BOSTON COLLEGE VS. PITTSBURGH - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game marks the 61st meeting between the two schools.
- Boston College is 22-38 all-time vs. Pittsburgh, with the series dating back to 1959-60 season.
- In ACC regular season play, the Eagles are 3-9 versus the Panthers.
- Last year, BC dropped a 90-65 decision to Pitt on March 2, 2024.
- From 1989-2004, both schools were members of the Big East.
- The Eagles compiled a 15-27 mark vs. Pitt during that span.
- BC downed Pitt, 79-57, to capture the 2001 Big East Championship.
- Pitt is BC's ninth all-time most common opponent (60 games).
- Pitt assistant coach Tim O'Toole's father Tom was inducted as a member of the Boston College Athletics Hall of Fame in 1977.
- Tom O'Toole played for the Eagles from 1949-52, finishing his career with 703 points, averaging 10.3 ppg for head coach Al McClelland.

D1000N BROWN

- With his 3-pointer with 10:51 remaining in the second half against Clemson, Dion Brown reached the 1,000 point mark for his career.
- The junior guard entered BC having scored 777 points in two seasons (54 games) at UMBC from 2022-24.
- Brown ranks fourth on BC in scoring this year, at 7.4 points per game.

DONALD HAND JR. - YEAR-OVER-YEAR IMPROVEMENTS

- Donald Hand Jr. is one of the ACC's Most Improved Players.
- Hand ranks third among all ACC players in scoring average increase and is the only one of the three to have done so at the same school.
- **He is averaging +11 more points per game and over a +4.0 jump in rebounding per game, compared to 2023-24.**
- Hand is one of three players in the ACC (Flagg - Duke; Raynaud - Stanford) to be named the conference's Player of the Week three times (Dec. 30; Feb. 3; Feb. 24).
- He is one of three players in the ACC who has registered at least 20 points and five rebounds in at least nine games this season (Flagg - Duke; Raynaud - Stanford).
- **He has a near double-digit increase in all three shooting percentages.**
- One of the ACC's top shooters, Hand is averaging nearly +2.0 more 3FG per game
- Using the metric PAR (points+assists+rebounds), he has seen over a +16 jump year-over-year and an +8.0 increase when measured per 40 minutes.
- After a season-ending injury in game two as a true freshman, his first significant playing time came in the 2023-24 season.

ON THIS DATE: MARCH 8

- Boston College is 4-10 all-time and 0-3 in ACC Tournament games played on the March 8 calendar date.
- On March 8, 1997, Boston College captured its first Big East Championship, downing Villanova, 70-58.
- March 8 marks the dual celebration of National Proofreading and National Peanut Cluster Days.
- Several notable events in history occurred on March 8 - 1817 - the New York Stock Exchange is founded; 1913 - the Internal Revenue Service begins; 1927 - Pan American Airlines incorporates; 1936 - the first stock car race is held in Daytona Beach, Fla.; 1974 - Charles de Gaulle Airport opens in Paris; 1987 - the last episode of "The A-Team" aired on NBC.
- Notable March 8 birthdays: U.S. Supreme Court justice Oliver Wendell Holmes; blues pioneer Mississippi John Hurt; actor Alan Hale; Hall of Fame outfielder Jim Rice; actor James van Der Beek.

HASTINGS MAKING AN IMPACT

- Redshirt freshman Jayden Hastings has steadily improved throughout his first season of college basketball.
- **Hastings has 13 games with at least two blocked shots - the most multi-block games by a BC freshman since Sean Williams posted 16 during his freshman campaign in 2004-05.**
- Last time out, Hastings poured in a career-high 18 points against Clemson, adding five rebounds, two blocks, and three steals.
- Hastings was 8-for-8 from the floor - the best by a BC player since Nik Popovic (9-9) against Minnesota on Nov. 26, 2018.
- Since the 1996-97 season, seven BC players have been perfect from the floor (min. eight FGA).
- Against Virginia Tech, Hastings was a perfect 4-for-4 from the floor, good for eight points, five boards, and two blocks.
- As a starter (3G), Hastings is averaging 7.0 points, 5.3 rebounds, 1.0 blocks while shooting 64.3% from the floor.
- In his first collegiate start on Dec. 21 against SMU, Hastings scored a season-high nine points in 29 minutes played.
- Against Louisville on Feb. 5, Hastings tied his season-best with nine boards and logged two blocked shots.
- For the season overall Hastings is connecting on 60.2% from the floor and has logged 39 total blocked shots.

