for first in the nation in runs scored with a pair of players from New Mexico State - Logan Bottrell and Nick Gonzalez - at 52 runs. He now sits third nationally.
- Meanwhile, Kelly led the nation in WHIP at 0.70 this season. He now sits ninth in the category.

NOTABLE PERFORMANCES FROM SIX GAMES TWO WEEKS AGO FOR THE HORNETS

- Ricardo Rivera picked up another conference win when the Hornets defeated Alcorn State 13-1. He logged 7.0 innings in the run-rule game, and allowed just one run on five hits. He also walked just one and struck out four. The freshman also started on Tuesday against Florida A&M, suffering the loss. For the week, Rivera logged 12.0 innings and allowed seven runs on 11 hits with eight strikeouts.
- Angel Jimenez finished the week hitting .526 in four games (including .538 in conference play) as he finished 10-for-19 with a pair of doubles. He also scored six runs and drove in a pair. - Cheneau picking up a pair of home runs in the same game for the first time in his career.
- Over the course of the weekend, Alabama State .445 with 71 runs scored on 65 hits. The Hornets picked up 29 extra base hits - 12 doubles, five triples and 15 home runs while drawing 37 walks. They were also hit seven times as a team, and slugged .863 over the course of four games. They also picked up quality starts from Ricardo Rivera and Darren Kelly over the Braves to help the Hornets hold on to the three-game advantage in the loss column over Jackson State.

HORNETS PICKED TO REPEAT IN EAST DIVISION, FIVE PLAYERS CHOSEN ALL-CONFERENCE

- Alabama State, fresh off a divisional championship last season, was chosen to repeat as the East Division champion in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) on a vote by the league's head coaches and sports information directors, announced by the conference office.
- The Hornets earned 73 points (including nine first place votes) to finish four points ahead of Jackson State in second place with six first place votes. Alcorn State earned 40 points for third in the division, while Texas Southern - the two-time defending champion - was chosen to win the West Division with 72 points (including nine first place votes).
- Alabama State tied for league honors with five selections on the two preseason teams with Jackson State and Grambling State, while UAPB had four selections. Texas Southern picked up three each, while Mississippi Valley State and Alcorn State each had one selection.
- Darrius Wright, an All-Conference selection last season, was one of two First Team selections this season for Alabama State. The senior right-handed pitcher finished 8-1 last season with a 2.36 earned run average a category in which he led the nation for three weeks at the beginning of the season. He finished with 12 starts as the Friday starter for Alabama State, logging 72.1 innings and giving up just 38 runs 19 earned. Wright won his first four starts of his career, and logged six-plus innings nine different times in 2018. He did not allow an earned run in five of starts, and finished ranked nationally in victories and earned run average.
- Meanwhile, Eriq White who missed all of last season was named First Team as a third baseman entering the 2019 season. As a sophomore, White was a First Team Preseason honoree and hit .282 that season in 46 games. He recorded 40 hits in 142 official at-bats and scored 24 runs, while knocking in another 15. White recorded five doubles and hit one home run as a sophomore, a year after being named the 2016 SWAC Freshman of the Year and selected as a First Team All-Conference member.
- A trio of Hornets were named to Preseason Second Team led by outfielder Noel Cheneau, who split his time in 2018 as an outfielder and at second base. The senior finished fifth on the team in hitting last year at .313 in 44 games (all starts), and recorded 55 hits. He also scored 32 runs and drove in another 26 while collecting 15 extra base hits (10 doubles, three triples and a pair of home runs). Cheneau slugged .438 and had an on-base percentage of .385, while finishing second on the team in stolen bases (13-of-19). He recorded multiple hits 14 times in 2018 and had a pair of four hit games, and drove in a career-high six runs against Alcorn State (4/8) and 10 in back-to-back games against Alcorn State and South Alabama (4/10).
- Sophomore shortstop Cristopher DeGuzman earned a Second Team nod after a stellar freshman season in the field. The sophomore played all 52 games - starting 43 and finished the season hitting .257. He scored 21 runs and

- drove in another 18, while collecting 37 hits including three doubles. He finished the year with 22 walks and seven sacrifice hits, and was perfect in stolen bases (3-for-3). The sophomore also finished the year with a .930 fielding percentage, and recorded multiple hits 13 times.
- Senior Terrell McCall rounded out the preseason selections, earning Second Team honors as a reliever a position he switched to for the 2018 season. McCall finished last year with 19 appearances, and finished with a 2-2 record and four saves in 33.0 innings pitched in his first season out of the bullpen. He recorded a 4.64 earned run average and allowed 21 runs 17 earned while allowing opponents to hit just .237 last season. McCall walked just 14 and struck out 40 in 2018.

VAZQUEZ NAMED TO #TOP10UNDER40 BY BASEBALL AMERICA

- Jose' Vazquez was recently identified by Baseball America as one of the top head coaches in the country, according to the publication.
- Vazquez spent 14 seasons as an assistant coach under Mervyl Melendez, who made the top 10 under 40 in 2013, and took over at Alabama State after Melendez was hired away by Florida International. Vazquez, a native of Puerto Rico, helped rebuild Alabama State's program and as head coach has guided the Hornets to back-to-back 30-win seasons and an appearance in the Southwestern Athletic Conference Tournament championship game.
- Vazquez was on the list that included Greg Lovelady
 of Central Florida, Jeff Duncan of Kent State, Matt Riser
 of Southeastern Louisiana, Shawn Stiffler of VCU, Jeff
 Mercer of Indiana, Justin Blood (Hartford), Ben Orloff of UC
 Irvine, T.J. Bruce of Nevada and Rucker Taylor of Davidson.

