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STORY LINES

- Head coach Alex Golesh enters his first season at the helm of the program and his fourth season as a head coach overall. His teams are 2-1 in the previous three season openers.
- The matchup at Mercedes-Benz Stadium marks Auburn's first neutral site game to begin a season since opening the 2019 season against Oregon in Arlington, Texas.
- Auburn is 4-1 in season openers in Atlanta with Saturday's matchup marking the first time the Tigers have opened in Atlanta since defeating No. 6 Washington 21-16 in the 2018 Chick-Fil-A Kickoff Game.
- The Tigers are 49-48-8 all-time in Atlanta, including 1-2 in Mercedes-Benz Stadium.
- Saturday's game is a rematch of Byrum Brown (USF) and DJ Lagway (Florida) from 2025, a game Brown's team won 18-16 in Gainesville.
- Auburn is 104-27-2 (.789) all-time in season openers, trailing only Alabama (105) and tied with Arkansas (104) for the most season-opening wins among current SEC schools.
- Auburn is also 30-14 (.682) in openers at neutral-site locations.
- Auburn is opening the season in consecutive years against P4 opponents and away from home for the first time since scoring wins over Washington and Oregon to open the 2018 and 2019 seasons.
- The Tigers have won 18 of their past 20 season openers dating back to the 2006 season, including nine straight season-opening wins since 2017. The nine straight season-opening wins is the third longest streak in program history.
- Alex Golesh is 2-1 in season openers in three seasons as an FBS head coach, including back-to-back victories.
- Auburn is 20-12-1 with a head coach making their Auburn debut, including 11-4 in the last 15. The Tigers are 12-1 when a head coach debuts at home, 3-5-1 on the road and 5-6 at neutral sites.
- With a season-opening victory in Waco last season, Auburn and Baylor are tied 2-2-1 in the all-time series that dates to 1954. The Tigers do hold a neutral site win over Baylor 33-13 in the 1954 Gator Bowl.
- Auburn is 25-8-1 all-time against the current members of the Big 12 with its now six games against Baylor the second most against any opponent in the league behind only Houston (7 meetings).
- Byrum Brown will be Auburn's 25th starting QB since 2000. The previous 24 are 18-6 in their Auburn debuts.
- Auburn's projected offensive line has combined for 130 career games played, including 68 starts. Senior center Cole Best leads the way with 39 games played and 23 starts.
- Auburn's 2026 campaign marks its 134th season of college football. The Tigers have 809 all-time wins, the 14th most among FBS programs.

MORE STORYLINES

- Thirty-two former Auburn letterwinners enter the 2026 season on NFL rosters.
- Auburn is 4-1 on September 5 all-time with the most recent game a 31-24 win over Louisville in Atlanta back in 2015.
- Auburn is 12-10-1 all-time in domed stadiums, including a mark of 1-2 in Mercedes-Benz Stadium. The Tigers' lone victory in the facility was 21-16 over Washington in 2018.
- Auburn has at least one defensive touchdown in 24 straight seasons, and in eight of the last nine years has at least one interception return for a touchdown.
- Auburn's four regular season wins over teams ranked No. 1 in AP/BCS/CFP are most in FBS since 2000.
- In the games in which senior defensive back Champ Anthony plays at least 20 defensive snaps, Auburn is 6-3.

AUBURN IN SEASON OPENERS

- Auburn is 104-27-2 (.789) all-time in season openers. The Tigers have won 18 of their past 20 openers dating back to the 2006 season; last year, Auburn defeated Baylor 38-24 in the season opener in Waco, Texas.
- First-year head coach Alex Golesh is 2-1 all-time in season openers.
- Auburn is 57-8-1 (.871) in season openers at home, 17-5-1 (.761) in openers on the road and 30-14 (.682) in openers at neutral-site locations.
- Auburn's total of 104 season-opening victories is behind only Alabama (105) and tied with Arkansas (104) for the most among current SEC schools.
- Auburn is 60-15 (.800) in 75 season openers against non-conference opponents since the inception of the SEC in 1933.

