LEAGUE PLAY DOMINATING THE UPCOMING SCHEDULE

- Boston College is in the midst of a nine-game stretch against Hockey East opponents, taking the team through the beginning of December
- As the Eagles are in the middle of the run of conference contests, BC already sits atop the Hockey East standings with 10 points from six games
- The Eagles have played more conference games than all but one team in the league, and are six points clear of six teams tied in second place with four points

ANASTOS BACK TO FULL HEALTH, EARNING LEAGUE HONORS

- Andie Anastos is back to full health after an injury suffered in the Eagles' second game of the season at Minnesota Duluth
- While she never technically missed a game since she has dressed for every contest, she did not play in three games (Oct. 9-15), returning to the ice on a regular shift during the Quinnipiac series
- Last weekend against Connecticut, however, Anastos was back to full health and made her impact known
- She scored four goals and match the NCAA mark for power-play goals in a game (3) on Friday at UConn
- For her four-goal effort last weekend, Anastos claimed her first-ever Hockey East Player of the Week award on Monday

LONERGAN TABBED HOCKEY EAST'S TOP ROOKIE

- · Caitrin Lonergan picked up Hockey East's first Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Year award of the 2016-17 season
- The Roslindale, Mass., product led all conference rookies in points as the season opened, and paced all freshmen nationally in goals (6)
- Her 11 points are third-most in HEA this season among all players, and her three power-play goals are the second-most in the NCAA
- This is Lonergan's first career Hockey East honor

FIRST-TIME SCORERS DOMINATE SCORE SHEET LAST SATURDAY

- In last Saturday's 5-1 win over UConn, three different players recorded their first-career points
- · Serena Sommerfield tallied her first-career goal in the third period ... it came in her 37th career game
- On the team's first goal, Caroline Ross and Erin Connolly combined to set up Ryan Little ... the assists were the first points in both Ross and Connolly's careers

LITTLE LIKED HER NEW ROLE

- Ryan Little moved up to the third line midway through the second period last Friday at Connecticut and remained there for the home leg against the Huskies on Saturday ... the move paid off for her, as she netted two goals in the first period at Kelley Rink
- Saturday marked the first two-goal game of her career ... in fact, the two goals doubled her career goal total (1)
 coming into the contest

KELLER SWAPPING MAROON & GOLD FOR RED, WHITE & BLUE

- Megan Keller will not be available to the Eagles this weekend Boston University while she is with the U.S.
 National Team at the Four Nations Cup ... she also missed last weekend's series with UConn
- She joined up with Team USA on Friday, Oct. 28, and is scheduled to return to the Eagles on Monday, Nov. 7.
- This will mark the second time she has played in the Four Nations Cup, also helping the U.S. win gold in 2014
- She is one of six BC Eagles on the 23 player roster set to represent the U.S., joining Alex Carpenter '16, Emily Pfalzer '15, Haley Skarupa '16, Kelli Stack '11 and Dana Triviano '16
- Keller is one of three collegians on the team and the youngest player on the U.S.' Four Nations Cup roster

SPECIAL TEAMS DOING SPECIAL THINGS

- · Boston College's special teams have been hot to start the season
- The Eagles lead the nation in combined special teams, proving successful in 60-of-97 opportunities this season (61.9 percent)
- On the power play, BC ranks first nationally with a 31.2 percent conversion (15-for-48) ... the team's 15 pow-

