## FIRST-AND-10

» Boston College football plays its first home game under head coach **Bill O'Brien**, the 37th coach in program history, Saturday, September 7 at 3:30 p.m. vs. Duquesne at Alumni Stadium.

» The game will be streamed on ACCNX and ESPN+. **Bill Spaulding** (play-by-play) and **Craig Haubert** (analyst) are on the call.

» Coverage on the Boston College Sports Network begins 30 minutes prior to kickoff on WEEI 93.7 FM. **Jon Meterparel** (play-by-play) is joined on the call by former BC linebacker **Pete Cronan** in the booth and quarterback **Scott Mutryn** on the sideline.

» BC is coming off a 28-13 win at No. 10 Florida State; the biggest road win against a top-10 opponent in program history.

» O'Brien was honored by the Dodd Trophy as its Coach of the Week recipient following the Eagles' week-one win at FSU.

» **Thomas Castellanos** broke the Eagles' all-time rushing record by a quarterback last week with 73 yards at FSU to push his career total to 1,186 in 14 career games. He threw two touchdowns and ran for one, while being named to the Davey O'Brien Award Great Eight for week one.

» **Treshaun Ward** was named the ACC Running Back of the Week following a 138-yard all-purpose performance with 77 on the ground and 61 through the air, including a touchdown.

» Boston College and Duquesne face off for the first time on the gridiron.

» BC last faced an opponent from the Northeast Conference in 2016 when it defeated Wagner, 42-10, in week four.

» Since the NCAA was first subdivided in 1978, the Eagles are 34-3 against Division I-AA or FCS opponents and have won 34 in a row. All three losses came in 1978.

## WEEK ONE RECAP

Monday, Sept. 2: Boston College 28, No. 10 Florida State 13  
Doak Campbell Stadium (Tallahassee, Fla.)

» The Eagles opened the **Bill O'Brien** era with a 28-13 win on the road at No. 10 Florida State.

» The win marked the first top-10 victory for BC since defeating No. 9 USC in 2014 and the first win over a ranked opponent in the season opener since No. 7 Texas in 1976.

» Former Seminole **Treshaun Ward** accounted for 138 all-purpose yards with 77 on the ground and a team-high 61 through the air with a receiving touchdown.

» **Kye Robichaux** led the rushing attack with 85 yards and a rushing touchdown, plus one in the air. QB **Thomas Castellanos** added 73 rushing yards as BC outgained FSU 263-21 on the ground.

» The Eagles totaled 369 yards of offense and held the ball for 39:09 time of possession, while committing just one penalty.

## THE O'BRIEN ERA

» Head coach **Bill O'Brien** was hired on Feb. 9 and introduced as the Eagles' 37th head coach on Feb. 15.

» O'Brien arrives at BC with head coaching stops at Penn State (2012-13) and in the NFL with the Houston Texans (2014-20). He is 67-57 overall as a head coach and 15-9 in college football.

» O'Brien has coached under six-time Super Bowl Champion Bill Belichick (2007-11 and 2023) as well as seven-time National Champion Nick Saban (2021-22).

» On the field, O'Brien has mentored NFL quarterbacks Tom Brady (2009-11), DeShaun Watson (2017-20) and Heisman Trophy Winner Bryce Young (2021-22).

## ON THIS DATE

### September 7, 1985

*Boston College 28, Temple 25*

» BC received a scare as an 18-point, fourth-quarter lead was cut to three, but the Eagles hung on in the end for their first victory of the young season in the Alumni Stadium home opener.

» Shawn Halloran threw for 250 yards on 20-for-30 passing and Troy Flutie led the receivers with five catches, while Troy Stradford ran for 115 yards on 18 carries.

### September 7, 1991

*No. 2 Michigan 35, Boston College 13*

» Three Michigan touchdowns in the final seven minutes broke open a titanic defensive struggle.

» Heisman Trophy winner Desmond Howard totaled four TDs, three receiving and one on a kick return, in front of a standing-room-only crowd in a game broadcast nationally on ABC.

**The Gregory P. Barber '69 and Family Head Football Coach**

Bill O'Brien was hired as the 37th head coach in Boston College football history on Feb. 9, 2024.

A 32-year coaching veteran in the college and professional ranks, O'Brien was elevated to his first head coaching post at Penn State in 2012. He guided the Nittany Lions to an overall record of 15-9 and 10-6 Big Ten mark during the span of two seasons while directing the program through a postseason ban. He was named the head coach of the NFL's Houston Texans in 2014, leading the franchise to a 52-48 record, four AFC South Division titles, and four playoff appearances - including two Wild Card round wins - between 2014 and 2020.