STREAKING IN SEASON OPENERS

- Auburn has won nine straight season openers dating back to 2017, outscoring the opponent 390-124 during the span.
- The Tigers haven't allowed more than 24 points in any of the eight season openers during the streak and have held the opponent to 14 points or fewer in five of the nine games.
- The nine game winning streak in season openers is the third longest in program history.
 - 16 straight wins (1907-22)
 - 11 straight wins (1935-46)
 - 9 straight wins (2017-present)

AUBURN IN ATLANTA

- Auburn is 49-48-8 all-time in Atlanta, including 1-2 in Mercedes-Benz Stadium.
- The Tigers are 34-35-4 all-time at Georgia Tech and 15-13-4 all-time in neutral site games.
- The team is 42-43-8 in Atlanta during the regular season, 3-3 in the SECCG and 4-2 in bowl games.
- Also including games in Athens (18-18), Columbus (19-23-2), Macon (6-2) and Savannah (1-0-1), Auburn is 93-91-11 all-time in Georgia.

SEASON OPENER SUPERLATIVES

- The Tigers have had numerous record-setting performances in season openers, including a pair of individual single-game records and a team record.
 - Bo Jackson: 290 rush yds vs. SW Louisiana (1985)
 - A. Wright: 263 rec yds vs. Pacific (1989)
 - Auburn: 565 rush yds vs. SW Louisiana (1985)

OPENERS VS. POWER CONFERENCE FOES

- Auburn is 38-18-1 in season openers against power conference teams all-time.
- The matchup with Baylor is the Tigers' second season straight opener against a power conference opponent after not doing so since the 2020 season.
- It marks the first time Auburn has opened consecutive seasons against the same opponent since opening against USC in 2002-03.
- Auburn is opening the season in consecutive years against P4 opponents for the first time since scoring wins over Washington and Oregon to open the 2018 and 2019 seasons.

SERIES HISTORY

- The series between Auburn and Baylor that dates back to 1954 is tied 2-2-1.
- Last year's meeting between the two programs was the first since 1976.
- Auburn won the only other neutral-site matchup, defeating the Bears 33-13 in the 1954 Gator Bowl in Jacksonville, Florida.

UP NEXT

- Auburn hosts Southern Miss at Jordan-Hare Stadium on Sept. 12 for Kickoff on the Plains. The Tigers are 107-16-3 (.860) all-time in home openers.
- Auburn's 23 all-time meetings with Southern Miss (18-5 record) are the most against any non-conference opponent not named Georgia Tech (92 games) and Clemson (51 games).
- The first meeting with Southern Miss was in Montgomery in 1946. Auburn has won four straight after losing back-to-back games in 1990-91. The teams last met in 2018 (AU, 24-13).

CAM NEWTON IS HONORARY CAPTAIN

- Auburn legend and 2010 Heisman winner Cam Newton will serve as honorary captain for the Aflac Kickoff Game.
- Joining Newton is Baylor's selection, 2011 Heisman Trophy recipient Robert Griffin III.
- The honorary captains will join for the pregame coin toss prior to the game.

HEAD COACHING DEBUTS

- Head coach Alex Golesh makes his Auburn debut vs. Baylor Saturday.
- Auburn is 20-12-1 in games with head coaches making their debuts, including 11-4 in the last 15.
- The Tigers are 12-1 when a head coach debuts at home, 3-5-1 on the road and 5-6 at neutral sites.

UBER-EXPERIENCED STAFF IN PLACE

- Auburn’s first-year coaching staff includes 93 years of Power 4 coordinator and coach experience including 10 of the 12 having coached previous seasons at the P4 level.
- Three of the staff members have served as defensive coordinators – Tim Banks, Coleman Hutzler and Brad Wilson.
- Three of the staff members have been head coaches in Larry Scott, DJ Durkin and Larry Porter.
- The staff has 51 combined years of experience in the SEC, including 15 combined years as coordinators.

