STORY LINES

- Alabama State made an appearance on the ESPN Top 10 after their buzzer-beating victory over Southern, 66-64 [1/25/21] on Monday at the Dunn-Oliver Acadome.
- The Hornets ended an 11-game losing streak to Texas Southern [2/3/20] at home last season, winning at the Dunn-Oliver Acadome, 79-55.
- The Hornets are one of just a few teams who have not been paused, and are the only team that has played all of their Southwestern Athletic Conference [SWAC] games to date - five - so far since January.
- Alabama State ended a 10-game losing streak dating back to last season with their 64-51 victory over Mississippi Valley State [1/12/21]. The game was originally scheduled for Monday night, but was moved due to a winter storm that came through the area.
- Alabama State head coach **Mo Williams** was on the sideline for the first time this season against Mississippi Valley State [1/12/21], picking up his first career win as a head coach.
- Williams follows eight of the previous 11 coaches who all recorded winning records in their first season. The last coach to record a winning record in their season was James Oliver [1978-79].
- Alabama State's game against Jackson State was the first Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) game televised this season as it was broadcast nationally on ESPNU. It is the only scheduled appearance for the Hornets this season on the ESPN family of networks.
- Alabama State last made the NCAA Tournament in 2011, losing to UTSA in the opening round. They also made the tournament in 2001, 2004 and 2009.
- Alabama State has logged 20-plus win 13 times, including 30 during the 1979-80 season in which they won 30 games.
- Texas Southern coach **Johnny Jones** was on the Alabama coaching staff in 2000-01, right before Williams arrived on campus as a player. Both have ties to the Southeastern Conference [SEC], with Williams playing at Alabama and Jones playing his college games at LSU.

QUICK HITS ...

- ◆ Alabama State head coach **Mo Williams** and assistant **Andrew Steele** each played their collegiate basketball at the University of Alabama, although not at the same time. Williams was named *The Sporting News* Freshman of the Year, and led the Crimson Tide to their only number one ranking in school history.
- ◆ Assistant coach **Trey Johnson** played at a pair of Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) schools during his playing career, finishing 10th in the nation in scoring during his junior season at 23.5 points per game and was named First Team All-SWAC. After declaring for the 2006 NBA Draft, Johnson returned to school and was named the Preseason SWAC Player of the Year and Preseason All-American. During his senior season, he set a single season record for points in a single game, points per game average (27.1), free throws made, and free throws attempted. He finished his career as a member of the 1,000-point club with 1,698 career points — placing in the top 10 in school history in just 2 seasons at JSU. Johnson also led Jackson State to 21 wins and the SWAC Tournament, earning Tournament MVP honors and was named the SWAC Player of the Year.
- ◆ Both Williams and Johnson played with two of the greats from the National Basketball Association (NBA) during their professional careers. Both played with LeBron James, while Johnson had the opportunity to play with Kobe Bryant.

ADDING SEVEN OR MORE NEWCOMERS ...

- ◆ Alabama State finds itself on a list that not many teams like to find themselves, one in which they add seven or more newcomers to a team to start the season. The Hornets, originally made the list with just seven, but added another near the beginning of the summer to give them eight.
- ◆ The Hornets join a list of 55 teams that added seven or more newcomers for the 2020-21 season. The list is headed by Arkansas with 12, followed by four schools with 11 (Alcorn State, Arizona, Seattle, and South Dakota). Six other schools are in double digits with 10 newcomers (Boise State, East Tennessee State, James Madison, Kentucky, Siena and Troy).
- ◆ The Hornets are among 27 schools who have eight newcomers on the roster.
- ◆ Ironically, of the 55 schools on the list, the Hornets play just one - Alcorn State - who has a former Hornet on their roster as a graduate transfer (Jacoby Ross).

NUMBER CHANGES FROM 2019-20 TO CURRENT SEASON ...

- ◆ Alabama State has quite a bit of number changes heading into the 2020-21 season, including a jersey swap on a newcomer during preseason practice as **Jordan Cousin** went from 32 to 5 before stepping on the floor for the Hornets.
- ◆ Senior point guard **DJ Heath** went from 0 to 3 for his final season, while fellow senior **Brandon Battle** went from 14 to 1 for his final season in Montgomery. Meanwhile, **Kezion Stewart** went from 24 to 15.

CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE ...

- ◆ **Mo Williams** and **DJ Heath** are not the only ones to have championship pedigree on this year's team. Senior **Kezion Stewart** has championship pedigree as his father, Dwight, played for the national champion Arkansas Razorbacks.