EAGLES AMONG THE ACC / NCAA LEADERS

- **ACC Overall:** Donald Hand Jr. ranks 14th in scoring (15.9), 19th in rebounding (6.1) and third in FT percentage (.874).
- Hand is one of three players to rank in the top 20 in scoring and rebounding in the conference.
- Maxime Raynaud (Stanford) and Cooper Flagg (Duke) are the others.
- Hand also ranks sixth in the ACC in 3-pointers made, averaging 2.3 3FGM per game. (68 total).
- Chad Venning sits in second in the ACC - and 56th nationally - in field goal percentage, connecting on 54.0% of his shots.
- Venning is also third in the ACC in blocked shots - 64th nationally - averaging 1.57 swats per outing.
- Jayden Hastings is tied for sixth in the ACC in blocks, swatting 1.30 shots per game so far this season.
- As a team, BC ranks third in the ACC - and 92nd in the country - in blocks per game (3.93).
- **ACC games only:** Hand ranks 12th in scoring (16.4 ppg), fourth in 3-point field goal percentage (.394), fourth in 3-pointers made (2.63/game), and 11th in free throw percentage (.854).
- Venning is sixth among all players in ACC play in field goal percentage (.533) and sixth in blocked shots (1.41)
- Jayden Hastings is tied for fourth in blocked shots in ACC games, swatting 1.42 shots per game.

GET THAT UP OUTTA HERE!

- Chad Venning has registered at least four blocked shots in a game on four occasions - most by any ACC player this season.
- In total - among all major conference players - Venning and 12 others have at least four games with four blocked shots.
- Ryan Kalkenbrenner (Creighton) and Jayden Quaintance (Arizona State) are tied for first, with eight games.
- Venning has blocked at least three shots in eight games - one of two ACC players to do so in 2024-25 (Zack Austin, Pitt).

GOOD THINGS COME IN THREE; HAND WINS THIRD POTW

- On Feb. 24, Donald Hand Jr. earned his third ACC Player of the Week honor of the season.
- Hand won it previously on Dec. 30 and Feb. 3, joining Maxime Raynaud (Stanford) and Cooper Flagg (Duke) as the only players to have captured the award at least three times in 2024-25.
- Hand joins Jared Dudley as the only other BC player to garner ACC weekly conference honors three times in the same year.
- In 2006-07, Dudley earned the top weekly player award on three occasions en route to being named ACC Player of the Year.
- Against Georgia Tech, Hand led all scorers with his ninth 20-point game. It was his ninth game this season with at least 20 points. Hand is one of eight players in the ACC to have at least nine 20-point performances in 2024-25.
- Versus Virginia Tech (Feb. 18), he had 16 points, as BC set a program record for lowest points allowed in an ACC game (36).
- Earlier this season on Dec. 30, history was made as Hand and his father became the first father-son duo to each earn ACC Player of the Week honors in their respective careers. Donald Hand Sr. was the ACC Player of the Week on Jan. 31, 2000 while starring at Virginia. The conference began its weekly awards program during the 1972-73 season.
- Since BC joined the ACC prior to the 2005-06 season, an Eagle has been selected ACC Player of the Week on 20 occasions, with 10 different players having captured the award at least once.

HIGH-PERCENTAGE VENNING

- Over his last 16 games, Chad Venning is averaging just under 14.0 ppg and connecting on just under 56% from the floor.
- He poured in a season-high 21 points - two off his career-best - against Notre Dame on Feb. 12.
- On Jan. 25, he scored 17 points (7-12 FG) in 30 minutes at UNC.
- Twice he's scored 19 points - vs. #3/3 Duke and at Georgia Tech. He added 17 points at UNC and at home vs. Syracuse.
- In the comeback win over Miami, Venning tallied 17 points (7-10), scoring 11 straight points for the Eagles in the first half.
- Overall this season, Venning has reached double-digits in the scoring column on 19 occasions.
- **For the season, Venning ranks second in the ACC in overall FG% (.540) and sixth in ACC games only (.533).**

BRINGING THE BOOM

- Boston College has registered 10 or more 3-pointers on nine occasions, including a season-high 14 at North Carolina.
- Through 30 games this season, the Eagles have made 201 3-pointers at a 35.1% clip.
- Donald Hand Jr. leads BC with 68 3FGM at a 37.8% clip; Joshua Beadle (50.0%) leads the team in percentage.
- The 35.1% 3FG% mark ranks eighth in the ACC; BC has connected on 36.7% in ACC play - also good for eighth.