FRESH HEAD COACHING FACES

- Along with Golesh coaching his first season at Auburn, the Tigers will take on four other SEC programs with first-year head coaches.
- Florida: Jon Sumrall (Sept. 19)
- LSU: Lane Kiffin (Oct. 24)
- Ole Miss: Pete Golding (Oct. 31)
- Arkansas: Ryan Silverfield (Nov. 7)

ADDING STARTING EXPERIENCE

- According to ESPN’s Bill Connelly, Auburn brought in more cumulative starting experience through the transfer portal than any other SEC program, totaling 176 starts.
- That figure includes QB Byrum Brown, OL Jo Simmons (James Madison) and Cole Best (USF), a group of USF wide receivers, and several other additions on the defensive side.

ALL-AMERICAN LINEBACKER XAVIER ATKINS

- Junior Xavier Atkins is first returning All-American on defense at Auburn since Tracy Rucker, who was a two-time All-American in 1987-88. Atkins has received multiple Preseason All-America honors for 2026 following his stellar 2025 campaign.
- Atkins and Brown gave Auburn two players on the Maxwell Award Preseason List, one of five programs in the SEC with multiple selections.
- Atkins (No. 16) and Brown (No. 80) were both on On3’s “Way-too-Early” Top 100 list for the 2026 season. Atkins was the highest rated linebacker on the list.
- Atkins finished the 2025 season with 9.0 sacks and 17.0 TFL - the most tackles for loss by an Auburn player since 2010.
- He was the first off-ball linebacker at Auburn to earn All-America honors since Karlos Dansby in 2003.

ALL EYES ON BYRUM BROWN

- Auburn QB Byrum Brown was Tom Luginbill’s No. 1 Best Fits from Portal on ESPN.com in January 2026.
- Brown is PFF’s highest rated returning quarterback in the SEC with a 2025 rating of 91.5. Brown along with Auburn center Cole Best have started 14 games together from 2024-25.
- The North Carolina native was only QB in the country in 2025 to grade above 85 as both a passer and runner according to PFF.
- He has thrown and rushed for a TD in eight straight games, twice as many consecutive games as any returning QB in FBS (Brad Jackson, Texas State - four). Since 2023, Brown leads all active QBs with 16 games with both a rushing and passing touchdown
- Brown rushed 175 times at USF in 2025, only 21 times since 1956 have SEC quarterbacks rushed that many times. Three Auburn players have done it – Sidle, 1963; Newton, 2010; Marshall, 2013.
- Brown is only active FBS QB entering 2026 with 7,600 pass yards, 2,200 rush yards, 60 pass TD and 32 rush TD. Only 14 quarterbacks have accomplished those totals since 1956.
- Brown has been responsible for 51 touchdowns in the red zone over his three seasons under Golesh.

BROWN DEBUT NOTABLES

- Brown is the 22nd Auburn quarterback since 1969 to make his team debut in a season opener. Auburn’s record in those games is 17-4.
- The last Auburn passer to make his first career start in a neutral environment was Bo Nix’s thrilling debut in Auburn’s win over Oregon in 2019 at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas.
- Of Auburn’s 45 starting quarterbacks since 1969, 27 of them have made their debuts against power conference opponents.

EXPERIENCED UNDER CENTER

- Brown is one of the most experienced quarterbacks in the nation, ranking fifth among active passers in career starts. His total leads the SEC.

RARE COMPANY

- Brown is one of only six players in the CFP era (since 2014) to post 3,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards in a season.
- The others? Jayden Daniels (LSU; 2023), Jalen Hurts (Oklahoma; 2019), Tyler Murray (Oklahoma; 2018), Lamar Jackson (Louisville; 2016-17) and Deshaun Watson (Clemson; 2015).
- Included in that group are three CFP appearances and three Heisman Trophy winners.

