THURSDAY'S HEADLINES

- BC is ranked second nationally in scoring (5.47 gpg) and third nationally in scoring defense (1.16 gapg)
- Alex Carpenter (23-22-45) leads the nation in points and points per game (2.37), while Haley Skarupa is tied for fifth in points (14-20-34) and sixth in points per game (1.79)
- Haley Skarupa enters the week with 199 career points and is looking to become the Eagles' third 200-point scorer in program history
- Megan Keller is the nation's leading scorer among defenseman with 22 points (7-15-22) ... her eight power-play assists also lead all players nationally
- Katie Crowley comes into Thursday's game with 199 career wins
- BC is 8-0-0 on the road this season and has out-scored its hosts 45-5 while posting four of its seven shutouts away from home

BC AGAINST SYRACUSE

- Thursday's game will be just the fifth time BC and Syracuse have met ... the Orange elevated to Division I status ahead of the 2008-09 season
- BC leads the short series, 2-1-1 ... BC is 1-0-1 at home and 1-1-0 on the road
- Last season the squads met at Kelley Rink with BC claiming a 10-2 win in the season opener
- In 2013-14, the teams met in Syracuse with the Orange winning, 4-1
- The programs also met in 2009-10 and 2010-11 ... the teams tied their first-ever contest on Oct. 9, 2009 in Chestnut Hill, before the Eagles earned a 5-2 win at Syracuse on Oct. 9, 2010
- Head coach Katie Crowley has a 2-1-1 career mark against Syracuse

EAGLES VS. THE ORANGE

- Lexi Bender (3g, 1a) and Alex Carpenter (2g, 2a) lead all current Eagles in scoring against the Orange
- Bender recorded her first career hat trick in the Eagles' 10-2 win to open the 2014-15 season ... her assist came in the teams' 2013-14 meeting in Syracuse
- All of Carpenter's points came in last season's win
- Kristyn Capizzano (1g, 2a) and Haley Skarupa (2g, 1a) each have three points ... Capizzano tallied one goal and one assist last season, and all three of Skarupa's points came in that game
- Dana Trivigno has a pair of assists both from the 2014-15 meeting
- Haley McLean (1g), Kali Flanagan (1a), Kenzie Kent (1a) and Katie Burt (1a) all have one point against Syracuse
- Katie Burt won her first-ever collegiate game against Syracuse, picking up the W in the 10-2 win last season with 15 saves in the effort
- Emily Pfalzer '15 is the Eagles' leading career scorer against Syracuse, notching six points - one goal, five assists - in last year's win

SKARUPA INCHING TOWARD 200-POINT MILESTONE

Haley Skarupa enters Thursday's game with 199 career points, one shy of reaching the 200-point plateau ... when she reaches 200 points, she will become the third women's player in BC history to reach that milestone ... Skarupa has 94 career goals and 105 career assists in 122 games ... Kelli Stack '11 was the first women's player to reach 200 points, doing so in 2011 and finishing her career with 209 points ... earlier this year, Alex Carpenter reached 200 points, as well.

CROWLEY CLOSE TO 200 WINS

Katie Crowley, now in her ninth season as the Eagles' head coach, has a career record of 199-73-39 at the helm of the Eagles' program ... she has a career winning percentage of .703 ... overall, this is her 13th season at The Heights after joining Tom Mutch's staff as an assistant coach ahead of the 2003-04 season.

REGULAR-SEASON NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Since 2012-13 seasons, Boston College has compiled a 26-7-4 regular-season record in non-conference match-ups ... so far this season, BC is 6-0-0 vs. non-league opponents ... in 2014-15, BC went 9-1-1 during the regular season against non-Hockey East opponents, with the lone loss coming to No. 4 Harvard in the Beanpot championship ... in 2013-14, the Eagles were 7-3-2 against non-HEA foes, after an 8-3-1 mark in 2012-13.

NATION'S TOP STREAKERS

Boston College holds the nation's longest current winning and unbeaten streaks at 19 games ... Wisconsin is second with an 18-game winning streak, while Quinnipiac's 10-game undefeated run (8-0-2) ranks third ... both BC and Wisconsin are the only two remaining teams nationally with a perfect 1.000 winning percentage this season.

