#### STORY LINES

- Tonight's meeting will be the third meeting between Iowa State and Alabama State all-time, with all three meetings coming in Ames. The teams last met in November 2018, a 79-53 victory by the Cyclones.
- Tonight's game will be the fourth consecutive road game for the Hornets, with all four being shown on the ESPN platform on either ESPN3, ESPN+, or the SEC Network.
- Juan Reyna (San Antonio, Texas) is the only player on the roster to score in double figures in all three games.
- Gerald Liddell (Cibolo, Texas) is no stranger to Iowa State, having played previously at Texas another Big 12 school.
- Alabama State returns five players who saw significant playing time in 2021-22 including Second Team All-SWAC Preseason pick Kenny Strawbridge (Rockford, Ill.) who returns as the team's leading scorer.
- Several newcomers come to Alabama State this season with Division I experience including Young (Wyoming), Gerald Liddell (Texas), Isaiah Range (Tarleton State), Michael Barber (Howard), and Ashton McClelland (Texas Suuthern).
- The Hornets were picked to finish eighth in the preseason poll on a vote from the league's head coaches and sports information directors with 125 total votes. They were just behind Alcorn State (128) in seventh and Florida A6M (138) in sixth. The top five included Texas Southern (237), Prairie View A6M (204), Jackson State (202), Grambling State (168), and Southern (167)
- Alabama State has a strong Jackson connection with coaches Mo Williams and Trey Johnson. But it doesn't stop there
  as Director of Operations Dana Johnson is a Tiger alum, and two players have ties Michael Barber and Jayme Mitchell. It
  is the second season for Williams and Johnson leading the Alabama State program.
- Alabama State last made the NCAA Tournament in 2011, losing to UTSA in the opening round. They also made the tournament in 2001, 2004 and 2009.

#### **OUICK HITS ...**

- Alabama State head coach Mo Williams played his collegiate basketball at the University of Alabama. He was named The Sporting News Freshman of the Year, and led the Crimson Tide to their only number one ranking in school history.
- Assistant coach Trey Johnson played at a pair of Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) schools during his playing career, finishing 10th in the nation in scoring during his junior season at 23.5 points per game and was named First Team All-SWAC. After declaring for the 2006 NBA Draft, Johnson returned to school and was named the Preseason SWAC Player of the Year and Preseason All-American. During his senior season, he set a single season record for points in a single game, points per game average (27.1), free throws made, and free throws attempted. He finished his career as a member of the 1,000-point club with 1,698 career points placing in the top 10 in school history in just 2 seasons at JSU. Johnson also led Jackson State to 21 wins and the SWAC Tournament, earning Tournament MVP honors and was named the SWAC Player of the Year.
- Both Williams and Johnson played with two of the greats from the National Basketball Association (NBA) during their professional careers. Both played with Lebron James, while Johnson had the opportunity to play with Kobe Bryant during his time with the Los Angeles Lakers.

#### ALABAMA STATE RETURNS FIVE WITH SIGNIFICANT PLAYING TIME ...

- The Hornets return six players who saw significant playing time in 2020-21 including second-leading scorer Kenny
   Strawbridge (Rockford, Ill.) who averaged 10.5 points and 7.2 rebounds per game, earning Second Team Preseason All-SWAC.
- They also return Kevion Stewart (Memphis, Tenn.) who averaged 8.2 points per game, while Jordan O'Neal (Mobile, Ala.) returns after averaging 5.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and a team-high 23 blocked shots. Meanwhile, E.J. Clark (Dallas, Texas) averaged 5.8 points per game and DJ Jackson (San Bernardino, Calif.) at 4.4 points per game.

#### SEVERAL NEWCOMERS DOT THE HORNETS ROSTER THIS YEAR...

- Several newcomers highlight this year's roster including a handful of transfers starting with Trace Young (Owensboro, Ky.)
  who sat out last season. The junior averaged 9.8 points per game two seasons ago at John A. Logan College after averaging
  6.8 points at Wyoming as a freshman. He is joined by Michael Barber (Jackson, Miss.) who averaged 12.5 points and 7.1
  rebounds per game at SW Mississippi after playing a year at Howard.
- Christian McCray (Las Vegas, Nev.) will add a scoring punch after he transferred over last season from Cal State Fullerton, and is joined by Gerald Liddell (Cibolo, Texas) who transferred in from Texas averaging 4.4 points per game. The Hornets added two more transfers in Ashton McClelland (Houston, Texas) from Texas Southern and Isaiah Range (Cedar Hill, Texas) from Tarleton State where he averaged 9.4 points per game as a freshman.
- A trio of freshmen join the team this season in Juan Reyna (San Antonio, Texas), Darrell Reed (Hammond, Ind.), and Jayme

#### CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE...

- Mo Williams is not the only person on the this team to have championship pedigree on this year's team. Senior Kevion Stewart has championship pedigree as his father, Dwight, played for the national champion Arkansas Razorbacks.
- Four other schools were just outside of five lettermen returning, as they have six returning from 2019-20. Those schools include Butler, James Madison, Southern Miss, and Tennessee Tech.

#### PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH FOR THE HORNETS ...

- Alabama State has several years of experience on the bench this season on the coaching staff with head coach Mo Williams, assistant coach Trey Johnson, and assistant coach Tyrone Levett all logging minutes in the professional ranks.
- Williams was drafted by Utah in 2003, and he would play his rookie season with the Jazz before spending the next four
  seasons with the Milwaukee Bucks. Williams played three seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers (2008-11) where he teamed up
  with LeBron James and helped the Cavs post a league-best 66 wins in 2008-09. Williams was selected to the NBA All-Star
  Game in his first season with Cleveland.
- After stints with the Los Angeles Clippers (2011-12), Portland Trail Blazers (2013-14), Minnesota Timberwolves (2014-15) and Charlotte Hornets (2015), Williams returned to Cleveland for the 2015-16 campaign. In his final season in the NBA, Williams and the Cavaliers defeated the Golden State Warriors in seven games to win the 2016 NBA Finals.
- Johnson began his professional career in 2007 and went on to play over 10 years in numerous countries all over the world. He spent parts of three NBA seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers, Toronto Raptors, Los Angeles Lakers, and New Orleans Hornets. Johnson was a member of the 2011 Lakers' playoff team as well. On his quest to become an NBA player, Trey also spent time in the NBA Development League, now known as the G-League, garnering NBA D-League All-Star honors twice (2008-09 and 2010-11). He earned Second Team D-League honors in 2008-09, and First Team honors in 2010-11 after leading the league in scoring at 25.5 points per game while also scoring a league-high 48 points in a single game.
- Johnson also starred internationally where he competed as a member of the Qatar National Team in the Asian Cup, hosted by
  Japan in 2012. He helped the country earn a bronze medal in the tournament, while also competing in the 2015 Asia
  Championship and the GCC Championship (Saudi Arabia).
- Following his career with Alabama State, Levett worked out for the Miami Heat and Detroit Pistons before getting his career started in Ireland with the Gleneagle Lakers. After short stints with the Kentucky Reach (WBL) and Southern Crescent Lightning (WBA), Levett played two years in Austria before playing for the Vermont Frost Heaves (ABA).
- He also played for AD Vagos (Portugal), Jamtland Basket (Sweden), Niigata Albirex BB (Japan) and LF Basket Norrbotten (Sweden) before landing in Canada. While in Canada, he become one of the league's all-time top scorers playing for the Longdon Lightning (2011), Halifax Rainmen (2011-13) and Saint John Mill Rates (2013-until retirement).
- Levett was a three-time all-star during his career and led Vermont to the ABA championship, while also being named All-WBA while playing for the Southern Crescent Lightning.

#### SPEAKING OF PROFESSIONAL BASKETBALL ...

- Former Hornets Tobi Ewuosho and Fausto Pichardo each inked professional deals during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Ewuosho signed his first professional contract to play overseas in Alabania after a stellar senior season, while Pichardo inked a deal to play in Latin America.

#### LAST TIME AGAINST IOWA STATE (NOVEMBER 2018) ...

- Alabama State fell behind early and couldn't overcome the hot-shooting of Iowa State, falling 79-53 in front of 13,696 at the Hilton Coliseum.
- Iowa State (1-0) and Alabama State traded the first two baskets of game, both three pointers including one from Leon Daniels of the Hornets to tie the game at 3-all just 50 seconds into the contest. However, from there the Cyclones went on a 12-0 run over the next three minutes to take a 15-3 lead with 16:23 remaining in the first half. Alabama State (0-1) battled back to within seven with 15:30 to play in the half on baskets by Reginald Gee and Fausto Pichardo.
- The lead stayed at seven for the next three minutes until Iowa State pushed it out to 10, at 20-10 with 12:29 to play and kept it at double figures for the remaining of the first half.
- After the Cyclones pushed the lead to as many as 19 late in the first half, Alabama State fought back to within at 10 with 11:17 remaining in the contest. The Hornets used a three-pointer from Jacoby Ross with 15:03 remaining to pull to within 13.
- Gee led Alabama State with 15 points on 50 (5-of-10) percent shooting from the floor, while Leon Daniels added 11 in his first collegiate start including connecting on a trio of three-pointers. Johnson finished the night with 11 rebounds for the Hornets, while Gene Davis added four assists.