SERIES NOTES

- The teams will play their 45th and 46th varsity games this weekend ... in varsity contests. BC leads the series 23-16-5
- Last year, Boston College won all four meetings, including the title game of the Hockey East Tournament
- At Kelley Rink, the Eagles are 9-7-2 against BU ... at Walter Brown Arena, the Eagles are 11-6-2 ... at neutral sites, the series is tied, 3-3-1
- Since the 2013-14 season, BC is 10-2-1 against Boston University overall, with the Eagles' two losses coming in the 2014 and 2015 Hockey East Championship games
- BC went six seasons without a home win against BU: 2007-08 through 2012-13 ... the
 Eagles won the Feb. 4, 2014 meeting at Kelley Rink to snap an 0-7-2 run at home against
 the Terriers ... however, since the 2013-14 season BC is 5-0-0 at home vs. Boston
 University
- BC and BU have met in the last three Hockey East Tournament championship games, with the Eagles snapping the Terriers two-tournament winning streak (2014, 2015) last season (2016)
- The two schools met numerous times in the Beanpot before the two programs' ascension to D1 status (BC in 1994-95 and BU in 2005-06) ... the teams met nine times while BC was a D1 program and before BU transitioned to D1 status in 2005-06, with the Eagles winning all nine games

PLAYER NOTES

- · Eight current Eagles have registered at least one point against Boston University
- Andie Anastos has collected 11 points in 13 career games against BU, coming on 6 goals and 5 assists ... as a freshman in 2013-14, she posted 8 points (4g, 4a) in 5 games
- Makenna Newkirk (3-2-5) recorded her first career hat trick on Nov. 7, 2015 at BU
- Kristyn Capizzano (2-3-5), Kenzie Kent (1-4-5) and Toni Ann Miano (both 1-1-2) all have multiple points ... Kent picked up three points in the 2016 Hockey East Championship game (1-2-3)
- Megan Keller (0-8-8) leads all active Eagles in assists against BU
- Kali Flanagan (0-1-1) also has recorded one point against the Terriers
- Katie Burt is 5-1-1 against BU with a 1.69 GAA, 2 shutouts and a .932 save percentage
 Burt's last appearance against the Terriers was a 25-save shutout in the HEA
 Championship game
- Gabri Switaj is 1-0-0 vs. the Terriers with a 3.00 GAA and a .870 save percentage; her first career start came against BU in a 4-3 win in January 2015

CHME NOTES

- er-play goals are tops nationally, as well
- On the penalty kill, the Eagles rank seventh nationally with a 91.8 percent success rate (45-for-49) while scoring one shorthanded goal
- So far this season, 17 of the Eagles' 30 goals more than half have come via special teams (15 PPGs, 2 SHGs)

POWER PRODUCTION ON THE POWER PLAY

- Three different Eagles are among the nation's leaders in power-play goals
- Andie Anastos is tied for the national lead with four, while freshmen Caitrin Lonergan and Delaney Belinskas are tied for fourth nationally with three apiece
- BC leads the nation in power-play goals with 15, and eight different players have notched a goal on the man-advantage this season
- Last Friday night, Anastos matched the NCAA record for power-play goals in a game with three, becoming the ninth player in NCAA history to score three PPGs in a game

WHISTLES WHILE YOU WORK ...

- Boston College is one of the nation's top penalty-kill teams, and it's been a handy trait this season
- The Eagles have already accumulated 118 penalty minutes on 55 penalty calls through 10 games
- BC ranks 11th nationally in penalty minutes per game (11.8) and the team's 118 penalties are fifth-most in the country
- The Eagles have been called for at least six penalties in seven of 10 games this season, including a season-high 8 at Minnesota Duluth on Oct. 1
- BC's low was one penalty which occurred Oct. 30 at UConn

.. BUT A BIG DIFFERENCE IN LEAGUE PLAY

- In the team's last three Hockey East games, BC has been whistled for no more than four penalties - last Saturday against UConn - with a low of one call at UConn last Friday

DEFENSE BUCKLING DOWN

- After opening the season with eight goals allowed in two games, the Eagles have averaged 1.00 goals allowed in the last eight games
- Seven times in the last seven games BC has surrendered one goal or less including shutouts of No. 3 Quinnipiac on Oct. 21 and Connecticut on Oct. 28
- BC has allowed an average of 20.3 shots per game the last seven contests

CAITRIN IS CUTTING IT UP!