WIN LEADERS

Boston College's 19 wins so far this season lead the nation ... Wisconsin (18-0-0) is second, while Minnesota (15-3-0) and Clarkson (15-3-2) are tied for third ... six of the 10 teams nationally with double-digit wins hail from the East: BC, Clarkson (15-3-2), Quinnipiac (13-1-3), Northeastern (13-4-1), Boston University (12-7-1) and Colgate (10-3-5) ... in 2014-15, the Eagles led the nation in wins (34) in their best-ever season that resulted in a final 34-3-2 record.

HOME COOKING COMING LESS FREQUENTLY

After playing 11 of their first 16 games at Kelley Rink, the Eagles will not play another home game until Jan. 18 ... BC is playing 13 of 18 on the road to close the regular season, including the next three games ... during the team's current road streak - which started on Nov. 28 at Northeastern and included two games last weekend at Maine - the team has a month off between Dec. 10 (at Syracuse) and Jan. 9 (at Boston University).

ROAD WARRIORS

Boston College is a perfect 8-0-0 away from home this season, winning away contests at No. 9 Cornell (twice), UConn, Boston University, New Hampshire, No. 4 Northeastern and Maine (twice) ... in BC's eight road games, the Eagles have out-scored their hosts 45-5 and have posted four shutouts (Cornell, UConn, UNH, Maine) ... BC's last road loss was a 3-2 defeat at No. 4 Harvard in the championship game of the 2015 Beanpot ... BC is 21-1-2 in away games since the start of the 2014-15 season.

STAMPING MAROON & GOLD ON NATIONAL CHARTS

Boston College players are prominent on the national scoring and goaltending charts so far this season:

- 10 players are ranked in the top 47 in points per game, the most of any school in the country
- Three (3) players are ranked in the top 25 in goals per game: Alex Carpenter (1.21), Haley Skarupa (0.74) and Makenna Newkirk (0.53), tied for most in the country with Minnesota and Wisconsin
- 11 players are ranked in the top 57 in assists per game most of any school in the country
- Three (3) defensemen are ranked in the top 6 in DMan scoring: Megan Keller is third, Kali Flanagan is tied for fourth and Lexi Bender is sixth
- Alex Carpenter leads the nation in game-winning goals, is second in power-play goals and tied for second in shorthanded goals, while Megan Keller, Makenna Newkirk and Haley Skarupa are tied for ninth in power-play goals.
- Makenna Newkirk is fourth nationally among freshman in scoring (1.11 ppg), and is the nation's top freshman goal scorer
- Katie Burt is second nationally in goals against average, save percentage and shutouts, and shares the national lead in winning percentage.

BEST-EVER START STRETCHES ON

Boston College enters Thursday's game at 19-0-0, marking the first time the Eagles have maintained a perfect record this late into the season ... last year in 2014-15, even as the Eagles set a program record going undefeated through the first 28 games, the team

earned a tie at St. Lawrence in the third game of the season to start 2-0-1 ... before this year, the longest Boston College had gone into the season with a perfect record was four games (4-0-0) in 2010-11.

CARPENTER HONORED BY HOCKEY EAST ... AGAIN

On Monday, Alex Carpenter drew her sixth Hockey East player of the week honor of the season, and the 15th of her career ... she was recognized after scoring six points (2g, 4a) - tied for the most points in the country last week - in a pair of wins at Maine ... additionally, she claimed the Hockey East career scoring title, having now recorded 136 points in conference games ... she passed Kelli Stack '11 (133 pts.) and Northeastern's Kendall Coyne '16 for the lead on Saturday, and extended the edge to two points over Coyne (134 pts.) on Sunday.