IF THIS, THEN THAT...

WITH A WIN AT PITTSBURGH...

- BC would finish 13-18 overall and 5-15 in ACC play
- The Eagles would improve to 23-38 all-time vs. Pitt
- BC would capture its first road victory of the season
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his 62nd win at Boston College and his 189th as a collegiate head coach.
- BC would earn victory #1,286 all-time in 92 seasons of basketball, dating back to 1904-05.

WITH A LOSS AT PITTSBURGH...

- Boston College would finish 12-19 overall; 4-16 ACC
- BC would fall to 22-39 all-time vs. Pittsburgh
- Boston College would register the 1,117th loss all-time in program history, dating back to the 1904-05 season.

RECORD BOOK UPDATE

- Chad Venning has cracked Boston College's single-season record book for blocked shots, coming in at 10th with 44.
- Donald Hand Jr.'s .874 FT% ranks third on BC's single-season list; his .851 career mark is also third-best in program history.

DEFENSE MECHANISM

- In the wins over Virginia Tech and Georgia Tech, Boston College's defensive scoring mark was 45.0 points per game.
- It marked the first time since the 2022-23 season that BC held back-to-back opponents under 55 points.
- That season, on Nov. 21, 2022 BC held Wyoming to 48 points and next limited Rhode Island to 49 points on Nov. 27, 2022.
- BC held Georgia Tech to 54 points - more than 20 points under its season average and more than 30 fewer than they scored in the first regular season matchup.
- The stifling BC defense held the Yellow Jackets to 32.1% shooting (18-56), including 5-of-23 from the perimeter.
- On Feb. 18, Boston College held Virginia Tech to a record-low point total - 36 points - in a 54-36 home win.
- The 36 points marked the lowest point total by an ACC opponent since Boston College joined the league at the start of the 2005-06 season (previous - 44 vs. Virginia on Feb. 26, 2011).
- BC's 36 points allowed ranks as the lowest scoring defensive point total by any ACC team this season and ranks as the fifth-lowest defensive scoring mark in an ACC game since 1996-97 (10 total games during that span).
- It ranks as the third-lowest single-game point total by an opponent in Conte Forum history (building opened in 1988-89): 32 - NJIT (Jan. 5, 2010); 33 - High Point (Nov. 13, 2019); 36 - Virginia Tech (Feb. 18, 2015).
- It tied for the fourth-lowest point total by an opponent in BC history, dating back to the restart of the program in 1945-46
- Dating back to 1945-46, it marked only the 13th time in program history that BC held an opponent under 40 points.

DONALD WITH A HOT HAND OVER EIGHT-GAME SPAN

- For over nearly a month (Jan. 25-Feb. 22), Donald Hand Jr. scored 179 points (22.4 ppg average) with 56 field goals (30 3FG).
- Included in that span was a career-high 31 points in a comeback win over Florida State.
- **Over the last 25 years, seven Boston College players have scored that many points over a eight-game span.**
- The last to do so was Ky Bowman, who scored 183 points between Dec. 31, 2018-Jan. 30, 2019 as a junior.
- Four former Eagles surpassed the 200-point mark over an eight-game span. Most recently, Jerome Robinson tallied 222 points between Jan. 21-Feb. 17, 2018; Olivier Hanlan (220) between Feb. 4-28, 2015; Tyrese Rice (205) between Feb. 9-March 8, 2008; Craig Smith (206) between Dec. 15, 202-Jan. 19, 2003.
- Troy Bell scored 255 points for an eight-game stretch between Feb. 5-March 4, 2003.

THE 60 POINT MARK

- Four times this season - and twice in ACC play - Boston College has held its opponents under 60 points.
- BC has captured its last 18 games, including its last seven non-conference matchups, when holding opponents to 60 or fewer.
- Under Earl Grant, the Eagles are 23-2 when keeping their opponents at 60 or less on the scoreboard.