- Freshman forward Caitrin Lonergan has already shown why she's a contender for ACHA National Freshman of the Year
- The forward from Roslindale, Mass., leads the Eagles in points with 11 from 6 goals and 5 assists
- She is currently second nationally in freshman scoring and is the leading goal scorer among all freshmen nationally
- Her three power-play goal are not only tied for the national freshman lead, but are also tied for fourth nationally among all skaters
- Lonergan has recorded at least one point in eight of 10 games this year, with her best output coming in the Eagles' 4-1 win at No. 3 Quinnipiac: one goal (SHG) and two assists, including the primary set-up on the game-winning goal

BIZAL GOING BONKERS BACK THERE

- Through 10 games, defenseman Grace Bizal already has seven points and is fied for third on the team in scoring
- As a freshman, Bizal posted 11 points in 41 game with all 11 points coming via assists
- So far this year, Bizal already has six assists which took her 26 games to reach in 2015-16 - and has scored her first career goal
- Bizal has been a key member of the Eagles' power-play unit this year, although only two
 of her assists have come on the man-advantage
- Already this year, BC is 5-0-0 when she records a point and 1-2-2 when she is held off the box score

DEFENSEMEN (AND THE GOALIE) SETTING THE TABLE

- Defensive players both defensemen and goaltenders have registered 25 of the Eagles' 51 assists so far this season ... that's 49 percent of BC's assists this year
- Megan Keller (6), Grace Bizal (6) are tied for the team lead in assists, while Kali Flanagan (5) and Toni Ann Miano (5) are tied for second-most assists on the squad
- Even goaltender Katie Burt has gotten into the action, already recording two assists in nine appearances, doubling her career total coming into the season
- Overall in scoring, three Eagles blue liners are tied for third on the team: Toni Ann Miano (2-5-7), Megan Keller (1-6-7) and Grace Bizal (1-6-7)

HOME UNDEFEATED MARK STILL CARRIES ON

- Eagles has extended its NCAA-record home unbeaten run to 56 games (54-0-2)
- The current run began on Oct. 19, 2013
- Since the start of the Eagles' undefeated home run in 2013, BC has out-scored its
 opponents 296-72, averaging 5.29 goals per game while allowing 1.29 goals against
- Boston College's NCAA-record 48-game home winning streak was snapped with the 0-0 tie with No. 3 Ouinnipiac on Oct. 21
- $\,\cdot\,\,$ The last time BC lost at Kelley Rink was Oct. 16, 2013, a 3-1 loss to New Hampshire

FRESHMEN FILLING THE LINEUP

- Boston College's freshman class has been relied on heavily this season so far
- The Eagles have dressed at least six freshmen in each game, with all seven dressing for four straight games (Oct. 8-15)
- Caitrin Lonergan not only leads the Eagles in scoring with 11 points (6g, 5a), but is second nationally in freshman scoring and leads all freshmen nationally in goals
- Delaney Belinskas is second both in team goals and NCAA freshman goals
- Lonergan and Belinskas each have three power-play goals, fied for second-most nationally among all players
- Bridget McCarthy has two points (1g, 1a) in 10 games, while Kate Annese has one assist in six games
- Caroline Ross has played all 10 games along the blue line with one assist, and Rachel Moore has played the last eight games at forward
- · Goaltender Molly Barrow has dressed each game, but has not seen any action

ANASTOS IS HOCKEY EAST'S ACTIVE CAREER SCORING LEADER

- With 74 career points in league play, Andie Anastos is the conference's active career scoring leader coming into the weekend
- · She is nine points ahead of second-place Denisa Krizova (Northeastern) who has 65
- Four Eagles are in the current top 11 active scorers, including Megan Keller, Kenzie Kent and Kristyn Capizzano

ANASTOS MAKING RUN FOR TOP-10

- Andie Anastos comes into the weekend with 110 career points and sits in 12th place on the Eagles' career scoring chart
- Anastos is now 15 points back of 10th-place Laura Traynham '97, who finished her career with 125 points ... she is three points back of 11th-place Mary Restuccia '12 (113 pts.)
- Anastos was the 13th player in program history to break the 100-point plateau

