» Boston College hosts Louisville at Alumni Stadium for its Family Weekend game on Saturday, Oct. 12 at Noon ET.
» The Eagles are 1-3 overall and 0-2 in the ACC.
» The game will air nationally on ACC Network. **Chris Cotter** (play-by-play) and former BC linebacker **Mark Herzlich** (analyst) are in the booth with **Lericia Harris** (reporter) on the sideline.
» Coverage on the Boston College Sports Network begins 30 minutes prior to kickoff on WEEI 93.7 FM and 850 AM. **Jon Meterparel** (play-by-play) is joined on the call by former BC linebacker **Pete Cronan** in the booth and quarterback **Scott Mutryn** on the sideline.
» Louisville leads the all-time series 8-6, including a 5-3 mark in the ACC, but BC has won three of the last five match-ups. The series began with a 41-7 Eagles' victory in Chestnut Hill in 1986.
» The Eagles won 34-27 in **Jeff Hafley's** first season in 2020, but fell to the Cardinals on the road, 14-28, a season ago.
» In 2020, BC rushed for 18 yards and forced three turnovers to reach the six-win mark. **Dennis Grosel** came off the bench for an injured **Phil Jurkovec** and threw two touchdown passes in the win.
» Last season, **Malik Cunningham** ran for three touchdowns and 133 yards to lead the Cardinals to victory. Louisville totaled 331 yards on the ground.
» Boston College welcomes back its 1982 and 1992 teams for Family Weekend vs. Louisville.
» The 1982 Eagles went 8-3-1 under head coach **Jack Bicknell** and played in the Tangerine Bowl. In 1992, **Tom Coughlin** and BC also went 8-3-1, earning a spot in the Hall of Fame Bowl and finishing No. 21 in the AP poll.

» The Eagles added a touchdown on their final drive as back-up quarterback **Emmett Morehead** connected with **Joe Griffin** for the first touchdown of their respective careers.

The Gregory P. Barber '69 and Family Head Football Coach

Jeff Hafley was introduced as The Gregory P. Barber '69 and Family Head Coach of the Boston College football program on Dec. 14, 2019.

Of the 24 coaches hired in the 2020 coaching cycle, Hafley enters the 2022 season tied for second among all Power Five head coaches with 12 victories. He has led the Eagles to bowl eligibility in each of his first two seasons at the helm.

On the recruiting trail, Hafley and his staff have signed two of the top recruiting classes in school history. The 2021 and 2022 signing classes earned ESPN's best ranking in program history since its rankings began in 2006. BC also earned its best showing in the 247 Sports rankings and was awarded its first Rivals top-30 class since 2004.

One of college football's top defensive minds, Hafley's defense ranked third nationally in passing yards allowed (173.5 per game) during the 2021 season. The Eagles were also top-30 nationally in six other defensive categories: total defense, red zone defense, first downs allowed, third down percentage, team passing efficiency, and defensive touchdowns. His disciplined squad led the ACC in fewest penalties and fewest penalty yards.

A total of 12 Eagles were All-ACC selections, led by First Team offensive linemen Zion Johnson and Alec Lindstrom. Johnson was named to seven different All-America teams and was selected 17th overall in the first round of the 2022 NFL Draft by the Los Angeles Chargers, becoming the 21st first round pick in school history.

In his first season on the Heights in 2020, Hafley finished with the most victories of any first-year head coach in college football. More impressive than the marked improvement on both sides of the ball from Boston College in 2020 was how the program handled playing in the COVID-19 pandemic. BC's team had just one positive COVID-19 result in over 9,000 administered tests since the team returned to campus in June of 2020.

Hafley helped improve BC's defense 52 spots in the national rankings in total defense as the Eagles allowed 62 fewer yards per game than the previous year, prior to his arrival. Isaiah McDuffie ranked fifth nationally in total tackles while Max Richardson ended the season 11th as Boston College was one of two schools in the entire country with two players finishing in the top 11 in tackles.

Nine Eagles were named All-ACC in 2020. Tight end Hunter Long was named a Second Team All-American by multiple outlets as he led all tight ends nationally in receptions and finished the year second in receptions.

Prior to taking over as head coach at Boston College, Hafley led a dramatic turnaround in leading the defense for Ohio State as the Buckeyes won the 2019 Big Ten Championship and qualified for the College Football Playoff.

A finalist for the Frank Broyles Award and the 247 Sports Defensive Coordinator of the Year, Hafley was one of the architects of a Buckeye defense that ranked first nationally in yards per play, second nationally in total defense, third nationally in scoring defense, third nationally in sacks, seventh nationally in rushing defense, second nationally in passing yards allowed and first nationally in red zone defense.

