First Pitch...

Boston College's final tune-up before ACC play takes the Eagles to Lexington, Ky. to take on Kentucky of the SEC at brand-new Kentucky Proud Park. The game is slated for a 4 p.m. first pitch and will air on SEC Network-Plus.

About the Eagles...

Boston College is 6-4 on the season after a 2-2 weekend with two wins over Eastern Kentucky and two losses to Evansville on EKU's campus. Freshman outfielder Sal Frelick leads BC in batting average (.436), RBI (12), doubles (4), slugging percentage (.667), on-base percentage (.500) and stolen bases [11]. Senior third baseman Jake Alu is second with a .359 average. Over the weekend, Alu hit a go-ahead, three-run home run in the Eagles' Friday win over EKU and a bases-clearing, three-run double to help secure Saturday's win vs. the Colonels. Freshman second baseman Cody Morissette blasted his team-leading second home run, a grand slam to cap off the Saturday win, and lifted his average to .349. Sophomore left fielder Chris Galland is the fourth BC hitter batting above .300 with a .318 average. He has scored a team-high 12 runs, while adding eight stolen bases. As a team, Boston College ranks fourth in the country with 35 stolen bases and first with 3.5 per game.

Scouting the Wildcats...

Coming off a sweep of Canisius, Kentucky is 8-3 and 5-0 at home. Left fielder **Ryan Shinn** leads the Wildcats with a .361 average and 14 runs scored to go with six doubles and two home runs. First baseman **Dalton Reed** has hit three doubles and three home runs, while batting .311. UK has totaled 11 home runs in 11 games as a team and is slugging a collective .434. Despite holding opponents to a .237 batting average, the Kentucky pitching staff owns a 5.16 earned run average. LHP **Mason Hazelwood** (0-1, 3.00) and RHP **Grant Macciocchi** (1-0, 2.45) have each made one start in the midweek.

HEAD COACH MIKE GAMBINO



Mike Gambino, a 1999 Boston College graduate, was named head baseball coach on July 19, 2010. He brought the Eagles to the program's first NCAA Tournament in seven years in 2016.

Last season, Gambino and the Eagles went 17-32. Four players were selected in the MLB Draft and freshman Chris Galland earned All-ACC Third Team.

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship, the first time they went to the conference tournament in back-to-back years since 2009-10. BC won 10 of its last 15 ACC games with sweeps over ND and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005, tying for the second most in program history. They tallied 13 ACC wins and their six ACC series victories set a school record. BC swept the Oxford Regional to advance to the program's first Super Regional. BC earned a national ranking for the first time in school history, ending the season in the top 25. For his efforts, Gambino was named the ABCA Northeast Region Coach of the Year.

Gambino saw Justin Dunn garner All-America thirdteam and Jacob Stevens collect freshman All-America. Stevens picked up NEIBA Freshman of the Year, while Dunn was named to the All-ACC Third Team.

In 2016 and 2015, Gambino mentored two first-round draft picks: Dunn, 19th overall by the Mets in 2016, and Chris Shaw, 31st by the Giants. It was the first time in program history the Eagles saw back-to-back first rounders. Overall, 23 players have been drafted in Gambino's head coaching tenure.

Gambino, who was an assistant at BC from 2003-05, came from Virginia Tech where he spent four years as an assistant under former BC coach, Pete Hughes. Prior to working in Blacksburg, Gambino spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers.

Gambino played for BC from 1997-2000. He hit .313 with 22 doubles, eight homers, 87 RBI and 117 runs. The Garrison, N.Y., native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast pick. Gambino played two seasons in the Red Sox organization.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from the Heights in English and theology. He lives in Needham, Mass., with his wife, Jill, and their children, Sonny and Callaban

Up Next...

The Eagles finish off their eight-game, 11-day swing through Kentucky with their ACC-opening series at Louisville. BC visits the Cardinals for three beginning on Friday, March 8.

Year-to-Year Comparison...

Boston College is a game better through 10 games than its 5-5 record to start 2018. The Eagles' scoring is up over a run and a half per game by comparison from 5.7 to 7.4.

Speeding Eagles...

Through week three, the Eagles lead the ACC with 35 stolen bases, which ranks fourth in the country; five behind national leader UAB. Individually, Sal Frelick is third in the country with 11 and Chris Galland ranks 18th with eight. As a team, Boston College swiped 92 bags in 2018. The Eagles ranked second in the ACC behind Louisville and 21st in the nation. BC averaged 1.88 per game; good enough for second in the league and 12th in the NCAA. Three Eagles tallied 19 stolen bases or more as Galland led the way with 28. He ranked 20th in the nation and 2nd in the ACC in overall steals and 12th in the country and first in the league with 0.58 per game. Dante Baldelli and Palomaki each stole 19 bags in 21 attempts; tying for eighth in the ACC. Collectively, BC stole bases at a 79.3% success rate. Jack Cunningham swiped eight, while Brian Dempsey added seven.

