STORY LINES

- ◆ **Isaiah Range** and **TJ Madlock** are each closing in on 1,000 career points after starting their careers at other institutions. Range currently sits at 990 career points after starting his career with 281 points at Tarleton State, while Madlock sits at 970 career points after starting his career with 395 points at South Carolina State. The duo, along with **CJ Hines** [transfer from Faulkner] have combined for 3,627 points during their careers. The duo will join 25 others who have scored 1,000 career points [while not all at Alabama State].
- ◆ Sophomore center **Ubong Okon** is grabbing rebounds at a mind-blowing pace for the Hornets this season including three games against national powers. The sophomore has started the last seven games and has grabbed 57 total rebounds, averaging 8.1 rebounds per game against LSU, USC, Auburn, South Florida, Johnson, MVSU, and UAPB. Prior to the six games, coming off the bench, Okon grabbed 36 rebounds in seven games averaging 5.1 rebounds per game.
- ◆ For the second consecutive season, Alabama State opened conference play with a pair of victories - this time on the road. It is the second straight season under head coach **Tony Madlock** that the Hornets have started the year off with back-to-back victories, and just the fifth time since 2010. The two road wins were the first time the Hornets have opened conference play up undefeated on the road since 2012 [Jackson State and Grambling State].
- ◆ Madlock became the first player in the Southwestern Athletic Conference to be named Player of the Week three times after earning the honor following the USC and Auburn games that he averaged 16.5 points per game. He was joined by Range who was named the SWAC Impact Player of the Week, the first for the Hornets this season, after his performances against USC and Auburn last week.
- ◆ All 15 players on this year's roster have seen action on the court after **Tadarius Jacobs** made his season debut against Johnson in the final non-conference game of the season on January 2.

HORNETS WIN TWO STRAIGHT TO OPEN CONFERENCE PLAY

For the second consecutive season, Alabama State opened conference play with a pair of victories - this time on the road. It is the second straight season under head coach **Tony Madlock** that the Hornets have started the year off with back-to-back victories, and just the fifth time since 2010. The two road wins were the first time the Hornets have opened conference play up undefeated on the road since 2012 [Jackson State and Grambling State].

HORNETS PICKED EIGHTH IN PRESEASON SWAC POLL

The Hornets were picked eighth in the preseason poll on a vote of the league's head coaches and communications professionals. Alabama State (121 votes) was picked behind Alabama A&M (140) and Prairie View A&M (151). The top five consisted of Texas Southern (240), Grambling State (233), Alcorn State (214), Jackson State (213), and Southern (153).

FAMILIAR FACES RETURNING TO MONTGOMERY

Some familiar faces will return to the Dunn-Oliver Acadome on Thursday night when Jackson State pays a visit to Alabama State. Former Alabama State head coach Mo Williams [13-35 in two seasons], associate head coach Trey Johnson, and assistant coach Keith Williams join former Hornet student-athletes Jordan O'Neal [7.4 ppg/5.7 rpg in three seasons] and Jayme Mitchell [2.9 ppg/1.3 rpg in one season] in returning to Montgomery.

FIVE PLAYERS IN DOUBLE FIGURES LEADS TO SECOND ROAD WIN TO OPEN SWAC PLAY

For the fourth time this season, Alabama State had five players score in double figures [against UAPB]. The five led Alabama State to its second consecutive road win to open Southwestern Athletic Conference [SWAC] play and a 3-1 record overall when it happens.

MADLOCK NAMED 2022-23 SWAC NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR, SECOND TEAM PRESEASON FOR 2023-24

Alabama State junior guard **TJ Madlock** was selected Second-Team Preseason All-Conference, announced by the conference office at Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) at Men's Basketball Media Days.

Madlock, the reigning SWAC Newcomer of the Year, returns after playing in 31 games last season (all starts) and averaged 11.2 points per game. He averaged 33.1 minutes per game, grabbing 189 total rebounds and averaging 6.1 rebounds per game.