RAPID FIRE ON OPPOSING GOALTENDERS

Just as the Eagles lead the nation in goals scored (104), they also have a penchant for scoring in quick succession this season ... 20 different times this year BC has scored two goals less than 3:00 apart, including eight times where back-to-back goals have come less than 1:00 apart ... the Eagles' quickest two goals came :09 apart against St. Lawrence on Oct. 11, with strikes at 3:11 and 3:24 of the third period ... three times this season, BC has scored three goals in less than 3:00: Oct. 24 at Cornell (16:43 - 17:29 - 18:57 of the third), Nov. 25 vs. Providence (4:03 - 5:38 - 6:53 of the second) and Dec. 6 at Maine (15:18 - 16:30 - 17:14 of the first).

STREAK'S STILL STRONG IN HOCKEY EAST

After the holiday break, BC will face Boston University on Jan. 9 riding a 38-game undefeated streak in regular-season conference

play that dates back to the 2013-14 season ... the Eagles' last loss in league play was Feb. 8, 2014, a 2-0 setback at Connecticut ... since that loss, BC is 37-0-1 in regular-season action, including last year's 20-0-1 season ... since the start of the 2012-13 season (the majority of the senior class' freshman year), BC is 68-4-4 in regular-season conference games.

HOME STREAK STRETCHES ON

When Boston College returns home in January, it will do so riding a 44-game home unbeaten run that dates back to Oct. 20, 2013 ... in this current stretch, BC has gone 43-0-1 and won the last 38 games played at Kelley Rink ... the Eagles have out-scored their opponents 235-57 during the unbeaten run, averaging 5.34 goals per game while allowing just 1.30 ... the last time BC lost at Kelley Rink was Oct. 16, 2013, a 3-1 defeat by New Hampshire.

SCORING STARTS EARLY ...

BC has scored the game's first goal within the first 5:00 of a game 10 different times this season and 13 times within the first 6:30 of a game ... in fact, BC has scored at least one goal in the first period in 18 of 19 games this season, with the only scoreless first period coming at UConn on Oct. 31.

... AND CONTINUES UNTIL THE HORN BLOWS

BC hasn't let up late in games this season, despite averaging the nation's top scoring margin (4.32 goals per game more than their opponents) ... in six separate games this season, the Eagles have scored a goal within the game's final 90 seconds, four times doing so within the final :30 of the game ... additionally, BC has won its only overtime game this season, scoring 2:17 into the extra stanza against Boston University on Nov. 10.

EAGLES GET OUT OF THE GATES WELL ...

BC has scored 36 goals in the first period this year, most among Hockey East teams and most in the conference in any period ... the Eagles have also allowed just two first-period goals this year, the best mark in HEA in any period ... the Eagles' 36 first-period goals are more than or equal to five conference teams' overall totals so far this season (UConn 36, Maine 35, Providence 35, Merrimack 30, UVM - 25).

... AND STAY HOT MIDDLE, LATE AND THROUGHOUT

In addition to the team's 36 first-period goals, the Eagles have tallied 33 goals in the second period (most in HEA in the second) and 34 in the third period (most in HEA in the third) ... Boston College has scored 104 goals this season, the highest total in the country ... the Eagles' 5.47 goals per game average is second nationally behind Minnesota (5.56).

GETTING AHEAD AND STAYING AHEAD

Of the 1140:00 played this season, Boston College has held the lead for 962:07 of action in 19 games - 85.4 percent of play this season ... the Eagles and their opponents have been tied for 173:06, with 123:22 of that coming at the start of the game ... Boston College has only trailed for 12:02 this season, or 1.06 percent of the season.

SPECIAL TEAMS STANDOUTS

This season, Boston College has been posting stand-out performances on special teams ... the Eagles rank fourth nationally in combined special teams, proving successful in 83-of-138 attempts this season (60.1 percent) ... on the power play, BC ranks second nationally, converting 22-of-72 chances (30.6 percent) ... BC has scored at least one PPG in 15 of the team's 19 games ... on the PK, the Eagles have killed 61-of-66 (92.4 percent) opponent chances with the man-advantage to rank fifth nationally ... BC started the season 35-for-35 on the PK, before Boston University broke the streak on Nov. 7.