THE EAGLES' NEXT CENTURIANS

- Three different Eagles are making a push for 100 career points this season after passing 75 points last season
- Kenzie Kent has 86 career points, Megan Keller has 83 and Kristyn Capizzano has 82 points
- When they make it to 100 points, they will be the 14th, 15th and 16th players to reach the 100-point plateau

MIANO CLOSING IN ON THE HALF-CENTURY MARK

- While three players are chasing 100 career points, Toni Ann Miano has 49 career points (14 goals, 35 assists)
- She will most likely be the Eagles' next player to reach the 50-point mark
- When Miano reaches 50 career points, she will be the eighth defenseman in program history to reach that mark

KENZIE'S KRAZY SPRING & SUMMER SCHEDULE

- · Kenzie Kent was called in to national team camp this summer, but with USA Lacrosse
- The Eagles' two-sport star was an All-ACC and IWLCA All-Northeast Region honoree in 2016 – while only playing the final 10 of the lacrosse team's 19 games
- She tallied 18 goals and added 17 assists for 35 points while helping lead the Eagles to the NCAA Tournament
- Kent played all 41 hockey games last season, finishing the year on March 20 in the National Championship game ... on March 26, she suited up for the lacrosse team against North Carolina at home and played the rest of the season

BURT STANDS TALL IN CONFERENCE PLAY, BUT GETS LITTLE RESPECT

- Katie Burt is Hockey East's back-to-back Goaltending Champion, but has yet to be voted to the conference's All-Star First Team in either of her collegiate seasons
- She was a Hockey East All-Star second-team honoree as a freshman and honorable mention last year
- She is now 40-1-1 in league play with a career GAA of 0.94 with a .951 save percentage and 17 conference shutouts - second most in league history with almost two full seasons left to play
- Burt's 40 conference wins are just 12 shy of the league's record of 52, held by Melissa Bourdon, UNH '07
- She has backed Hockey East's top defense the last two years and led the conference in GAA, wins, save percentage and shutouts in both of her collegiate seasons

BURT'S NEXT HEA SHUTOUT WILL TIE THE RECORD

- Katie Burt's next Hockey East shutout will lift her into a tie for the conference's career shutout record
- Currently, the mark is held by Melissa Bourdon (UNH '07) who had 18 in her career
- Burt enters the weekend with 17 career league shutouts
- BC's Molly Schaus '11 ranks third on the list with 14

BURT IMPACING NCAA CAREER MARKS ALREADY

- Despite being just a junior, Katie Burt already appears in the NCAA career goaltender records
- She is 16th in career wins (70) 11 wins back of the top 10 (BC's own Molly Schaus '11 with 80)
- Additionally, she is tied for eighth on the career shutouts list with 25, now five shy of ranking in the too five
- Three records she is not ranked in because they are only determined once a player is done playing are career winning percentage, GAA and save percentage
- Burt's .900 career winning percentage (70-6-4) would be the NCAA record if her career ended today (current record: .897 by Minnesota's Amanda Leveille '16)
- Also, her career 1.23 GAA would rank fifth in NCAA history, while her .940 career save percentage would be tied for eighth in NCAA history.

DELANEY DOES A RARE FEAT

- Delaney Belinskas' four-goal effort against Maine on Oct. 9 was a rarity for the Eagles
- It was just the eighth time in program history that a player scored four or more goals in a single game
- It also marked the first time a BC freshman scored four goals in a game in 21 years, since Erin Magee '99 did so on Jan. 7, 1996
- Belinskas' four-goal day was the Eagles' third such game in the last 10 months after the team went 17 years without one
- Alex Carpenter had four goals at Syracuse (12/10/15) and Haley Skarupa potted four at Boston University (1/9/16) last season, the first occasions since Jen Buckley '01 did so on Dec. 29, 1999

HEAD COACH KATIE CROWLEY

In the 13 years since Katie (King) Crowley arrived at The Heights the Boston College women's hockey team has undergone a transformation.