While at Penn State, O'Brien was recognized in 2012 with a pair of national coaching awards - the Paul "Bear" Bryant National Coach of the Year, and the George Munger Award for Coach of the Year by the Maxwell Football Club. The Nittany Lions' eight wins in 2012 were the most by a first-year head coach in school history, earning O'Brien Big Ten Coach of the Year honors. In 2013, O'Brien and Penn State won seven games, including two top 25 victories, downing No. 18 Michigan at home and winning at No. 14 Wisconsin. The Nittany Lions boasted two first team All-Americans during his tenure - linebacker Michael Mauti (2012) and wide receiver Allen Robinson (2013) - and 10 All-Big Ten selections.

O'Brien returned to the NFL in 2014 as the head coach of the Houston Texans. During his tenure, Houston posted five winning seasons, including back-to-back double-digit win seasons in 2018 (11-5) and 2019 (10-6). The 21 combined wins rank as the second-most in a two-year span in franchise history. Houston's offense ranked in the top-10 in rushing in the league on four occasions. The 2019 Texans' squad featured a 3,500-yard passer, a 1,000-yard rusher, and a 1,000-yard receiver for only the fourth time in franchise history.

After his time in Houston, O'Brien returned to the college game as the quarterbacks coach and offensive coordinator at Alabama under Nick Saban in 2021 and 2022. He mentored Heisman Trophy winning QB Bryce Young and helped

the Crimson Tide reach the College Football Playoff national championship game in 2021. In his second season, Alabama was fourth nationally in scoring offense (41.1 points/game), 11th in total offense (477.1 yards/game) and 19th in passing offense (281.5 yards/game) en route to an 11-2 record and a victory in the Sugar Bowl.

O'Brien, who totaled six years across two stints on Bill Belichick's staff, helped guide the New England Patriots to two AFC titles and appearances in Super Bowl XLII and XLVI in six total years on the Patriots' coaching staff. Most recently, he spent the 2023 season as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach of the New England Patriots. He served in four different roles in Foxboro, including offensive coordinator during the 2011 season. With O'Brien as the OC, the Patriots went 13-3, earned the top-seed in the AFC, led the AFC in scoring (32.1 points per game), and ranked second in the NFL in total offense (428.0 yards per game) on the way to the Super Bowl. O'Brien was also the quarterbacks coach for two seasons, working directly with Tom Brady. During that time, Brady earned 2010 Associated Press MVP and All-Pro First Team honors.

Before entering the NFL, O'Brien gained 14 years of experience at the collegiate level, including 12 years in the ACC. His coaching career began at his alma mater Brown, serving as the tight ends coach (1993) and inside linebackers coach (1994). He then began an eight-year stretch at Georgia Tech as a graduate assistant (1995-97), running backs coach (1998-00) and offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach (2001-02). O'Brien then spent two seasons as the running backs coach at Maryland (2003-04) before a two-year stint as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Duke (2005-06).

Originally from Dorchester, Mass., O'Brien played linebacker and defensive end at Brown and graduated with a double concentration in political science and organizational behavioral management in 1992. O'Brien and his wife, Colleen, have two sons, Jack and Michael.

2024 CAPTAINS

» The Eagles elected six captains for the 2024 season. Quarterback **Thomas Castellanos** and offensive linemen **Drew Kendall** and **Ozzy Trapilo** were chosen to represent the defense.

» Linebacker **Kam Arnold** and defensive end **Donovan Ezeiruaku** will captain the defense. Ezeiruaku is a two-time captain.

» Linebacker **Joe Marinaro**, a former walk-on, was elected as special teams captain.

AGAINST THE RANKED

» Boston College is 34-123-1 all-time against opponents ranked in the top-25. The Eagles snapped a streak of 15 straight losses to ranked opponents and 25 straight to AP-ranked opponents with a 21-20 win at No. 16 NC State (11/12/22).

» The Eagles' capped the 2023 season with a 23-14 win over No. 17/24 SMU in the Wasabi Fenway Bowl (12/28/23).

» This season's 28-13, season-opening victory at FSU (9/2) marked BC's first top-10 win since No. 9 USC (2014), first season-opening top-25 win since No. 7 Texas (1976) and largest road win against a ranked opponent in program history.

DUAL-THREAT

» **Thomas Castellanos** emerged as QB1 after coming off the bench in week one of 2023 and went on to produce a 2,000-yard passing, 1,000-yard rushing season; the fifth such season by an ACC quarterback since 1996.

TOUCHDOWN TOMMY

» **Thomas Castellanos** passed for 305 yards and ran for 95 in BC's 2023 week-three game against No. 3 FSU. He became just the 22nd quarterback since 1996 to have gone over 300 and 95 in a game against an AP-ranked Top-25 opponents.

