Career Record - 116-25

Belmont retired #25 in honor of Kelli Davis on January 15, 1996. Davis garnered NAIA First-Team All-America honors in 1994 after earning honorable mention accolades in 1993, and she achieved Scholar-Athlete All-America status those two seasons as well. Davis ranks third on Belmont's all-time scoring list with 2351 points, and she is the owner of four school records - most points in a season (794), most three-point field goals in a career (415), most three-point field goals in a season (126) and most three-point field goals in a game (8).



/// CHRISSIE HERRING (1990-94)

Career Record - 116-25

Belmont retired #40 in honor of Chrissie Herring on January 15, 1996. Herring was a first team NAIA All-American in 1993, a Second-Team All-American in 1994, Tennessee Collegiate Athletic Conference Player of the Year her final two seasons and District 24 Player of the Year as a junior. She was a four-time All-TCAC selection as well. Herring holds Belmont records for career points (2,450), career rebounds (1,233), rebounds in a season (334), best field goal percentage in a season (.671) and most field goals made in a season (298).



/// AIMEE SMITH (1988-92)

Career Record - 110-27

Belmont retired #42 in honor of Aimee Smith on November 11, 1992. Smith set seven school records during her career and was Belmont's first NAIA First-Team All-American in 1992. She ranks second on the school's career scoring list with 2,355 points while her .587 career field goal percentage, 174 free throws made in a season and 540 career free throws are Belmont records. Smith was an honorable mention All-American in 1991 and Tennessee Collegiate Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 1990.

HISTORY OF THE CURB EVENT CENTER

The Curb Event Center is the centerpiece of the Belmont Athletics' program. Opened in the fall of 2003 and funded by a \$10 million donation from the Curb Family Foundation and well-known music executive Mike Curb, it serves as the home of BU's volleyball and basketball programs.

The Curb Event Center arena has 5,000 permanent seats in an oval configuration, and a permanent maple hardwood floor. It has three full-size basketball courts and eight suites. In addition to the arena, the center also includes offices for the Athletics Department, locker rooms for the Belmont athletic teams along with visiting teams, athletic training facilities, and weight rooms and other facilities for the athletics program.

Beyond its athletic functions, the Curb Event Center is designed also to host major music and entertainment events - concerts, speakers, road shows, trade shows, and corporate events - and is wired to support live television broadcast from a dedicated TV control room, numerous permanent camera platforms and two state-of-the-art, high definition videoboards.

Since its opening, the Curb Event Center has already hosted several special events; however none more noteworthy than the 2008 Presidential Town Hall Debate and the 2020 Presidential Debate.

The Belmont women's basketball team has posted a winning home record in all but two of the 15 seasons since the Curb opened with an overall winning percentage greater than 70 percent.

HISTORY OF STRIPLIN GYMNASIUM

Striplin Gymnasium served Belmont athletics from 1962-2001. The 2,500 seat arena also housed locker room facilities for baseball and both soccer programs.

The Belmont women's basketball team found nearly unmatched success when playing in the 37-year-old facility. Coach Betty Wiseman established the home-court advantage as Belmont's first coach. The team had four undefeated seasons during her tenure, including a two-year 22 game winning streak at Striplin. During Coach Wiseman's 16-year-stint as head coach, Belmont hosted such teams as Western Kentucky, Vanderbilt, Tennessee, and North Carolina.

In the fall of 1984, Tony Cross returned to his alma mater to begin a coaching career that has found nearly unparalleled success at Belmont. In 17 seasons, BU never had a losing record inside the confines of Striplin winning at least 13 games ten times. During the 1990-91 season, the team reached uncharted territory, compiling a 20-0 record and using that season to catapult the team to a school record 28 home wins in a row between 1990-1992. One of the most telling statistics is the Bruins record at home since its first Division I schedule in 1997. Belmont has compiled a 45-7 record, including a streak of 27 in a row.

The Bruins closed out Striplin Gym in grand fashion, by defeating arch-rival Lipscomb by a 78-62 score in the final game at Striplin. The All-Striplin team was announced at the game in front of 1,103 fans on hand to see the final 'Battle of the Boulevard' in Striplin Gym.
