WAVEPOINTS

- The Pepperdine men's basketball team continues its homestand with a Saturday afternoon contest against Alabama State.
- · This is part of a stretch that will see the Waves end non-conference play with four of the final five games at home. It began with Monday's 82-69 win over San Jose State.
- Jan Zidek has taken over the team's scoring lead at 11.9 points per game. He's fourth in the WCC in free throw percentage (87.9%).
- Newcomers have scored 52.0% of the points so far this season, and freshmen have 36.6% of the points. Topping that list is **Houston Mallette** at 11.4 points per game. He has a team-best 24 three-pointers, ranking seventh in the WCC (2.2 per game).
- Mike Mitchell Jr. is tied for third in the WCC in assists (4.8 per game). He tied his season high with eight assists against San Jose State.
- Jade' Smith needs three more steals to break into Pepperdine's all-time top 10.
- Victor Ohia Obioha, who is coming off a double-double that included a career-high 12 rebounds, ranks second in Pepperdine history in field goal percentage (62.2%). He's the only Wave to have scored in double-figures in three of the last four games.
- Keith Fisher III scored a season-high 21 points against San Jose State, which is where he started his college career.
- The Waves were one of the best free throw shooting teams in the country last season and they've been good so far again this year at 76.0% (ranking third in the WCC).
- The Waves are coming off a season in which they won the 2021 College Basketball Invitational (CBI).

LAST MEETING

Back on December 19, 2012 in New Orleans ... Pepperdine won its first game at the Tulane Classic, beating Alabama State 66-58 (the Waves would fall to the host Green Wave 69-54 the next day). Four players scored 10 or 11 points against the Hornets, including Jett Raines, who went on to make the All-Tournament team. The Waves shot a season-high 53.8% in the contest.

GAME #12 — Saturday (December 11) at Firestone Fieldhouse in Malibu, California: Pepperdine (3-8) vs. Alabama State (1-8) at 3 p.m.

WAVECASTS — Monday's game can be watched online via WaveCasts on the WCC Network. Veteran play-by-play man **AI Epstein**, a 2015 Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame inductee who is now in his 37th season, will be behind the microphone. This will be his 1,107th consecutive men's basketball broadcast for the Waves.

HOME GAME TICKET POLICIES — Due to L.A. County health rules, proof of vaccination or proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within the 72 hours prior to an event is required to attend Pepperdine home men's basketball games. Tickets are available via e-ticket ONLY and must be purchased online before arriving onto campus. Single-game non-conference tickets cost \$25 for reserved, \$15 for general admission, \$12 for child general admission and \$10 for groups. To purchase e-tickets and/or read the spectator guidelines and COVID-19 policies, visit: https://gowav.es/WavesTix. Due to campus construction, nearby parking may be limited and guests are advised to arrive early.

LAST GAME — **Keith Fisher III** led five players who scored in double-figures as the Waves started December's homestand with an 82-69 win over San Jose State on Monday night. Fisher scored 21 points on 9-for-11 shooting, matching the highest output by a Wave so far this season. Pepperdine had a season high for points and kept the Spartans to 38.2% shooting, an opponent season low. The Waves had a great first half, leading by as many as 20 points. The Spartans cut the deficit to 10 in the second half before Pepperdine pulled away. **Victor Ohia Obioha** had a double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds.

NEWCOMERS — The Waves' new players (four freshmen and two grad transfers) have scored 52.0% of the points this season. The freshmen alone account for 36.6% of the scoring.

RECORDS WATCH — **Victor Ohia Obioha** has made 62.2% of his career shots, which ranks second all-time behind **Orlando Phillips**, who was at 65.4% over the 1981-82 and 1982-83 seasons ... **Jadé Smith** has 132 career steals. He needs 135 to break into Pepperdine's top 10.

2021-22 HONORS — **Jan Zidek** was named to the all-tournament team at the SoCal Challenge after averaging 18.5 points in two games in San Juan Capistrano.

