BEMIDJI STATE NOTES:

- The Bemidji State University men's hockey team drops the puck on the conference season this weekend by traveling to Michigan Technological University to face the (RV) Huskies for a Central Collegiate Hockey Association series.
- The Beavers and Huskies begin their two-game, CCHA series Friday, Oct. 21 at MacInnes Arena in Houghton, Mich., followed by the series finale Saturday. Puck drop for game one is scheduled for 6:07 p.m. CDT, and then 5:07 p.m., Saturday.
- Both games will be streamed live on FloHockey.tv with play-by-play and color commentary provided by Husky Athletics. A Beaver Radio Network broadcast can be found on 92.1 FM or online at www.beaverradionetwork.com. Live stats can also be found at: https://www.michigantechhuskies.com/sports/mice/2022-23/schedule
- Bemidji State is 20-19-6 all-time against the Huskies but its 6-10-5 when playing in Houghton.
- The Beavers and Huskies last met in the CCHA Playoffs semifinal round last year where BSU earned a 5-2 victory and advanced to the CCHA Championship. In their regular season series in Houghton a year ago, Michigan Tech swept the Beavers by scores of 5-2 in both games.
- Including regular season and postseason, Bemidji State went 2-3-0 against the Huskies last season.
- Fifth-year senior Ross Armour and senior Elias Rosén lead all returners with nine career points against the Huskies with Armour leading the Beavers with three goals and Rosén adding two.
- Senior Will Zmolek leads all active skaters with a career on-ice rating of +9 against MTU with Armour and Kyle Looft following with a +7 rating.
- Sophomore Mattias Sholl has seen the most action against Michigan Tech and is 2-2-0 with a .893 save percentage and 3.28 goals against average.
- His fellow netminder Gavin Enright has made one start against the Huskies and is 0-1-0 with a .886 save percentage and 4.06 goals against average.
- Both the Beavers and Huskies are receiving votes in the DCU/USCHO.com national poll but just the Huskies are receiving votes in teh USAToday/USAHockeyMagazine poll. Michigan Tech is receiving 10 more points than the Beavers in the poll.
- The Beavers have a lot of turnover from its 2021-22 roster that finished third during the Central Collegiate Hockey Association regular season and advance all the way to the CCHA Championship game.
- Bemidji State graduated five of its top-10 scorers from last season including all three of its top-three scorers.
- The Beavers graduated 82 of the team's 118 goals from a year ago for a percentage of 69.5 percent of the team's scoring.
- Head coach Tom Serratore and his staff has attempted to supplement that loss of scoring by adding three transfer students with at least two years of collegiate experience as well as seven freshmen to the team.
- One of those transfers is Mitchell Martan from Canisius College who has already made an impact to the team. After being shutout in their first game against Arizona State, Martan factored in on four of the Beavers five goals in game two including scoring the game-winning, overtime goal.
- Martan finished the game with four points off two goals and two assists and was voted the CCHA Forward of the Week the following Monday.
- Other notable performances on the season-opening weekend were sophomore Jere Vaisanen and junior Eric Martin who each recorded three points on Saturday.
- Martin tied a career-high with three assists in the game while Vaisanen totaled three points (1g-2a) for the first time in his
- Bemidji State's top returning scorer is senior Elias Rosén who is coming off a 26-point (7g-22a) season where he was a 2021-22 All-CCHA First Team selection, Scholar-Athlete and All-Academic Team selection.
- Rosén recorded an assist in game two but was inches away from scoring twice in the series after hitting the crossbar twice.
- Rosén will also serve as an alternate captain this season and was named to the 2022-23 Preseason All-CCHA team.

22nd on the Beavers' career scoring list for defensemen. He is fourth on the list for defensemen during BSU's Division I era and is one point shy of tying Justin Baudry for third.

- Fifth-year senior Ross Armour will co-captain the team with senior defenseman Kyle Looft while Rosén and senior Will Zmolek will serve as alternates.
- Bemidji State's top returning skaters include Rosén (26pts), Martin (19pts), Armour (16pts), Zmolek (15pts), Jere Vaisanen (8pts) and Looft (8pts).
- The Beavers return all three goaltenders from last season including sophomore Mattias Sholl who led the team with 26 games played and posted a 13-13-0 record with a .904 save percentage, 2.75 goals against average. Junior Gavin Enright follows after appearing in 14 games and posted a 5-6-0 record with a .889 save percentage and 3.37 GAA. Senior Michael Carr also made four appearances and was 1-1-0 with a .868 save percentage and 4.01 goals against average.
- Bemidji State's strength is its returning defense as it returns six of its eight defensemen from last season including four in its top six pairings.
- Last season, the Beavers finished fourth in the CCHA by holding opponents to 3.10 goals per game and third on the penalty kill with a .805 penalty-kill percentage.
- Tom Serratore is in his 22nd season at the helm of the Bemidji State Men's Hockey program and owns a 355-329-92 career record.
- Through the first two games of the season, Bemidji State is averaging 2.50 goals per game and allowing 3.50 goals per game for scoring margin of -1.00 which is fifth in the conference.
- Bemidji State leads the nation with a face-off win percentage of .620 but is third to last with 62 face-off wins after most teams have played four games already.
- Armour led the Beavers in the face-off circle and won 68.4 percent of draws (26-of-38) in the season-opening series.
- Bemidji State went 2-for-6 on the power play against Arizona State which leads the CCHA but is the least amount of chances in the league.
- The Beavers' penalty kill alowed two goals on four chances for a penalty kill percentage of .500.

