FIRST-AND-10

» Boston College is home for the first time in four weeks when it hosts Louisville in a Friday night game at Alumni Stadium for a 7:30 p.m. kickoff on Oct. 25.

» The game will be broadcast on ESPN2. **Anish Shroff** (play-by-play) and Heisman winner **Andre Ware** (analyst) are on the call with sideline reporter **Morgan Uber**.

» Coverage on the Boston College Sports Network begins 30 minutes prior to kickoff on WEEI 93.7 FM. **Jon Meterparel** (play-by-play) is joined on the call by former BC linebacker **Pete Cronan** in the booth and quarterback **Scott Mutryn** on the sideline.

» BC is 9-9 in regular season Friday games since 1991, 5-7 at home and 4-2 in such games on ESPN2. The game marks the first-ever Friday match-up between the Eagles and Cardinals.

» The Eagles last won a Friday night game at home in the 2021 Red Bandanna Game against Virginia Tech.

» Boston College trails the all-time series, 7-9, including a 4-6 mark in ACC games with the home team winning the last six contests. BC was the last road team to score a win; 45-42 in 2017.

» Louisville doubled up Boston College, 56-28, in Kentucky a year ago. The last match-up in Chestnut Hill was a 34-33 BC win in 2022.

» Defensive end **Donovan Ezeiruaku** ranks third in the country in total sacks at 9.0, which ranks second in the ACC. His 12.0 TFLs are also third in FBS, but tops in the conference.

» **Thomas Castellanos** is top-10 nationally in passing efficiency (5th, 176.2) and yards per attempt (9th, 9.43), which both rank second in the ACC.

» The BC defense has intercepted nine passes, ranking 15th in the FBS and fourth in the ACC. BC intercepted just eight passes in 2023.

WEEK SEVEN RECAP

Thursday, Oct. 17: Virginia Tech 42, Boston College 21
Lane Stadium (Blacksburg, Va.)

» Boston College trailed 28-0 at the half before storming back for a 21-0 third quarter, but Virginia Tech forced a turnover on downs early in the fourth and went on to score 14 unanswered.

» The Hokies generated 532 yards of offense, including 368 on the ground.

» Each team committed three turnovers, with BC using a fumble and an interception to full its third-quarter comeback attempt.

» BC scored three touchdowns over a span of 5:53. It marked the fastest BC scored three touchdowns since a five-touchdown quarter at Syracuse (2019) in which the Eagles scored three touchdowns over stretches of 3:40 and 5:05.

» Nickelback **Cameron Martinez** recorded a team-high seven tackles, while adding a sack, two TFLs, fumble recovery and interception.

THE O'BRIEN ERA

» Head coach **Bill O'Brien** was hired on Feb. 9 and introduced as the Eagles' 37th head coach on Feb. 15.

» Two games into his tenure, O'Brien had BC back in the AP Top-25 for the first time in seven years.

» BC also sold out the second home game of O'Brien's time on the Heights; a win in the annual Red Bandanna Game over Michigan State. It was just the second sellout at BC in the last six years.

ON THIS DATE

Oct. 25, 1986

Boston College 19, West Virginia 10 (Morgantown, W.Va.)

» BC snapped a nine-year losing streak to WVU behind four Brian Lowe field goals and a Jon Bronner touchdown.

» Troy Stradford set the all-time BC career rushing mark with a 96-yard performance.

» The win moved BC to 4-3 on the way to a 9-3 season that ended with a Hall of Fame Bowl win over Georgia.

Oct. 25, 2007

No. 3 Boston College 14, No. 11 Virginia Tech 10 (Blacksburg, Va.)

» Matt Ryan and the Eagles stunned the Lane Stadium crowd with two TD drives in the waning moments of the fourth quarter.

» Ryan got BC on the board with a 16-yard fade to Rich Gunnell for a score with 2:11 left on the clock. BC recovered an onside-kick to set up Ryan for the game-winning TD to Andre Callendar.

The Gregory P. Barber '69 and Family Head Football Coach

Bill O'Brien was hired as the 37th head coach in Boston College football history on Feb. 9, 2024.

A 32-year coaching veteran in the college and professional ranks, O'Brien was elevated to his first head coaching post at Penn State in 2012. He guided the Nittany Lions to an overall record of 15-9 and 10-6 Big Ten mark during the span of two seasons while directing the program through a postseason ban. He was named the head coach of the NFL's Houston Texans in 2014, leading the franchise to a 52-48 record, four AFC South Division titles, and four playoff appearances - including two Wild Card round wins - between 2014 and 2020.