Fisher III at San Jose State/Illinois State: 6 double-doubles, 29 double-figure point games, 6 20-point games, 9 double-figure rebound games ROSTER UPDATES — Darryl Polk Jr. (wrist) missed the first nine games of the season before returning December 3 at UC Santa Barbara ... Maxwell Lewis was cleared to play by the NCAA after missing the first six games of the season and made his debut on November 24 vs. TCU ... Aladji Gassama and Paul Jordan are slated to redshirt their freshman seasons ... Braun Hartfield, who last played on November 24, has been removed from the roster.

ROSTER NOTES — Pepperdine has eight returners and seven newcomers. The breakdown is one graduate transfer, four seniors, one junior, three sophomores and six freshmen. Returning players account for 35.6% of last year's points, 41.4% of the rebounds, 24.8% of the assists and 38.5% of the minutes. Two of the top six scorers are back, and four of the top eight.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTES — Pepperdine's non-conference schedule features three 2021 NCAA Tournament teams: Grand Canyon (Nov. 27, home), UC Santa Barbara (Dec. 3, away) and Oregon (Dec. 21, away). The Waves played in the inaugural Southern California Challenge in San Juan Capistrano and faced Fresno State and TCU in nationally televised games. Eight of the 15 non-conference games will be at home.

WCC NOTES — Pepperdine was picked seventh in the preseason coaches poll. The order went Gonzaga, BYU, Saint Mary's, Loyola Marymount, San Francisco, Santa Clara, Pepperdine, Pacific, San Diego and Portland ... With the WCC's 16-game schedule, the Waves won't host Loyola Marymount and won't travel to Santa Clara.

OLYMPICS — **Jan Zidek** spent a portion of his summer at the Czech Republic's National Team camp ahead of the Olympics. He was one of just two college players to receive an invitation to the 18-man camp. The Czech Republic ended up qualifying for the Olympics for the first time in the nation's history (although Zidek was not part of the final Olympic squad) ... Pepperdine alum **Brian Goorjian** served as head coach of Australia's men's basketball team for the third time at an Olympics, and led the Boomers to bronze, their first-ever medal.

RECRUITS — The Waves landed three players during the November signing period that will join the squad next season. They are 6-foot-5 guard **Malik Moore**, 6-foot-8 forward **Jalen Pitre** and 6-foot-11 forward **Jevon Porter**. Moore is is a two-time all-league player at Heritage Christian High in Northridge. Pitre was an all-league player at Long Beach Poly High last year and is attending a year of prep school at the Woodstock Academy in Connecticut. Porter, whose older brothers Michael Jr. and Jontay have played in the NBA, is a four-star recruit according to ESPN who averaged 22.4 points and 11.5 rebounds last season at Father Tolton Catholic High in Missouri.

LAST SEASON — The Waves finished third in the WCC, made the semifinals of the WCC Tournament and won the postseason CBI. They did so behind one of the best 1-2 combinations in program history. **Colbey Ross** departed as the program's all-time leader in points and assists, among dozens of school records, and as the only player in the history of Division I men's basketball to accumulate totals of at least 2,200 points, 800 assists and 400 rebounds. He was joined on All-WCC and all-region teams by **Kessler Edwards**, the MVP of the CBI, who turned pro after his junior season and was taken in the second round of the NBA Draft by the Brooklyn Nets. The Waves went 15-12 overall.

PEPPERDINE BASKETBALL — This is the 84th season of Pepperdine men's basketball, and the 49th year that the Waves have called Firestone Fieldhouse home. The Waves began the campaign with 1,265 wins all-time. Pepperdine has been to the NCAA Tournament 13 times (last in 2002) and has won 12 West Coast Conference regular-season titles (last in 2002) and three WCC Tournament crowns (last in 1994). The Waves won the College Basketball Invitational in 2021.