The Memphis (Tenn.) native shot 35.9 (121-for-337) percent from the floor and 26.9 (25-for-33) percent from beyond the arc, while also converting on 70.4 (81-for-115) percent of his free throws. He also dished out 91 assists, recorded 11 blocks, and added 42 steals last season. Madlock scored a career-high 25 points against UAB (11/7/22) and grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds against Alabama A&M (2/25/23) last season.

He was joined on the second team by Romelle Mansel (Jackson State), Ken Evans, Jr. (Jackson State), Joe French (UAPB), and Preseason Defensive Player of the Year Jourdan Smith (Grambling State). The first team was made up of Preseason Player of the Year PJ Henry (Texas Southern), Jeremiah Kendall (Alcorn State), Zion Harmon (Bethune-Cookman), Chase Adams (Jackson State), and Kylan Milton (UAPB).

HORNETS SWEEP SWAC AWARDS THE WEEK OF DECEMBER 26

TJ Madlock and Isaiah Range swept the Players of the Week awards after games against USC and Auburn. Madlock became the first three-time winner of the SWAC Player of the Week after winning the award in week one and week three. The junior averaged 16.5 points per game in contests against USC and Auburn this week, scoring a game-high 17 points against USC. He added 16 points, all in the second half, against Auburn on the road to run his streak of double-figure games to 10 of 11 this season. He finished the week connecting on 40.0 (12-of-30) percent of his shots. Madlock also grabbed four rebounds, dished out four assists, blocked three shots, and recorded three steals.

Meanwhile, Range won the first SWAC Impact Player of the Week award this season for Alabama State after averaging 14.5 points per game in a pair of games against USC and Auburn. The senior scored a team-high 16 points against Auburn and added 13 against USC while shooting 37.5 (12-of-32) percent from the floor with five three-pointers. He also grabbed seven rebounds, dished out a pair of assists, and recorded a pair of steals in the two games. Range has scored in double figures in six of the seven games since his return this season.

MADLOCK EARNS SECOND PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD AFTER WEEK IN BIRMINGHAM

Madlock earned his second Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) Player of the Week award, announced by the conference office on Tuesday afternoon. Madlock averaged 15 points per game over the Thanksgiving week, helping Alabama State to a pair of wins at the Samford MTE.

The junior finished the week shooting 55.9 (19-of-34) percent from the floor and converted 62.5 (5-of-8) percent from the free throw line. He grabbed 16 total rebounds from his guard spot, averaging 5.3 per game, dished out five assists, and recorded five steals. The junior scored 25 points in a win over North Carolina A&T, snapping a two-game losing streak, and added another 16 against Merrimack on Saturday to wrap play over the week for the Hornets. Against North Carolina A&T, Madlock converted on 61.1 (11-of-18) percent shooting from the floor and grabbed six rebounds, while he shot 40.0 (6-of-15) percent from the floor with seven rebounds against Merrimack.

MADLOCK PICKED AS SWAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK FOLLOWING FIRST WEEK OF ACTION

Junior guard **TJ Madlock** was selected as the first player of the week after he averaged 17.5 points and 7.0 rebounds in the first two games of the season for the Hornets in road losses to Ole Miss and Iowa. The junior guard scored in double figures in both games including a season-high 23 points against Iowa. He finished the night shooting 40.9 (9-of-22) percent from the floor and 83.3 (5-of-6) percent from the free throw line.

He also grabbed six rebounds, dished out a pair of assists and recorded two steals. In the season opener, Madlock scored 12 points

on 33.3 (4-of-12) percent from the floor and 66.7 (4-of-6) percent from the free throw line. He also grabbed eight rebounds, and dished out three assists.

AMONG THE LEADERS IN THE CONFERENCE ENTERING FINAL GAME IN 2023 [SOUTH FLORIDA]

TJ Madlock is among the best in the conference when it comes to scoring at 16.2 points per game, sitting sixth through the first 10 games of the season [conference leader - Kylan Milton, UAPB at 19.45]. Meanwhile, **CJ Hines** is currently tied for 17th in the SWAC in scoring at 12.00 points per game. Madlock is also ninth in the conference in field goal percentage [.416].