From a sub-.500 team when she arrived as an assistant coach to a national power nine years after becoming head coach, Crowley has established the Eagles as the East's preeminent team and one of the elite programs in the nation.

For her success, Crowley is the two-time defending AHCA National Coach of the Year (2015, 2016) and the four-time defending Hockey East Coach of the Year (2013, 2014, 2015, 2016).

In her 10 seasons as head coach, Crowley has guided BC teams to five NCAA Frozen Fours (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2016), three Hockey East regular-season titles (2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16), two Hockey East tournament championships (2011, 2016) and four Beanpot crowns (2009, 2011, 2014, 2016).

Her players have been just as prolific, earning the 2015 Patty Kazmaier Award, 10 Patty Kazmaier Award Finalist nods, 11 All-America honors, four of the last eight Hockey East Players of the Year awards and four conference rookies of the year awards, in addition to 31 spots on Hockey East All-Star teams since 2008.

At the international level, Crowley's BC teams have featured:

- Three United States Olympians
- Eight members of the United States' IIHF World Championship squads
- 32 selections to U.S. Four Nations Cup rosters
- 24 nods on U.S. Under-22 Select Teams and 2 selections to the Canada National Development Team
- 19 players on IIHF Under-18 World Championship squads (18 Americans, one Canadian)

Additionally, both Crowley, her associate head coach – Courtney Kennedy, herself a two-time Olympian – and volunteer assistant goalkeepers coach Alison Quandt have coached U.S. U18 squads at the IIHF World Championships.

The Eagles have improved upon the previous campaign in each of the last six seasons. After establishing a new program record for wins (22) in 2008-09, her 2010-11 program set a new mark at 24, which was eclipsed in 2012-13 with 27 wins. That mark was once again re-established in 2014-15 when the Eagles posted 34 wins and then shattered last year with 40 wins - the second-highest single-season total in NCAA history.

On a conference level, the 2011-12 squad established a program record for Hockey East wins with 15 victories, besting the 2008-09 team's total of 14. That mark has been extended each of the last four seasons: 17 wins in 2012-13, 18 wins in 2013-14 and 20 – as part of an undefeated 20-0-1 season – in 2014-15 before the Eagles posted the only perfect record in Hockey East history (men or women) with a 24-0-0 record in 2015-16.

Crowley is a 1997 Brown graduate and played in three Olympic games with the U.S. National Team, winning gold in 1998 (Nagano), silver in 2002 (Salt Lake City) and bronze in 2006 (Turin).

She is married to former Boston College, '94 Olympic and NHL player Ted Crowley. The couple has a 3-year old daughter, Camryn, who is frequently found at home games and many road games in New England.

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH COURTNEY KENNEDY

Courtney Kennedy is in her 10th season on the Boston College women's hockey staff and has been a key part of the Eagles' rise to prominence.

Since arriving at The Heights as Katie Crowley's top assistant, Kennedy has helped BC develop into the East's top team and one of the nation's powers, as well as one of the top-choice collegiate hockey destinations for the country's top players.

In addition to her on-ice coaching duties – with an emphasis on the defensive corps and special teams – Kennedy also heads the Eagles' recruiting efforts and oversees all hockey operations for the team. She was promoted to associate head coach before the 2012-13 season.

Since 2007-08, Boston College has claimed 12 defenseman spots and five goaltender spots on the Hockey East All-Star team, including both first-team defensemen in 2015-16.

While Kennedy's defenders earned praise and recognition for their personal accomplishments, the parts come together to form a tremendous unit.

The Eagles are consistently among the nation's top 10 defensive corps, four times ranking in the top five: 2008-09 (1.75 gpg); 2010-11 (1.73 gpg), 2014-15 (1.21 gpg) and 2015-16 (1.18 gpg).