A WIN WOULD ...

- ◆ Be the third in the career of **Mo Williams** as a head coach.
- ◆ Be the second win in 14 games for the Hornets against Texas Southern, after ending an 11-game losing streak to the Tigers last season at home.
- ◆ Be the first in the Texas Southern series for Williams.
- ◆ Be the third conference win for the Hornets in 2021.

RETURNING FIVE OR LESS LETTERMEN ...

- ◆ Alabama State is one of 23 schools that are returning five or less lettermen from the 2019-20 basketball season that was cut short due to COVID-19. (Only counted those players who earned letters, including walk-ons — so no redshirts/sit-out transfers counted).
- ◆ Kentucky returns the fewest players from last season with just two, while three other teams - Arkansas, East Tennessee State and Georgia Southern return three players each. Nine other schools - Kansas State, Arkansas State, Boise State, Iowa State, Montana, Sam Houston State, Seattle, Weber State and Xavier - return four each.
- ◆ Alabama State is among ten schools who return five letterwinners entering the 2020-21 season. They join Arizona, Holy Cross, Illinois State, LSU, Mississippi State, South Dakota, Southern Illinois, Troy, and Virginia Tech.
- ◆ Four other schools were just outside of five lettermen returning, as they have six returning from 2019-20. Those schools include Butler, James Madison, Southern Miss, and Tennessee Tech.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH FOR THE HORNETS ...

- ◆ Alabama State has several years of experience on the bench this season on the coaching staff with head coach **Mo Williams**, assistant coach **Trey Johnson**, and assistant coach **Tyrone Levett** all logging minutes in the pro ranks.
- ◆ Williams was drafted by Utah in 2003, and he would play his rookie season with the Jazz before spending the next four seasons with the Milwaukee Bucks. Williams played three seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers (2008-11) where he teamed up with LeBron James and helped the Cavs post a league-best 66 wins in 2008-09. Williams was selected to the NBA All-Star Game in his first season with Cleveland.
- ◆ After stints with the Los Angeles Clippers (2011-12), Portland Trail Blazers (2013-14), Minnesota Timberwolves (2014-15) and Charlotte Hornets (2015), Williams returned to Cleveland for the 2015-16 campaign. In his final season in the NBA, Williams and the Cavaliers defeated the Golden State Warriors in seven games to win the 2016 NBA Finals.
- ◆ Johnson began his professional career in 2007 and went on to play over 10 years in numerous countries all over the world. He spent parts of three NBA seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers, Toronto Raptors, Los Angeles Lakers, and New Orleans Hornets. Johnson was a member of the 2011 Lakers' playoff team as well. On his quest to become an NBA player, Trey also spent time in the NBA Development League, now known as the G-League, garnering NBA D-League All-Star honors twice (2008-09 and 2010-11). He earned Second Team D-League honors in 2008-09, and First Team honors in 2010-11 after leading the league in scoring at 25.5 points per game — while also scoring a league-high 48 points in a single game.
- ◆ Johnson also starred internationally where he competed as a member of the Qatar National Team in the Asian Cup, hosted by Japan in 2012. He helped the country earn a bronze medal in the tournament, while also competing in the 2015 Asia Championship and the GCC Championship (Saudi Arabia).
- ◆ Following his career with Alabama State, Levett worked out for the Miami Heat and Detroit Pistons before getting his career started in Ireland with the Gleneagle Lakers. After short stints with the Kentucky Reach (WBL) and Southern Crescent Lightning (WBA), Levett played two years in Austria before playing for the Vermont Frost Heaves (ABA).
- ◆ He also played for AD Vagos (Portugal), Jamtland Basket (Sweden), Niigata Albirex BB (Japan) and LF Basket Norrbotten (Sweden) before landing in Canada. While in Canada, he become one of the league's all-time top scorers playing for the Longdon Lightning (2011), Halifax Rainmen (2011-13) and Saint John Mill Rates (2013-until retirement).
- ◆ Levett was a three-time all-star during his career and led Vermont to the ABA championship, while also being named All-WBA while playing for the Southern Crescent Lightning.

SPEAKING OF PROFESSIONAL BASKETBALL ...

- ◆ Former Hornets **Tobi Ewuosho** and **Fausto Pichardo** each inked professional deals during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- ◆ Ewuosho signed his first professional contract to play overseas in Albania after a stellar senior season, while Pichardo inked a deal to play in Latin America.

BACK-TO-BACK DOUBLE-DOUBLES FOR STRAW ...