I'VE GOT SIX ON IT

- Roger McFarlane has grabbed at least six rebounds in 33 of his last 51 games played, dating back to Dec. 16, 2023.
- He has had at least six rebounds in 72 of his 120 career games - better than 60% of his games played.
- McFarlane has grabbed at least six boards in 10 games this season; BC is 7-3 in those games.
- The 6-4 guard ranks second on the team in rebounding, averaging nearly 5.0 boards per outing.

EXTRA FRAMES

- Boston College followed up its triple-overtime game at Syracuse with a double OT affair at home against Notre Dame.
- The last time BC had back-to-back overtime games was March 9-10, 2022 against Wake Forest and Miami, respectively.
- It marked the first time since 1991-92 that Boston College has played two multiple overtime games in the same season.
- BC has played four overtime games this season - the most in a single-season since the 2021-22 campaign.

BEADLE'S BUZZER-BEATING BUCKETS

- Nine of the 17 3-pointers from Joshua Beadle this season have come with 10 seconds or less on the shot or game clock.
- Included in those nine was the game-winning 3FG as time expired vs. Boise State in the Cayman Islands Classic title game.
- The grad transfer guard has made 17-of-34 attempts from the perimeter this season at Boston College (50.0%).
- In ACC play, Beadle has connected on 52.4% (11-21) of his attempts from long distance.
- Entering this season, Beadle had made 9-of-49 (.184) from beyond the arc in 65 games at Clemson.

ANOTHER DOUBLE-DIGIT COMEBACK WIN FOR THE EAGLES; BC STUNS FSU, 77-76

- Boston College registered its second double-digit comeback win in ACC play, besting Florida State, 77-76, on Feb. 1.
- BC trailed by as many as 15 points - 59-44 with 12:40 to go; the Eagles held FSU without a FG for nearly the next 10 minutes.
- Minute of Mayhem: Down 70-62 with under 1:00 to play, Donald Hand Jr. converted a traditional three-point play with :48 left.
- After two FSU free throws made it 72-65 with :44 left, Fred Payne corralled a miss and went to the line, making both FT.
- Trailing by five - 72-67 - Payne logged a steal off a bad pass by FSU's Jamir Watkins and called timeout with :35 left.
- On the ensuing possession, Hand was fouled and made two FT, making it 72-69 with 30 ticks to play.
- Two more Seminoles foul shots made it a two-possession game again - 74-69 - with :28 remaining.
- Payne would strike again, converting a three-point play with 15 seconds to go, making it a two-point game - 74-72.
- Florida State extended its lead back to 76-72 after two more free throws with :14 to go.
- Payne drove to the basket and had his layup blocked, but Chad Venning tipped it in with :07 left, making it 76-74.
- Chas Kelley III stole an errant FSU inbound pass and made a 25-foot 3-pointer, giving BC its first lead since the first half.
- The 15-point deficit erased against the Seminoles marked the fifth-largest comeback win in program history.
- **Nine of BC's last 32 wins dating back to last season have come when the Eagles have trailed by double-digits.**

SHARING IS CARING

- Twice this season Boston College dished out 20 or more assists: 20 at North Carolina (20) and 22 vs. Notre Dame.
- Joshua Beadle notched six assists against the Irish, while Fred Payne registered a season-best five helpers.
- Against UNC, Beadle led BC with six assists, while Chad Venning, Dion Brown, and Donald Hand Jr. each had three dimes.

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT AT CAROLINA

- Boston College had one of its best offensive outputs of the season at North Carolina on Jan. 25.
- BC's 96 points tied for the second-most in an ACC game in program history; the 89 points in regulation is tied for seventh-best.
- The 14 3-pointers made against the Tar Heels tied for sixth-most in a game for Boston College.
- The Eagles connected on 54.5% from the floor and 58.3% from the perimeter; one of 16 Division I teams to do that in 2024-25.
- BC was the first team to do so in ACC play in three seasons (Notre Dame vs. Pitt, March 5, 2022).
- Since 1996-97, only 12 teams in ACC play have connected on 54% from the field and 58% from the perimeter.
- Joshua Beadle went 6-for-6 from the floor (2-2 3FG), scoring 14 points to go with six assists - one of four DI players to be perfect from the floor with at least six attempts, while also dishing out six helpers.