» Castellanos was the first quarterback to lead BC on a five-game win streak as the starter in all five games since **Chase Rettig** in 2010.

» His 13 rushing touchdowns were the third most in the ACC and the most in a season or career by a BC quarterback. Castellanos' 13 rushing TDs were the most by an Eagle since **AJ Dillon** ran for 14 in 2019.

» Castellanos was responsible for three touchdowns at FSU (9/2) and rushed for 73 yards to pass **Tyler Murphy** for the most career rushing yards by a BC quarterback at 1,186.

LICENSE TO SCORE

» Wide receiver **Lewis Bond** appeared in eight games with six receptions for 57 yards in his first two seasons.

» Bond, a versatile receiver that can play all three wide out positions, emerged in 2023 as a primary option for the BC quarterbacks.

» Bond scored his first career touchdown in the season-opener, BC's first touchdown of the season, on an 11-yard catch. A week later, Bond earned his first start and hauled in five passes. In week three vs. FSU, he scored on a 32-yard catch-and-run to cap the Eagles' opening-drive en route to an 80-yard game.

» He led BC in receptions (52), receiving yards (646) and touchdowns (7). He is one of four returners in the ACC to post a season of 50/600/7 or better.

» Bond's season was the seventh since 1996 by a BC receiver with at least 45 catches, 600 receiving yards and seven touchdowns. He is one of six such receivers in the ACC this year.

» Transfer running back **Kye Robichaux** began the 2023 season fourth on the depth chart, but injuries thrust him into a feature role in week-two against Holy Cross. He produced a 94-yard game on 19 carries with a touchdown.

» A week later, Robichaux got his first start as an Eagle and went for 64 yards and a touchdown on 21 carries.

» Robichaux has had his number called on seven fourth-down attempts and converted five, including three against FSU.

» In his first start and first full game back since a week-four injury, Robichaux produced a career-high 165 rushing yards with two touchdowns at Georgia Tech (10/21/23). He totaled 219 all-purpose yards, adding 54 receiving yards on three catches and was rewarded as the ACC Running Back of the Week.

» Robichaux opened the season with a two-touchdown, 85-yard game at FSU (9/2). He scored his first TD on a reception from Castellanos before plunging in for his second TD of the game on the ground.

SHAKE MCGOWAN

» Transfer wide receiver and kick returner Jayden McGowan arrives at BC from Vanderbilt, where he amassed 1,609 all-purpose yards in two seasons.

» McGowan totaled 80 receptions in two seasons and 836 yards with three touchdowns.

» The Hornung Award Watch List honoree, was also named to Bruce Feldman's Freaks List on *The Athletic* as he boasts a 4.36 40 time, 370 bench, 500 squat and 275 power clean.

DEPTH ON THE LINE

» BC has started the same five players on the offensive line in 11 of 12 regular season games a year ago. In 2022, the Eagles did not repeat a starting o-line combination until its week-10 win at NC State (11/12/22).

» **Ozzy Trapilo**, a two-year starter at tackle, is coming off an All-ACC Second Team season. He posted a team-best 81. pass block grade and overall 75.0 rating from PFF.

» **Drew Kendall** has started 24 of the Eagles' last 25 games at center. He earned CFN Freshman All-America in 2022.

» **Logan Taylor**, who transferred to BC from Virginia, started all 13 games at left tackle in 2023.

» Sixth-year lineman **Jack Conley** has started 19 games over the last three seasons. He started all 12 games of 2022 at four positions and five starts last year with four as an eligible tight end plus the Fenway Bowl, when he returned to guard.

**BC O-Line Career Starts:** Ozzy Trapilo (25), Drew Kendall (25), Logan Taylor (23), Jack Conley (20), Dwayne Allick (12), Jude Bowry (3), Kevin Cline (2).

FRONT FOUR

» **Donovan Ezeiruaku**, a 2022 All-ACC pick, finished fourth in the league in sacks (8/5) and tackles for loss (14.5) in 2022. Last season he was fourth on the team with 53 tackles.

» Ezeiruaku opened the season with a two-sack game at FSU (9/2), matching his 2023 season total.

» **Neto Okpala** took over as the starter opposite Ezeiruaku early in 2023 and produced 26 tackles, five TFLs and two sacks.

» **Cam Horsley** anchors the group inside at defensive tackle with 48 games and 36 starts under his belt. He made 41 tackles, including three TFLs, a season ago.

» **George Rooks**, a former Michigan Wolverine, was the new-comer to the group a season ago, winning the other starting spot on the interior. He totaled 29 tackles and four quarter-back hurries in his first season at BC.