RUSHING LEADERS GALORE

- Auburn's running back room features not one, not two, not three, but four different rushers that led their respective teams in rushing in 2025.
- Senior Jeremiah Cobb led the Tigers a season ago with 969 yards, narrowly missing his first 1,000-yard season.
- Newcomers Bryson Washington (Baylor; 788 yds), Nykahi Davenport (USF; 612 yds) and Tae Meadows (Troy; 695 yds) all led their previous teams before making the move to the Plains this offseason.

LOADED WIDE RECEIVER ROOM

- Coached by former Auburn letterman Kodi Burns, the 2026 receiver room features several newcomers that followed the staff from USF.
- The leading receiver in Tampa last year is junior Keshawn Singleton. A Georgia native, Singleton has four career 100-yard games and led the team with 877 yards and eight scores.
- Singleton, who appeared on the Biletnikoff Award Watch List, had at least one reception in his final 15 games at USF from 2024-25.
- He totaled 66 receptions for 1,121 yards and 10 touchdowns during the span.
- Senior Chas Nimrod has connections with the staff back to his high school days in Northwest Arkansas that moved to Tennessee, USF and now Auburn. He had 466 yards and 3 TD in only 7 games before a season-ending injury.
- Sophomore Jeremiah Koger received the bulk of his playing time after the Nimrod injury and made the most of it totaling 587 yards and 8 TD, the second most for a FBS freshman.
- Sophomore Christian Neptune excels in the slot and has his best game of the season in USF's Cure Bowl appearance with 102 yards.

O-LINE EXPERIENCE

- Auburn's offensive line will welcome five new starters in 2026, and the projected group has combined for 130 career games played, led by Cole Best's 39.
- The O-line has also combined for 68 career games started, with Best again leading the charge with 23. Jo Simmons is close behind with 29 games and 14 starts.
- When healthy, Stanton Ramil was a stalwart at Michigan State starting 13 of the 16 games played.
- Jacob Strand (18 games played) and Cole Skinner (28 games played) have experience but have both started only eight games.

WELL-TRAVELED SIGLER IS FINALLY HOME

- Senior defensive lineman Cody Sigler is a New Hope, Ala. native and has seen all levels of college football in his four seasons of competition.
- Following a brief visit at Division III Huntingdon College, Sigler walked on a Division II West Alabama in 2022. After a redshirt season, he played in 10 games as a reserve in 2023 before bursting on the scene with 12.0 TFL and 6.0 sacks in 2024.
- Sigler moved on to Arkansas State in 2025 where he earned All-Sun Belt honors after post-ing 35 tackles, 7.0 TFL and 5.0 sacks in 11 starts.
- Notably Auburn assistant defensive line coach Larry Scott III was Sigler's position coach at UWA in 2022-23.
- Sigler has 79 tackles, 20.0 TFL and 11.0 sacks along with two FR over 33 games in his career.

BIG PLAY RAY

- Senior defensive back Rayshawn Pleasant is back for a final season and is one of the biggest return threats in the entire country.
- The West Monroe, La. Native is a former All-American and leads all active FBS players with five non-offensive touchdowns in his collegiate career.
- He has three career kick return touchdowns including last season's 98-yard score against Baylor plus a pair of interception returns for touchdowns.

- Alex McPherson, a member of the Lou Groza Award Preseason Watch List, enters the 2026 season having made 14 consecutive field goals and ranks 8th in program history in the category.

- He went a perfect 6-for-6 on FG in Auburn's win at Arkansas last season, matching an Auburn and SEC record for FGM in a game - tying former Tigers Daniel Carlson (2016 vs. LSU) and Al Del Greco (1982 vs. Kentucky).
- McPherson is a perfect 87-for-87 on PAT in his career and is 40-for-45 (88.9%) on FG - the best mark in Auburn history.
- Auburn has made 189 consecutive PATs dating back to the beginning of the 2021 season.

