

HORNETS SET TO HOST DANGEROUS DELTA DEVILS SQUAD

- The Hornets on Alert: Alabama State University hosts a Mississippi Valley State University team seeking its first win of the 2022 season on Saturday, Oct. 15. Kickoff is slated for 2:00 pm at ASU Stadium and will air on Bounce TV (WSFA 12.2).
- ➡ INSIDE THE SERIES: This is the 50th meeting between Alabama State and Mississippi Valley with the Hornets leading the all-time series 33-16. The Delta Devils claimed a 44-31 win in Itta Bena, Miss., last season, snapping an 11-game Hornet win streak in the series. The Hornets have won the last nine meetings in Montgomery and are 5-0 against MVSU since ASU Stadium opened in 2012.
- 10th ANNIVERSARY: The Hornets are celebrating ASU Stadium's 10th anniversary in 2022. Bama State looks to snap a two-game home skid streak following a 26-12 setback to Jackson State University last week. The Hornets are 29-18 since ASU Stadium opened in 2012.
- © COME JOIN CROWD: A record crowd of 31,334 piled into ASU Stadium to see Alabama State's Homecoming battle with Jackson State University. The attendance eclipsed the previous record crowd of 27.828 set against Tuskegee in 2019. The Hornets currently rank **7th** in FCS home attendance, averaging 17,475 per home game. Five SWAC schools rank in the top 20. Jackson State (6th/31,358 avg.), Florida A&M (11th/12,388 avg.), Southern (15th/15,528) and Alabama A&M (16th/10,350 avg.).
- REMEMBERING AWYSUM HARRIS: The Hornets will wear an AH sticker on their helmets and a framed #50 iersev and helmet will be displayed in his locker throughout the 2022 season in remembrance of a sophomore linebacker (#50). **Awysum Harris** of Decatur, Ala. The jersey will also accompany the team and rest on the defensive bench



- trailed 38-31 with under two minutes in the game when **Brandon Gaddy** blocked a field goal and **Cameron Rampersaud** scooped it and ran it back for a touchdown before it was called back due to an offsides call. Mississippi Valley scored on the next play to secure a 44-31 win with 1:10 left in the game.
- THE SIP: Alabama State boasts eight players on the 2022 roster with ties to the state of Mississippi. Jeffery Scott Jr. (Vicksburg, Miss.), Demosthenes Jones (Jackson, Miss.). Tre Phillips (Olive Branch, Miss.), Marcus Harris (Jackson, Miss.), Rashard Daniels (Horn Lake, Miss.), Nelson Jordan (Starkville, Miss.), Roderick Daniels (Horn Lake, Miss.). Additionally, three staffers have ties to the Magnolia State, including running backs coach Greg Ruffin (Jackson State/6 yrs.), offensive line coach Alex Jackson (Mississippi Valley State/2 yrs.), and Associate AD for Football Administration LaTova Williams (Jackson State and Alcorn State).
- BALL HAWKS: Colton "Bubba" Adams, Damaurez Bellamy and Irshaad Davis rank among the top tacklers in the SWAC. Adams and Bellamy registered career highs in tackles against Jackson State. Adams collected a career-high 18 tackles, including 10 solo stops, a tackle for loss and two pass breakups. The 18 tackles were the Wetumpka, Ala., native's third game with double-figure tackles. Adams tallied 11 against Miles and 13 against Prairie View A&M. Adams has amassed a SWAC-high 59 tackles and 29 solo tackles along with 30 assisted stops. Bellamy finished with 10 tackles (5 solos) against JSU while his 29 tackles this season are tied for 15th. Davis is tied for 18th in the conference with 36 tackles

- ➡ PRESEASON ALL-SWAC: The SWAC announced its 2022 Preseason All-Conference Football selections during SWAC Football Media Day in Birmingham, Ala. Safety Irshaad Davis and offensive lineman Robert Alston IV were First-Team Preseason All-SWAC selections. Davis posted a team-high 67 tackles (13th SWAC), 40 solo stops, on the way to garnering Second-Team All-SWAC honors in 2021. Davis tied for third in the SWAC with three interceptions and had six tackles for loss and two sacks.
- SWAC PRESEASON POLL: The league's 2022 predicted order of Finish announced Jackson State (116) as the top pick in the SWAC Eastern Division. Florida A&M (108), Alabama A&M (87), Alabama State (60), Bethune-Cookman (56), and Mississippi Valley State (35) make up the East Division rankings. Southern (111) was tabbed to finish first-place in the SWAC Western Division. Alcorn State (110), Prairie View A&M (82), Grambling State (77), Arkansas-Pine Bluff (42), and Texas Southern (40) round out the West Division rankings.

