### SETTING THE SCENE

- Boston College closes the regular season with a home-and-home series against No. 17 UConn this weekend, beginning Friday on Senior Night at Kelley Rink on NESN at 7 p.m.
- The series shifts to UConn's brand new Toscano Family Ice Forum in Storrs on Saturday afternoon with faceoff at 4 p.m. on ESPN+
- Boston College can clinch home ice in the Hockey East First Round with one point over the final weekend and can finish as high as sixth in the league
- The Huskies, who enter the weekend fourth in the standings with a two-point lead on UMass Lowell, beat the Eagles 5-1 in Hartford back on Oct. 27, 2022

### SENIOR NIGHT

- Prior to Friday's series opener, BC will honor eight members of the Class of 2023: graduate manager Will Dahlquist, graduate transfers Mitch Benson, Cam Burke and Christian O'Neill, and seniors Mitch Andres, Liam Izyk, Jack Moffatt and Marshall Warren
- The senior class has helped lead the Eagles to a pair of Hockey East Regular Season Championships and an NCAA Tournament berth in 2021 as sophomores
- Boston College's three graduate students have skated in all 32 games this season and have combined for 370 career NCAA games played

### MAINE RECAP

- BC was swept at Maine last weekend in a two-game series at Alford Arena
- Maine held off numerous comeback attempts and opened the weekend with a 6-3 Hockey East victory on Friday night, ending the Eagles' three-game winning streak
- Cutter Gauthier and Nikita Nesterenko both had three-point nights with a goal and two assists, while Trevor Kuntar also collected a pair of assists
- Boston College matched a season-high with three power play goals
- On Saturday, Victor Ostman made 31 saves and Maine held off a third period surge to edge Boston College by a 2-1 final to sweep the series
- Gauthier registered his team-leading 16th goal of the season in the second period
- BC finished with 34-29 and 32-27 advantages in shots over the Black Bears

### SERIES HISTORY

- This weekend will mark the 23rd and 24th all-time meetings in the series
- Boston College leads the all-time series with UConn 14-6-2
- UConn has won the last three meetings after a 10-game stretch in which BC went 8-1-1
- BC fell 5-1 to UConn at the XL Center on Oct. 27 in the first regular season meeting as the Huskies used a four-goal third period to snap a 1-1 tie at the second intermission
- The loss snapped a four-game winning streak in Hartford for the Eagles
- Boston College was undefeated all-time in Chestnut Hill (7-0-2) in the series prior to a pair of UConn victories last season during the second half by 5-4 and 6-4 finals

# GAME NOTES

## MONTHLY HONORS

- Cutter Gauthier has been named the Pro Ambitions Hockey East Rookie of the Month for February after winning the award in November
- Gauthier led all Hockey East rookies with 10 points on three goals and seven assists in eight games during the month
- He had at least one point in seven of his eight games with a pair of multi-point outings, including a three-point night at Maine last Friday
- The forward posted a team-best 33 shots on goal, which ranked sixth in the NCAA among first-year players, and was plus-two for the month
- Gauthier is second in the league in goals per game (0.57) and power play goals (7)

## JUNIOR CLASS

- Boston College's junior class represents four of the team's top six scorers
- Nikita Nesterenko, Trevor Kuntar, Colby Ambrosio and Eamon Powell have combined for 94 points this season, which is nearly 38% of the team's scoring
- Three of the four have already surpassed their career-highs in points
- Ambrosio is four away from his career-high, but has tied his career-best in goals (9)

## TRICKY NESTY

- Nikita Nesterenko ranks seventh in Hockey East in points per game (0.94)
- Nesterenko has seven points in four games over the last two weekends
- The winger has registered six multi-point games this season
- The Coney Island native has already established new career-highs in goals (11), assists (19) and points (30)
- He also has a career-high 94 shots on goal, which is tied for 14th in Hockey East
- Nesterenko was named the Hockey East Player of the Week on Feb. 20 following his first career hat trick against UMass on Feb. 17
- The junior added an assist for a career-high four-point performance

## KUNTAR STREAKIN'

- Trevor Kuntar recently set a career-high with a seven-game point streak (5-4-9), which was snapped last Saturday at Maine
- He has established career-highs in goals (13), assists (14) and points (27)
- The Boston Bruins draft pick has also set a new career-high with 122 shots on goal, second in Hockey East behind only Merrimack's Alex Jeffries (123)
- Kuntar has moved up to seventh in Hockey East in goals per game (0.43) and 12th in the league in points per game (0.90)
- The Buffalo native has at least one point in 21 of his last 28 games overall

## COOKING WITH GAS

- Rookie Andre Gasseau has a point in six of his last eight games and ranks fourth on the team in scoring with a line of 7-17-24
- Gasseau has recorded seven multi-point performances during his freshman season, five of which have come since Jan. 14
- The California native has collected 16 points over his last 15 games (4-12-16)
- The winger has moved up into 24th in Hockey East in points per game and is second on the team in assists (17) behind Nesterenko
- Gasseau ranks seventh in points among all Hockey East rookies
- He ranks second in the league and sixth nationally with a pair of shorthanded goals

## A CUT ABOVE

- Cutter Gauthier has been named to the Watch List for the Tim Taylor Award, given to the National Rookie of the Year
- Gauthier ranks second overall in Hockey East in goals per game (0.57) and fifth in the league in points per game (1.14)
- The fifth overall selection in the 2022 NHL Draft is tied for second among league rookies and tied for sixth overall with 32 points
- Gauthier has seven multi-point games to his credit this season
- He also ranks fourth in the league with 113 shots on goal, including 12 last weekend

