STORY LINES

- Alabama State and North Alabama have not met since meeting twice during the 1980-81 season, although they were scheduled to play before the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Hornets have won back-to-back games at home and three dating back to Mobile on November 4. Two of the wins -Tuskegee and Mobile - were exhibition games.
- Alabama State completed a five game road swing to open the season with all five games shown nationally. The first four were shown on the ESPN platform on either ESPN3, ESPN+, or the SEC Network, while the Iowa game was on the Big Ten Network.
- Alabama State returns five players who saw significant playing time in 2021-22 including Second Team All-SWAC Preseason
 pick Kenny Strawbridge (Rockford, Ill.) who returns as the team's leading scorer.
- Several newcomers come to Alabama State this season with Division I experience including Young (Wyoming), Gerald Liddell (Texas), Isaiah Range (Tarleton State), Michael Barber (Howard), and Ashton McClelland (Texas Suuthern).
- The Hornets were picked to finish eighth in the preseason poll on a vote from the league's head coaches and sports information directors with 125 total votes. They were just behind Alcorn State (128) in seventh and Florida A&M (138) in sixth. The top five included Texas Southern (237), Prairie View A&M (204), Jackson State (202), Grambling State (168), and Southern (167).
- Alabama State has a strong Jackson connection with coaches Mo Williams and Trey Johnson. But it doesn't stop there
 as Director of Operations Dana Johnson is a Tiger alum, and two players have ties Michael Barber and Jayme Mitchell. It
 is the second season for Williams and Johnson leading the Alabama State program.
- Alabama State last made the NCAA Tournament in 2011, losing to UTSA in the opening round. They also made the tournament in 2001, 2004 and 2009.

OUICK HITS ...

- Alabama State head coach Mo Williams played his collegiate basketball at the University of Alabama. He was named The Sporting News Freshman of the Year, and led the Crimson Tide to their only number one ranking in school history.
- Assistant coach Trey Johnson played at a pair of Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) schools during his playing career, finishing 10th in the nation in scoring during his junior season at 23.5 points per game and was named First Team All-SWAC. After declaring for the 2006 NBA Draft, Johnson returned to school and was named the Preseason SWAC Player of the Year and Preseason All-American. During his senior season, he set a single season record for points in a single game, points per game average (27.1), free throws made, and free throws attempted. He finished his career as a member of the 1,000-point club with 1,698 career points placing in the top 10 in school history in just 2 seasons at JSU. Johnson also led Jackson State to 21 wins and the SWAC Tournament, earning Tournament MVP honors and was named the SWAC Player of the Year.
- Both Williams and Johnson played with two of the greats from the National Basketball Association (NBA) during their professional careers. Both played with Lebron James, while Johnson had the opportunity to play with Kobe Bryant during his time with the Los Angeles Lakers.

ALABAMA STATE RETURNS FIVE WITH SIGNIFICANT PLAYING TIME ...

- The Hornets return six players who saw significant playing time in 2020-21 including second-leading scorer Kenny
 Strawbridge (Rockford, Ill.) who averaged 10.5 points and 7.2 rebounds per game, earning Second Team Preseason All-SWAC.
- They also return Kevion Stewart (Memphis, Tenn.) who averaged 8.2 points per game, while Jordan O'Neal (Mobile, Ala.) returns after averaging 5.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and a team-high 23 blocked shots. Meanwhile, E.J. Clark (Dallas, Texas) averaged 5.8 points per game and DJ Jackson (San Bernardino, Calif.) at 4.4 points per game.

SEVERAL NEWCOMERS DOT THE HORNETS ROSTER THIS YEAR...