Ubong Okon is currently fourth in the conference at 6.56 rebounds per game [conference leader - Brian Myles, PVAMU at 7.10]. Meanwhile, Hines is currently fourth in the conference in assists at 3.80 [conference leader - Rashad Williams, UAPB at 4.31].

RANGE RETURNS WITH A RAGE IN SCORING

Senior **Isaiah Range** returned to the court for the first time in the regular season since his season-ending injury 23 games into the season last year. He quickly responded by scoring in double figures in the first two games of the season, scoring 15 against Samford and adding another 13 against North Carolina A&T. Over the three-game span, Range averaged 11 points which was where his career average stood through 86 games.

NAIA ALL-AMERICAN TRANSFERS TO ALABAMA STATE

Junior guard **CJ Hines**, a former NAIA All-American, transferred to Alabama State during the summer and will be in uniform for the upcoming season. Hines played two years at Faulkner and was named 2022-2023 SSAC Player of the Year. He was also named a NAIA First Team All-American after he averaged 21.4 points per game and 5.2 rebounds per game. He also averaged 4.7 assists per game. Hines was a two-time first team All-SSAC selection and was named Third Team All-American in 2021-22.

A DIFFERENT LOOK TO THE SCHEDULE FOR THE 2023-24 SEASON

Alabama State has changed up its schedule from year's past, adding more home games prior to Christmas and another before conference play begins in January. The Hornets will suit up 13 times inside the Dunn-Oliver Acadome. Prior to conference play, the Hornets will face LaGrange (Oct. 30), Oglethorpe (Nov. 14), Mississippi University (Dec. 3), USC (Dec. 19), and Johnson (Jan. 2).

SCHEDULE LOADED WITH TOUGH OPPONENTS FROM POWER-5 CONFERENCES

The 2023-24 schedule is littered with tough opponents from Power-5 conferences including the regular season opener against Ole Miss (Nov. 6). They will also face Iowa (Nov. 10), Memphis (Nov. 17), LSU (Dec. 13), USC (Dec. 19), and Auburn (Dec. 22). The Hornets will face South Florida (Dec. 29), and will face three teams in Birmingham including Samford (Nov. 22), North Carolina A&T (Nov. 24), and Merrimack (Nov. 25).

MOST HOME GAMES FOR HORNETS

The 13 home games by the Hornets this season is the most since the 2013-14 season when Alabama State finished 13-1 at the Dunn-Oliver Acadome and 19-13 overall. That season, the Hornets went on to play in the CIT against Sam Houston. Their only loss came against Southern (2/24).

FIRST TIME OPPONENTS ON THE SCHEDULE

Alabama State will face five opponents for the first time in school history this season when it lines up against Oglethorpe (Nov. 14), Merrimack (Nov. 25), Mississippi University (Dec. 3), South Florida (Dec. 29), and Johnson (Jan. 2).

LONGEST ROAD TRIP OF THE SEASON COMES IN STATE

Alabama State has one road trip that will last longer than a pair of games this season and that will take place over the Thanksgiving weekend in Birmingham (Ala.). The Hornets will take part in the Samford MTE against Samford (Nov. 22), North Carolina A&T (Nov. 24), and Merrimack (Nov. 25).

SIZE ON THIS YEAR'S ROSTER

Alabama State has six players listed at 6-6 or bigger on this year's roster including **D'Ante Bass** (6-6), **Jabari Williams** (6-11), **Darrell Reed** (6-8), **Eric Coleman** (6-8), **Jasteven Walker** (6-10), and **Ubong Okon** (7-1).

