# THE LEAD

Iowa State looks to surpass its win total from a season ago when it hosts Alabama State at Hilton Coliseum.

### **KEY STORYLINES**

- Iowa State plays its third-straight home game to open the season ... the Cyclones will play their first four games at home for the first time since the 2012-13 season.
- T.J. Otzelberger, who won his 100th game in the season opener, improved to 2-0 as head coach of the Cyclones ... he looks to become the fifth consecutive Cyclone coach to start 3-0.
- The Cyclones turned up the defense against Oregon State and held the Beavers to just 50 points on Friday in a 10-point win ... it was the fewest points by a power conference opponent against the Cyclones since Oklahoma State scored 50 in February of 2016.
- Gabe Kalscheur became the first Cyclone since Nick Weiler-Babb (2017-18) to lead the team in scoring in the season's first two games ... Kalscheur scored 15 in Friday's win.
- Izaiah Brockington also reached double

- figures and posted the first Cyclone double-double of the season with 10 points and 12 rebounds ... it was his first career double-double ... Brockington is averaging 14.0 points and 9.0 reb, the only Big 12 player averaging those marks.
- ISU's bench is averaging 25.0 points per game, led by 10.0 ppg from Caleb Grill ... Grill has a team-high five three-pointers and is shooting 45.5 percent from beyond the arc ... players off the bench are shooting 54.1 percent from the field.
- Tyrese Hunter is one of six freshman nationally averaging at least 6.0 assists per game after a seven assist performance on Friday night against the Beavers ... among them, he's one of just three averaging 10 points and six dimes.
- The Cyclones have snapped losing streaks of 18-straight games overall, eight home games and 25 games against power conference opponents.

# IN THE PAST...INTO THE FUTURE

### **LAST TIME OUT...**

■ Iowa State improved to 2-0 with a 60-50 win against Oregon State, snapping a 25-game losing streak to power conference opponents ... the Cyclone defense led the way, allowing OSU to shoot just 33.9 percent from the field, the lowest opponent field goal percentage since Texas shot 29.3 percent on Feb. 15, 2020 ... just two Cyclones reached double digits, led by Gabe Kalscheur with 15 points ... Izaiah Brockington recorded the first double-double by a Cyclone since Micheal Jacobson (vs. Texas, 2/15/2020) ... the Cyclones outrebounded the Beavers, 39-34 ... Tyrese Hunter dished out seven assists ... Tristan Enaruna matched his career high with two blocks.

■ Four straight at home to open the season as the Cyclones host Grambling State on Sunday, Nov. 21 at 5 p.m. Fans can get four 200-level tickets for just \$43 (\$10.75 per ticket).

### FROM THE NOTEBOOK

#### **QUICK HITS**

- Kalscheur is seventh in the Big 12 averaging 17.0 points per game ... Brockington is fifth in the league in rebounding with 9.0 rebounds per game.
- Iowa State is one of eight remaining Big 12 teams that are undefeated.
- The Cyclones have snapped a number of long losing streaks to start the season:
   18-game losing streak, 8-game home losing streak, 25 game losing streak to power conference opponents.
- Tyrese Hunter became the first Cyclone freshman to start a season opener since Talen Horton-Tucker in 2018.
- Hunter is assisting on 48.3 percent of ISU's field goals when he is on the floor
- Iowa State allowed just 0.69 points per possession against Oregon State, its fewest allowed against a power conference opponent since 2015 against Texas Tech ... it is also the fewest allowed against a power conference team in the nation this season.
- The Cyclones attempted 33 free throws in the opener, the most in the first game of the season since the 2014 opener against Oakland (37).
- ISU's 14 steals were the second most by a Cyclone team in the season opener going back to 2005-06 season (15 vs. Mississippi Valley in 2019).
- The Cyclones are shooting 64.9 percent on 2-point field goals, 14th nationally.
- Five Cyclones reached double figures in the opener ... ISU didn't have a single game during the 2020-21 season with five tallying double digits.
- Iowa State has trailed just 1:06 of the first two games with its biggest deficit being one point against Oregon State.
- The Cyclones are shooting 51.8 percent from the field in the second half.
- Caleb Grill is averaging 28.2 minutes per game, the most among reserves in the Big 12 Conference ... joins OSU's Bryce Thompson as only players in league to play multiple games off the bench and be averaging at least 10.0 ppg.

