OPENING KICK

- Alabama State looks to rebound after a season-opening loss to UAB
 on the Thursday night, 24-19, in which they had a pair of opportunities
 to pull the upset. The Hornets had the ball inside the five and were
 unable to score, and also had the ball in their hands in the last minute.
- Alabama State had three individuals who were recognized for their play against UAB. Irshaad Davis was named the STATS FCS Freshman of the Week honorable mention after forcing a pair of fumbles in his first collegiate game. Meanwhile, Anthony Craven (Special Teams Player of the Week) and Duran Bell (Newcomer of the Week) were each honored by the conference office.
- A win Thursday night would be the second consecutive season that the
 Hornets will have defeated Tuskegee at home, both under Eley. Last
 season, they defeated Tuskegee in overtime at the Labor Day Classic to
 kick off the season. Alabama State has not won back-to-back games
 against Tuskegee since 1994-1995, when they were in the midst of
 nine-game winning streak in the rivarly.
- Alabama State and Tuskegee have met two times in the Labor Day Classic (splitting both contests), however, the two teams used to play annually in the Turkey Day Classic. Tonight's game marks the 102nd meeting between the two teams, with Tuskegee holding a 62-36-3 overall lead.
- Carl Thompson and Leeward Brown, from Alabama State, both had brothers who played for Tuskegee.
- Alabama State's all-time winningest coach, Houston Markham (Jr.), won both of his games against UAB during his career. The 11-year head coach passed away earlier this summer, but not before he finished with a 65-50-4 record (before forfeits handed a few more wins) from 1987 through 1997.

KEY STORYLINES

- The meeting will be just the second all-time for Alabama State head coach Donald Hill-Eley at the helm of the Hornets. He won his first and only meeting at the helm of the Hornets last season in overtime.
- Alabama State has not won back-to-back games against Tuskegee since 1994-1995, when they won nine games straight in the series - the longest for the Hornets. They also won six straight against Tuskegee from 1975 to 1980.



Duran Bell was named SWAC Newcomer of the Week after rushing for 112 yards on 10 carries in a season-opening 24-19 loss to UAB last Thursday night.

Interviews

In order to have time to arrange for player interviews, please provide 48 hours notice to the Athletic Strategic Communications Office. Player interviews may be conducted at the Houston Markham Football Complex or in the Athletic Strategic Communications Office. The Alabama State training rooms, locker rooms, weight room and meeting room areas are off-limits to the media. Your cooperation is appreciated.

For telephone interviews, the student-athlete will be provided with the number and will make the call at a mutually-agreed upon time. Phone numbers of student-athletes will NOT be made available to the media. For interviews with head football soccer coach **Donald Hill-Eley** and/or Alabama State assistant coaches, please contact **Travis Jarome** in the Athletic Strategic Communications Office.

In general, Alabama State practices, held at the Houston Markham Complex, are open to the local media and the public.

In general, individual game credentials will not be mailed but can be picked up in the Athletic Strategic Communications Office the week of the game, or at the ASU Stadium.

Press Row Services

A media workroom is located on the pressbox level of ASU Stadium. Game notes, rosters, programs and other information will be available in this room prior to games. Half-time and post-game statistics will be delivered to press row as soon as possible. Complete post-game box scores will be available approximately 20 minutes after the game.

Alabama State head coach **Donald Hill-Eley** and selected players will meet with the media each Wednesday at 11 a.m. during the season. Requests for specific players should be made to the Athletics Strategic Communications Office on Sunday afternoon prior to the press opportunity.

LEGEND PASSES AWAY THIS SUMMER

Alabama State's all-time winningest football coach, Houston Markham, Jr. passed away this summer in Montgomery.

Markham, the winningest head coach in Hornets' football history, leaves behind a legacy unmatched at Alabama State. He coached at the institution from 1987 until 1997, leaving the school with 68 victories which still stands as the highest total among any coach in school history.

His best season at the helm of the Hornets came in 1991 when the team finished 11-0-1, winning the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) championship. The only blemish on the record for the Hornets that season came against Texas Southern when the two teams tied at 14-all, as the Hornets raced to the HBCU National Championship with a 36-13 victory over North Carolina A&T in the Alamo Heritage Bowl.

Markham, who finished with a career record of 68-47-4 (.588), also had four players drafted in the National Football League (NFL) draft during his tenure.

HORNETS PICKED FOURTH IN SWAC

Alabama State (4-7, 3-4 a season ago), was picked behind defending champion Alcorn State in the East Division. Alabama A&M and Jackson State were each picked above the Hornets in the preseason poll, while Mississippi Valley State was picked to finish fifth. In the West Division, defending division champion Southern was picked ahead of Prairie View A&M and Grambling State; while Texas Southern and UAPB were picked fourth and fifth respectively.

