Entry to ASU Stadium

By entering the ASU Stadium, I understand that my entrance involves inherent risks with the COVID-19 pandemic. By entering the facility, I voluntarily assume all risks of loss, damage, illness or injury, which I may sustain.

I will make no claim against and release, waive, discharge hold harmless and indemnify, on behalf of myself, my personal representative and my heirs, Alabama State University and its officers, agents and employees for any and all claims and causes of action for any injury or loss, or for damages, costs, expenses, or compensation that may occur during or result from my entrance, whether arising through the negligence, omission, default, or other action of any person or event associated with this event.

Temperature Checks

Everyone entering ASU Stadium will have their temperature checked.

Mask-Mandatory

Alabama State University is a mask-mandatory campus. In order to enter the ASU Stadium and remain, a mask must be worn at all times and social distancing will be enforced.

Clear Bag Policy

The clear bag policy will be in place at the ASU Stadium at all times.

Tailgating

There will be no tailgating allowed around ASU Stadium or on the Alabama State University campus due to COVID-19 protocols.

Gameday Parking

Game day purchase for parking is in Zone K, L and O. ADA spaces are available in Zone O.

Parking will be \$15.00.

Parking on game day is cashless.

Stadium Entry Points

Please be mindful of each entry point for the stadium, and make plans to enter through that gate on Gameday with gates opening at 4:00 pm:

- Gates A & B – Season Ticket Holders (Club Lounge and Loge)
- Gate C – Students and Season Ticket Holders
- Express Gate – Emergency Use
- Gate D – Suite holders, Loge, Club Lounge
- Gate E – Player Pass gate (home and away)
- Gates H and I – Students and Season Ticket Holders
- Gate J - Band only

Safety Measures

Alabama State University has taken safety measures for the 2021 spring football season:

- Complete facility disinfected by Drone (DraganFly)
- Additional staff available for cleaning of frequently touched areas
- Sanitizing Stations are located throughout the stadium
- Social distancing machines
- Temperature checks
- Mask Mandatory facility
- Decals placed on the cement throughout the stadium to help with lines and social distancing

COVID-19 Self-Screening Checklist

All attendees to athletic events at Alabama State will be asked to review the screening checklist before arrival to campus:

- Have you received a positive COVID-19 test in the past 14 days?
- Do you have a fever greater than 100.4 F?
- Do you have new muscle aches not related to another medical condition or another specific activity?
- Do you have a new or worsening cough that is not related to another medical condition?
- Do you have a sore throat, runny nose and/or congestion not related to another medical condition?
- Do you have, or are you suffering from, shortness of breath that is not related to another medical condition?
- Do you have a recent loss of smell or taste?
- Do feel nauseous or have a new onset of vomiting and/or diarrhea not related to another medical condition?
- Have you had recent close contact in the last 14 days with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19?

If you answered yes to any of the questions above, immediately self-isolate and contact your medical provider. Please do not attend any campus facility, program, activity, or event.

Tickets

Only those fans who purchased season tickets will be allowed entry during the 2020-21 season, along with those on the visiting team pass list. Single game tickets will not be on sale at any point during the season.

The ASU Stadium will operate at a limited capacity for the season, which will include season ticket holders and student tickets when they become available. Seating / Distance and Family

All seats will be socially distanced in the stadium. A family will be allowed to sit together in groups of four only. We ask that you please refrain from moving around the stadium, unless absolutely necessary. At no time will spectators be allowed to sit on the row behind the teams on the sideline, must maintain social distancing and masks are mandatory at all times.

Cheer / Band

A map will be made available for all band and cheer seating, as neither group be allowed on the field. The band will not perform at halftime, and no visiting bands will travel.

Concessions

All concessions will be cashless.