COMEBACK KIDS VS. THE CANES

- Boston College registered its largest home comeback win in program history against Miami on Jan. 1.
- Trailing by 19 - 32-13 - with just under nine minutes to play in the first half, BC came back to win, 78-68.
- The comeback began from there, as the Eagles closed the half on a 16-9 push to make it a 41-29 deficit at the break.
- BC began the second half on an 8-2 push and Roger McFarlane's 3FG with 8:52 to go gave BC its first lead of the day - 56-55.
- The Eagles outscored the Canes, 22-13 from that point on - and 49-27 in the second half - to secure the win.
- The previous high for a home comeback was 18 points, set on Dec. 29, 2004 as the Eagles reversed course on Kent State.

QUINTEN POST SHINING FOR NBA'S WARRIORS

- Former Boston College great Quinten Post had a breakout game as a rookie on Jan. 23 with the Golden State Warriors.
- Post scored 20 points, making five 3-pointers, while adding five rebounds and three assists in 20 minutes of action.
- The last Eagle alum in the NBA to post at least that stat line: Reggie Jackson had 35 points, five boards, and 13 assists for the Denver Nuggets in a game against the Los Angeles Clippers on Nov. 27, 2024.
- The last BC player to tally at least 20 points in his NBA rookie campaign: Ky Bowman had 25 points to go with three rebounds and five assists with the Golden State Warriors on Nov. 25, 2019 against the Oklahoma City Thunder.
- Prior to that, the last Eagle NBA rookie with at least 20 points: Craig Smith scored 26 points for the Minnesota Timberwolves on Jan. 26, 2007 vs. the Seattle SuperSonics.
- Post earned his first career NBA start on Jan. 29, as the Warriors hosted the Oklahoma City Thunder.
- The 7-foot rookie had his two-way contract converted to a standard NBA deal on Feb. 7. He had been selected to the 28-player pool for the 2025 NBA G League Up Next Game, to be played during NBA All-Star Weekend in San Francisco.

DOUBLE IT UP

- Through the first five games of the year, a BC player logged a double-double: Donald Hand Jr. (22p/10r) vs. The Citadel, Roger McFarlane (11p/11r) vs. VCU, Elijah Strong (25p/13r) vs. Temple, Hand (15p/14r) vs. Loyola (Md); Hand vs. ODU (12p/10r).
- It marked the first time since the 2006-07 season where at least one player posted a double-double in five consecutive games.
- So far this season, Hand leads BC with four double-doubles, while Strong has two, and McFarlane one.

CAYMAN, SAW, CONQUERED: EAGLES GO 3-0 AND WIN CAYMAN ISLANDS CLASSIC

- Joshua Beadle's 3FG with 2.2 seconds left propelled Boston College past Boise State, winning the Cayman Islands Classic.
- The 63-61 win over Boise State clinched the first MTE victory since the 2018-19 season for BC, when it captured the inaugural Fort Myers Tipoff. It was the first eight-team MTE win since the Eagles won the 2003 Paradise Jam.
- Each of the three victories for the Eagles had decidedly different paths toward their eventual outcomes.
- In the opener vs. ODU, BC led for nearly 35:00 and posted both its highest point total (82) and largest margin of victory (30).
- Donald Hand Jr. posted his third double-double of the season (12p/10r) as 14 different Eagles saw action.
- The Eagles dished out a season-best 18 assists and committed a season-low eight turnovers in the balanced victory.
- Against Missouri State, the Eagles drilled 3-pointers to force overtime (Donald Hand Jr.) and win the game (Elijah Strong).
- Hand and Fred Payne led BC with 18 points apiece, while Strong added 13 points - with eight coming in the overtime period.
- Boston College logged its most blocked shots in a game in nearly two years, swatting away 10 Missouri State attempts.
- In the title game against Boise, the Eagles erased a nine-point deficit with less than nine minutes remaining.
- The game saw seven ties and five lead changes in the second half before Beadle's gamewinning trifecta sealed the win.
- Chad Venning led BC with 16 points; Beadle's 3-pointer elevated him to a new career-high in points, with 13.
- The stout Eagles' defense held the Broncos without a field goal for the final 9:00 and 24 points below their season average.
- Hand Jr. was named tournament MVP, averaging 12.0 points, 6.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists in the three games.
- Strong was also named to the all-tournament team, averaging 10.7 points and 4.3 rebounds in BC's three victories.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR DONALD ON OPENING NIGHT