HEAD COACH TOM SERRATORE

BEMIDJI STATE '87 / 22ND SEASON AT BEMIDJI STATE SEVEN-TIME COACH OF THE YEAR (2004, 2005, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2017*, 2020*)

Conventional sports wisdom has long contended it is never wise to follow a legend. However, sporting a laundry-list of achievements after 21 years as head coach at Bemidji State, it appears Tom Serratore is more than comfortable in the role.

The legacy Serratore was asked to continue upon accepting the role as Bemidji State's seventh head coach in 2001 is one of the finest in all of collegiate athletics. Serratore walks by the trophy case on his way to practice each day, in full view of the 13 small-college national championship trophies enshrined therein, trophies won by future hockey Hall of Fame member R.H. "Bob" Peters.

Serratore not only had the challenge of inheriting one of the dynasties in the history of collegiate athletics, he also was called to oversee its growth into a Division I program.

While Serratore will be the first to admit he'll not be able to replicate Peters' achievements, there can be little doubt the program is in the right hands. BSU finished 4-26-4 in 2000-01, the year before Serratore took control of the program. He led BSU to a 12-18-5 record during his rookie campaign, and increased BSU's win total each of the four years that followed. BSU finished 23-13-1 in 2004-05, giving



the Beavers a school-record for wins in a Division I season and back-to-back 20-win campaigns for the first time as a Division I program. In 2008-09 Serratore led the Beavers through the regular season to post their fourth CHA championship in six years before their third CHA Tournament championship, the program's first NCAA Division I Tournament victory and a chance represent the university and the CHA in the Frozen Four for the first time.

Under Serratore's guidance, 33 BSU skaters earned All-CHA honors, including two-time First-Team All-CHA picks Marty Goulet (2002-03), Bryce Methven (2003-04), Matt Climie (2006-07), Travis Winter (2006-07, Cody Bostock (2007-08), Brad Hunt (2009-2010) and Matt Read (2009-2010), while Andrew Murray (2005) and Read (2010) pulled down Player of the Year honors and with four Beavers earned CHA Rookie of the Year laurels. Since moving conference homes to the WCHA, 11 BSU players have been selected to the All-WCHA squads, including two-time members Matt Prapavessis (2014-2015) and Michael Bitzer (2017-2018). Bitzer also earned the WCHA's Rookie of the Year award in 2015 and Player of the Year honor to cap the 2017 season, while Elias Rosén captured Defensive Player of the Year laureels in 2020-21. In addition, Murray (2004-05), Read (2009-10) and Bitzer (2016-17) were recognized as All-Americans, while Brendan Harms won the Senior CLASS Award (2016-17) under Serratore. Three players have earned All-CCHA accolades under the tuteledge of Serratore including All-CCHA First Team selection in 2022-23, Elias Rosén. Owen Sillinger (Second Team) and Mattias Sholl (Rookie) were also named all-league players followed the 2022-23 season.

Academic excellence has been a staple of the BSU program under Serratore. The Beavers were perennial academic leaders in the CHA, and under Serratore's guidance continued that into the WCHA. In 10 seasons, the Beavers have had 159 student-athletes named to the league's All-Academic Team, while 110 have earned the WCHA's prestigious Scholar-Athlete Award, including 10 in 2020-21. BSU has also had 18 CoSIDA Academic All-District V selections under Serratore, including two-time First Team Academic All-America selections Peter Jonsson (2004-05) and Brendan Harms (2016-17).

Serratore's achievements have not gone unnoticed. He is a five-time CHA Coach of the Year, winning the honor in 2004, 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2010, while he pulled down the WCHA Coach of the Year award in 2017 and 2020 and has been named a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, given annually to the American Hockey Coaches Association's National Coach of the Year, seven times, including a runner-up finish in 2009.

Serratore took the reigns as the seventh head coach at Bemidji State in 2001 after having spent the previous three seasons (1998-01) as the associate head coach for Peters. He also spent six seasons as an assistant coach at St. Cloud State University (1993-98) under Craig Dahl.