#### PROTECTING THE ROCK

Hunter has 12 assists and seven turnovers this season for a 1.71 assistto-turnover ratio, which ranks 12th in the Big 12 Conference ... he's had a positive assist-to-turnover ratio in his first two games.

### STREAKS OF NOTE

- 3 The Cyclones have won three consecutive games against nonconference opponents at Hilton Coliseum.
- 12 ISU has won 12 consecutive games when shooting 50 percent or better from the field ... in the season opener, the Cyclones snapped a 32-game streak of not shooting 50 percent.
- 7 Izaiah Brockington has connected on all seven free throws attempted this season.

#### **HOME SWEET HILTON**

Iowa State will play 19 games at Hilton Coliseum, the most since the 2010-11 campaign.

### **NEW LOOK CYCLONES**

- Along with a new coaching staff, Iowa State returned just five players (three scholarship) from last season's team ... the Cyclones have just 20 total starts back from last season, but no player with double-digit starts.
- It marks the first time since the 1997-98 season that the Cyclones officially returned no starters.
- ISU returned just 13.3 percent of its scoring, 25.6 percent of its rebounding and 24 percent of minutes played, all of which rank at the bottom of the Big 12 Conference.

### **ISU-ASU NOTES**

- Iowa State faces Alabama State for the third time in series ... the Cyclones have won the other two meetings by an average of 26.5 points ... ISU averaged 19.5 assists in the previous two meetings with the Hornets.
- Iowa State is 34-1 all-time against teams currently in the Southwestern Athletic Conference ... the only loss was a 2019 New Year's Eve setback to Florida A&M when the Rattlers were part of the MEAC ... today's game is the first of four games against the SWAC this season.
- Otzelberger is 4-0 against current members of the SWAC.
- Alabama State is coached by former NBA All-Star Mo Williams, who was an NBA World Champion in 2016 with the Cleveland Cays.
- George Conditt is the only Cyclone that has faced the Hornets before, scoring five points during his freshman season in 2018 ... Conditt blocked four shots in that game.
- Alabama State features former Texas Longhorn Gerald Liddell ... he played in one game against the Cyclones, scoring two points in a 2019 win in Austin ... in all, he played 35 games in three seasons for UT.

### FROM THE NOTEBOOK

#### **OTZ IS BACK!**

- After spending the last five seasons as head coach at South Dakota State and UNLV, T.J. Otzelberger has returned to Iowa State as the 21st head coach in program history.
- Otzelberger, the second youngest coach in the Big 12 Conference (44 years old), has averaged 19.8 wins per season and made three postseason appearances (2 NCAA/1 NIT).
- Otzelberger has been on staff for the school's previous three coaches: Greg McDermott, Fred Hoiberg and Steve Prohm.
- The last three Cyclone teams he worked with went 69-35 (.663) with NCAA Tournament appearances every season.
- Credited with signing or development of Cyclone greats like Royce White, Will Clyburn, Tyrus McGee, Georges Niang, Melvin Ejim, Monte Morris, Abdel Nader, Scott Christopherson, Matt Thomas, Naz Mitrou-Long and Deonte Burton, among others.
- At SDSU, coached three-time Summit League Player of the Year Mike Daum, who scored more than 3,000 career points.

#### POWER CONFERENCE REINFORCEMENTS

Of the 12 players on ISU's roster, seven are newcomers ... of those seven newcomers, four joined the Cyclones in the form of power conference transfers ... that total is tied for the most nationally:

#### MOST POWER CONFERENCE TRANSFERS ADDED

- 4 Iowa State, New Mexico, Texas A&M, TCU, Grand Canyon
- The four power conference transfers add significant experience to the roster to the tune of more than 2,000 points and 315 games played.

### **CONDITT CAN DO IT**

- After what he called a "horrible" junior season, senior big man George Conditt went overseas with Puerto Rico to play in the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournament and found his groove again.
- At the tournament, he shot 76.5 percent from the field and averaged 14.5 points ... against Serbia and Dallas Mavericks' Boban Marjanovic, Conditt scored 20 points.
- Conditt enters the season with 98 blocked shots, second most actively among Big 12 players.