POWER PLAY PRODUCERS

Several Eagles are among the national leaders in power-play scoring ... Alex Carpenter (7 PPG) is second nationally in power-play goals and leads the nation in power-play points (7-6-13) ... Megan Keller (3), Makenna Newkirk (3) and Haley Skarupa (3) are tied for ninth nationally in power-play goals ... Andie Anastos (2), Kenzie

Kent (2) and are tied for 32nd nationally ... Keller's eight power-play assists also lead the nation in that category.

DOUBLE-EDGED PK UNIT

Not only are the Eagles ranked fifth nationally on the penalty kill (92.4 percent), but BC's five shorthanded goals this season are the second-highest total nationally ... Wisconsin leads the country with six shorties, while the next closest teams is Boston University with four ... Alex Carpenter has a pair of shorthanded goals, while Haley Skarupa, Kristyn Capizzano and Lexi Bender have each added one.

TRIVIGNO KNOCKING ON TOP 10's DOOR

Dana Trivigno became the latest Eagle to hit the 100-point mark on her career and she's set to join the top 10 in scoring in short order ... Trivigno enters Thursday's game in 11th place in the BC scoring charts with 109 points, four points back of 10th place (113 - Mary Restuccia '12). ... her first-period goal on Nov. 10 against BU was her 100th career point, and she become the 12th player in BC history to reach that 100-point plateau ... Trivigno is the third player of the Class of '16 to reach 100 points.

SKARUPA SOARING ON SCORESHEET

Through 19 games, Haley Skarupa has recorded 34 points from 14 goals and 20 assists ... Skarupa enters the week tied for fifth nationally in points, and sixth nationally in points per game (1.79) ... her 20 assists are tied for the fourth-highest total nationally, while she is one of eight players who have scored 14 or more goals ... as a junior in 2014-15, Skarupa ranked second nationally in points per game (1.92) and third overall in scoring with 71 points.

GOAL, POWER-PLAY GOAL RECORDS ON THE HORIZON

Having already claimed the school's points, assists and game-winning goals records this season, two more career records are in Alex Carpenter's reach: goals and power-play goals ... Carpenter has scored 113 goals, three back of the school record 116 set by Erin Magee '99 ... she also has 24 career power-play goals, tied with Kelli Stack's '11 for the school record ... she will claim the PPG record for herself with her next strike with the man-advantage.

HALEY COMETING UP RECORD CHARTS, TOO

Haley Skarupa is also doing damage to the Eagles' record book ... she enters the week third in career scoring with 199 points, having jumped fourth-place Erin Magee '99 (198 pts.) last weekend ... she is currently fourth in career goals with 94, four back of third-place Kelli Stack '11 (98) ... Skarupa has 105 career assists and ranks third

at BC, six back of second-place Stack (111) ... she is also third in career shorthanded goals (10) as Allie Thunstrom '10 holds the record with 12 ... when Skarupa hits 200 points, she will be the third BC women's player in BC history to reach the 200-point threshold, and the seventh player - man or woman - to reach it.

TIP OF THE HAT

BC players have recorded five hat tricks this season ... Alex Carpenter (3), Haley Skarupa (1) and Makenna Newkirk (1) have all potted three goals in a game this season ... the Eagles' five hat tricks this year is the team's highest total since the 2012-13 season when they had six: Alex Carpenter (3), Haley Skarupa (2) and Dana Trivigno (1).

MOVERS & SHAKERS IN BC HOCKEY HISTORY

Both Alex Carpenter and Haley Skarupa are not only making waves on the BC women's hockey records, but they're also having an impact on BC's overall hockey scoring records ... Carpenter is currently the second-leading scorer - man or woman - in BC hockey history and just four points back of all-time leading scorer, David Emma '91 (239 points) ... Skarupa enters the weekend in seventh place overall, and is just one of nine players who have scored at least 198 career points ... Carpenter is now 10 goals back of the school's all-time goal scoring record (Brian Gionta '01 - 123 goals), and eight assists shy of the all-time assist record (Mike Mottau - 130 assists).