- Donald Hand Jr. logged his first career double-double - 22 points and 10 rebounds - in the opener vs. The Citadel.
- Hand connected on 11-for-11 from the free throw line, becoming the first Eagle to make at least 11 FT without a miss since Quinten Post - now with the Golden State Warriors - knocked down 11-of-11 vs. Virginia on Feb. 25, 2024.
- It marked the 22nd time since 1996-97 where a BC player was perfect from the charity stripe with at least 10 attempts.
- Since 1996-97, 97 Boston College players have logged a double-double while scoring at least 20 points.
- It marks the first time a BC player logged his first career double-double while scoring at least 20 since Nov. 30, 2022.

WHOLE WIDE WORLD

- BC has had at least two international players on its roster in each of the last nine - and 11 of the last 12 seasons.
- Boston College has had at least one foreign-born player on its roster for the last 12 seasons, dating back to 2013-14.
- This season, newcomers Luka Toews and Kany Tchanda are the first two Eagles from Japan and Congo, respectively.

EARL GRANT

THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Earl Grant is in his fourth season as the Clement and Elizabeth IZZI Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Since his arrival at the Heights in 2021, Grant has established a culture of gritty and relentless play on the court, combined with selfless humility, a family atmosphere, and holistic development as people and players off the court.

This past season, Grant guided the Eagles to their deepest postseason run in 13 years as BC advanced to the second round of the National Invitation Tournament. Finishing with a 20-16 overall record, Grant's 2023-24 BC squad registered the highest overall

win total for the program since the 2010-11 season and the most true road victories in a season (7) in nearly two decades.

For the second time in three seasons under Grant, Boston College advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2024 ACC Championship, falling in overtime against Virginia. Grant tied Al Skinner for the most wins in ACC Tournament play by a BC coach, with five.

In 2023-24, BC was led by Quinten Post, who finished his three-year career as one of the top players in the ACC and in the nation. He earned 2023-24 ACC All-Conference Second Team honors, while also earning a spot on the conference's All-Defensive and All-Tournament teams. Post led Boston College in scoring, rebounding, and blocked shots, while ranking second in assists. The 7-footer was one of only two players in the ACC in 2023-24 to rank among the top 10 in the league in scoring, rebounding, blocked shots, and field goal percentage in the regular season. He became one of only five Boston College players over the last three decades to average at least 17 points and eight rebounds per game.

Additionally, Post was one of only three players in the last 30 years to record 50 3-pointers made, 100 assists, 50 blocked shots, and 30 steals in a single season. He was selected by the Golden State Warriors in the second round of the 2024 NBA Draft, becoming the 34th player in Boston College history to be drafted into the NBA.

During the 2022-23 campaign, Grant's gritty group tallied three wins over nationally ranked opponents, including a 63-48 drubbing of No. 6 Virginia - the first win over a top 10 team in nearly six seasons. Led by ACC Most Improved Player Quinten Post, Boston College won nine games in ACC play - the most since the 2010-11 campaign. Four of the Eagles nine ACC wins came on the road - the highest win total in away league games since 2008-09. As a result, BC and Grant extended their partnership through the 2028-29 season.

In his first season, Grant's Eagles advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2022 New York Life ACC Tournament in Brooklyn, narrowly missing a trip to the semis after a two-point overtime loss to Elite Eight participant Miami. Grant also orchestrated one of the highest-rated recruiting classes in program history, signing two four-star ranked players in the same class for the first time ever. The incoming class of newcomers ranked 30th nationally by Rivals.com and 33rd by 247sports.com.

On March 17, 2021 Grant was introduced as Boston College's 13th head men's basketball coach, bringing an impressive track record to Chestnut Hill after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CofC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players - Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley - were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CofC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member

of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CofC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley - the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson - 58.4 points per game - in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajukwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidy Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacci, have three sons: Trey, Eyziah and Elonzo.