- Several newcomers highlight this year's roster including a handful of transfers starting with Trace Young (Owensboro, Ky.)
 who sat out last season. The junior averaged 9.8 points per game two seasons ago at John A. Logan College after averaging
 6.8 points at Wyoming as a freshman. He is joined by Michael Barber (Jackson, Miss.) who averaged 12.5 points and 7.1
 rebounds per game at SW Mississippi after playing a year at Howard.
- Christian McCray (Las Vegas, Nev.) will add a scoring punch after he transferred over last season from Cal State Fullerton, and is joined by Gerald Liddell (Cibolo, Texas) who transferred in from Texas averaging 4.4 points per game. The Hornets added two more transfers in Ashton McClelland (Houston, Texas) from Texas Southern and Isaiah Range (Cedar Hill, Texas) from Tarleton State where he averaged 9.4 points per game as a freshman.
- A trio of freshmen join the team this season in Juan Reyna (San Antonio, Texas), Darrell Reed (Hammond, Ind.), and Jayme

RARE FEAT - PAIR OF DOUBLE-DOUBLES IN SAME GAME ...

- Alabama State had a rare feat happen on Saturday in their home opener against North Carolina Central when a pair of players recorded a double-double in the same game.
- A pair of starters, **Gerald Liddell** and **Jordan O'Neal** recorded career nights in the win with Liddell finishing with 22 points and 11 rebounds, while O'Neal went for 19 points and 14 rebounds.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH FOR THE HORNETS ...

- Alabama State has several years of experience on the bench this season on the coaching staff with head coach Mo Williams, assistant coach Trey Johnson, and assistant coach Tyrone Levett all logging minutes in the professional ranks.
- Williams was drafted by Utah in 2003, and he would play his rookie season with the Jazz before spending the next four
 seasons with the Milwaukee Bucks. Williams played three seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers (2008-11) where he teamed up
 with LeBron James and helped the Cavs post a league-best 66 wins in 2008-09. Williams was selected to the NBA All-Star
 Game in his first season with Cleveland.
- After stints with the Los Angeles Clippers (2011-12), Portland Trail Blazers (2013-14), Minnesota Timberwolves (2014-15) and Charlotte Hornets (2015), Williams returned to Cleveland for the 2015-16 campaign. In his final season in the NBA, Williams and the Cavaliers defeated the Golden State Warriors in seven games to win the 2016 NBA Finals.
- Johnson began his professional career in 2007 and went on to play over 10 years in numerous countries all over the world. He spent parts of three NBA seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers, Toronto Raptors, Los Angeles Lakers, and New Orleans Hornets. Johnson was a member of the 2011 Lakers' playoff team as well. On his quest to become an NBA player, Trey also spent time in the NBA Development League, now known as the G-League, garnering NBA D-League All-Star honors twice (2008-09 and 2010-11). He earned Second Team D-League honors in 2008-09, and First Team honors in 2010-11 after leading the league in scoring at 25.5 points per game while also scoring a league-high 48 points in a single game.
- Johnson also starred internationally where he competed as a member of the Qatar National Team in the Asian Cup, hosted by Japan in 2012. He helped the country earn a bronze medal in the tournament, while also competing in the 2015 Asia Championship and the GCC Championship (Saudi Arabia).
- Following his career with Alabama State, Levett worked out for the Miami Heat and Detroit Pistons before getting his career started in Ireland with the Gleneagle Lakers. After short stints with the Kentucky Reach (WBL) and Southern Crescent Lightning (WBA), Levett played two years in Austria before playing for the Vermont Frost Heaves (ABA).
- He also played for AD Vagos (Portugal), Jamtland Basket (Sweden), Niigata Albirex BB (Japan) and LF Basket Norrbotten (Sweden) before landing in Canada. While in Canada, he become one of the league's all-time top scorers playing for the Longdon Lightning (2011), Halifax Rainmen (2011-13) and Saint John Mill Rates (2013-until retirement).
- Levett was a three-time all-star during his career and led Vermont to the ABA championship, while also being named All-WBA while playing for the Southern Crescent Lightning.

SPEAKING OF PROFESSIONAL BASKETBALL ...

- Former Hornets Tobi Ewuosho and Fausto Pichardo each inked professional deals during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Ewuosho signed his first professional contract to play overseas in Alabania after a stellar senior season, while Pichardo inked a deal to play in Latin America.

MCCRAY SETTLES INTO ROLE OFF THE BENCH FOR HORNETS ...