**RECORD WHEN..** 

#### THREE-HEADED MONSTER THROUGH FIRST TWO GAMES ...

- Trace Young, Isaiah Range and Juan Reyna led the Hornets in the first two games of the season on the scoreboard in games against WKU and Vanderbilt.
- The trio scored 53 points against WKU with Young leading the team with 23 points, while Reyna added 16 and Range 14. They then combined for 30 points against Vanderbilt with Young leading the way with 12, Reyna 10 and Range nine.

#### REYNA CONTINUES TO IMPRESS ...

- Juan Reyna continues to impress for Alabama State, becoming the first player this year to score in double figures in the first three games.
- He scored a career-high 16 against WKU (11/9/21), then added 10 against Vanderbilt (11/10/21) and another 10 against Missouri State (11/13/21) all on the road.

#### LIDDELL NO STRANGER TO IOWA STATE ...

- While no current Hornet has suited up in an Alabama State uniform, junior Gerald Liddell has as a member of the Texas Longhorns of the Big 12 before his transfer to Alabama State.
- Liddell played against the Cyclones back on March 2, 2019.

#### COLLEGE COACHES WITH AN NBA TITLE ...

- Opening the 2021-22 season there are only six head coaches who have won an NBA title and are leading their own college program this season.
- That list includes Juwan Howard (Michigan), Mo Williams (Alabama State), Lindsey Hunter (Mississippi Valley State), Darrell Walker (Little Rock), Mark Madsen (Utah Valley), and Speedy Claxton (Hofstra).

#### COLLEGE COACHES WITH AN NBA (AND ABA EXPERIENCE) ...

- There are several college coaches leading their own college program this season who have either NBA or ABA experience as a player.
- The list includes Steve Alford, Nevada, Speedy Claxton (Hofstra), Hubert Davis (North Carolina), Johnny Dawkins (Central Florida), Juan Dixon (Coppin State), Bryce Drew (Grand Canyon), Kim English (George Mason), Patrick Ewing (Georgetown), Penny Hardaway (Memphis), Steve Henson (Texas-San Antonio), Fred Hoiberg (Nebraska), Juwan Howard (Michigan), Lindsey Hunter (Mississippi Valley State), Bobby Hurley (Arizona State), Mark Madsen (Utah Valley State), Cuonzo Martin (Missouri), Aaron McKie (Temple), Fran O'Hanlon (Lafayette - ABA), Lorenzo Romar (Pepperdine), Jerry Stackhouse (Vanderbilt), Damon Stoudamire (Pacific), Reggie Theus (Bethune-Cookman), Darrell Walker (Little Rock), Mo Williams (Alabama State), and Mike Woodson (Indiana).

#### STRAWBRIDGE EARNS PRESEASON HONOR ...

- Alabama State redshirt sophomore Kenny Strawbridge (Rockford, Ill.) was named to the Second Team Preseason All-Conference team, announced by the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC).
- Strawbridge was second on the team in scoring last season at 10.5 points per game, scoring 189 total points in 18 games during the shortened season where the Hornets played conference-only games. He shot 35.9 (61-of-170) percent from the floor and 23.4 (11-of-47) percent from beyond the arc.
- The redshirt sophomore led the team from the free throw line, shooting 71.8 (56-of-78) percent from the free throw line. He was also second on the team in rebounding at 7.2 rebounds per game, grabbing 130 total including 32 offensive rebounds. #### **GAME RECAPS**

### GAME 1 WKU 79, Alabama State 74 November 9, 2021

**BOWLING GREEN, Ky. |** Trace Young (Owensboro, Ky.) narrowly missed a double-double at E.A. Diddle Arena on Tuesday night, but it wasn't enough to overcome a late Western Kentucky run as the Hilltoppers were able to escape with a 79-74 victory.