While at Penn State, O'Brien was recognized in 2012 with a pair of national coaching awards - the Paul "Bear" Bryant National Coach of the Year, and the George Munger Award for Coach of the Year by the Maxwell Football Club. The Nittany Lions' eight wins in 2012 were the most by a first-year head coach in school history, earning O'Brien Big Ten Coach of the Year honors. In 2013, O'Brien and Penn State won seven games, including two top 25 victories, downing No. 18 Michigan at home and winning at No. 14 Wisconsin. The Nittany Lions boasted two first team All-Americans during his tenure - linebacker Michael Mauti (2012) and wide receiver Allen Robinson (2013) - and 10 All-Big Ten selections.

O'Brien returned to the NFL in 2014 as the head coach of the Houston Texans. During his tenure, Houston posted five winning seasons, including back-to-back double-digit win seasons in 2018 (11-5) and 2019 (10-6). The 21 combined wins rank as the second-most in a two-year span in franchise history. Houston's offense ranked in the top-10 in rushing in the league on four occasions. The 2019 Texans' squad featured a 3,500-yard passer, a 1,000-yard rusher, and a 1,000-yard receiver for only the fourth time in franchise history.

After his time in Houston, O'Brien returned to the college game as the quarterbacks coach and offensive coordinator at Alabama under Nick Saban in 2021 and 2022. He mentored Heisman Trophy winning QB Bryce Young and helped

the Crimson Tide reach the College Football Playoff national championship game in 2021. In his second season, Alabama was fourth nationally in scoring offense (41.1 points/game), 11th in total offense (477.1 yards/game) and 19th in passing offense (281.5 yards/game) en route to an 11-2 record and a victory in the Sugar Bowl.

O'Brien, who totaled six years across two stints on Bill Belichick's staff, helped guide the New England Patriots to two AFC titles and appearances in Super Bowl XLII and XLVI in six total years on the Patriots' coaching staff. Most recently, he spent the 2023 season as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach of the New England Patriots. He served in four different roles in Foxboro, including offensive coordinator during the 2011 season. With O'Brien as the OC, the Patriots went 13-3, earned the top-seed in the AFC, led the AFC in scoring (32.1 points per game), and ranked second in the NFL in total offense (428.0 yards per game) on the way to the Super Bowl. O'Brien was also the quarterbacks coach for two seasons, working directly with Tom Brady. During that time, Brady earned 2010 Associated Press MVP and All-Pro First Team honors.

Before entering the NFL, O'Brien gained 14 years of experience at the collegiate level, including 12 years in the ACC. His coaching career began at his alma mater Brown, serving as the tight ends coach (1993) and inside linebackers coach (1994). He then began an eight-year stretch at Georgia Tech as a graduate assistant (1995-97), running backs coach (1998-00) and offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach (2001-02). O'Brien then spent two seasons as the running backs coach at Maryland (2003-04) before a two-year stint as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Duke (2005-06).

Originally from Dorchester, Mass., O'Brien played linebacker and defensive end at Brown and graduated with a double concentration in political science and organizational behavioral management in 1992. O'Brien and his wife, Colleen, have two sons, Jack and Michael.

FRIDAY NIGHT HEIGHTS

» This week's game against Louisville marks the 19th regular season Friday game for Boston College since 1993. The Eagles are 9-9 in Friday games, including 5-7 at home.

» Last season, BC went 1-1 with a primetime win at Syracuse in week nine before an afternoon game the day after Thanksgiving against Miami at home.

» The Eagles' last home win on a Friday was the 2021 Red Bandanna Game when BC took down Virginia Tech, 17-3.

DUAL-THREAT

» **Thomas Castellanos** emerged as QBI after coming off the bench in week one of 2023 and went on to produce a 2,000-yard passing, 1,000-yard rushing season; the fifth such season by an ACC quarterback since 1996.

TOUCHDOWN TOMMY

» Through seven games, **Thomas Castellanos** has five multi-TD games, including a career-high four vs. Duquesne (9/7). He has already matched his passing touchdown total from a year ago with 14.

» Castellanos was responsible for three touchdowns at FSU (9/2) and rushed for 73 yards to pass **Tyler Murphy** for the most career rushing yards by a BC quarterback at 1,186.