A standout defensive backs coach throughout his career in the NFL and collegiate ranks, Hafley's work as the defensive backs coach at Ohio State led to impressive results. The Buckeyes totaled 15 interceptions in 2019, tied for ninth nationally, while allowing just 25 pass plays of 20+ yards. Before arriving at Ohio State, Hafley spent the previous seven seasons in the NFL, the last three with the San Francisco 49ers as defensive backs coach.

Prior to his time with San Francisco, Hafley was the secondary coach for two seasons in Cleveland, the secondary/safeties coach with Tampa Bay in 2013 and a defensive backs assistant with the Buccaneers in 2012.

His coaching career includes 11 seasons in collegiate football before a move to the NFL in 2012, and then seven subsequent seasons there. After starting his career working as running backs coach for one season (2001) at Worcester (Mass.) Polytechnic Institute, Hafley moved on to the University of Albany for four seasons as defensive assistant and defensive backs coach (2002-05).

He then coached at the University of Pittsburgh for five seasons (2006-10) where he worked under the direction of Dave Wannstedt and helped mentor Darrelle Revis into a Jim Thorpe Award finalist in 2006. Hafley was a defensive assistant/cornerbacks coach in 2006-07 and was secondary coach from 2008-10.

One season as the defensive backs coach at Rutgers, working under Greg Schiano, followed his positions at Pittsburgh. The Scarlet Knights ranked ninth nationally in passing defense in his one season there, 2011. Hafley helped develop future NFL standout defensive backs Duron Harmon and Logan Ryan during his time in Piscataway.

Hafley moved on to the NFL following his year at Rutgers and coached two seasons with the Buccaneers, serving as assistant defensive backs coach in 2012 and secondary/safeties coach in 2013. Two seasons with the Cleveland Browns followed under coach Mike Pettine.

Three seasons as defensive backs coach with the San Francisco 49ers, 2016-2018, preceded Hafley's position with the Buckeyes. He worked under Chip Kelly in 2016 and Kyle Shanahan the final two seasons. In 2018, the 49ers ranked 11th in the league in passing defense. They were 14th in 2016 after ranking 27th in 2015, the year before Hafley arrived.

Hafley and his wife, Gina, have two daughters, Hope and Leah.

PRIMETIME PLAYERS
» BC at Florida State (9/24) marked the third consecutive night game for BC.
» The Eagles last played in three straight primetime games in 2007, with Matt Ryan at quarterback, when a top-20 BC squad, peaking at No. 2 in the polls, played four consecutive games that kicked off after 7:30.
» In that stretch, BC won at Virginia Tech, lost to Florida State, lost at Maryland and won at Clemson.
» BC plays its fourth night game in six contests when it hosts Clemson (10/8) for the Red Bandanna Game.

FASTEST TO 4,000
» **Phil Jurkovec** threw for 320 yards against Maine (9/17) to become the 10th 4,000-yard passer in BC history and first since Anthony Brown (2017-19).
» Jurkovec is the third fastest to reach the milestone; having done so in 19 games. Doug Flutie (1981-84) and Shawn Halloran (1985-86) each did so in 17 games.

BOUNCING BACK
» With losses to Rutgers (9/3) and Virginia Tech (9/10), Boston College found itself at 0-2 for the first time since 2011 and just the second time since 1994.
» BC has started a season 0-2 25 times, 12 of which were prior to 1950, and have finished .500 or better in six of the 13 occurrences since 1951; most recently a 7-4-1 campaign in 1994.

HEY, ARNOLD
» Linebacker **Kam Arnold** played cornerback in high school, moved to safety as a freshman in 2020 and then transitioned to linebacker in 2021.
» He has started 15 of the last 16 games at linebacker.
» At Virginia Tech (9/10/22), Arnold made a career-high 12 tackles. He is second on BC with 27 tackles on the season.

CAREER DAY
» Tight end **George Takacs**, a graduate transfer from Notre Dame, made seven catches for 84 yards in his BC debut against Rutgers (9/3).
» His yard total for the game surpassed his career receiving yard total with the Irish (78), while his seven catches were one behind his career total at ND (8).
» Takacs and Phil Jurkovec were a part of the same signing class that entered Notre Dame in the fall of 2018.
» In week three, Takacs scored his first touchdown at BC and third of his career. He last scored in 2021 for ND vs. Stanford.