Young finished with a game-high 23 points on 56.3 (9-of16) percent shooting from the floor and grabbed nine rebounds in his debut for Alabama State, pacing three players in double figures for the Hornets. Juan Reyna (San Antonio, Texas) added 16 points in his collegiate debut, while Isaiah Range (Cedar Hill, Texas) added 14 points off the bench for the Hornets.

Alabama State (0-1) jumped ahead early and after WKU (1-0) tied the game at 5-all with 16:23 to play in the first half, they led until late in the second half. The Hilltoppers were able to take their first lead of the game with 4:02 remaining on one of their 17 free throws (out of 30 attempts) gave them a 64-63 lead. They were able to push the lead to seven (70-63) with 90 seconds to play before Alabama State trimmed it to four a pair of times.

The Hornets trimmed the lead to 75-72 with 21 seconds remaining on a pair of free throws by Reyna, one of nine (out of 11 attempts) by the Hornets. After WKU was able to extend the lead to 77-72, Alabama State answered with another two free throws by Reyna to get the deficit to 77-74 with nine seconds remaining before the Hilltoppers were able to put it away at the line.

Alabama State finished the night shooting 48.3 (28-of-58) percent from the floor and 40.9 (9-of-22) percent from beyond the arc, while WKU connected on 43.8 (28-of-64) percent from the floor and 31.6 (6-of-19) percent from beyond the arc.



### GAME 2 Vanderbilt 91, Alabama State 72 November 10, 2021

NASHVILLE, Tenn. | Despite shooting 50 percent from the floor Wednesday night, Alabama State couldn't withstand a pair of runs by Vanderbilt falling to the Commodores 91-72 on Wednesday night.


Alabama State (0-2), playing their second road game in as many days, outshot the Commodores from the floor despite taking eight less shots on the night. The Hornets hit 50 (26-of-52) percent from the floor and 31.6 (6-of-19) percent from beyond the arc.

They also connected on 82.4 (14-of-17) percent from the free throw line, but it was the turnovers and a big first half run that put room between the two teams. Alabama State was forced into 24 turnovers and gave up a 10-0 run early in the first, scored all by Myles Stute to extend the Commodores lead to 22-12 with 10:31 remaining in the first half.

The Hornets battled back but Vanderbilt (1-0) pushed the lead to 15 at the break and Alabama State was unable to recover

Trace Young (Owensboro, Ky.) led Alabama State with 11 points, while Jordan O'Neal (Mobile, Ala.) and Juan Reyna (San Antonio, Texas) added 10 in the loss. Isaiah Range (Cedar Hill, Texas) added nine off the bench, while Jayme Mitchell (Jackson, Miss.) and Christian McCray (Las Vegas, Nev.) added eight each.

Jordan Wright led Vanderbilt with 16 points, while Jamaine Mann recorded a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds. Scotty Pippen, Jr. added 15 and Stute 13 in the win. Vanderbilt finished the night shooting 45.3 (29-of-64) percent from the floor and 28.6 (8-of-28) percent from beyond the arc.



#### GAME 3 Missouri State 78, Alabama State 60 November 13, 2021


**SPRINGFIELD, Mo.** | Gerald Liddell (Cibolo. Texas) led four players in double figures for Alabama State as the Hornets dropped their third consecutive road game to open the season, falling to Missouri State 78-60 at JQH Arena on Saturday night.

Liddell finished the night 14 points on 6-of-13 shooting from the floor and picked up three steals, while Kenny Strawbridge (Rockford, III.) finished with 12 points on 5-of-10 shooting from the floor with a pair of blocked shots. Jordan O'Neal (Mobile, Ala.) chipped in with 11 points and a pair of blocked shots.

Juan Reyna (San Antonio, Texas) scored in double figures for the third consecutive game, adding 10 points with a pair of three-pointers for the Hornets who finished the night shooting 38.7 (24-of-62) percent from the floor. They also shot 21.1 (4-of-19) percent from beyond the arc and 66.7 (8-fo-12) percent from the free throw line.

Meanwhile, Isiaih Mosley led Missouri State (1-1) with 31 points on 12-of-22 shooting from the floor, while Gaige Prim finished with a double-double scoring 11 points and grabbing 14 rebounds.

Missouri State shot 42.9 (27-of-63) percent from the floor and 26.7 (8-of-30) percent from beyond the arc, while also shooting 84.2 (16-of-19) percent from the free throw line.
