ENTRY INTO EVENTS

There will be no admission to the Black & Gold Game inside ASU Stadium, or at the softball games against Alabama A&M inside the Barbara Williams Softball Complex.

Gates A, B and D will be open for those fans attending the Black & Gold game, and all fans are asked to sit in the lower bowl on the home side of the stadium. Gates will open at 9:30 am Saturday morning for the Spring Game. Admission is \$5 for each home baseball game at the Wheeler-Watkins Baseball Complex, with gates opening one hour prior to the games.

High School bands attending the game will enter through Gate E.

PARKING ON FAN-FILLED WEEKEND

Parking will be available throughout campus throughout the weekend for each event taking place on the Alabama State University campus.

RV parking will be located in the grass area behind the museum adjacent to the Wheeler-Watkins Baseball Complex, and in the upper Dunn-Oliver Acadome parking lot. No RVs will be allowed to park in the parking lot adjacent to the Barbara Williams Softball Complex / Wheeler-Watkins Baseball Complex due to games at both of those facilities.

Admissions will be holding a College Fair inside ASU Stadium on Saturday morning, beginning at 9:30 and running until 11:30 am. The College Fair is open to all prospective students, and will take place under the Jumbotron on West Side of the stadium.

Concessions will be open throughout the day inside ASU Stadium, with concessions stands 112 and 103 open for the contest. Meanwhile, concessions will be available inside the Barbara Williams Softball Complex and the Wheeler-Watkins Baseball Complex.

No golf carts will be allowed on campus during the weekend due to all of the activities taking place.

** Approximately the size of a hand with or without a handle or strap no larger 4.5" x 6.5"