O-LINE NEW
» Boston College's offensive line features five new starters in 2022 after all five linemen earned All-ACC recognition a year

ago; led by first-team selections Zion Johnson, a first-round pick of the Chargers, and Alec Lindstrom. Ben Petrula earned third-team honors and Tyler Vrabel picked up an honorable mention. All four enter 2022 on NFL rosters, while the lone returner **Christian Mahogany** will miss the season due to an ACL injury. In the spring of 2022, Mahogany ranked as the No. 2 guard on Mel Kiper's draft board for 2023.

» Right guard **Jack Conley** and left tackle **Ozzy Trapilo** combine for all four of the lines career starts entering the season with two apiece. Conley started as an eligible sixth lineman at Clemson (10/2/21) and at left tackle against NC State (10/16/21) in place of Vrabel. Trapilo earned a start at left guard as Johnson moved to left tackle for Vrabel against Virginia Tech (11/5) and covered right guard for Mahogany against Florida State (11/20).

» Center **Drew Kendall** redshirted as a true freshman last year after appearing in two games. He is the highest rated prospect of the group; a four-star by 247 Sports and Rivals.

» Kendall, **Finn Dirstine** (left guard) and **Kevin Cline** (right tackle) all made their first career start against Rutgers (9/3).

» The o-line has a new coach this year in 16-year NFL veteran assistant **Dave DeGuglielmo**. DeGuglielmo got his start in coaching as an offensive graduate assistant for Tom Coughlin at Boston College in 1991.

MOVEMENT UP FRONT

» **Ozzy Trapilo** started the opener at left tackle, but then missed two games due to injury.

» **Jack Conley** has started at three different positions in the first three games; right guard, left tackle, right tackle.

» **Kevin Cline** was injured in week two at Virginia Tech (9/10) and will miss the rest of the season.

» **Dwayne Allick** spent his 2020 freshman season as a back-up center and moved to defensive line in the 2021 preseason due a lack of depth. He remained on defense through 2022 spring ball, but returned to the offense this preseason. He has now started the last two games at right guard.

» Former preferred walk-on **Nick Thomas** was elevated to starting left tackle vs. Maine (9/17).

» **Drew Kendall** (center) and **Finn Dirstine** (left guard) have started all four games at the same position.

» BC also rotates former defensive lineman **Jackson Ness**, who converted this past spring, into the interior.

JUNGLELAND

» Boston College secondary, known as "The Jungle", ranked third in the country in 2021 with 173.5 passing yards allowed per game.

» In the season opener against Rutgers, the Eagles allowed just 110 passing yards. BC followed that performance with 140 passing yards allowed against Virginia Tech.

» The two games marked the fifth and sixth games of fewer than 150 passing yards allowed to a Power 5 opponent in the last two seasons and sixth and seventh overall.

» Cornerback **Elijah Jones** recorded the team's first interceptions of the season against the Scarlet Knights.

PUNTER PLATOON

» BC employed two punters in the season opener against Rutgers (9/3). **Danny Longman**, who has handled kickoffs since 2018, won the job in preseason camp, but it was freshman **Sam Candotti** that made the first appearance of the season.

» Longman, who punted twice in 2019, averaged 43.4 yards per punt with five attempts in the season opener.

» At Virginia Tech (9/10), Longman punted 10 times, averaging 44.3 yards per kick. He recorded a long of 76 yards; just the fourth punt of 76 yards or more in BC history, the first since Johnny Ayers in 2004 and one off the program record.

» Candotti, a 22-year old freshman from Niddrie Victoria, Australia, was called upon for a first-quarter punt in Rutgers' territory and dropped a 33-yard kick out of bounds at the three-yard line.

» Candotti played Australian football for Airport West FC and East Keilor FC before training as a punter at Prokick Australia.

2022 CAPTAINS

» A season ago, BC named captains on a weekly basis ahead of each game. For 2022, head coach Jeff Hafley and the Eagles have elected seven veterans to serve as captains: **Vinny DePalma**, **Zay Flowers**, **Pat Garwo**, **Phil Jurkovec**, **Marcus Valdez**, **Jaiden Woodbey** and honorary captain **Christian Mahogany**, who will miss the season due to injury.

» Valdez is a two-time team captain after serving as a captain in Hafley's first season of 2020. He is the first two-time captain since Jon Baker (2017, 2018) and the first two-time captain on defense since Mike McLaughlin (2008, 2009).

» All seven players earned the honor of game captain during the 2021 season. Flowers, Garwo, Jurkovec, Valdez and Woodbey each served as game captains twice, while DePalma and Mahogany were each a game captain once.