HOMECOMING FOR HEAD COACH TONY MADLOCK, THREE TIMES THIS SEASON

Alabama State head coach **Tony Madlock** had a homecoming of sorts in the 2023-24 season opener at Ole Miss, a school he once coached at. The second-year Alabama State coach was an assistant coach for four years at Ole Miss before serving as the interim head coach in the final five games of the 2018 season. He also had a homecoming at Memphis - where he was the point guard alongside Penny Hardaway during his playing days and served as an assistant coach later in his career. He finished off his homecoming visits to Auburn in the final game before Christmas on Dec. 22 - serving as an assistant coach at all three stops.

RETURNING OUTPUT FROM 2022-23 SEASON

Alabama State returns 46.2 percent of its scoring from last season with 907 points. The Hornets return their top two scorers in **Isaiah Range** and **TJ Madlock**. They also return 38.9 of their rebounding from a season ago.

ADDING UP THE MILES DURING THE 2023-24 NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE

Alabama State wrapped up the non-conference portion of the schedule that has seen games playing at Ole Miss, Iowa, Memphis, Samford, LSU, Auburn, and now South Florida. The Hornets added up to 5,082 miles round trip.

ONE OF TWO TEAMS TO WIN ON THE ROAD TO OPEN CONFERENCE PLAY IN 2024

Alabama State was one of just two teams to win on the road to start Southwestern Athletic Conference [SWAC] play in 2024, joining Alabama A&M. The Hornets pulled off a 54-51 victory over Mississippi Valley State [1/6], while Alabama A&M walked away with a one-point victory over UAPB. The two teams switch opponents on Monday night.

AND YES THEY ARE RELATED

Alabama State head coach **Tony Madlock** and student-athlete **TJ Madlock** are related as the father-son duo become the second in the last five years of Alabama State basketball. They join the likes of former assistant coach Steve Rogers who coached both of his sons, Steve and Austin, during his time at Alabama State.

10 DAYS OFF AFTER HOME GAME AGAINST MUW - LONGEST BREAK OF THE SEASON

Alabama State had its longest break of the season after the game on Sunday against MUW, as it was be off for 10 days before taking the court again, on the road against LSU on Dec. 13. That game started a string of four consecutive games on air with two on SEC Network+ and another two on ESPN+, all on the road.

STREAK ENDS AT 231, ROAD STREAK CONTINUES IN THREE-POINTERS MADE

Alabama State had a streak of at least one three-pointer in 231 consecutive games dating back to January 2016. The streak ended at home on January 2 against Johnson when the Hornets went 0-for-17. The last time the Hornets did not hit a three-pointer came on January 11, 2016 against UAPB at home.

Speaking of streaking, the Hornets have connected on at least one three-pointer from beyond the arc on the road in 179 consecutive road games dating back to the 2011-12 season.

CLOSING IN ON 1,000 CAREER POINTS - A PAIR WITHIN REACH OF THE MARK

Isaiah Range and **TJ Madlock** are each closing in on 1,000 career points after starting their careers at other institutions. Range currently sits at 990 career points after starting his career with 281 points at Tarleton State, while Madlock sits at 970 career points after starting his career with 395 points at South Carolina State. The duo, along with **CJ Hines** (transfer from Faulkner) have combined for 3,668 points during their careers. The duo will join 25 others who have scored 1,000 career points (while not all at Alabama State).

HORNETS ARE AMONG THE NATION'S BEST IN REBOUNDING THROUGH 15 GAMES

The Hornets are currently ranked 32nd in the nation in offensive rebounds per game [13.33] and are 36th overall in rebounding [40.40] so far through 15 games. They are also 93rd in the nation in defensive rebounds per game [27.07].

NEED A STEAL, SOMEONE CALL MICAH OCTAVE

Micah Octave has recorded at last one steal in all 15 games for the Hornets this season, including three against Auburn [12/22] and matched that against South Florida [12/29/23].

