First Pitch...

The Boston College baseball team embarks on the 2019 season under ninth-year head coach Mike Gambino at Jackson State this weekend. The Eagles and Jaquars meet for game one on Friday, Feb. 15 at 6 p.m. at Braddy Field.

About the Eagles...

BC dropped to 17-32 in 2018 after back-to-back seasons in the ACC Tournament. The Eagles claimed a road series on opening weekend last season by taking two out of three at Santa Clara. Junior infielder Brian Dempsey in Boston College's top returning hitter after posting a .319 average as the BC second baseman a season ago. Sophomore left fielder Chris Galland earned All-ACC Third Team and Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-American with a .316 average and 28 stolen bases in his rookie campaign. On the mound, senior Dan Metzdorf returns for his senior year after being drafted by the Yankees at the conclusion of the 2018 season. Despite a 1-8 record with a 5.74 earned run average, Metzdorf posted four starts of seven innings or more, including an eight-inning, 13-strikeout no-decision vs. Virginia Tech and eight innings of shutout ball, earning the win, at Notre Dame.

Scouting the Jaguars...

Jackson State went 34-18 overall and 17-7 in the SWAC, good enough for third overall in the conference and second in the East Division. The Jaguars have won 30 games or more in the last six seasons and made back-to-back regionals in 2013 and 2014. JSU hit a conference-leading .304 with a 4.62 team ERA; second in the SWAC. Infielder Raul Hernandez hit a team-high .382 with 50 RBI, 17 doubles and seven home runs. Outfielder Dezmond Chumley hit .320 with 44 runs scored and 34 driven in with five home runs to go with 11 stolen bases. Pitcher Kevin Perez went 11-4 on the bump with a 4.35 ERA and 74 strikeouts in 93 innings of work. Nikelle Galatas posted a 9-3 record with a 4.58 ERA in 88.1 innings pitched.

Struck out 18 in 19.1 innings on the Cape.

HEAD COACH MIKE GAMBINO



Mike Gambino, a 1999 Boston College graduate, was named head baseball coach on July 19, 2010. He brought the Eagles to the program's first NCAA Tournament in seven years in 2016.

Last season, Gambino and the Eagles went 17-32. Four players were selected in the MLB Draft and freshman Chris Galland earned All-ACC Third Team.

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship, the first time they went to the conference tournament in back-to-back years since 2009-10. BC won 10 of its last 15 ACC games with sweeps over ND and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005, tying for the second most in program history. They tallied 13 ACC wins and their six ACC series victories set a school record. BC swept the Oxford Regional to advance to the program's first Super Regional. BC earned a national ranking for the first time in school history, ending the season in the top 25. For his efforts, Gambino was named the ABCA Northeast Region Coach of the Year.

Gambino saw Justin Dunn garner All-America thirdteam and Jacob Stevens collect freshman All-America. Stevens picked up NEIBA Freshman of the Year, while Dunn was named to the All-ACC Third Team.

In 2016 and 2015, Gambino mentored two first-round draft picks: Dunn, 19th overall by the Mets in 2016, and Chris Shaw, 31st by the Giants. It was the first time in program history the Eagles saw back-to-back first rounders. Overall, 23 players have been drafted in Gambino's head coaching tenure.

Gambino, who was an assistant at BC from 2003-05, came from Virginia Tech where he spent four years as an assistant under former BC coach, Pete Hughes. Prior to working in Blacksburg, Gambino spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers.

Gambino played for BC from 1997-2000. He hit .313 with 22 doubles, eight homers, 87 RBI and 117 runs. The Garrison, N.Y., native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast pick. Gambino played two seasons in the Red Sox organization.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from the Heights in English and theology. He lives in Needham, Mass., with his wife, Jill, and their children, Sonny and Callaban

The Series...

Opening day marks the first meeting between Boston College and Jackson State. The series will also be the first for the Eagles against any of the 10 universities in the SWAC.

Un Next...

BC hits the road again for a visit to Bethune-Cookman in Daytona Beach, Fla. The series begins Friday, Feb. 22. The Eagles and Wildcats are meeting for the first time since a season-opening series in 2017. Bethune-Cookman leads the all-time series, which began in 2006, 4-3.

Season Openers...

Boston College is 22-24 in season openers on record and 3-5 under Gambino. The Eagles opened 2018 with a 5-1 win over Santa Clara on the road. **Jake Palomaki** went 3-for-5 from the leadoff spot with three RBI and a two-run homer. **Jacob Stevens** earned the win in five-scoreless innings with eight strikeouts to just one walk.