EAGLES CROWDED AT TOP OF HOCKEY EAST SCORING

BC claims the top two scorers in Hockey East (league games only) this season, as Alex Carpenter (10-17-27) is ranked first and Haley Skarupa (12-12-24) second ... additionally, 10 of the top 20 scorers all hail from The Heights ... Andie Anastos (6-9-15), Kristyn Capizzano (5-10-15), Dana Trivigno (3-12-15) and Megan Keller (3-12-15) are all tied for sixth, while Kenzie Kent (7-6-13) is tied for 12th, Kali Flanagan (5-7-12) and Lexi Bender (3-9-12) are tied for 15th and Makenna Newkirk (5-6-11) is 20th ... Skarupa's 12 goals are second in HEA behind Northeastern's Kendall Coyne, while Carpenter's 17 assists lead the league.

HEA CAREER SCORING TITLE WILL BE RACE TO THE FINISH

The Hockey East (only) career scoring chase will stay hot all winter as two current players enter the week ranked 1-2 ... last weekend, Alex Carpenter jumped both former record holder Kelli Stack '11 and Northeastern's Kendall Coyne '16 to become the conference's career scoring leader ... Stack (133 pts.) set the record in 2011, and on Friday night, Coyne tied Stack's record with her 133rd career point ... however, on Saturday afternoon, Carpenter recorded four points to leapfrog both players and claim the title for herself ... that night, Coyne added a single point to move into a tie with Carpenter, but on Sunday, the Eagles' captain posted two points to retake the career lead ... BC has played 13 league contests (of 21) this season, while Northeastern has played 10.

SKARUPA WILL ALSO HAVE A PLACE AMONG THE TOP

In addition to Alex Carpenter and Northeastern's Kendall Coyne's season-long battle for the conference's career scoring title, BC's Haley Skarupa is also poised to make a major move up the league's career charts ... she is currently ranked sixth in career scoring with 116 points ... UNH's Sam Faber '09 is next up with 118 points, while BU/UNH's Jenn Wakefield '12 had 121 career points ... Kelli Stack '11 is currently third (133 pts.)

KENZIE KEEPING IT ROLLING

After five games without a point, Kenzie Kent has picked up nine points - four goals, five assists - in the team's last four games ... the scoring marks pushed her season totals to 7 goals and 13 assists and 20 points ... her scoring production recently has coincided with a return to the same line she played on as a freshman, with Kent on the left wing, Alex Carpenter in the center and Haley Skarupa on the right wing ... she started the season with Carpenter in the center and Makenna Newkirk on the right for 14 games.

BURT BACKING IT ALL UP

Katie Burt has been her usual brick wall in goal of late, allowing just eight goals and posting seven shutouts in her last 13 outings ... she has 17 career shutouts, second in program history despite playing in only 51 games ... Burt enters the weekend second nationally in GAA (0.98), second in save percentage (.957), second in shutouts (7) and tied for first in winning percentage (1.000) ... as a freshman in 2014-15, Burt led the nation with a 1.11 GAA and was tied for third nationally with 10 shutouts, a mark that matched the BC single-season record ... Burt is now four shutouts back of the BC career record (21, Molly Schaus '11).

GABRI GETTING HERS, TOO

Gabri Switaj has stood tall in her four appearances (including three starts) in net so far this season ... the sophomore has gone 3-0-0 with a 1.91 goals against average in wins over Maine, New Hampshire and Providence ... she's posted a .907 save percentage ... for her career, Switaj is 5-0-0 in eight appearances with a 1.97 GAA.

NEWKIRK'S THE NEW KID

Makenna Newkirk has adjusted well to the college game ... Newkirk has recorded 21 points - tied for fourth on the team - with 10 goals and 11 assists ... she is the nation's second-leading rookie scorer in points, and fourth-leading rookie scorer in points per game (1.11) ... Newkirk's 10 goals are third on the team, and she shares the national lead in freshman goalscoring with Robert Morris' Amber Rennie.

DEFENDERS GETTING IN THE SCORING ACTION

Three of the Eagles' regular six defensemen are ranked in the nation's top six in DMan scoring per game ... Megan Keller (7-15-22) is third nationally in defenseman points per game (1.16), but leads all defenseman nationally in both goals (7) and points (22) ... Kali Flanagan is ranked fourth in points per game (1.00), and her 19 points are the fourth-highest total among all defensemen ... Lexi Bender is ranked sixth in points per game (0.95) with 18 points (4-14-18) in 19 games.