» Castellanos' 28 career touchdown passes at BC are tied for 11th most in program history with **Paul Peterson** (2003-04) and one back of **Tim Hasselbeck** (1997-00) for 10th.

» In 2023, Castellanos was the first quarterback to lead BC on a five-game win streak as the starter in all five games since **Chase Rettig** in 2010.

» His 13 2023 rushing touchdowns were the third most in the ACC and the most in a season or career by a BC quarterback. Castellanos' 13 rushing TDs were the most by an Eagle since **AJ Dillon** ran for 14 in 2019.

GET TO KNOW GRAYSON

» Transfer quarterback **Grayson James** arrived at BC from Florida International in the spring of 2024.

» James started 11 games over three years at FIU, earning All-Conference USA Honorable Mention as a sophomore in 2022 with 1,967 passing yards.

» James made his first start at BC against Western Kentucky (9/28). He went 19-for-32 for 168 yards and a touchdown.

» He became the first BC quarterback to pass and run for a TD in his first start since Jeff Smith (2015 vs. Clemson).

» James began his high school career at John Paul II High School in Plano, Texas, where he was teammates with fellow BC Eagle **Jerand Bradley**. He finished his high school career at Duncanville. James and Bradley hooked up for the game-winning touchdown in the fourth quarter against WKU.

WARD ZERO

» Two-time transfer running back **Treshaun Ward** enters week eight as the Eagles' leading rusher with 305 yards and is fourth in receiving with 170 yards.

» Ward was named the ACC Running Back of the Week after a 138-yard all-purpose effort at his original team, FSU (9/2).

» Ward surpassed 2,000 career rushing yards vs. Duquesne.

WELCOME TO THE ROBICHAUX

» Transfer running back **Kye Robichaux** began the 2023 season fourth on the depth chart, but injuries thrust him into a feature role in week-two against Holy Cross. He produced a 94-yard game on 19 carries with a touchdown.

» A week later, Robichaux got his first start as an Eagle and went for 64 yards and a touchdown on 21 carries.

» Robichaux opened the 2024 season with a two-touchdown, 85-yard game at FSU (9/2). He scored his first TD on a reception from Castellanos before plunging in for his second TD of the game on the ground.

» He is third on the team with 239 rushing yards to go with three rushing touchdowns and one receiving touchdown.

TURBO TIME

» Explosive freshman running back **Turbo Richard** is second on the team in rushing with 271 yards on 51 carries.

» He carried the ball 15 times for a game-high 74 yards in the Eagles' week two win against Duquesne (9/7).

» He scored his first career TD against Michigan State (9/21).

» Richard, who is from Hickory, N.C., was the South Carolina Upper State Champ in the 100m with a 10.90 as a senior at Northwestern HS.

RED ZONE THREAT

» Six-foot-five transfer wide receiver **Jerand Bradley** has five receptions and two touchdowns on the season. He scored on a game-opening drive at Missouri (9/14) and hauled in the game-winning touchdown vs. Western Kentucky (9/28).

» Bradley arrived at BC after three years at Texas Tech, where he led the Red Raiders in all receiving categories in 2022.

» Bradley played two years of high school football with BC quarterback **Grayson James** at John Paul II High School in Plano, Texas before finishing his scholastic career at DeSoto.

BIG SKY TO THE BAY STATE

» Redshirt-freshman **Reed Harris** is the first player on record from the state of Montana to play ACC football.

» A dual-threat QB in high school, Harris recruited was an 'athlete' and saw limited action as a true freshman in 2023 with one catch in four games.

» He had the first catch of the season for BC in 2024 at FSU (9/2) and followed with a 72-yard TD against Duquesne (9/7). The score marked the longest TD reception by an Eagle since tight end Hunter Long's 77-yard TD vs. Pittsburgh in 2020.

» Harris made his first career start at Missouri (9/14) and caught a 67-yard touchdown.

LICENSE TO SCORE

» Wide receiver **Lewis Bond** appeared in eight games with six receptions for 57 yards in his first two seasons.

» Bond, a versatile receiver that can play all three wide out positions, emerged in 2023 as a primary option for the BC quarterbacks.

» Last season, he led BC in receptions (52), receiving yards (646) and touchdowns (7). He is one of four returners in the ACC to post a season of 50/600/7 or better.