Returning to The Magnolia State...

Despite having never faced a team from Mississippi, this trip will be Boston College's second to "The Magnolia State". In 2016, the Eagles were sent to the NCAA Oxford Regional, hosted by Ole Miss. BC ran through the field; winning the regional in three games and avoiding the host Rebels.

Speeding Eagles...

As a team, Boston College swiped 92 bags in 2018. The Eagles ranked second in the ACC behind Louisville and 21st in the nation. BC averaged 1.88 per game; good enough for second in the league and 12th in the NCAA. Three Eagles tallied 19 stolen bases or more as Chris Galland led the way with 28. He ranked 20th in the nation and 2nd in the ACC in overall steals and 12th in the country and first in the league with 0.58 per game. Dante Baldelli and Palomaki each stole 19 bags in 21 attempts; tying for eighth in the ACC. Collectively, BC stole bases at a 79.3% success rate. Jack Cunningham swiped eight, while Brian Dempsey added seven.

Two Lane Turnpike...

Senior pitcher **Thomas Lane** is joined on this team's roster by younger brother and freshman **Travis Lane**. The two righties grew up in Georgetown, Mass. and played at Phillips Academy. Both were four-year starters in high school and garnered All-Northeast regional honors from Perfect Game before arriving on the Heights. The Lanes are the first pair of brothers to play for BC since **Dave ('11)** and **Jim Laufer ('12)**.

Suozzi Carries No. 8 Tradition...

Junior outfielder **Joe Suozzi** was voted by coaches and teammates to wear No. 8 in 2019 in honor of **Peter "Sonny" Nictakis.** Suozzi became the eighth player to earn the honor since Gambino ('99) instituted the team tradition to remember his teammates. Nictakis was a two-time captain for the Eagles in 1998 and 1999. He lost his courageous seven-year battle with Hodgkin's disease in the summer of 2000. Until 2011, his No. 8 had not been worn since his final season.

Two-Time Captain...

Graduate lefty **Carmen Giampetruzzi** served as a co-captain with Palomaki in 2018. He was elected by his teammates to serve in that role in 2019. Last season, he also wore the No. 8 jersey and pitched in four games before being shut down for labrum surgery.

The New Class...

Boston College welcomed 11 student-athletes to its class of 2022 ast fall. The Eagles added six pitchers and five position players from a class with a footprint that stretches from Massachusetts to California. Infielder/outfielder Sal Frelick (Lexington, Mass.) was named the Boston Globe Athlete of the Year as a senior after starring in football, hockey and baseball at Lexington High School. He was also named the "Top Pro Prospect" of the Futures League as a .361 hitter in 2018. Infielder Cody Morissette (Exeter, N.H.) was a three-time All-State selection, two-time Division I Player of the Year and helped Exeter High School to back-to-back state championships. Right-handed pitcher Mason Pelio (San Diego, Calif.) was named a Perfect Game Honorable Mention All-American and was rated as the No. 364 draft prospect by Baseball America.

Murphy Returns to Staff...

John Murphy, who spent 2018 at Army West Point, begins his third season overall with the Eagles in 2019 after serving as the team's volunteer assistant for the 2016 and 2017 seasons. He returned to the Heights in January after helping the Black Knights to a NCAA Regional appearance as the hitting coach a season ago. In his career as a coach and player, Murphy, who played two seasons in the Yankees' organization as a sixth-round pick, played in two regionals (2011, 2012) and has coached in two (2016, 2018).

RHP Jacob Stevens was drafted for the third time in four years and signed by the Diamondbacks (21st-639). RHP Brian Rapp went to the Twins (26th-784) and Dan Metzdorf was picked by the Yankees (38th-1,147).

#FormerBirdballers...

Chris Shaw (Giants No. 4 Prospect by MLB.com) became the 41st BC player to debut in the majors on August 31. His first career hit came three days later; a pinch-hit home run that stood as the game winner over Colorado... Mike King (Yankees) and Justin Dunn (Mets) were named the MiLB Pitchers of the Year by their respective organizations... King (Yankees (No. 22) pitched to a 1.79 ERA and held opponents to a .202 average across three levels... Dunn (Mariners No. 3) was traded for All-Stars Robinson Cano and Edwin Diaz in the offseason... Dunn struck out 156 in 135.1 innings and held a 3.59 ERA across two levels.