In 2015, Kennedy was honored by her peers with the AHCA Women's Ice Hockey Assistant Coach Award, which recognizes an assistant coach's body of work in women's hockey.

Kennedy, a Woburn, Mass., native, was a two-time All-America defenseman at Minnesota in 1999 and 2001. As a senior in 2001, she earned Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year honors. She was also a Top Three finalist for the Patty Kazmaier Award. As a junior in 2000, she helped lead Minnesota to its first national title.

Kennedy and Crowley were mainstays on the U.S. National Team, including as teammates on the 2002 and 2006 U.S. Olympic teams. In 2002, Team USA won the silver medal in Salt Lake City, Utah, and in 2006, it took home the bronze medal in Turin, Italy. Kennedy also played for Team USA when it captured the gold medal at the World Championships in 2005.

This year, Kennedy returns as an assistant coach for the U.S. Under-18 National Team, a position she also held in 2012-13 and 2013-14 leading to a pair of silver medals at the IIHF World Under-18 Championships.

DID YOU KNOW??

The Boston College coaching staff has won eight Olympic medals.
Assistant coach Gillian Apps won three golds with Canada (2006, 2010, 2014). Head coach Katie Crowley has one gold (1998), one silver (2002) and one bronze (2006) and associate head coach Courtney Kennedy has one silver (2002) and one bronze (2006), both with Team USA.

DID YOU KNOW??

Boston College is the only Div. 1 women's hockey program in the country to finish with a Top-5 ranking each of the last six seasons (2010-11 through 2015-16)?

No other program can make that claim.

ASSISTANT COACH CHUUAN APPS

Three-time Olympic gold medalist Gillian Apps is the newest member of the Boston College women's hockey coaching staff. She joined Katie Crowley's staff as an assistant coach in September 2016 and works with the Eagles' forwards and handles many of the team's administrative duties.

Apps was a 14-year member of the Canadian National Team and was part of three Olympic gold-medal teams: 2006 in Turin, 2010 in Vancouver and 2014 in Sochi.

She retired from international play in September 2015 with 50 goals and 50 assists in 168 international appearances. In addition to Olympic gold in all three of her appearances, Apps is also a three-time World Champion (2004, 2007, 2012).

Apps attended Dartmouth, graduating in 2007 with a degree in psychology. While a member of the Big Green, Apps made 113 career appearances, scoring 90 goals and adding 68 assists. She captained the team as a senior, posting a career-best 46 points (30 goals, 16 assists) en route to ECAC player of the year accolades, New England Hockey Writers Association most valuable player and Patty Kazmaier Top 10 Finalist honors. She graduated as Dartmouth's career leader in penalty minutes.

Professionally, Apps played six seasons with the Brampton Thunder of the Canadian Women's Hockey League, helping the club win the 2008 CWHL Championship in her rookie season. In 2011-12, she led the squad in scoring with 39 points (19 goals, 20 assists) in 27 games.

VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH AUSON QUANDI

Alison Quandt has been a part of the Boston College women's hockey program for the last 15 years and has seen the program rise into one of the nation's elite teams.

After wrapping up her four-year career on the ice after the 2005-06 season, Quandt joined the coaching staff as the goaltending coach ahead of the 2006-07 season. In her 10 seasons as the goaltenders' mentor, she has helped develop some of the top goalies in not only the collegiate game, but also for the U.S. National Team pipeline.

Many members of Quandt's goaltenders have gained conference, national and international recognition.

Since 2006-07, Boston College has claimed six goaltender spots on the Hockey East All-Star team and three conference goalkeeping champions as the Eagles' stable of goaltenders included Molly Schaus '11 (2010, 2014 U.S. Olympian), Kierra Kingston '12, Corinne Boyles '14, Megan Miller and most recently, Katie Burt (2014 & 2015 U.S. Under-18s; 2016 U.S. Under-22s), who has ranked in the top four nationally in practically every goaltending category in each of her first two seasons.