BENDER CONTINUES HER CLIMB UP D CHARTS

Lexi Bender enters the weekend with 18 points (4g, 14a) and is ranked fifth nationally in defenseman points and sixth in defenseman points per game (0.95) ... with 80 career points, Bender is fourth on the BC defenseman career scoring list behind Emily Pfalzer '15 (102), Genevieve Missirlian '99 (83) and Blake Bolden '13 (82) ... Bender is second in defenseman assists with 63 and is now 16 back of career assist leader Pfalzer (79).

KELLER BRUISING FROM THE BLUELINE

Megan Keller has been a rock at the blue line this season ... defensively, she's helped anchor the Eagles defense that has allowed 1.16 goals per game - third best in the country - and held opponents to one or fewer goals in 13 of 19 games with seven shutouts ... offensively, she's collected 22 points (7g, 15a), third on the team ... Keller's 1.16 points per game are third nationally among defensemen ... also, she's a +32 on the season, the second-best mark on the team.

FLANAGAN ON FIRE

Kali Flanagan has posted a career-best 19 points this season, from five goals and 14 assists through 19 games ... her five goals have already surpassed her 39-game freshman year total of three, while her 14 assists have more than doubled her rookie-season mark of 6 ... five times this season she's recorded multiple points, including matching her career best with three points last Saturday at Maine

... she has picked up at least one point in 12 of 19 games this season ... defensively, she's been part of the Eagles' defense that is ranked third nationally (1.16 gapg) ... Flanagan is a +27 on the year, the team's fourth-best mark.

ANASTOS MAKING AN IMPACT

Andie Anastos is tied for fourth on the Eagles with 21 points (9g, 12a), and her +28 rating is third-best on the team ... this season, Anastos has recorded seven multiple-point games, including a three-point effort at Maine on Sunday with one goal and two assists ... the junior captain now has 86 career points to rank 17th all-time at BC ... when she reaches the 100-point mark, she will become the 13th player to reach the century plateau.

KENT KEEPS GOING ALL YEAR LONG

Kenzie Kent keeps going all year long at The Heights, on the ice in the fall and winter before heading out to the lacrosse field in the spring ... on the lax field, Kent earned a place on the IWLCA national all-rookie team in 2015 after scoring 22 goals and 25 points in just eight games last year ... on the ice, she's collected 58 career points (14g, 44a) in 58 career games ... Kent is familiar playing with top teams as the hockey team has been ranked in the Top 3 for the entirety of her career, while lacrosse was a Top 5 team last year.

TRIVIGNO COZY IN THE PENALTY BOX

Dana Trivigno has spent her fair share of time in the penalty box in her BC career ... through 19 games into the season, Trivigno has 90 penalties for 188 career minutes ... she's fourth on the BC career penalties chart and third in career penalty minutes ... Becky Zavisza '09 holds the career penalties mark (105), while Mary Restuccia '12 holds the career penalty minutes mark (219 min.) ... Trivigno leads the team in penalties (15) and PIMs (30) this season.

GRIEVES' GETS OFF TO HOT START AS A SENIOR

Meghan Grieves is off to a career-best start in her senior year ... the forward has collected 12 points (5g, 7a) through 19 games, now matching her previous single-season best from 39 games in 2014-15 (8g, 4a) ... after an 8-point (3g, 5a) freshman campaign in 2012-13, she recorded one point in 35 appearances as a sophomore ... her 7 assists this season is a new single-season best for the senior.

CLASS OF ITS OWN

The Class of 2016 is the only graduating class in BC hockey history to claim three players who reached the 100-point mark as Alex Carpenter (235), Haley Skarupa (199) and Dana Trivigno (109) have all now reached the century mark ... prior to this, the Class of '15 had a pair of players to reach the 100-point mark: Emily Field (138) and Emily Pfalzer (102) ... NOTE: Carpenter matriculated at BC with the Class of 2015, but moved to the Class of 2016 after taking a leave of absence during the 2013-14 school year to play with Team USA at the Sochi Olympics.