WAVES IN THE PROS — **Kessler Edwards** was taken in the second round of the 2021 NBA Draft (44th overall) by the Brooklyn Nets. It was just the fifth time that a Wave was picked in the first two rounds, and it was the first time a Wave had been drafted since 2005. He signed a two-way contract with the Nets, allowing him to move between Brooklyn and the G League's Long Island Nets.

Edwards has become the 18th former Pepperdine player to see action in the NBA (he made his debut on November 16 against Golden State and scored eight points in nine minutes), a list that includes notables such as **Dennis Johnson** (a 2010 Naismith Hall of Fame inductee, the 1979 NBA Finals MVP and a three-time NBA champion) and **Doug Christie** (a 15-year NBA veteran who was a mainstay on the All-Defensive Team). Two

Waves — Yakhouba Diawara (2012/France) and Marcos Leite (1972, 1980, 1984/ Brazil) — have played in the NBA and competed at the Olympics.

Kameron Edwards, Kessler's older brother, was in the G League Santa Cruz Warriors' training camp. Colbey Ross has begun his pro career in the Czech Republic. Other Waves currently or recently active in the pros include Alex Acker (Italy), Kene Chukwuka (Uruguay), Stacy Davis (Poland), Chase Griffin (Germany), Chris Reyes (Mexico), and Nikolas Skouen (Norway).

Pepperdine once had a streak of 34 consecutive seasons with at least one Pepperdine alum on an NBA roster, which began in 1976-77 after the ABA/NBA merger and ended in 2010-11.

LORENZO ROMAR

Lorenzo Romar, who has been a successful head coach for more than two decades and is known as one of the nation's top recruiters, returned to Pepperdine prior to the 2018-19 season for his second stint in charge of the men's basketball program.

At the start of the 2021-22 season, Romar had a career record of 438-330 over 24 seasons as a head coach at Pepperdine, Saint Louis and Washington.

Romar posted a 42-44 record at Pepperdine from 1997-99 in his first head coaching job. At the start of 2021-22, over six seasons with the Waves, his record was 89-90.



After an initial rebuilding season in 1996-97, he led the Waves to 17 and 19 wins the next two years. An 11-win improvement from year one to year two ranked as one of the nation's top turnarounds. In 2018-19, he took the Waves from six to 16 victories, meaning that he's been responsible for two of the four times in Pepperdine history that the Waves have improved by double-digit wins. He led Pepperdine to its first postseason title since 1994 with the 2021 CBI championship.

At UW, he built the Huskies into a perennial contender over 15 seasons. He helped produce 11 NBA first-round draft picks and 17 NBA players, while his teams played in six NCAA Tournaments, three NITs and one CBI. He was a three-time Pac-10 or Pac-12 Coach of the Year.


At Washington and Arizona, where he was the associate head coach for one season before coming to Pepperdine, Romar worked with back-to-back NBA #1 overall draft picks (Markelle Fultz and DeAndre Ayton). As a head coach, he's produced 17 NBA Draft picks (most recently Kessler Edwards in 2021) and a total of 26 as either a head coach or assistant

Romar won an NCAA title as an assistant coach at UCLA in 1995. He was selected in the seventh round of the 1980 NBA Draft and played five seasons in the NBA. He played collegiately at Washington.

Assistant coach **Curtis Allen** played for Romar at Washington and was an assistant coach at Washington State for nine seasons (he was an assistant to Bone at both WSU and Portland State) ... Assistant coach **Gerald Brown** is a former Pepperdine great who played for Romar for two seasons and was a three-time All-WCC first team honoree between 1994-98. He played a season in the NBA with the Phoenix Suns and was also briefly a Harlem Globetrotter ... Director of operations **John Impelman** is in his 13th year on Pepperdine's staff. Romar is the third head coach he has worked for in various capacities. Impelman is the great-grandson of UCLA coaching legend John Wooden, and his father Craig is a former Pepperdine assistant coach ... Former walk-on **Michael Wexler** graduated in December 2020 and transitioned from player to graduate manager at that time.


