1 Bethune-Cookman continues a daunting start to Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference play with road games at Howard and Norfolk State. The preseason favorites, BCU starts play on the road against teams slotted 2-4

2 In last season's thriller, the Wildcats edged the Bison in OT, 92-87. BCU erased a 10-point second half deficit and tied the game with only one second remaining on a Soufi Diakite-to-Shawntrez Davis fastbreak alley-oop. It will be Ryan Ridder's first trip to Burr Gym. Last year's game was moved to nearby Trinity University

3 BCU is in the midst of five-straight and eight of nine away from Moore Gym. The Wildcats will total 17,926 miles this season that has included trips from California to Boston

4 Cletrell Pope continues to assert himself. Following his 20-rebound, 15-point barrage at NCCU, he paces the MEAC with his 174 total boards (8th NCAA), 7.40 defensive rebound average, 4.20 offensive rebounds (1st NCAA), 11.6 rebounding average (6th NCAA), and eight double-doubles

5 The 'Cats lead the MEAC in defensive rebounding average (27.8), rebounding average (40.93), and 3pt defense (30.2%). BCU is second in rebound margin (+2.9), offensive boards (13.1), & FG defense (42.1%)

Alumni Bag Season

A pair of recent Bethune-Cookman graduates signed professional contracts overseas this offseason. Reggie Baker ('17) joined Cab Madiera (Portugal) , and defending MEAC Player of the Year Brandon Tabb ('18) inked with Horsens IC in Denmark.

Tabb also competed in the inaugural Dos Equis 3-on-3 Tournament in San Antonio following the 2017-18 season where he and the MEAC alumni placed second.

Three Musketeers

BCU saw three players named to the Preseason All-MEAC team, and was picked first in the predicted order of finish for the first time in school history.

Forwards Shawntrez Davis and Soufiyane Diakite were named to the First Team, and senior guard/forward Isaiah Bailey to the Second Team.

Diakite was named BCU's second-ever Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year last spring after he pulled in a conference-best 313 rebounds (28th nationally) and averaged 9.8 per-game. He led the MEAC with a 6.59 defensive rebounding average and a 3.19 offensive board average. In the regular season finale at FAMU (3/1) led BCU to a share of its second ever MEAC regular season title with 27 points on 13-13 shooting and became the only player in the 2018 season to go 13-13 from the floor in the NCAA. Diakite finished third in the MEAC with 11 double-doubles, and shot 57.3% from the floor to set a new BCU single-season record.

Davis was named to the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Second Team and First Team NABC District 15 after finishing second in the MEAC with 1.22 blocks per-game. The Atlanta native was second on the team in offensive, defense, and total rebounding, as well as field goal percentage. His 8.7 rebounding average was third in the conference, and his 277 total boards placed him fourth in the MEAC. The forward was dependable as the only Wildcat to start all 32 games, and he averaged 27 minutes per-game. Davis led the team with a 37.7% success rate from three and was second in the MEAC with 13 double-doubles.

Bailey was named Third Team All-MEAC after leading team with 4.8 assists-per-game, which also ranked fifth in the MEAC. He posted BCU's first-ever triple-double against D1 competition, and third overall, when he went off for 19 points, 13 rebounds, and 10 assists vs. SSU (Feb. 24). Bailey broke the 20-point mark seven times in 2018, and reached double-figures in 22 consecutive outings until the season finale tournament loss to Morgan State. The senior also scored 10+ and in 28 of his 31 games played. His 172 made free throws was third in Wildcat single-season records, and his 219 free throw attempts finished tied for third with C.J. Reed (2011).

November To Remember

BCU just posted its second ever three-win November. Coupled with last season's 4-3 mark in the month, the Wildcats have now posted their best consecutive November in program history.

To cap the month, BCU defeated cross-county foe Stetson at home, 84-74, to mark the first time in series history that the Wildcats won Volusia County bragging rights in consecutive years.

Owning The Owls

In its 72-70 home victory against FAU on Dec. 1, BCU claimed its first victory over a Conference USA opponent, and the win carried the most quality of its four, as FAU entered with a NET ranking of 90

Good Thing For 9 Lives

As noted on page 2, BCU began the 2018-19 campaign with three Preseason All-MEAC picks. However, due to a variety of reasons, the Wildcats have only been able to play the trio in the same contest just three times.

Isaiah Bailey suffered a season-ending injury in game three, Shawntrez Davis served an indefinite team suspension starting 12/1 against FAU, and Soufi Diakite DNP against JU on 12/15 for the first time in his BCU career. The Wildcats have used six different starting lineups through their first 12 games.

Pope's Christmas

Cletrell Pope dialed up his game during the month of December. Over the first five games of the month, Pope averaged 31.8 minutes with 12.2 points and 13.2 rebounds. He shot a team-high 57.4% and also led BCU with 5 blocks in the stretch. Pope also chipped in 4 steals.

On the season, only four times has he not collected double-figure rebounds.