Home Run Hitters...

Last season, Boston College hit just 14 home runs in 49 games; averaging 0.29 per game. Through 10 games, the Eagles have gone up top seven times; averaging 0.70 per game. BC hitters combined for four home runs at Bethune-Cookman (2/22-24). It marked the first time that the Eagles homered three games in a row since going deep five games in a row with 11 home runs from March 31 to April 5, 2015.

Freshman Impact...

Nine of Boston College's 11 freshman have played through the first two weeks of the season. The five Eagles' hitters have combined to hit .351 (40-for-118) with 16 runs scored and 13 driven in. Four freshman pitchers have accounted for 28.2 (33%) of BC's 87 innings pitched. RHP **Joe Mancini** is 1-1 with a 2.31 ERA in 11.2 innings with opponents hitting .190. RHP **Mason Pelio** (1-0, 2.45) tossed seven innings of one-run ball at EKU (3/2) to become the first BC freshman to pitch seven or more and allow one run or less since Jacob Stevens vs. Louisville (4/22/16).

Shades of '16...

Dan Metzdorf became the first opening day starter to pitch seven innings or more with no earned runs since Mike King vs. NIU (2016). Sal Frelick was the first BC freshman to homer in his debut since Gian Martellini in that same game vs. NIU (2016). Going further back in the record books, BC started two freshmen (Frelick and Cody Morissette) for the first time on opening day since the Eagles put Chris Shaw, Logan Hoggarth and Joe Cronin in the lineup in 2013.

Season Openers...

Boston College is 23-24 in season openers on record and 4-5 under head coac **Mike Gambino**. The Eagles opened 2019 with a 7-3 win over Jackson State on the road. **Sal Frelick** went 3-for-4 with his first career home run and two stolen bases. **Dan Metzdorf** earned the win in seven innings of two-hit ball with one unearned run.

Two-Time Captain...

Graduate lefty Carmen Giampetruzzi served as a co-captain with Palomaki in 2018. He was elected by his teammates to serve in that role in 2019. Last season, he also wore the No. 8 jersey and pitched in four games before being shut down for labrum surgery.

Suozzi Carries No. 8 Tradition...

Junior outfielder Joe Suozzi was voted by coaches and teammates to wear No. 8 in 2019 in honor of Peter "Sonny" Nictakis. Suozzi became the eighth player to earn the honor since Gambino ('99) instituted the team tradition to remember his teammates. Nictakis was a two-time captain for the Eagles in 1998 and 1999. He lost his courageous seven-year battle with Hodgkin's disease in the summer of 2000. Until 2011, his No. 8 had not been worn since his final season.

Two Lane Turnpike...

Senior pitcher Thomas Lane is joined on this team's roster by younger brother and freshman Travis Lane. The two righties grew up in Georgetown, Mass. and played at Phillips Academy. Both were four-year starters in high school and garnered All-Northeast regional honors from Perfect Game before arriving on the Heights. The Lanes are the first pair of brothers to play for BC since Dave ('11) and Jim Laufer ('12).

The New Class...

Boston College welcomed 11 student-athletes to its class of 2022 ast fall. The Eagles added six pitchers and five position players from a class with a footprint that stretches from Massachusetts to California. Infielder/outfielder Sal Frelick (Lexington, Mass.) was named the Boston Globe Athlete of the Year as a senior after starring in football, hockey and baseball at Lexington High School. He was also named the Int Run Games (3) "Top Pro Prospect" of the Futures League as a .361 hitter in 2018. Infielder Cody Morissette (Exeter, N.H.) was a threetime All-State selection, two-time Division I Player of the Year and helped Exeter High School to back-to-back state championships. Right-handed pitcher Mason Pelio (San Diego, Calif.) was named a Perfect Game Honorable Mention All-American and was rated as the No. 364 draft prospect by Rasehall America.

2018 MLB Draft...

Four Eagles were selected on day three of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft. Jake Palomaki led off for the Eagles, who have had three or more players drafted in each of the last four years. Palomaki was selected as a second baseman by the Rays with the 540th overall selection in the 18th round. RHP Jacob Stevens was drafted for the third time in four years and signed by the Diamondbacks (21st-639). RHP Brian Rapp went to the Twins (26th-784) and Dan Metzdorf was picked by the Yankees (38th-1,147).

Murphy Returns to Staff...

John Murphy, who spent 2018 at Army West Point, begins his third season overall with the Eagles in 2019 after serving as the team's volunteer assistant for the 2016 and 2017 seasons. He returned to the Heights in January after helping the Black Knights to a NCAA Regional appearance as the hitting coach a season ago. In his career as a coach and player, Murphy, who played two seasons in the Yankees' organization as a sixth-round pick, played in two regionals (2011, 2012) and has coached in two (2016, 2018).