FIVE NAMED ALL-SWAC

Alabama State had five players selected as Preseason All-SWAC on a vote by the league's head coaches and sports information directors this summer.

The Hornets had four players named First Team All-Conference and one other named Second Team. On the defensive side of the football, Christian Clark was named First Team on the defensive line after playing in 11 games on the interior line. He recorded 53 total tackles, fifth highest total on the team and recorded 22 solo stops. The redshirt junior garnered 5.0 tackles for loss, totaling 11 yards and recorded a pair of pass breakups on batted balls. Clark finished with a quarterback hurry and one fumble recovery, while also recorded a blocked kick.

He was joined on the defensive side of the ball on the first team by returning starting linebacker Darron Johnson who was named Second Team at the conclusion of last season. Johnson led the team in tackles with 78 despite missing the Prairie View A6M contest. The junior had 29 solo stops on the season and also recorded 5.0 tackles for loss. He also recorded 0.5 sacks (three yards) and had two interceptions – one of which he returned for a 27-yard touchdown for his first career score. Johnson recorded five or more tackles nine times this past season, including a career-high 14 against Alcorn State. He recorded eight against Tuskegee in the season opener and had seven against Grambling State.

The Hornets also had a pair of specialists named First Team this season, including punter Anthony Craven. The senior, in

his first year with the Hornets, took over for all-conference performer Trevor Vincent and responded by ranking 18th in the country in punting (second in the conference) at a 42.7-yard average. The junior punted the ball 78 times for 3,310 total yards, while recording four touchbacks and forced seven fair catches. Craven pinned Alabama State opponents inside the 20 on 29 occasions and has 20 punts of 50 or more yards, including a career-high 80-yard punt against South Alabama. Meanwhile, Ezra Gray was named First Team return specialist after he became one of the most respected kick returners in the conference, forcing teams to kick the ball away from him midway through the 2018 season after returns of 72 yards and 99 yards (called back from touchdown) in the first three weeks of the season. Gray finished in the top 50 in the nation (third in the conference) in combined kick returns, and in the top 75 in the nation (third in the conference) in kickoff returns at 23.4. He was also in the top 100 in the nation (fifth in conference) in all-purpose yards per game, while also leading the team in rushing.

Senior defensive back Joshua Hill was the fifth player to earn All-Conference honors as he was named Second Team entering 2019. Hill played in 11 games and finished third on the team in tackles with 61, while recording 41 solo stops. He recorded one tackle for loss from safety position and recorded a pair of interceptions on the season. Hill finished the season with three pass breakups, a fumble recovery and forced three fumbles.

THOMPSON NOMINATED FOR GOOD HANDS AWARD FOR SECOND STRAIGHT YEAR

Alabama State senior offensive lineman Carl Thompson has been named one of 137 nominees across each division of college football for the 2019 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®, the only nominee from the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC). It is the second consecutive year that Thompson has been nominated for the award.

Across America, many college football players receive praise for their superior performance on the field. Today, however, only a select group of those student-athletes have the honor of being commended for their distinguished accomplishments off the field when Allstate Insurance Company and the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) announce 169 nominees for the 2018 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®.

The Allstate AFCA Good Works Team® has been one of the most esteemed honors in college football for more than 25 years. The student-athletes who are nominated for this award not only demonstrate a unique dedication to community service and desire to make a positive impact on the lives around them, but they also show tremendous perseverance as well as the ability to overcome personal struggles and come out victorious against all odds.

NINE NAMED PHIL STEELE PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Alabama State had nine players named to the 2019 Phil Steele All-SWAC team announced by the publication. The Hornets were represented on each side of the ball by the publication, including three on the First Team. A pair of specialists - Anthony Craven (punter) and Eza Gray (return specialist) were named to the first team, alongside Christian Clark



CLOSING IN ON 500

After last season, Alabama State is just three wins shy of 500 all-time. The Hornets have compiled a 497-478-41 record in their history entering 2019.

Duran Bell became the first Alabama State running back to hit the century mark this season running the football. The transfer sophomore used a 67-yard first quarter touchdown run against UAB to finish the night with 112 yards on 10 carries.

Senior tight end Larry Brown III entered the season opener with three career receptions, but left the contest doubling his career output. The senior hauled in five receptions from quarterback KHA'Darris Davis to catch two more passes than he had for his career coming in.

DAVIS NAMED HONORABLE MENTION FCS FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Alabama State freshman Irshaad Davis was named honorable mention STATS FCS Freshman of the Week for his performance against UAB Thursday night.

Davis, who saw action at safety and on special teams, in his first collegiate game and led the Hornets with seven total tackles, including six solo stops in a 24-19 loss to FBS-member and defending Conference USA champion UAB. He also forced a pair of fumbles, including one inside the team's 10-yard line.