» Bond's season was the seventh since 1996 by a BC receiver with at least 45 catches, 600 receiving yards and seven touchdowns. He is one of six such receivers in the ACC this year.

» In week two vs. Duquesne (9/7), Bond caught five passes on five targets for 98 yards, including a career-best 49-yard TD.

» He posted his second career 100-yard game with 102 yards on six receptions, including the game-winning 42-yard touchdown against Michigan State (9/21).

» Bond's 90 career receptions are 29th all-time at BC. He surpassed 1,000 career receiving yards at Virginia (10/5).

SHAKE MCGOWAN

» Transfer wide receiver and kick returner **Jayden McGowan** arrives at BC from Vanderbilt, where he amassed 1,609 all-purpose yards in two seasons.

» McGowan totaled 80 receptions in two seasons and 836 yards with three touchdowns.

» The Hornung Award Watch List honoree, was also named to Bruce Feldman's Freaks List on *The Athletic* as he boasts a 4.36 40 time, 370 bench, 500 squat and 275 power clean.

TIGHT END IN THE END ZONE

» In back-to-back games, tight end **Kamari Morales** found the end zone against Duquesne (9/7) and Missouri (9/14).

» Morales is third on the team in receptions at 15, while being tied for the team lead in receiving touchdowns at three.

» At North Carolina, Morales set the program record for most career touchdown receptions by a Tar Heel tight end with his 10th back in 2022. Morales now has 13 career touchdowns. The BC record is held by **Pete Mitchell** at 20.

» He became the first BC tight end to score in back-to-back games since Jacksonville State transfer **Trae Barry** did so against Colgate and Massachusetts to open the 2021 season.

BLOCKING GRADES

» The Eagles' offensive line ranks 12th in FBS with a 76.5 run block rating from PFF.

» Right tackle **Ozzy Trapilo** is the Eagles' highest graded blocker overall at 83.3. Left tackle **Jude Bowry** is first in pass block (84.5), while Trapilo leads in pass block (80.2).

DEPTH ON THE LINE

» BC started the same five players on the o-line in 11 of 12 regular season games a year ago. In 2022, the Eagles did not repeat a starting combination until a week-10 win at NC State.

» **Ozzy Trapilo**, a two-year starter at tackle, is coming off an All-ACC Second Team season. He posted a team-best 81. pass block grade and overall 75.0 rating from PFF.

» **Drew Kendall** has started 29 of the Eagles' last 30 games at center. He earned CFN Freshman All-America in 2022.

» **Logan Taylor**, who transferred to BC from Virginia, started all 13 games at left tackle in 2023. Taylor was out week one at FSU (9/2), but came in off the bench against Duquesne (9/7).

» Sixth-year lineman **Jack Conley** has started 24 games over the last four seasons. He started all 12 games of 2022 at four positions and five starts last year with four as an eligible tight end plus the Fenway Bowl, when he returned to guard.

INTERCEPTIONS: BY THE NUMBERS

» The Boston College defense ranks 15th in FBS and fourth in the ACC with nine interceptions. It is the most interceptions by a BC defense since 10 in 2021. The Eagles have already passed their season interceptions totals from 2023 (8) and 2022 (7).

» The Eagles last posted more than 10 interceptions in a season with 18 in back-to-back years in 2017 and 2018.

» BC has three multi-interception games this season and has at least one interception in five of seven games.

FRONT FOUR

» **Donovan Ezeiruaku**, a 2022 All-ACC pick, finished fourth in the league in sacks (8.5) and tackles for loss (14.5) in 2022. Last season he was fourth on the team with 53 tackles.

» **Neto Okpala** took over as the starter opposite Ezeiruaku early in 2023 and produced 26 tackles, five TFLs and two sacks.

» **Cam Horsley** anchors the group inside at defensive tackle with 53 games and 41 starts under his belt. He made 41 tackles, including three TFLs, a season ago.

» **George Rooks**, a former Michigan Wolverine, was the new-comer to the group a season ago. He totaled 29 tackles and four quarterback hurries in his first season at BC.

EAZY-E

» **Donovan Ezeiruaku**, a two-time captain, has posted a team-leading 49 tackles, 9.0 sacks and 12.0 tackles for loss.

» He is the second in the ACC and third in FBS in sacks and sacks per game (1.29). He is also first in the ACC and third in FBS in TFLs and TFLs per game (1.6).

