Under the guidance of fourth-year head coach **Terry Bowden**, the Zips stand 3-3 overall and 1-1 in MAC play after a 47-21 MAC win at Eastern Michigan on Oct. 10. Akron returns 47 lettermen, including 12 starters. The Zips utilize a spread offense and a 4-3 defense.

After six games, senior RB **Conor Hundley** (Hamilton, Ohio) is the team's leading rusher with 474 yards and six touchdowns on 85 carries. Under center, sophomore QB **Thomas Woodson** (Monroeville, Pa.) leads the Zips with 57-of-110 for 898 yards and seven touchdowns. Senior WR **Imani Davis** (Miami, Fla.) is the top receiver with 19 catches for 293 yards and two touchdowns. Senior LB **Jatavis Brown** (Belle Glade, Fla.) is the top defender with 52 tackles, 7.5 TFL, 5.0 sacks, and a forced fumble.

In this week's national rankings, Akron is ranked No. 13 in turnover margin (1.00), No. 15 in fumbles recovered (6), No. 17 in rushing defense (103.7), No. 20 in red zone defense (0.737), and No. 30 total defense (328.8).

Individually, sophomore WR **Jerome Lane** (Akron, Ohio) leads the nation in yards per reception (28.83) and ranks No. 25 in receiving TDs (4). Sophomore QB **Thomas Woodson** is No. 4 in passing yards per completion (15.75) and No. 30 in yards per attempts. Junior CB **DeAndre Scott** (Frederick, Md.) is No. 6 in total interceptions (4) and No. 10 in interceptions per game (0.7).

Under the guidance of second-year head coach **Dino Babers**, Bowling Green stands 4-2 overall and 2-0 in MAC play after a 62-38 win over Massachusetts on Oct. 10. The Falcons return 46 letterwinners, including 15 starters, to their Falcon Fast offense and 4-3 defense.

After six games, senior RB **Travis Greene** leads the rushers with 473 yards and four touchdowns on 81 carries. Under center, redshirt senior QB **Matt Johnson** is 190-of-275 for 2,534 yards and 19 touchdowns. Sophomore WR **Roger Lewis** is the top receiver with 48 catches for 902 yards and seven touchdowns. Defensively, sophomore LB **Austin Valdez** has 61 tackles, four break-ups, 3.0 TFL, and an interception.

In the NCAA stats, the Falcons are ranked No. 1 in first downs (184), No. 2 in passing offense (435.3), No. 4 in total offense (604.7), No. 8 in passing efficiency (166.24), and No. 10 in scoring offense (40.7). Individually, redshirt senior QB **Matt Johnson** is No. 1 in passing yards (2,534), No. 1 in passing yards per game (422.3), No. 1 in total offense (443.0), No. 2 in completions (31.67), No. 4 in passing TDs (19), and No. 9 in completion percentage (.691). Sophomore WR **Roger Lewis** is No. 1 in receiving

### AKRON-BOWLING GREEN CONNECTIONS

BGSU defensive coordinator **Kim McCloud** served as Akron's defensive backs coach during the 2011 season.

Bowling Green has four players from the Akron area- redshirt sophomore LB **Nate Locke** (Canton, Ohio/Massillon HS), senior TE **Vito Sosic** (Cleveland, Ohio/St. Ignatius/Akron), redshirt freshman DB **Jack Walz II** (Cleveland, Ohio/St. Edward), and redshirt freshman OL **De'Angelo Ware** (Cleveland Heights, Ohio/Cleveland Heights).

### AKRON-BGSU: THE SERIES

Saturday's game is the 22nd meeting between Akron and Bowling Green in series history, which began in 1941. The Falcons lead, 14-7. In MAC games only (since 1992), BGSU leads, 13-5. Bowling Green has won the last six outings against the Zips.

In the teams' last meeting on Tuesday Nov. 4, 2014, Akron's offense out-gained Bowling Green, racking up 398 yards of total offense, but it was not enough to offset five turnovers as the Zips dropped a 27-10 decision to the Falcons at InfoCision Stadium - Summa Field.

Jatavis Brown was a standout defensively for Akron, leading all defensive players with a career-high 16 tackles, including nine solo efforts and two forced fumbles. Justin March added nine tackles and Se'Von Pittman posted seven. QB Kyle Pohl set career highs for completions (31) and attempts (62), throwing for 304 yards to lead the Zips' offensive charge. Jawon Chisholm rushed for 65 yards in the game, and scored Akron's only touchdown to move into second place on the program's all-time rushing list.

On Sept. 28, 2013, Akron jumped out to a 14-3 lead in the first quarter, but was shut out from that point and gave up a 31-14 decision to Bowling Green in MAC play at Doyt Perry Stadium.

Akron QB Kyle Pohl was responsible for both of the Zips' touchdowns. The first came off a 51-yard pass to L.T. Smith III with 12:38 to go in the opening stanza and the second was a three-yard rush of his own with 5:39 left in the first period to give UA a 14-3 edge.