BELL NAMED SWAC NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

Duran Bell was named the Newcomer of the Week after he finished with a career-high 112 yards on 10 carries in the Hornets' 24-19 loss to FBS-member and defending Conference USA champion UAB Thursday night. The redshirt sophomore touched the ball for the first time on offense and scored on a 67-yard run to tie the game against the Blazers in the first quarter. He ended the night averaging 11.2 yards per carry, while also catching three passes for eight yards.

CRAVEN NAMED SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Anthony Craven was named the Special Teams Player of the Week after was forced to punt nine times on the night as the two teams combined for 17 total punts. He finished the night averaging 49.1 yards per punt - two yards above his career average - with a long of 64 yards. He also hit three inside the 20 and allowed just two punts. He recorded six punts over 50 yards in the loss.

CRAVEN NAMED TO PRESEASON WATCH LIST

Anthony Craven was one of 28 punters from across the country named to the inaugural FCS Punter of the Year Preseason Watch List, announced by the Augusta Sports Council Friday morning.

The senior, in his first year with the Hornets in 2018, took over for all-conference performer Trevor Vincent, and responded by ranking 18th in the country in punting (second in the conference) at a 42.7-yard average.

He finished the season with 78 punts for 3,310 yards, while recording four touchbacks and forced seven fair catches. Craven pinned Alabama State opponents inside the 20 on 29 occasions and had 20 punts of 50 or more yards, including a career-high 80-yard punt against South Alabama.

Craven was named All-Conference for his efforts last season and earned First Team Preseason All-SWAC honors this season.

The Council, who also selects the Ray Guy Award recipient at the FBS level, will announce the 10 semifinalists in November and three finalists in early December. The winner will be announced in early January.

They are joined on the team by defensive back Irshaad Davis who played at Carol City High School, and defensive back Jeffrey Hill who played for Cogdell in high school.

GRAY NEARING 1,000 CAREER YARDS

Ezra Gray enters the second week of the season needing just 248 yards to reach 1,000 for his career. He rushed for 384 yards on 100 carries last season. His best game last season was when he rushed for 130 yards on 20 carries in a loss to Grambling State.

He recorded 34 yards on six carries against UAB, averaging 5.7 yards per carry on the night.

HILL RANKS IN TOP 10 IN SINGLE-SEASON PUNT RETURN AVERAGE AFTER 2018

Joshua Hill sits eighth at the school for punt returns in a single season. The senior returned just eight punts last year, but registered 114 yards and averaged 14.3 yards per return.

CRAVEN SECOND IN PUNTING AT ALABAMA STATE AFTER FIRST YEAR

Anthony Craven is second at the school in punting just after one season. He booted the ball 78 times for an average of 42.7 vards.

CRAVEN RECORDS BEST NIGHT AT ALABAMA STATE IN CAREER

Anthony Craven recorded his best night as a Hornet against UAB when he averaged 49.1 yards per punt and had six punts

go over 50 yards including a 64-yarder.

HANSON RETURNS FOR JUNIOR SEASON

Hanson needs just six points to hit 100 during his junior year. He has 93 career points after a 52 point sophomore season.

ALABAMA STATE - TUSKEGEE TIES

Alabama State and Tuskegee have a couple of ties heading into the contest this season. Offensive linemen Leeward Brown and Carl Thompson are brothers of former Tuskegee players Leeward Brown and Osband Thompson - both of who have graduated.

OVERTIME LAST YEAR ENDED STREAK

Alabama State ended a winless streak against Tuskegee (0-2) inside ASU Stadium last season with an overtime win. After forcing a field goal opportunity that was eventually blocked, Alabama State answered on the first play with a sweep to Ezra Gray for the winning score.

ATTENDANCE

Alabama State played in front of the third-largest crowd to watch a UAB contest (over 39,000) and will enter the stadium to face Tuskegee looking to set a new record of 27.501. The stadium mark is 27.500 and the top three attendance marks have all come against the Golden Tigers.

HOLDING OPPONENTS UNDER 200 YARDS RUSHING / 150 YARDS PASSING

Alabama State held UAB to under 200 yards rushing and 150 yards passing in the season opener. The Blazers were able to get just 176 yards on the ground as a team, and threw for just 114 on the Hornets' defense.

STADIUM INFORMATION

ASU Stadium on the campus of Alabama State University in Montgomery, Alabama is a 26,500-seat stadium that replaces the Cramton Bowl as the host venue for the Alabama State Hornets football team. The first game in the New ASU Stadium was the 89th Turkey Day Classic on November 22, 2012 in which the Hornets hosted the Tuskegee Golden Tigers. The game was a sell-out and was televised nationally on ESPNU.