OPPONENT NOTEBOOK: MISSISSIPPI VALLEY STATE

- ► Alabama State and Mississippi Valley State tangle for the 50th time on the gridiron with the Hornets holding a 33-16 record in the series. MVSU claimed a 44-31 win in Itta Bena, Miss., in 2021 to end an 11-game ASU winning streak.
- ▶ Mississippi Valley is under the direction of **Vincent Dancy**, who is 7-35 in the midst of his fifth season in Itta Bena.
- ▶ Alabama State has won nine straight games in Montgomery, Ala., dating to a 13-10 MVSU victory in 2002.
- ► MVSU ranks last in scoring offense and total offense. The Delta Devils have not reached 10 touchdowns in six games and average 8.5 points per game. ► Total offense, averaging 533.8 yards per game. Total defense, averaging 185.5 yards per game.
- ► OFFENSIVE NOTES: The Devils rank last in total and scoring offense while giving up the most sacks by a SWAC team with 20. Delta Devils quarterback Jamari Jones went 13-23 for 151 yards and one touchdown but was sacked six times in a lopsided loss to Alcorn State.. Mississippi Valley ran for 168 yards on 38 attempted with 3.3 yards per carry on the ground.
- ▶ DEFENSIVE NOTES: Ronnie Thomas in first in the SWAC in tackles for loss with 14 (11 solo /3 assisted and also first in sacks with seven (6 solo, 2 assisted).
- MVSU is the alma mater of NFL Hall of Famer Jerry Rice. Rice is a 3x Super Bowl Champion, Super Bowl MVP, 10X 1st Team All-Pro, and 6x NFL receptions and receiving touchdowns leader. Rice was drafted in the first round of the 1985 NFL Draft by the San Francisco 49ers. As a sophomore, Rice caught 66 passes for 1,133 yards and seven touchdowns. The next year he set NCAA Division I-AA records for receptions (102) and receiving yards (1,652) and his 27 touchdown receptions in 1984 set the NCAA mark for all divisions. Rice finished ninth in the 1984 Heisman Trophy voting and finished his college career with 301 catches for 4,693 yards.
- MVSU is also the alma mater of Ashley Ambrose, who was drafted in the second round of 1992 in the NFL Draft. He is a one-time pro bowler and all pro. His #33 is retired by the Atlanta Falcons, Indianapolis Colts, and New Orleans Saints.

NEWS. NOTES. & SIDEBAR STATS

- TRIPLE THREAT: The trio of Jacory Merritt, Santo Dunn and Ja'Won Howell shoulder much of the load in the running game. Dunn is 12th with 42 carries for 260 yards and one touchdown while Merritt is 13th in the SWAC with 66 attempts for 258 yards and one touchdown. Howell has been the go-to back in the red zone, carrying the ball 36 times for 133 and a team-best three touchdowns. Howell has been the go-to in short yardage and on the goal line, with three touchdowns off of 39 carries for 167 yards.
- ◆ TOP TARGETS: Alabama State quarterbacks spread the wealth with 19 different receivers posting receptions in 2022. Jeremiah Hixon, Isaiah Scott, and LeVontae Shenault, and have been the top targets. Hixon leads the team with 17 catches (T8th SWAC) for 143 yards following a season-high six receptions against Jackson State. Scott has 12 catches (T12th SWAC) and 203 receiving yards (T13th) while Shenault has a team-high 210 receiving yards and 14 receptions. Kisean Johnson missed the first four games but is an emerging target with eight receptions for 160 and a touchdown in three games.
- STINGY STINGING D: ASU ranks 3rd (24th FCS) in total defense (333.5./29th FCS), 5th (32md FCS) in pass defense, (195.8), 3rd in scoring defense (22.3/32n FCS) and 5th in rush defense (137.7). The Hornets' defense put on a second-half lockdown in the win over Texas Southern. The Alabama State defense held Texas Southern to 112 yards in the second half which included minus-nine yards rushing and 46 yards passing in the final quarter.
- BEHIND ENEMY LINES: The Hornets are 5th with 2.0 sacks per game and 12.0 total sacks while their 6.3 tackles for loss are 6th in the SWAC. Steffon Young-Rolle is tied for 3rd in the SWAC with 3.0 sacks and 9th with .50 sacks per game while Adrian Maddox's 5.5 tackles for loss are tied for 5th. Brandon Gaddy is 13th with 1.0 tackles for loss per game and 6th in the SWAC with 5.0 TFLs.
- PASS DEFENSE: The Hornets rank 5th in the SWAC (32nd FCS), yielding 195.8 passing yards per game, while the 59.3 completion percentage defense is the 5th in the SWAC. ASU also ranked 5th with five interceptions with Adrian Maddox and Keenan Isaac tied for the league lead with two interceptions while Issac is 1st in passes defended (6 PBU, 2 INT) and 2nd in pass breakups (6).
- THIRD DOWNS: Alabama State ranks third in the SWAC in third-down defense, limiting opponents to 37.1 percent (26-of-70).
- SPECIAL TEAMS: Aubrey Grace is 4th in the SWAC, averaging 41.8 yards a punt, while his eight punts downed inside the opponent's 20 are also 4th in the SWAC. Santo Dunn's 100 combined kick return yards are 13th and Jeremiah Hixon's 76 yards are 17th in the SWAC
- HBCU TOP 50 NFL: Keenan Issac and Irshaad Davis garnered a lot of preseason attention after recently being named to Jordan Reid's ESPN Top 50 HBCU NFL Prospects. Isaac is