GOLESH AND GORDON WITH QB'S

- In eight seasons coaching quarterbacks, Joel Gordon has five players with 3,000+ passing yards. Auburn only has two in program history. His most notable pupil prior to Byrum Brown is current San Francisco 49ers QB Brock Purdy during his time at Iowa State.
- As both a coordinator and head coach, Alex Golesh has a history of strong QB play. Below is a list of his starters since 2020.

LONGTIME OC + QB CONNECTION

- Offensive Coordinator/Quarterback coach Joel Gordon and quarterback Byrum Brown working together in 2026 will be the first time Auburn has had a starting quarterback and an offensive coordinator together in consecutive season since Jarrett Stidham and Chip Lindsey in 2017-18.
- Gordon and Brown have worked together each of the last four seasons.
- It is the first time Auburn has had a QB/OC combo together for more than two seasons since Brandon Cox and Al Borges from 2005-07.
- Entering 2026, Auburn is one of four Power 4 programs with a head coach, offensive coordinator and quarterback together for the fourth straight year (others: Notre Dame, Texas, Georgia).

SEC QB RUSHING FOR 1,000 YARDS

- There have only been nine seasons all-time where a SEC quarterback rushed for more than 1,000 yards.
- Those nine seasons were produced by eight players including former Auburn QB's Jimmy Sidle (1963), Cam Newton (2010) and Nick Marshall (2014).
- Byrum Brown rushed for 1,008 yards during the 2025 season at USF.

- Auburn has three sets of brothers on its 2026 roster, tied with five other programs for the most in the country: Antonio Melendez and Elijah Melendez, Shadarius Toodle and Shadrick Toodle Jr., Chris Wells and Corey Wells.

STARTER STREAKS

- The Tigers enter the 2026 opener with three projected starters on streaks of consecutive starts longer than 15 games.
- Likely center Cole Best has started the last 22 games he played dating back to the 2024 season at USF.
- Standout defensive lineman Cody Sigler has started 22 straight game going back through his time at Arkansas State into his days at West Alabama.
- Playmaking wide receiver Keshaun Singleton was a constant at USF starting the last 19 games he played for the Bulls from 2024-25.

THE ATHLETIC FREAKS LIST

- A pair of Auburn standouts made appearances on Bruce Feldman's Freaks list on The Athletic this summer.
- QB Byrum Brown made his second straight appearance on the list and was joined by senior defensive end Da'Shawn Womack. Last year, new Auburn receiver Keshaun Singleton was on the annual list.
- On Brown: The former USF QB made the Freaks List last year. The 6-3, 235-pounder improved his bench press to 315 pounds from 300 and is still squatting 600 pounds, a hefty load for any QB, while also hitting 22.5 mph on the GPS. A 32-game starter for USF, Brown is being counted on to do more big things for the Tigers after following coach Alex Golesh to Auburn. He hit on 66.3 percent of his passes for 3,158 yards in 2025 with 28 TDs and 7 INTs, in addition to running for 1,008 yards and 14 TDs in Golesh's fast-paced attack.
- On Womack: The 6-5, 260-pound former five-star recruit is on his third SEC program after stops at LSU and Ole Miss. Last year for the Rebels, Womack, who has tremendous speed, posted career highs in tackles (27) and TFLs (4.5), along with two sacks. This offseason, he clocked 21.6 mph on the GPS, squatted 565 pounds and bench-pressed 350 pounds.

SPORTING NEWS 140 ALL-AMERICA DECADE TEAMS

- The Sporting News marked its 140th anniversary by naming an All-America team for each of the last seven decades. Three Auburn players were selected:
- 1970s – **Terry Beasley** (WR): Two-time All-American (1970-71) who caught 141 passes for 2,507 yards and 29 touchdowns in his career, leading the SEC in scoring and receiving in 1970.
- 1980s – **Bo Jackson** (All-Purpose): 1985 Heisman winner and Auburn's all-time leading rusher and the only Tigers back to rush for 4,000+ career yards. Two-time All-American, three-time All-SEC.
- 1980s – **Tracy Rocker** (DL): In 1988 became the first SEC player to win both the Outland Trophy and Lombardi Award. Two-time All-American, three-time All-SEC, with 21.0 career sacks.