FIRST ROAD WIN COMES IN FINAL SECONDS

Alabama State recorded its first road win of the season and needed every second to do so against Mississippi Valley State [1/6]. The Hornets trailed with just over 10 seconds remaining before **Eric Coleman** knocked down his first free throw. He missed the second and the loose ball was picked up by **TJ Madlock** who scored and hit the free throw to put Alabama State up one with 6.4 seconds left. **Amarr Knox** sealed the win with a steal and dunk at the buzzer.

SECOND SEASON AT ALABAMA STATE

Tony Madlock enters his second season as the head men's basketball coach at Alabama State University after arriving on campus for the 2022-23 season.

In his first season at the helm of the Hornets, Madlock led the team to an 8-23 record including a non-conference victory over Eastern Illinois, while also leading the team to six Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) victories in his first season. He also coached his son, T.J., to the SWAC Newcomer of the Year award after averaging 11.2 points per game.

Madlock came to Alabama State after a year at South Carolina State in which his team finished 15-16 overall and 7-7 in the MEAC, falling to Morgan State in the conference tournament. The Bulldogs recorded non-conference victories over South Florida, High Point, Tennessee State, The Citadel, and Charleston Southern. They averaged 71.8 points per game last season while shooting 39.3 percent from the floor, while also leading the nation in offensive rebounds per game (15.23). They also finished third in the country in total rebounds per game at 41.81, trailing only Buffalo and Gonzaga.

He was named as a finalist for the Joe B. Hall Award, given to college basketball's top first-year coach after leading South Carolina State to its highest win total since 2015-16. The 15 wins by South Carolina State is the highest total in five seasons, with he and his son - TJ - leading the Bulldogs to one of the top turnarounds in the NCAA with 14 more wins than the program had all of 2020-21.

Prior to being named the head coach of the Bulldogs, he spent three years as an assistant coach under former NBA All-Star Penny Hardaway at Memphis. Madlock, who has 25-plus years of experience as a college assistant, also spent 2017-18 as the interim head coach at Ole Miss. During his time at Memphis, he reunited with Hardaway - a teammate during the 1991-92 season in which they reached the 1992 Elite Eight. As an assistant coach on the Tiger staff, he helped guide Memphis into a national powerhouse beginning in 2018 with the No. 1 recruiting class in 2019.

While at Ole Miss (2015-17), Madlock helped guide the Rebels to back-to-back 20-win seasons, including a trip to the NIT Quarterfinals. He coached the Rebels' Sebastian Saiz to all-league honors and to a record-breaking senior season, as well as Stefan Moody, who earned first team All-SEC honors for two straight years.

Prior to Ole Miss, Madlock spent four seasons as an assistant coach on Tony Barbee's staff at Auburn and four seasons as an assistant at UTEP. He was an assistant at Arkansas State for nine seasons, where he spent six of his nine years as the assistant head coach prior to leaving for UTEP. He helped Arkansas State to the 1998 Sun Belt Conference regular season championship and the 1999 Sun Belt Conference tournament title, during a stint in which recruited six JUCO All-Americans and the only junior college player in Arkansas State history to score 1,000 points in two seasons. He is also credited with developing four all-conference players and the Sun Belt Conference Newcomer of the Year.

An honorable mention All-American and first team All-State point guard, Madlock began

his coaching career as an assistant coach and teacher at his alma mater, Melrose High School in Memphis. The Golden Wildcats posted a 67-29 mark over the three seasons with Madlock on the staff, and Melrose was the 1997 state tournament runner-up with a 32-7 record.

Madlock earned a bachelor's degree in marketing from then-Memphis State in 1991 in 3.5 years. A four-year letterman and three-year starter for Memphis from 1988-92, Madlock was a member of four postseason tournament teams for the Tigers, reaching the NCAA Tournament and NIT two times each.

He still ranks among the school's all-time leaders for games played (128), and averaged double figures as a junior and senior. Madlock played one year of professional basketball in South America before starting his coaching career.

Madlock is married to the former Stacie Bryant of Memphis. They have two children - a daughter, Kyndal, and a son, T.J.