ranked **18th** while Davis is listed at **32nd** on the list.

- BOXTOROW AA: Irshaad Davis was named to the BOXTOROW Preseason HBCU All-American list. The SWAC dominated the list with 15 selections out of the 28 players named to the team.
- EAST-WEST SHRINE BOWL 1000 LIST:
 The East-West Shrine Bowl announced its list of all-star game-eligible players from the SWAC, MEAC, Big South, and CIAA, who were determined eligible for the 1000 List for the 2023 East-West Shrine Bowl, and the 2023 NFL Draft. Alabama State's Naytron Culpepper and cornerback Keenan Issac are among 16 SWAC players with the potential to receive an invitation to play in the 2023 East-West Shine Game on Feb. 2 in Las Vegas, Nev.

FCS PUNTER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST: Punter Aubrey Grace was named to the Augusta Sports Council's preseason watch list for the 2022 FCS Punter of the Year Award, which honors the nation's top collegiate FCS punter. Grace earned BOXTOROW All-American and All-SWAC Second-Team honors in 2021. The Pike Road High product was among

- the nation's best in punting with a 41.1-yard average, averaging a season-best 48 yards per punt against Mississippi Valley State. Additionally, Grace forced three fair catches and pinned seven punts inside the 20 and nine of over 50 yards. The 22 candidates on the list incorporate a broad spectrum of Football Championship Series (FCS) punters.
- ◆ HBGU POWER RANKINGS: Alabama State moved from 15th to 10th in the NCAA HBCU Power Rankings. The Hornets finished 16th in the final 2021 HBCU Power Rankings. Jackson State tops the poll followed by South Carolina State (2), Tennessee State (3), North Carolina Central (4), and Southern (5). Alcorn State (6), Florida A&M (7), North Carolina A&T (8) and Alabama State (10) round out the top 10.

- ASU SPORTS HALL OF FAME: Alabama State will induct its first Athletics Hall of Fame Class since 2000. The 2022 induction class features seven football inductees and the 1991 national championship football team.

Brad Baxter was a three-time all-conference performer in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) during his time at running back for the Hornets. He finished his career as the school's all-time leading rusher and scored 30 career touchdowns. He later went on to an NFL career with the New York Jets. Former quarterback.

Darnell Kennedy finished his career as one of the most prolific passers in SWAC history over a four-year span. He finished with 11,753 yards and 102 touchdowns over a four-year period, completing 859 passes. He also piled 12,888 yards of total offense – both school records.

Reggie Barlow finished his career at Alabama State as the third leading receiver at Alabama State. He hauled in 133 receptions for 2,536 yards with 17 touchdowns. His best season came in 1994 when he hauled in 58 passes for 1,267 yards and 12 touchdowns. Barlow would go on to win a Super Bowl with Tampa Bay before returning to his alma mater as the head coach.

Reginald Brown, a member of the 1991 HBCU National Championship team, finished his career just one catch behind fellow Hall of Fame selection Barlow. He finished with 132 receptions for 2,271 yards and 23 touchdowns. He recorded 48 receptions for 815 yards and eight touchdowns during the 1990 season.

Rickey Jones, who led Alabama State to the 1991 HBCU National Championship under center and finished his career as the leader in total offense (he is currently second all-time) with 6,823 yards. He finished his career with 5,456 yards (passing) and 1,273 yards rushing, and he is second all-time in passing (including 49 touchdowns).