» Ezeiruaku opened the season with a two-sack game at FSU (9/2), matching his 2023 season total.

» He has recorded at least one sack in five games, including his second two-sack game coming against MSU (9/21).

» Against Western Kentucky (9/28), Ezeiruaku dominated with career-highs in tackles (14), sacks (3) and TFLs (4). His three-sack game was the first by an Eagle since Wyatt Ray had four at Wake Forest in 2018.

HEY, ARNOLD

» **Kam Arnold** played corner in high school, moved to safety as a freshman and then transitioned to linebacker in 2021.

» He has started 40 consecutive games at linebacker.

» Ranking third on the team in tackles a year ago, Arnold is the Eagles’ top returning tackler with 66.

» He was named Defensive MVP of the Fenway Bowl with six tackles, two TFLs and a sack.

» Arnold has posted eight or more tackles three times this season with a season-high 11 vs. Western Kentucky (9/28). He also grabbed his third career interception that day.

THE LINEBACKER ROOM

» Junior **Daveon Crouch** won a starting job this year after playing on special teams the last two seasons. He has started all seven games and is fifth on the team with 33 tackles.

» Redshirt-junior **Owen McGowan** has contributed on special teams, defense and offense throughout his career. He caught a touchdown pass last year at Syracuse and posted eight tackles. This year, he has 16 tackles in seven games.

THE JUNGLE

» Through seven games, the BC owns a pass coverage of 83.9 rating, according to PFF.

» The secondary was responsible for all four takeaways vs. Michigan State (9/21) with three interceptions and a forced fumble on a kickoff by safety **Carter Davis**.

» BC players have totaled eight interceptions and 20 pass break-ups with **Amari Jackson** leading with five. Jackson picked off his first pass of the season against MSU (9/21).

» Cornerback **Max Tucker** and nickelback **Khari Johnson** lead the team with two interceptions apiece.

WHAT’S POPPIN’ NOW?

» **Amari Jackson** came away with a pick-six at Georgia Tech, a three-interception day for the BC secondary last season, and earned the Pop-Tarts Crazy Play of the Week.

» Jackson has started 20 games, including five as a true freshman and all 13 games a year ago.

» Last year, he totaled 39 tackles, including 33 solos, last season. According to PFF, Jackson was BC’s most targeted defensive back with 52 targets.

» Jackson hauled in his first interception of the 2024 season against Michigan State (9/21).

» Following an in-game injury at Virginia (10/5), Jackson was ruled out for the season due to an ACL injury.

TURNT UP TO THE MAX

» Cornerback **Max Tucker** earned his first career start in week 12 against Miami (11/24/23) with two tackles and a PBU.

» Tucker, from Catholic Memorial, was the last player signed in the early signing period, offered on Signing Day 2022.

» He debuted at Louisville (9/23) and a week later made a game-ending tackle vs. Virginia (9/30).

» Tucker recorded his first career interception at FSU (9/2) with a 58-yard return to set up a BC touchdown.

» He secured the win over Michigan State (9/21) with 36 seconds left with an interception in the end zone.

TWO-TAKEAWAY DAY

» At Virginia Tech (10/17), nickelback **Cameron Martinez** recorded a fumble recovery and an interception. He became just the fifth player at BC since 2009 to record two takeaways on a fumble and interception in the same game and first since **Jaiden Woodbey** at Louisville in 2021.

» Martinez added a sack and two TFLs in the game to be the only player since 2009 with a fumble recovery, interception and a sack. Woodbey is the only other player among the five to have added a TFL to his line.

CD AT THE FREE

» Redshirt-freshman **Carter Davis** made his first career start in the season opener at free safety against Florida State (9/2). He is fourth on BC with 36 tackles through six games.

» Against MSU (9/21), Davis grabbed his first career interception and forced a fumble on special teams plus five tackles.

» Davis contributed a team-high nine tackles in the Eagles' win over the Seminoles.

» As a true freshman, the Baltimore native played in three games, primarily at corner, and maintained his redshirt.

LUCA THE LEG

» **Luca Lombardo** won the placekicker job out of training camp after handling kickoffs for the first eight games of 2023 before an injury sidelined him.

» Lombardo made his first career field goal attempt, a 39-yarder, against Michigan State (9/21).

» A high school soccer player, he began his college journey as a freshman at Syracuse, but did not make the football team. He joined the Eagles after training camp in 2023 in time to kick in the season opener.