The stadium's current capacity sits at 26,500 but the project was designed to allow for future expansion that can expand the capacity to 55,000.

The stadium also holds a restaurant and retail space which welcome visitors to the stadium and area 365 days a year.



HEAD COACH, DONALD HILL-ELEY



Donald Hill-Eley is in his third season at Alabama State University, and was named the Head Football Coach of the program on December 7 following a stint as the Interim Head Coach.

Eley was named to the Interim role on October 6 after an O-5 start to the season, and guided the Hornets to five wins in their final six games including a victory in the Magic City Classic over Alabama A&M and a pair of wins on opponents' homecoming weekends. He also guided the

Hornets to four road wins to close the season, all in conference play.

He came to Alabama State after a one-year stint as wide receivers coach at Norfolk State, and was responsible tight ends and special teams.

During the 2016 season, Alabama State used four quarterbacks who combined to throw for 1,824 yards, while averaging 165.8 per game. Also the quarterbacks tossed 11 touchdown passes.

Last season ASU used three quarterbacks who combined to throw for 2,104 yards and 14 touchdowns while completing 60 percent of their passes.

ASU's passing game averaged 191.3 yards per game which was sixth in the SWAC. Their 60.1 percent completion percentage was second and its 7.1 yards per completion was fourth.

The long-time Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) coach spent 13 seasons at Morgan State (2001-13). After his first season as offensive coordinator, Eley spent the final 12 as head coach and was named 2002 MEAC Coach of the year. His 59 wins rank third all-time in Bears' history.

He spent four seasons at Hampton (1997-2000) as offensive coordinator and pro liaison, helping the Pirates win an HBCU National Championship, two MEAC titles, and the 1999 Heritage Bowl.

Eley spent four seasons in professional football in the Canadian Football League, first with the Baltimore Stallions (1994-95) as receivers coach before two seasons with the Toronto Argonauts as a guest coach (1996-97). Hill was on the staff of three straight Grey Cup championship teams (1995-97) during his time in the CFL.

After graduating from Virginia Union, he entered the coaching ranks at his alma mater in 1991 before becoming a graduate assistant at Hampton in 1992, where he received his master's in counseling in 1995. He is presently completing his Ph.D. at Morgan State. Eley is a member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., and a Prince Hall Mason. He is the father of Ayinde (16) and Jacob (7).

He is married to the former Kelley Butler.

ALABAMA STATE 19 UAB 24

LEGION FIELD • BIRMINGHAM, AL August 29, 2019 • Attendance: 39, 165

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. I Alabama State came up short in its bid to pull off the upset of an FBS opponent, falling to UAB 24-19 in front the third largest crowd in UAB history (39,165) Thursday night at Legion Field.

Duran Bell led Alabama State (0-1) with a career-high 112 yards on the ground on just 10 carries that included a 67-yard first quarter touchdown. Larry Brown III also turned in a career night for the Hornets as he caught five passes for 25 yards, while Irshaad Davis led the defense in his first collegiate game with seven tackles and two forced fumbles.

The Hornets had their chances during the contest, forcing a pair of turnovers and getting inside the three-yard line in the fourth quarter. They got the ball with just three minutes remaining in the contest and moved the ball across midfield, until an interception ended the contest.

How They Scored

UAB got on the board first with a one-yard run by Tyler Johnston III with 8:55 to play in the first quarter to cap off a nine-play, 84-yard drive.

Alabama State answered with a 67-yard run by Bell with 8:13 to play in the quarter (just 42 seconds after the Blazers' score) to cap off a two-play drive and tie the game at 7-all. The Hornets took advantage of a turnover and scored when KHA'Darris Davis hit Tyrek Allen for a 16-yard catch and run, giving Alabama State a 13-7 lead with 8:01 left to play in the opening frame.

UAB took a 14-13 lead with 7:43 to play in the opening quarter when Myron Mitchell took the ensuing kickoff 98-yards for a score. The Blazers would add a 46-yard field goal by Nick Vogel (10:33) and a 23-yard pass from Johnston to Kendall Parham (4:39) to take a 24-13 lead into the hreak.

Alabama State added the final score of the game in the third quarter with 5:31 to play as Davis hit Joshua Knight over the middle with a 7-yard touchdown.

Key Stat of the Game

Alabama State ran the ball 32 times for 145 net yards, while UAB finished the night with just 176 on the ground on 46 carries. The Hornets averaged 4.5 yards per carry, compared to UAB's 3.8 yards per carry.

Although the defense did not have a sack on the night, they recorded four tackles for loss (14 yards) and had a quarterback hurry with their new defensive scheme. The defense held UAB to 0-10 on third down attempts until 5:24 in the fourth, UAB finished the game 1-13.