- Christian McCray seems to have settled into a role off the bench for Alabama State through the first five games of the season.
- The junior transfer from Cal State Fullerton came off the bench against Iowa on the road in the last game to score 20 points in just over 16 minutes of action. Couple that with a eight-point performance against Vanderbilt and McCray is averaging 1.1 points per minute played.
- He is also the second-leading scorer on the team through the first give games of the season at 10.0 points per game.

HOME SWEET HOME ...

- Alabama State played a rare November home game that is not listed as an exhibition when they take the floor against North Carolina Central. That is not the only home game however this calendar year.
- The Hornets have already had an exhibition game this season against Mobile at home, and they will play Tuskegee (11/22), North Alabama (11/28) and Samford (12/8).

RANGE RECORDS FIRST DOUBLE-DOUBLE ...

- Isaiah Range recorded the first double-double of the season for the Hornets in the loss to Iowa State (11/16/21) on the road.
- He scored 15 points on 7-of-13 shooting from the floor, and grabbed 10 rebounds (eight of which were defensive rebounds) to lead Alabama State in both categories.

THREE-HEADED MONSTER IN FIRST TWO GAMES ...

- Trace Young, Isaiah Range and Juan Reyna led the Hornets in the first two games of the season on the scoreboard in games against WKU and Vanderbilt.
- The trio scored 53 points against WKU with Young leading the team with 23 points, while Reyna added 16 and Range 14. They
 then combined for 30 points against Vanderbilt with Young leading the way with 12, Reyna 10 and Range nine.

REYNA IMPRESSIVE THROUGH FIRST THREE GAMES ...

- Juan Reyna continues to impress for Alabama State, becoming the first player this year to score in double figures in the first three games.
- He scored a career-high 16 against WKU (11/9/21), then added 10 against Vanderbilt (11/10/21) and another 10 against Missouri State (11/13/21) all on the road.

COLLEGE COACHES WITH AN NBA TITLE ...

- Opening the 2021-22 season there are only six head coaches who have won an NBA title and are leading their own college
 program this season.
- That list includes Juwan Howard (Michigan), Mo Williams (Alabama State), Lindsey Hunter (Mississippi Valley State), Darrell Walker (Little Rock), Mark Madsen (Utah Valley), and Speedy Claxton (Hofstra).

COLLEGE COACHES WITH AN NBA (AND ABA EXPERIENCE) ...

- There are several college coaches leading their own college program this season who have either NBA or ABA experience as a player.


The Hornets had four players in double figures led by Trace Young (Owensboro, Ky.) and Jordan O'Neal (Mobile, Ala.) with 12 points each in the win. Young finished with a team-high seven rebounds and four steals in his first game in a Hornet uniform, while O'Neal finished with six rebounds and a pair of blocked shots.

Meanwhile, Isaiah Range (Cedar Hill, Texas) and Michael Barber (Jackson, Miss.) each added 10 points for Alabama State, with Barber collecting seven rebounds. Range added five rebounds and three assists in the win.

Alabama State shot 55.2 (16-of-29) percent from the floor in the second half to pull away from the Rams who had drawn to within 12 at the break. They ended the night shooting 50.9 (28-of-55) percent from the floor and 25.0 (4-of-16) percent from beyond the arc, while hitting 75.0 (12-of-16) percent from the free throw line.

The Hornets won every statistical category apart from second chance points (14-13), outrebounding Mobile 45-30 and added a 19-2 advantage on fast break points. The largest lead of the night for Alabama State was 27 with 9:11 remaining in the game, while went on a 12-0 scoring run midway through the first half to widen the margin.

GAME 2 WKU 79, Alabama State 74 November 9, 2021



Young finished with a game-high 23 points on 56.3 (9-of16) percent shooting from the floor and grabbed nine rebounds in his debut for Alabama State, pacing three players in double figures for the Hornets. 


The Hornets had a pair of chances to tie the game in the final three minutes but couldn't convert and turned the ball over three times which allowed Iowa State to pull away down the stretch.