WHITE RETURNS AFTER MISSING ALL OF LAST SEASON

- Eriq White returns to the Alabama State lineup after missing all of last season for the Hornets due to oreseason surgery.
- Even after missing all of last seasn, he was named First Team as a third baseman entering the 2019 season.
- As a sophomore, White was a First Team Preseason honoree and hit .282 that season in 46 games. He recorded 40 hits in 142 official at-bats and scored 24 runs, while knocking in another 15. White recorded five doubles and hit one home run as a sophomore, a year after being named the 2016 SWAC Freshman of the Year and selected as a First Team All-Conference member.

KELLY RETURNS AFTER TOMMY JOHN SURGERY, BACK IN ROTATION

- Darren Kelly led the nation in strikeouts with 41 through three starts last season before he flet a pop in his throwing shoulder against Alabama ASM.
- Prior to his arm injury, he recorded a school record 16 strikeouts against Southern (2/23), and then followed that up with another 14 against Alcorn State (3/2). He also had four in three innings against Alabama A&M (3/9) before leaving with the arm injury.
- Before the injury Kelly went 2-0, 1.96 with 41 strikeouts in 21 innings pitched.

FORMER HORNET ELECTED TO SWAC HALL OF FAME

 Former Alabama State University student-athlete and coach, Larry Watkins, was one of seven individuals selected as a member of the 2018 Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) Hall of Fame class, announced by the



- conference office.
- Watkins joins Alcorn State's Dave Washington, Jr., Grambling State's Ralph A. Garr, Sr., Jackson State's Eric Strothers, Prairie View A&M's Nathaniel Gross, Southern's Roger Cador, and longtime league administrator Lonza Hardy in this year's class. The class will be enshrined November 29 at the Sheraton in Birmingham (Ala.), with the induction set to being at 6 pm with a reception.
- The newest members of the Hall of Fame were selected from a list of nominees who were submitted by his or her respective institution. The nominees were then elected for induction by the selection committee from members appointed by SWAC Presidents and Chancellors.
- Watkins is synonymous with Alabama State baseball, having played for the team as a centerfielder nicknamed the "Toy Cannon." A member of the first Alabama State team to appear in the NCAA playoffs, the Hornet lifer coached the program for more than 30 years, amassing a school-record 513 victories and numerous postseason appearances. Watkins was named SWAC Coach of the Year in 1991 and twice won Eastern Division Coach of the Year honors.
- Currently, he serves as a Special Assistant to the Athletic Director at his alma mater, and the Hornets' home field carries his namesake alongside former Alabama State coach Herbert Wheeler.
- Watkins becomes the 18th member of the SWAC Hall of Fame from Alabama State. He joins the likes of C.J. Dunn (1992), Severne Frazier (1992), John H. Jones (1993), G.H. Lockhart (1993), John Garrick Hardy (1994), Charles (Buddy) Spears (1994), Frank Lewis (1995), Jesse White (1995), Norman W. Walton II (1996), William B. Gary (1997), Eddie Robinson, Jr. (1998), Lewis Jackson (1999), James Oliver (2002), Horace Crump (2009), Reggie Barlow (2013), Steve Rogers (2015) and last year's inductee Shameka Jackson (2017).

SUCCESSFUL SUMMER STINTS FOR SEVERAL RETURNING HORNETS, AS WELL AS NEWCOMERS

- Several returning Alabama State baseball players who helped the Hornets claim the East Division crown in the SWAC, return to campus after successful summer stints.
- Santiago Garcia, who spent time as a catcher and designated hitter for Alabama State last season, returns for his sophomore season after being named the MINK Player of the Year and was named an All-Star. He also helped lead the Sedalia Bombers to the MINK League championship.
- Chris Lewis, who split time with Gustavo Rios at first base last season, returns for his sophomore season after being named a MINK League All-Star. He played alongside Garcia, and helped the Bombers to the league championship.
- Cristopher DeGuzman and Terrell McCalll each teamed up in the Valley League with the New Market Rebels to help the team win their league championship. Meanwhile, newcomer Trevor Jurievich, was named an MACL All-Star.

HERNANDEZ DRAFTED BY ATLANTA BRAVES IN 29th Round, who's next?

- Senior third baseman Ray Hernandez became the latest draftee from Alabama State in the MLB First-Year Player Draft as he was selected by the Atlanta Braves in the 29th round.
- Hernandez, who holds the school record in slugging percentage, doubles and home runs, was the 862nd overall pick in draft.
- The senior from Orlando (Fla.) was among the nations best in several categories as he led Alabama State to the East Division championship in the Southwestern Athletic

- Conference (SWAC) this season. He finished the season hitting .379 with 11 home runs both team highs for the Hornets and finished with 45 runs batted in and 46 runs scored. He also connected on 12 doubles and led the team with a .601 slugging percentage as the Hornets made the semifinals of the conference tournament.
- A two-time all-conference selection for the Hornets, Hernandez finishes his career leading the school with 35 home runs and second in runs batted in with 172. He was also named All-Tournament at the conclusion of the SWAC championship tournament after hitting .471 in five games with three doubles and four runs batted in.

GRAND SLAM CENTRAL - REACHED THREE