- ◆ After narrowly missing a pair of double-doubles on the opening weekend of the season, redshirt sophomore **Kenny Strawbridge** got his first ... and then his second ... in back-to-back games this past week on the road. And he did so on his birthday weekend no less, as he celebrated a birthday on Monday [1/11/21].
- ◆ Strawbridge scored a career-high 18 points and grabbed 10 rebounds against UAPB [1/9/21] in a loss on Saturday night, and followed that up with 11 points and a career-high 11 rebounds. He continues to lead Alabama State in scoring and rebounding through the first four games this season.
- ◆ **Tobi Ewuosho** recorded the school's lone double-double last season.

LAST TEAMS TO TAKE THE FLOOR IN 2020-21...

- ◆ Alabama State was one of just two teams in NCAA Division I who have not taken the floor although their conference has not opted out of the season. The Hornets joined Merrimack as the the final two teams to take the floor, after halting all basketball activities in early November.

IN THE SWAC ...

- ◆ Alabama State did not have a player picked for the preseason team in 2020-21 after having senior **Tobi Ewuosho** named to the second team last season. The only other player the Hornets had on the roster who earned an honor was **Jacoby Ross** who was awarded the Freshman of the Year, but transferred to Alcorn State for his final season.

GRADUATE SUITING UP FOR ALABAMA STATE ...

- ◆ Alabama State had one of their own graduate this past November in senior **Kevious Stewart**, who was awarded a scholarship prior to the shutdown. He is the son of former Arkansas standout Dwight Stewart. He got his first start this season against Jackson State [1/4/21].

COLLEGIATE HEAD COACHES WITH NBA PLAYING EXPERIENCE ...

- ◆ Alabama State's **Mo Williams** is one of 26 current NCAA Division I head men's basketball coaches with playing experience in the NBA. He is also one the youngest on the list.
- ◆ The list contains the likes of Steve Alford [Nevada], Tony Bennett [Virginia], Johnny Dawkins [Central Florida], Juan Dixon [Coppin State], Bryce Drew [Grand Canyon], Patrick Ewing [Georgetown], Penny Hardaway [Memphis], Steve Henson [UTSA], Fred Hoiberg [Nebraska], Juwan Howard [Michigan], Lindsey Hunter [Mississippi Valley State], Bobby Hurley [Arizona State], Larry Krystkowiak [Utah], Jim Les [UC Davis], Mark Madsen [Utah Valley], Donyell Marshall [Central Connecticut State], Cuonzo Martin [Missouri], Aaron McKie [Temple], John Pelphry [Tennessee Tech], Mark Pope [BYU], Terry Porter [Portland], Lorenzo Romar [Pepperdine], Jerry Stackhouse [Vanderbilt], Damon Stoudemire [Pacific], Darrell Walker [Arkansas-Little Rock], and Williams.

TATE CATCHES FIRE AGAINST UAPB ...

- ◆ Sophomore **LaTrell Tate** came off the bench against UAPB on the road [1/9/21] with 17 points off the bench in 27 minutes. He finished a perfect 100 [8-for-8] percent from the free throw line.

- ◆ The lead was extended to 52-50 on a **Brandon Battle** free throw with 38 seconds to play.
- ◆ Alcorn State was able to hold on for the win after a three-pointer and four free throws in the final seconds.
- ◆ The comeback was the largest of the season under first-year head coach Mo Williams, and was the largest comeback in a Southwestern Athletic Conference [SWAC] game for the Hornets in the last five years.

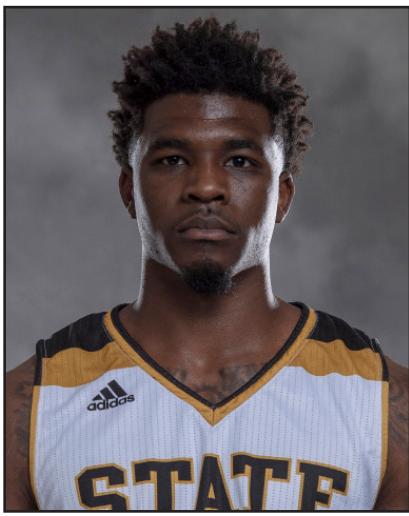

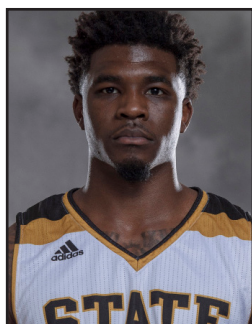