Former quarterback **Tarvaris Jackson** was inducted into the Ring of Honor earlier this season and is fourth all-time at the school in passing with 4,898 yards and 38 touchdowns. He also finished his career fourth in total offense with 5,709 total yards and recorded the third-best passing season (2004) with 2,556 yards and 20 touchdowns.

Eddie Robinson Jr. (Distinguished Sportsman) a two-time All-SWAC performer and a member of the 1991 HBCU National Championship team, finished his career as a two-time SWAC Defensive Player of the Year selection and Sheridan Black College All-American. He was named the Black College Sports Defensive Player of the Year in 1991 and was named a finalist for the William V. Campbell Trophy before being drafted in the second round of the NFL Draft by the Houston Oilers.

The **1991 Alabama State football team** captured the HBCU National Championship with an 11-0-1 record. The team scored 40 or more points five times in the season and defeated North Carolina A&T in the Heritage Bowl to win the HBCU national championship.



Eddie Robinson, Jr. was named the 30th head coach in Alabama State University on November 26, 2021, returning to his alma mater.

A native of Louisiana, Robinson was born and raised in New Orleans. He attended Brother Martin High School, graduating in 1988. He furthered his education attending Alabama State University on an academic scholarship. He earned a Bachelor's degree in chemistry in 1994.

He lettered in football all four years and earned All-SWAC honors and SWAC Defensive Player of the Year honors in 1990 and 1991, Sheridan Broadcasting Network All-America honors in 1990 and 1991, as well as Defensive Player of the Year honors in 1991 as a linebacker for the Hornets. Robinson also achieved academic All Conference honors and was recognized as The Toyota Leadership Award recipient in 1990. In 1998, he became the youngest individual to be inducted into the SWAC Hall of Fame at 28 years old, and in 2012 he was recognized as a MEAC/SWAC Challenge Legend.

Robinson was the Houston Oilers' second round pick in the 1992 NFL draft, the 50th player selected.

He was a stalwart in the community during his 11-year NFL career, playing with the Houston Oilers (1992–1995), Jacksonville Jaguars (1996–1997), Tennessee Titans (1998–2001) and Buffalo Bills (2002); appearing in Super Bowl XXXIV with the Titans in 2000. He finished his career with 850 tackles, 23 sacks and six interceptions. Robinson received the Titans Unsung Hero award for the Tennessee Titans during his career. He was the ultimate professional and obtained the knick name "Steady Eddie" for his methodical preparation and on field knowledge of the game, receiving accolades from his coaching staff and teammates for his leadership skills and attention to detail.

Robinson retired from the NFL following the 2002 season and entered the business world, and is currently the owner/manager of Magnolia River LLC Real Estate Investment Company.

He was a college football analyst for Fox Sports South, ESPNU, ESPN3 and Comcast Sports South from 2005 until 2014. In addition he was a co-host on a regionally televised weekly sports show INSIDE SWAC from 2006 to 2009, and continues to broadcast collegiate football games on the radio and appears on sports podcast as a featured guest.

Robinson possesses more than 30 plus years of experience at various levels of Football. He is a stellar ASU Alumnus and a man of vision who has a proven record of success. He assisted ASU in establishing its Football Hall of Fame and has been a consistent supporter of ASU athletic programs financially and by supporting athletic administrations and coaches.

He has worked to support the mission of HBCU's academically and athletically.

He has hosted Youth Football camps at Alabama State University, Texas Southern University and in his Houston Third Ward community. Robinson regularly speaks to high school students and young athletes promoting life skills and planning for success. He is an NFL Ambassador for USA Football helping to promote the game of football to parents and young football players. He mentored and coached an inner-city baseball league in the Sunnyside neighborhood of Houston, and incorporated a program to help young African-American baseball players achieve youth and high school success in baseball with a goal of playing baseball in college and professionally. Two of his players have signed college scholarships to play college baseball with others expected to follow this path and all have plans to attend college. He volunteers his time with the Houston school districts' Real Men Read program, reading to elementary school kids, and sharing his keys to success.



ASU Stadium on the campus of Alabama State University in Montgomery, Alabama, is a 26,500-seat stadium that replaceD the Cramton Bowl in 2012 as the host venue for the Alabama State Hornets football team. The first game in the New ASU Stadium was the 89th Turkey Day Classic on November 22, 2012 in which the Hornets hosted the Tuskegee Golden Tigers. The game was a sell-out and was televised nationally on ESPNU.

The stadium's current capacity sits at 26,500 but the project was designed to allow for future expansion that can expand the capacity to 55,000.

The stadium also holds a restaurant and retail space which welcome visitors to the stadium and area 365 days a year.