## POWER UP

- BC ranks second in Hockey East and ninth nationally on the power play at 24.8%
- The Eagles have scored at least once on the power play in 22 of their last 30 games
- Boston College has scored on the power play in each of its last five games and netted all four of its goals in the Maine series with the man advantage
- Cutter Gauthier (7) and Trevor Kuntar (6) rank second and third in the league respectively in power play goals

## AT THE DOT

- BC is third in Hockey East and 12th nationally in faceoff percentage at 52.9%
- The Eagles are +84 at the dot over their last 22 contests
- They have won or tied the faceoff battle in 14 of those 22 games
- Cam Burke ranks eighth in Hockey East with 281 faceoffs won while Trevor Kuntar is 11th with 253 wins at the dot
- Burke and Kuntar are tied for fourth in the league in faceoff percentage among skaters with at least 400 attempts at 57.6% each

## AWARD WATCH

- Graduate goaltender Mitch Benson, junior defenseman Eamon Powell and freshman forward Cutter Gauthier have been nominated for the Hobey Baker Award
- Awarded annually to college hockey's top player, the Hobey Baker's fan voting will run until Sunday, March 5 at midnight
- Nikita Nesterenko and Eamon Powell are semifinalists for the Walter Brown Award, presented to the best American-born college hockey player in New England
- Cutter Gauthier is on the Watch List for the Tim Taylor Award (Rookie of the Year)

# NHL NOTES

## NHL NOTES

- Alex Tuch (Buffalo) became the third New York native to record 100 points with the Sabres on Feb. 24, joining Tim Connolly and former Eagle Brian Gionta
- Tuch also scored his 100th NHL goal on Feb. 21 against Toronto
- Zach Sanford (Nashville) was recalled from Milwaukee (AHL) on Feb. 26
- Thatcher Demko (Vancouver) was activated from injured reserve on Feb. 27, making 34 saves in a win against Dallas
- Chris Kreider (NY Rangers) is the sixth player with eight or more 20-goal seasons and the eighth player to reach 250 career goals in Rangers history

## PRO EAGLES

- 20 former Boston College men's hockey players earned spots on NHL Opening Night rosters, which ranked second among Division I schools behind only Michigan (21)
- Eight different former Boston College players have made their NHL debuts over the last two seasons, which leads all NCAA schools
- Cutter Gauthier became BC's 22nd first round pick over the summer, moving BC into sole possession of third in the NCAA behind Michigan and Minnesota
- Five first round picks have played on the Heights in the last five years

## LORD STANLEY

- Former Boston College forward Alex Newhook added Boston College's 21st name to the Stanley Cup in June as the Colorado Avalanche defeated the two-time defending champion Tampa Bay Lightning 2-1 in Game 6 of the Stanley Cup Final in Tampa
- A native of St. John's, Newfoundland, Newhook became the 13th different former Eagle to hoist the Cup and the fourth since 2016
- The 21-year-old posted 33 points last season on 13 goals and 20 assists before adding four assists in 11 playoff games during Colorado's Stanley Cup run
- BC's 21 Stanley Cup winners trail only Wisconsin (22) in NCAA history

# A NEW ERA ON THE HEIGHTS



SCHILLER FAMILY HEAD COACH

## GREG BROWN

Former Boston College All-American defenseman Greg Brown '90 was named The Schiller Family Head Hockey Coach on May 6, 2022, becoming just the fifth head coach of BC men's hockey since 1932.

Brown spent 14 seasons behind the bench for the Eagles from 2004-18 as an assistant on former head coach Jerry York's staff, helping to bring three national championships to the Heights in 2008, 2010, and 2012. After eight seasons as an assistant coach, he was elevated to associate head coach following the 2012 NCAA title, BC's third championship in a five-year span.

During his 14 years coaching at Boston College, Brown helped lead BC to six Hockey East Tournament Championships, seven Hockey East Regular Season Championships, 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, and seven NCAA Frozen Four berths. Brown was also selected as an assistant coach for Team USA at three different IIHF World Junior Championships.

Brown served as an assistant coach in the NHL for the New York Rangers for three years from 2018-21, where he coached former Eagle forwards Chris Kreider and Kevin Hayes. Last season (2021-22) as the head coach of Dubuque in the USHL, he led the Fighting Saints to a second-place finish in the USHL Eastern Conference and an increase of 16 wins from the year prior.

While at Boston College, Brown won back-to-back Hockey East Player of the Year Awards in 1989 and 1990. He was named a First Team All-American and a finalist for the Hobey Baker Award both years. In three NCAA seasons, Brown registered 24 goals and 96 assists for 120 points in 119 career games.

He was the captain of the Eagles as a senior in 1989-1990 for a team that won 28 games and reached the NCAA Semifinal. Boston College went 84-33-5 (.709) during his three seasons on the Heights, winning Hockey East Championships in 1987 and 1990.

He was selected to the U.S. Olympic Team during his sophomore year for the Calgary Olympics in 1988 and again for the Albertville Olympics in 1992.

Brown was drafted 26th overall by the Buffalo Sabres in the 1986 NHL draft and played four NHL seasons for Buffalo, Pittsburgh, and Winnipeg. He played professional hockey in Europe for eight more seasons before retiring in 2003, and made his return to the Heights in 2004 as an assistant coach for York.

The Brown family has many connections to Boston College men's hockey. Greg's older brother Doug was a four-year standout forward for the Eagles from 1982-86, posting 162 points and earning a spot on two All-America teams. Greg and Doug are members of the Boston College Varsity Club Athletic Hall of Fame.

Greg's nephews Patrick Brown (2010-14) and Christopher Brown (2015-19) were also forwards at BC, both serving as captains.
