Everyone entering ASU Stadium will have their temperature checked.





MASK MANDATORY

SAFETY MEASURES

Alabama State University has taken safety measures for the 2021 fall football season:

- Complete facility disinfected by Drone (DraganFly)
- Additional staff available for cleaning of frequently touched areas
- Sanitizing Stations are located throughout the stadium
- Social distancing machines
- Temperature checks
- Mask Mandatory facility
- Decals placed on the cement in the concession stand areas to help with lines and social distancing

HYDRATION STATION

All seats will be socially distanced in the stadium. A family will be allowed to sit together in groups of four only. We ask that you please refrain from moving around the stadium, unless necessary. At no time will spectators be allowed to sit on the row behind the teams on the sideline, must maintain social distancing and masks are always mandatory.

Please remember to stay hydrated and aware of any current medical conditions and medication prior arrival! Be advised that ASU will have several hydration stations available for complimentary small cups of water.

Additionally, ASU will have increased hydration stations provided by Coca-Cola for purchase:

- Soft drinks
- Dasani
- Powerade

TAILGATE POLICY

There will be limited tailgating allowed in the designated area near ASU Stadium due to COVID-19 protocols.

GAMEDAY PARKING (SEE BACK FOR MAP)

There is NO parking in the neighborhoods, so please be mindful. There will be branded signage to direct you to the public and specific permitted lots for parking. Please see the maps created to simplify and explain, how to best plan your ASU Gameday experience.

Game day parking is \$15.00, and all transactions are cashless, to help reduce the amount touching, and provide a safer experience for all involved.

Parking map (Zones K,L, and O, and Forest Avenue lot parking available)

- Please note that South Jackson Street is ONLY available for band and local traffic
- Plan to enter the campus from Carter Hill (east or west)
- Note that vehicles parked outside of ASU designated parking areas above, will be subject to immediate towing

STUDENT PARKING

Please always keep your Student IDs on you. You will need your ID to access the main entrances to campus and student parking at the Acadome.

All students are asked to park their vehicles in the front parking lot of the Acadome (Lot V) during all home football games. The parking lots along south University Drive (MLK-PEYTON FINLEY-BESSIE BENSON-ABERCROMBIE-BEHIND BIBB GRAVES-CYNTHIA ALEXANDER- on SOUTH UNIVERSITY DRIVE,

between R.C. HATCH HALL and WEST UNIVERSITY DRIVE) will also be available for student parking during home football games.

On game day, all students are asked to enter the campus by way of the STUDENT GATE, located at Carter Hill Road and West University Drive (Cynthia Alexander Apartments) - across from the Tennis Courts. Students are asked to have their vehicles moved to the student parking areas by 5 p.m. on Wednesday before the Thursday home football game.

- Entry & Parking is Cashless

- Gate E - Player Pass gate (Recruit)
- North Ticket Window (Will Call)
- Gate H - Media
- Gates H and I - Season Ticket Holders and Visitors Will Call
- Gate J - Band only

Students may enter all gates except Gate D