### **ENARUNA ON THE WING**

- Tristan Enaruna, a Kansas transfer, is believed to be the first player to transfer to the Cyclones from a conference foe.
- The Almere, Flevoland, Netherlands, native gives the Cyclones a skilled win with great length ... can make plays off the dribble, finish at the rim and knock down perimeter shots.

 A four star and top-60 recruit, Enaruna is one of three Cyclones with international experience (Conditt, Puerto Rico; Kunc, Slovenia).

#### TRUE TO HIS WORD

- Freshman point guard Tyrese Hunter originally committed to Iowa State under former coach Steve Prohm ... Hunter stayed true to his word as Otzelberger rerecruited the Racine, Wisconsin, native to the school.
- Played at St. Catherine's for Nick Bennett, nephew of Dick Bennett and cousin of Tony Bennett, and helped the Angels to a 53-1 record his last two seasons ... won Division 3 state title as a senior.
- A consensus four-star recruit, was ranked No. 35 in 247sports composite, the second-highest ranked ISU recruit during the internet rankings era.

### FIRE UP THE GRILL.....AGAIN!

- Caleb Grill started his career at Iowa State in 2019 before transferring to play for Otzelberger at UNLV last season ... now he's back at Iowa State to play for Otzelberger, who he originally signed with at South Dakota State.
- Grill is one of five players in the nation's top six conferences to transfer back to their original school this season.
- The Wichita, Kansas, native tied for the team lead with 27 starts at UNLV and was fourth on the team averaging 9.1 ppg ... he was second on the team with 55 made 3-pointers.

### FROM THE NOTEBOOK

#### **ADDING SOME JAZ**

- Washington State transfer Aljaž Kunc was the first player to join Iowa State after T.J. Otzelberger was named head coach.
- Kunc provides the Cyclones with length as a skilled frontline player that has proven to have the ability as a Power-5 player to knock down threes and stretch the defense ... a highly active player that can rebound outside his area.
- Has connected on 54 career 3-pointers and shot nearly 80 percent from the charity stripe.

### **GO AHEAD, GABE!**

- In search of shooting last spring, the Cyclones added Minnesota transfer Gabe Kalscheur to the mix.
- Kalscheur immediately added leadership, toughness, defensive prowess and basketball IO to team.
- The Edina, Minnesota, native was a threeyear starter for the Gophers and a team captain ... he made 180 3-pointers in his three seasons in Minneapolis, including a Big Ten-best 76 threes in 2019-20.
- Kalscheur has proven multiple times that when he's hot, you get him the ball ... at Minnesota he hit four or more 3-pointers in 11 games, including games of 8-for-11, 7-for-9, 7-for-12, 6-for-8 and 6-for-6.

#### WHAT DO YOU ZAY?

- Izaiah Brockington had success at Penn State and Otzelberger is looking for more of the same at Iowa State.
- Brockington gives the Cyclones an experienced and physical playmaking guard ... Brockington is considered an elite rebounder at the guard position, having pulled down nearly five rebounds per game last season.
- The brighter the lights the better he played ... Brockington had some of his best performances against NCAA Tournament quality teams ... last season he scored 24 points against Virginia Tech and 21 against Illinois.

### **BIG ROB**

- Motor. Enthusiasm. Ability to run the floor ... Jones, a transfer from Denver, excels in those areas and is a physical defensive presence that proved during the recruiting process that his top priority was impacting a winning culture.
- On top of that, Jones connected on nearly 57 percent of his field goal attempts at Denver.

#### **HILTON MAGIC**

- Iowa State is playing its 51st season at Hilton Coliseum ... the arena opened in 1971 with a win against Arizona in the first game.
- ISU has recorded a 74.1 winning percentage (568-199) at the arena.
- ISU has ranked among the nation's top-30 teams in attendance the last nine non-Covid seasons.
- Hilton Magic was coined in 1989 by Des Moines Register sportswriter Buck Turnhull.

#### **IOWA STATE VS. RANKED OPPONENTS**

- Iowa State is 110-280 all-time against ranked opponents (at tip).