Michael Barber (Jackson, Miss.) added seven points and ten rebounds off the bench, while Ashton McClelland (Houston, Texas) added six on a pair of three-pointers. Trace Young (Owensboro, Ky.) added 10 points for the Hornets who outscored Iowa in the second half.

Alabama State shot 49.2 (29-of-59) percent from the floor and 45.8 (11-of-24) percent from beyond the arc. They also connected on 68.4 (13-of-19) percent from the free throw line. Meanwhile, the Hawkeyes shot 52.1 (38-of-73) percent from the floor and 45.5 (20-of-44) percent from beyond the arc. They also shot 75 (12-of-16) percent from the free throw line

Keegan Murry led Iowa with 26 points and Payton Sandfort added 21. Jordan Bohannon added 12 (all on three-pointers) and became the all-time leader in three-pointers made in Big Ten history.

GAME 7 Alabama State 80, NCCU 74 (ot) November 20, 2021

MONTGOMERY, Ala. | Alabama State used a pair of double-doubles by Gerald Liddell (Cibolo, Texas) and Jordan O'Neal (Mobile, Ala.) to push past North Carolina Central 80-74 in overtime at the Dunn-Oliver Acadome on Saturday night.

Liddell paced Alabama State (1-5) with 22 points and 11 rebounds in 38 minutes of action, including hitting a lay-up to tie the game with just 6.6 seconds left in overtime and sealing the win at the line in the extra frame. Meanwhile, O'Neal finished with 19 points and 14 rebounds (including six offensive boards) while playing just 32 minutes after fouling out in regulation.


The two finished just eight rebounds shy of the entire North Carolina Central team.

Juan Reyna (San Antonio, Texas) finished with 14 points including a big three in overtime to put the Hornets up, while Isaiah Range (Cedar Hill, Texas) finished with 11.

Alabama State led late in the second half before North Carolina Central stormed back from a seven-point deficit at 66-59 with just under four minutes to play to take a two-point led with under 30 seconds left in regulation. After a timeout, Liddell drove the length of the floor and hit a lay-up to tie the game, before DJ Jackson (San Bernardino, Calf.) had a chance to win it at the buzzer after a steal but missed an off-balance three-pointer.

The Hornets finished the night shooting 43.5 (27-of-62) percent from the floor and 35.0 (7-of-20) from beyond the arc. They also finished the night shooting 67.9 (19-of-28) percent from the free throw line.

Randy Miller, Jr. led North Carolina Central with 23 points.



GAME 8 (EXHIBITION) Alabama State 91, Tuskegee 65 November 22, 2021


MONTGOMERY, Ala. Alabama State trailed by one at the break but used a big run at the beginning of the second half to pull away from Tuskegee for a 91-65 victory at the Dunn-Oliver Acadome on Monday night.

Alabama State (2-5) shot 42.9 (12-of-28) percent from the second half but found themselves trailing to the Golden Tigers after a pair of free throws with just 23 seconds left before half. Alabama State was unable to convert a pair of free throws with under a second to play and went into the locker room down 37-36.

The second half was a different story as the Hornets came out on a 19-2 run that started with a pair of three-pointers from freshman Juan Reyna (San Antonio, Texas) to go up 42-37 with 19 minutes to play in the game. After a Tuskegee basket cut the lead to 44-39, the Hornets scored 11 consecutive points to push the lead to 55-39 with 15:54 to play. The lead continued to grow throughout the second half growing to as many as 30 with just 1:35 to play in the game.

Christian McCray (Las Vegas, Nev.) led Alabama State with 15 points, pacing three players in double figures. He finished the night shooting 7-of-9 from the floor, while Kevion Stewart (Memphis, Tenn.) and Reyna each finished with 10. Meanwhile, DJ Jackson (San Bernardino, Calif.) finished with five points, nine rebounds, and five assists on the night for the Hornets who finished shooting 53.4 (31-of-58) percent from the floor.

They also finished the night shooting 42.2 (7-of-17) percent from beyond the arc and 57.9 (22-of-38) percent from the free throw line. They also outrebounded the Golden Tigers 40-30, while turning the ball over just 14 times.