THE LAST TIME VS. BAYLOR
AUBURN 38, BAYLOR 24

In his Auburn debut, Jackson Arnold, the 2022 national high school player of the year returned to the Lone Star State and led the Tigers to a 38-24 victory over Baylor Friday at McLane Stadium.

Playing two hours south of his hometown in Denton, Texas, Arnold rushed for 137 yards and two touchdowns while adding 108 passing yards, securing Auburn's win with a 27-yard TD rush late in the fourth quarter on fourth down.

Arnold averaged 8.6 yards per carry on 16 rushes while completing 11 of 17 passes to pace Auburn's 307-yard rushing effort.

Leading 17-10 at the half, Auburn doubled its lead on a 70-yard drive with Arnold's 21-yard run crossing midfield and setting up Jeremiah Cobb's 2-yard touchdown to put the Tigers ahead 24-10 with 5:40 remaining in third quarter.

Baylor answered with a 75-yard drive, cutting Auburn's lead to 24-17 on Sawyer Robertson's touchdown pass to Camden Knighten on fourth-and-goal from the 4-yard line with 58 seconds left in the third quarter.

Rayshawn Pleasant immediately regained momentum for the visitors, fielding Baylor's kickoff at Auburn's 2-yard line in the middle of the field, cutting to his left and racing 98 yards down the sideline to give the Tigers a 31-17 lead with 35 friends and family members in attendance.

Baylor responded with a 79-yard touchdown drive, again trimming the Tigers' lead to seven points on Robertson's third touchdown pass, a 4-yarder to Michael Trigg at the 11:48 of the fourth quarter.

Auburn then consumed more than half of the fourth quarter, putting away the game with a 75-yard, 12-play touchdown drive, with Arnold converting three third downs before beating the Bears at their own game, going for it on fourth-and-1 and scoring on a 27-yard run up the middle for the game's final score with 4:32 remaining.

Baylor took a 3-0 lead on the game's opening possession on Connor Hawkins 36-yard field goal. On their second drive, the Bears had first-and-goal at Auburn's 8-yard line after a 57-yard pass completion, but the Tigers held Baylor to 5 yards on three rushes, then forced an incompletion on fourth down to take over on downs.

Auburn drove 96 yards on 12 plays to take a 7-3 lead with Arnold picking up a first down with a 9-yard run on third-and-7. Consecutive false start penalties gave Auburn first-and-20, but a 26-yard pass from Arnold to Malcolm Simmons picked up a first down at Baylor's 37-yard line. Two plays later, Arnold rushed up the middle behind a block from center Connor Lew and cut to his right for a 24-yard touchdown.

Auburn's defense recorded a three-and-out, then the Tigers claimed a 14-3 with a run-heavy, seven-play, 65-yard drive that Damari Alston capped with a 9-yard touchdown run at the 10:29 mark of the second quarter.

Arnold's 23-yard pass to Cam Coleman set up Alex McPherson's 21-yard field goal with 5:45 left in the first half, giving the Tigers 17 consecutive points. Baylor cut Auburn's lead to 17-10 at the half with 3:21 to play in the half on Robertson's 33-yard touchdown pass on fourth-and-8.

Keyron Crawford led Auburn with seven tackles and one of the Tigers' four sacks.

Pat Dye Field at Jordan-Hare Stadium, the nation's 11th-largest on-campus stadium with a capacity of 88,043, is in its 83rd year as home to the Auburn Tigers.

On football Saturdays in Auburn, Jordan-Hare Stadium becomes Alabama's sixth-largest city. A record number of 63,500 season tickets were sold before the 2023 and 2024 seasons.