HEAD COACH RYAN RIDDER

Ryan Ridder wasted no time changing the culture of Bethune-Cookman men's basketball with immediate success on and off the court. His inaugural 2017-18 Wildcat team finished 18-14 overall, and 12-4 in MEAC play to claim a share of BCU's second-ever MEAC regular season title. The win totals were the second-most in school Division 1 history for overall and conference play. The Wildcats broke numerous school records and featured the MEAC Player of the Year, Brandon Tabb, and Defensive Player of the Year, Soufiyane Diakite, increased BCU's RPI rating by over 60 points, and while being hired on Mar. 21, 2017, maintained a 1000 APR to finish 2016-2017 academic year while signing 6 new student-athletes for 2017-18.

He was chosen as the recipient of the Joe B. Hall Award, which is bestowed to the top first year Division 1 Head Coach over finalists from Miami, Louisville, Oklahoma State, and Washington among others.

His team got off to a quick start with its winningest November in school history by totaling four victories. BCU defeated two ASUN Conference opponents for the first time ever with road victories over Jacksonville and Stetson, and BCU finished with the second-most road wins ever with eight. In January, BCU put together its second-longest win streak ever with six straight wins to open up the 2018 calendar year.

In addition to Tabb and Diakite, Ridder coached All-MEAC members Shawntrez Davis and Isaiah Bailey. His team took home six Defensive Player of the Week honors, most in the conference, and had two Player of the Week Honors. Ridder himself was also named a HoopDirt.com D1 Coach of the Week during the season.

His 2017-18 team finished with new school D1 records in scoring (2622 points and 81.9 per-game), free throws (575), attempts (820), rebounds (1346), rebounding average (42.1 and second nationally behind UNC), and assists (501). The Wildcats were second in both three-pointers made (241) and attempts (759), and finished fourth in single-season history with 123 blocks.

Under the eye of Ridder, Tabb finished first in single-season and BCU career history in free-throw percentage, and finished 22nd all-time in Wildcat scoring.

Ridder was named Men's Head Basketball Coach at Bethune-Cookman University on March 31, 2017.

No stranger to Daytona Beach area basketball as both a player and coach, Ridder comes to Bethune-Cookman after a four-year stint at Daytona State College. Ridder was successful in helping lead a resurgence of the Falcons program that produced 95 victories and four Mid-Florida Conference championships.

Additionally at Daytona State, Ridder coached 17 all-conference players, four all-region student-athletes, and one NJCAA Second Team All-America performer. Daytona State also finished the regular season ranked in the NJCAA National Poll in all four Ridder's seasons. Ridder was named Mid-Florida Conference Coach of the Year in each of his four seasons at the helm of the Falcons program.

Off the court, Ridder's student-athletes had a 100 percent graduation his first two years, and 96 percent overall across four years.

Daytona State was also the only team in its region to achieve a 3.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA) and one of 12 teams in the country to hold a 3.0 cumulative GPA during the 2014-2015 academic and athletic year. Sixteen of his players have gone on to play basketball at four-year schools, including Tanksley Efiyanayi (UCF), Rashuan Stimage (DePaul) and Wesley Alcegaire (Bowling Green).

The son of legendary Embry-Riddle Men's Basketball Head Coach Steve Ridder, Ryan first made his mark as one of Volusia County's premier high school players under Ed Miller at Father Lopez High School. While playing for the Green Wave at Father Lopez, Ridder earned all-area accolades three times while scoring over 1,100 points and dishing out 300 assists. He was named an all-state honorable mention performer in both his junior and senior years, respectively.



After starting his collegiate career at Wooster, he transferred back home to play for his father at Embry-Riddle from 2006-08, starting at point guard and serving as team captain in his junior and senior season. He led the Sun Conference with a 4.24 assists average as a senior. He earned a degree in Aerospace Studies in 2008.

Upon graduation, Ridder moved to North Carolina where he remained involved with basketball on the skill development side. He trained players from youth to those with NBA aspirations while working for the Hoop City U basketball training academy. In addition, he was the head coach for a number of teams engaged in international competition with 365 Sports, and he served as the assistant boys' basketball coach at North Raleigh Christian.

He returned to Embry-Riddle, spending the 2009-10 campaign as a volunteer assistant, helping his father coach the Eagles to a 30-6 record and a quarterfinals berth in the NAIA National Tournament.

No stranger to the Division I level of athletics, Ridder served three years as an assistant coach at Campbell University in Buies Creek, North Carolina. During Ridder's three years with the Fighting Camels, the program's recruiting classes were among the highest ranked in the Atlantic Sun Conference. He helped the Fighting Camels knock off power conference members Iowa and Auburn, as well as in-state rivals East Carolina, Appalachian State and UNCW.

Ridder earned his Master's Degree in Sports Management from California University of Pennsylvania in 2009.

He married Jen (Calnan) on May 6th, 2017, with Dominique Taylor and Jeff Clapacs in his wedding party.

Ryan and Jen welcomed in their first child, Brixton, in August.