DEFENSIVE TURNAROUND

» The Eagles ranked 125th in total defense in 2019 and in two years under **Jeff Hafley's** staff improved 97 spots to 28th in 2021, the second biggest jump in the country.

» BC gave up just 344.2 yards per game of total offense in 2021; a 134.5 ypg improvement over two years. Only Houston (166.3) had a bigger improvement over that period.

» The Eagles' improved their scoring defense by 10.0 points per game to 22.2; the sixth-largest jump in the country in two years and third-largest among Power 5 programs.

» Per PFF's advanced metrics, the Eagles are the most improved FBS team in tackling defense and second most improved FBS team in coverage defense in the last two years.

» BC is the only FBS team to improve its PFF defensive grade by 10 or more points (10.7), tackling grade by 20 or more points (38.0) and coverage grade by 20 or more points (32.4).

NO FLY ZONE

» Boston College head coach **Jeff Hafley's** resume throughout his coaching career has been coaching defensive backs. Now as head coach, Hafley's BC teams have been elite against defending the pass since arriving at the Heights.

» Looking back at BC's history, since the Eagles joined a conference in 1993 (BIG EAST) and later the ACC in 2005, the 2021 defense allowed the fifth-fewest passing yards per game (173.5 yards per game), while the 2020 team allowed the second fewest (168.2).

GARWO CAN GO

» Running back **Pat Garwo** rushed for a then career-high 160 yards at UMass (9/11/21), becoming BC's first 100-yard rusher since David Bailey at Syracuse (Nov. 7, 2020). Garwo's previous career best was 36 yards vs. Pitt (10/10/20).

» Garwo became the first BC rusher over 150 yards since AJ Dillon (242) and David Bailey (172) did so at Syracuse (11/2/19).

» Garwo averaged 10.7 yards per attempt, tied for the seventh-best single-game yards per carry average for a BC player since 1996.

» He started the remaining 10 games and rushed for 1,045 yards to become the 19th 1,000-yard rusher in BC history; recording the 24th 1,000-yard season by an Eagle.

» Garwo ripped off a career-long 67-yard run for BC's first touchdown to cap off a 99-yard scoring drive in a 41-34 OT win against Missouri (9/25/21).

» Garwo finished with his second 100-yard game of the year and second of his career with a career-high 175 vs. Mizzou.

» Garwo registered four 100-yard rushing games in 2021.

MY COUSIN VINNY

» **Vinny DePalma** missed all of 2020 with an Achilles injury. The New Jersey native returned in 2021 and finished third on the team in tackles at 54.

» He started six games, including four of the final five at middle linebacker a season ago.

» DePalma is first on the team with 32 tackles and forced the third fumble of his career vs. Maine (9/17).

COVER CORNER

» **Josh DeBerry** primarily played nickel back in 2021 and finished fourth on the team with 53 tackles, despite missing the final two games of the season. One of the top cover corners in the ACC, DeBerry tied for second on the team with two interceptions and added three pass breakups.

» Not only an elite cover corner, DeBerry led BC with eight tackles for loss in 2021.

300-YARD PASSING GAMES

» BC totaled just seven 300-yard passing games from 2010-19, including just three games of 300+ yards since 2013.

» In 27 games under Jeff Hafley, BC has posted nine 300-yard passing games.

ZAY ALL DAY

» Boston College wide receiver **Zay Flowers** was named to the Biletnikoff Award watch list for the second year in a row.

» Flowers put together one of the best seasons by a BC wide receiver ever in 2020. An All-ACC first-team selection, Flowers was just the second BC wide receiver to be named first-team All-ACC in school history (Alex Amidon, 2012). He finished 18th nationally and second in the ACC with 892 yards receiving, ranked 26th nationally with 56 receptions and tied for 12th nationally with nine touchdown receptions.

» The speedster from Fort Lauderdale finished with his second 100-yard receiving game of the season in 2020 with six catches for 162 yards and a career-high three scores in the 31-30 victory in overtime over Pitt. Flowers became the first BC player with three receiving touchdowns in a game since Kelvin Martin at Holy Cross (11/22/86). He tied the school record with five other players with three touchdown receptions.

» An All-ACC third-team pick in 2021, he caught 44 passes for 746 yards and five touchdowns.

» Flowers became the 10th 2,000-yard receiver in BC history with an 11-yard touchdown vs. Rutgers (9/3). He current ranks fifth with 2,309 receiving yards.

» He is tied for fourth in BC career history with six career 100-yard receiving games.