The stadium is named for Ralph "Shug" Jordan, Auburn's all-time winningest football coach, and Clifford Leroy Hare, a member of Auburn's first football team, president of the old Southern Conference and longtime chairman of Auburn's Faculty Athletic Committee.

Legendary coach Pat Dye has also had his name forever attached to Jordan-Hare Stadium, as the turf officially became known as Pat Dye Field at Jordan-Hare Stadium prior to the 2005 Iron Bowl. Dye, who served as coach and athletics director at Auburn (1981-92) and was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame (2005), led Auburn to a 99-39-4 record and four SEC titles in his 12 seasons on the Plains.

Auburn's current string of 22 consecutive sellout crowds at Jordan-Hare Stadium, including the Mercer game, breaks the previous program record streak of 17 consecutive sellout crowds, set between the 2013 Georgia game and the 2016 Clemson game.

What is now Jordan-Hare Stadium was dedicated November 30, 1939, at the Auburn-Florida game. Babe McGehee, who passed away in 2005, scored the first touchdown in what was then called "Auburn Stadium," by catching a pass from Dick McGowen. McGowen, who later coached at Auburn under Jordan, kicked the extra point and Auburn tied Florida, 7-7.

That first stadium held 7,500 seats and consisted of what is now the bottom part of the lower west stands. When the stadium was renamed "Cliff Hare Stadium" in 1949, 14,000 seats—the present lower east stands—had been added, raising capacity to 21,500.

Jordan became head coach in 1951 and the stadium underwent three major expansions in 15 years. More than 40,000 seats, virtually half of the stadium's present capacity, were added while Jordan was the coach.

Cliff Hare Stadium became Jordan-Hare Stadium in 1973. It was the first stadium in the country to be named for an active coach.

Overall, Auburn has played 463 games in Jordan-Hare Stadium, winning 352, losing 104 and tying seven for a winning percentage of .768 against some of the best teams in college football.

ALEX GOLESH » HEAD COACH



Alex Golesh, widely regarded as one of college football's premier offensive minds, has been named Auburn's 33rd head coach following three transformative seasons at South Florida.

The 2025 campaign showcased Golesh's offensive brilliance as USF posted a 9-3 record and ranked among the nation's elite in multiple categories. The Bulls finished No. 2 nationally in total offense (501.7 yards per game) and No. 5 in scoring (43.0 points per game), posting 500-plus yards in eight of nine regular season games. Under his guidance, quarterback Byrum Brown became just the 12th player in FBS history to pass for 3,000 yards and rush for 1,000 in a single season.

South Florida's resurgence included a return to the AP Top 25 for the first time since 2018 and consecutive victories over ranked opponents—defeating Boise State and Florida to open the season—a program first. The Bulls ranked in the top 25 of 20 national statistical categories spanning offense, defense, and special teams.

Golesh engineered a remarkable turnaround at USF, compiling 23 wins over three seasons after the Bulls won just four games in the prior three years. His 2023 debut produced the largest single-season improvement in school history, jumping from 1-11 to 7-6, including a historic 45-0 bowl victory over Syracuse—the largest shutout in NCAA bowl history. He became the first coach to lead USF to bowl eligibility in his first three seasons, earning postseason victories in both 2023 and 2024.

Prior to USF, Golesh coordinated Tennessee's explosive offense from 2021-22, transforming the Vols from No. 108 nationally in total offense to No. 1 in 2022. His unit led the country in scoring, total offense, and yards per play while coaching Biletnikoff Award winner Jalin Hyatt and Maxwell Award finalist Hendon Hooker. The performance earned him Broyles Award finalist recognition.

His coaching journey includes successful stints at Iowa State, UCF, Illinois, and Toledo, consistently elevating programs through elite recruiting and player development. Born in Moscow, Russia, and raised in Ohio, Golesh earned his bachelor's degree from Ohio State in 2006. He and his wife Alexis have two children, Corbin and Barrett.