KICKING CONNOR

» **Liam Connor** took on kickoff responsibilities during his freshman season in 2022. He stepped in as the placekicker in week one last year against NIU (9/2/23).

» Connor connected on a 42-yarder vs. Virginia (9/30/23) and added a second 42-yard FG that stood as the game-winner.

» He matched his career-long at Pitt (11/16) and later surpassed it with a kick from 45 yards in a 3-for-3 game; the first three-field goal game of his career.

» He went 11-for-14 on the season again matching his career-high with a 45-yarder in the Fenway Bowl.

2024 CAPTAINS

» The Eagles elected six captains for the season. Quarterback **Thomas Castellanos** and offensive linemen **Drew Kendall** and **Ozzy Trapilo** were chosen to represent the defense.

» Kendall and Trapilo's fathers Pete Kendall (1992-95) and the late Steve Trapilo (1982-86) both played on the offensive line at BC with Trapilo serving as a captain in 1986.

» Linebacker **Kam Arnold** and defensive end **Donovan Ezeiruaku** will captain the defense. Ezeiruaku is a two-time captain.

» Linebacker **Joe Marinaro**, a former walk-on, was elected as special teams captain. Marinaro's father Mike played defensive tackle at BC from 1989-92.

SCHEDULE NOTES

» BC opened the season at Florida State, which was the ACC's undefeated champion heading into Bowl Season.

» BC played one of the ACC's six road games vs. the SEC when it made a return trip in a home-and-home to Missouri (9/14).

» The Eagles play seven home games for the second year in a row. BC went 3-4 and home in 2023.

» The schedule featured first-time match-ups with Duquesne (9/7) and Western Kentucky (9/28).

» BC's week-four game with Michigan State marked the 11th annual Red Bandanna Game.

TRANSFER TALK

» Boston College added 10 players in the transfer portal following the 2023 season and all 10 maintained their commitment to BC following the Eagles' coaching change.

THE COACHING STAFF

» **Bill O'Brien** made five new hires to his first Boston College coaching staff, retained four assistants and made one internal promotion.

» **Will Lawing** was brought on as the offensive coordinator/tight ends coach. He has spent the last 13 years working with O'Brien at Penn State, the Texans, Alabama and the Patriots.

» On the defensive side of the ball, O'Brien brought on **Tim Lewis** as the coordinator. Lewis spent 20 years in the NFL with two stops as a DC with the Steelers and Giants.

» The additional new hires include **Ray Brown** (secondary), **Jeff Comissiong** (defensive line) and **Dan O'Brien** (linebackers). Brown arrived on the Heights from Washington State, while Comissiong and O'Brien make their return to BC. Comissiong was the Eagles' defensive line coach from 2007-12 when he coached BC legends B.J. Raji and Ron Brace. O'Brien, a 2005 grad, was a student assistant during his father Tom O'Brien's tenure as head coach of the Eagles.

» Special teams coordinator and safeties assistant **Matt Thurin** is the longest tenured coach on staff at five seasons.

» Three assistants return to the offense with **Matt Applebaum** (offensive line), **Savon Huggins** (running backs) and **Darrell Wyatt** (wide receivers) all back.

» The staff is rounded out by the promotion of **Jonathan DiBiasi** from offensive analyst to quarterbacks coach. A product of nearby Everett High School, DiBiasi is in his fifth season on staff, second consecutive, in two stints at BC beginning as a graduate assistant and first returning as an analyst.

The Eagles raced out to a 21-0 lead in the first quarter and never looked back. Justice Smith ran for 145 yard sand a score on 18 caries, while Omari Walker added two rushing scores.

BC kicker Colton Lichtenberg hit a 27-yard field goal as time expired to win.

Reigning Heisman winner Lamar Jackson accounted for five touchdowns and 512 yards, but BC rookie running back AJ Dillon countered with four scores and 272 yards on the ground as the Eagles score 28 straight points after trailing 21-7 at the half.

Dennis Grosel, who came off the bench against Louisville a year earlier and started the rest of the way, entered when Phil Jurkovec sustained an injury with BC up 20-13 in the third quarter.

Zay Flowers hauled in two touchdowns of 50+ yards, a 57-yarder and a 69-yarder, both from Phil Jurkovec, as part of a 5-catch, 151-yard outing. Jurkovec threw for 304 yards and three touchdowns, on 18-of-21 passing, with one interception.