» The combination of Ezeiruaku and Okpala on the edges with Horsley and Rooks inside started 10 games together in 2023.

HEY, ARNOLD

» **Kam Arnold** played corner in high school, moved to safety as a freshman and then transitioned to linebacker in 2021.

» He has started 36 of the last 37 games at linebacker.

» Ranking third on the team in tackles a year ago, Arnold is the Eagles' top returning tackler with 66.

» He was named Defensive MVP of the Fenway Bowl with six tackles, two TFLs and a sack.

WHAT'S POPPIN' NOW?

» **Amari Jackson** came away with a pick-six at Georgia Tech, a three-interception day for the BC secondary last season, and earned the Pop-Tarts Crazy Play of the Week.

» Through two seasons, Jackson has started 18 games, including five as a true freshman and all 13 games a year ago.

» He totaled 39 tackles, including 33 solos, last season. According to PFF, Jackson was BC's most targeted defensive back with 52 targets and held opposing receivers to a 57.7 completion percentage.

TURNT UP TO THE MAX

» Cornerback **Max Tucker** earned his first career start in week 12 against Miami (11/24) with two tackles and a pass break-up.

» Tucker, from Catholic Memorial, was the last player signed in the early signing period, offered on Signing Day 2022.

» He debuted at Louisville (9/23) and a week later made a game-ending tackle vs. Virginia (9/30).

» Tucker recorded his first career interception at FSU (9/2) with a 58-yard return to set up a BC touchdown.

CD AT THE FREE

» Redshirt-freshman **Carter Davis** made his first career start in the season opener at free safety against Florida State (9/2).

» Davis contributed a team-high nine tackles in the Eagles' win over the Seminoles.

» As a true freshman, the Baltimore native played in three games, primarily at corner, and maintained his redshirt.

KICKING CONNOR

» **Liam Connor** took on kickoff responsibilities during his freshman season in 2022. He stepped in as the placekicker in week one last year against NIU (9/2).

» The Leominster, Mass. native connected on all three PAT attempts with the final try tying the game with :05 left on the clock and forced overtime. He then made his first career field goal attempt in OT from 39 yards out.

» Connor connected on a 42-yarder vs. Virginia (9/30) and added a second 42-yard FG that stood as the game-winner.

» He matched his career-long at Pitt (11/16) and later surpassed it with a kick from 45 yards in a 3-for-3 game; the first three-field goal game of his career.

» He went 11-for-14 on the season again matching his career-high with a 45-yarder in the Fenway Bowl.

TRANSFER TALK

» Boston College added 10 players in the transfer portal following the 2023 season and all 10 maintained their commitment to BC following the Eagles' coaching change.

## THE COACHING STAFF

» **Bill O'Brien** made five new hires to his first Boston College coaching staff, retained four assistants and made one internal promotion.

» **Will Lawing** was brought on as the offensive coordinator/tight ends coach. He has spent the last 13 years working with O'Brien at Penn State, the Texans, Alabama and the Patriots.

» On the defensive side of the ball, O'Brien brought on **Tim Lewis** as the coordinator. Lewis spent 20 years in the NFL with two stops as a DC with the Steelers and Giants.

» The additional new hires include **Ray Brown** (secondary), **Jeff Comissiong** (defensive line) and **Dan O'Brien** (linebackers). Brown arrived on the Heights from Washington State, while Comissiong and O'Brien make their return to BC. Comissiong was the Eagles' defensive line coach from 2007-12 when he coached BC legends B.J. Raji and Ron Brace. O'Brien, a 2005 grad, was a student assistant during his father Tom O'Brien's tenure as head coach of the Eagles.

» Special teams coordinator and safeties assistant **Matt Thurin** is the longest tenured coach on staff at five seasons.

» Three assistants return to the offense with **Matt Applebaum** (offensive line), **Savon Huggins** (running backs) and **Darrell Wyatt** (wide receivers) all back.

» The staff is rounded out by the promotion of **Jonathan DiBiaso** from offensive analyst to quarterbacks coach. A product of nearby Everett High School, DiBiaso is in his fifth season on staff, second consecutive, in two stints at BC beginning as a graduate assistant and first returning as an analyst.

## SCHEDULE NOTES

» BC opens the season at Florida State, which was the ACC's undefeated champion heading into Bowl Season. Castellanos put up 400 yards of total offense in a narrow, two-point defeat to the No. 3 Seminoles at home in 2023.

» BC plays one of the ACC's six road games vs. the SEC when it makes a return trip in a home-and-home to Missouri (9/14).

» The Eagles play seven home games for the second year in a row. BC went 3-4 and home in 2023.

» The schedule features first-time match-ups with Duquesne (9/7) and Western Kentucky (9/28).