Pohl ended the day 22-of-37 passing for 199 yards, and rushed six times for 26 yards. Smith was the Zips' leading receiver, catching five balls for 89 yards. Jerrod Dillard had five catches for 50 yards for UA.

Bowling Green scored its first points on a 29-yard field goal by Tyler Tate 9:31 into the game, and closed the margin to 14-10 when Matt Johnson hit Shaun Joplin with a 22-yard TD pass with 1:41 to go before halftime.

The Falcons took a 17-14 lead when William Houston found the endzone from two yards out with 6:47 to go in the third quarter. Travis Green caught a 30-yard pass from Matt Johnson for a score with 1:41 to go in the third and Green's 11-yard TD run with 4:49 left in the game provided the final margin.

Johnson completed 18-of-29 passes for 229 yards and was sacked six times, all coming during the first half. Green rushed 24 times for 142 yards and Joplin had five catches for 78 yards for the Falcons.

## AKRON RANKED NO. 2 IN MOST IMPROVED TEAMS

Phil Steele has ranked the Akron Zips at No. 2 in his Top 10 list of the nation's most improved teams entering the 2015 season. Miami (Fla.) is No. 1, followed by UA, Michigan, Pittsburgh, Indiana, Temple, Texas, Northwestern, Ball State, and Colorado.

## ZIPS QUICK HITS

- Five of Akron's 2015 opponents—Oklahoma (Russell Athletic), Pittsburgh (Armed Forces), Louisiana (R+L Carriers), Bowling Green (Camellia), and Central Michigan (Bahamas)—participated in bowls in 2014.
- Five of Akron's 2014 opponents—Penn State (Pinstripe), Marshall (Boca Raton), Pittsburgh (Armed Forces), Bowling Green (Camellia), and Ohio (not selected)—were bowl eligible following the 2014 season.
- In 2015, Akron opens its seventh season playing on-campus in InfoCision Stadium – Summa Field. The Zips have a 14-25 record at the venue (4-2 in 2014). The stadium opened in 2009.
- Since 1979, Akron has faced 25 nationally ranked teams, going 1-24. The Zips' sole victory was a 34-20 win over No. 25 Marshall at the Rubber Bowl on Nov. 2, 2002.
- The 2015 season marks the 10th Anniversary of the Zips' 2005 Mid-American Conference championship. Under coach **J.D. Brookhart**, UA defeated Northern Illinois, 31-30, in the MAC title game before participating in the Motor City Bowl, its first bowl appearance as an NCAA Division I-A member (FBS).

The Akron Zips racked up 500 yards of total offense behind sophomore QB **Thomas Woodson** en route to a 47-21 win over Eastern Michigan at Rynearson Stadium on a beautiful sunny afternoon.

With its second consecutive road win, Akron fired on all cylinders with huge performances in the running and passing games.

In his third start of the season, Woodson went 14-of-22 for 222 yards and a career-high four touchdowns. He also rushed for 72 yards.

Sophomore WR **Jerome Lane** finished with a career-best two touchdowns and 104 yards (all in the first half), marking the first 100-yard performance of his collegiate career.

Senior RB **Conor Hundley** led all rushers with 119 yards and a career-high two touchdowns on 17 carries.

Defensively, senior LB **Dylan Evans** (Nazareth, Pa.) racked up a team-high 10 tackles, including five solo stops.

## POSTGAME NOTES

- Sophomore WR **Jerome Lane** had a TD reception on each of his first two catches on the day. The two TD receptions were the most in a game in his young career. He finished with four catches for 104 yards, all in the first half. It marked the first 100-yard performance of his collegiate career.
- Senior PK **Robert Stein** (Cincinnati, Ohio) was a perfect 6-for-6 in extra points on the day, extending his consecutive made streak to 46. He also converted a 39-yard field goal in the second quarter.

Junior QB **Matthew Hoyer's** older brother **Brian** is currently the starting QB with the Houston Texans.

## OFFENSE

#### QUARTERBACK POSSIBILITIES

All three quarterbacks have seen action so far; each brings a different strength to the Zips' offense.

Sophomore **Thomas Woodson**, who saw action in eight games with two starts as a redshirt freshman last fall, rushed three times for 30 yards at No. 19 Oklahoma. He played on a short-yardage play against Pitt but recorded no stats. In the win over Savannah State, Woodson came off the bench and guided the Zips to the endzone. He finished the game 12-of-20 for 207 yards and a touchdown. He also rushed 11 times for 63 yards and a touchdown.

In the win at Louisiana, Woodson moved into the starting role. He finished the game at 13-of-29 for 238 yards and a career-best two touchdowns. His 72-yard TD pass to Jerome Lane was a career-long. He was also the Zips' leading rusher, finishing with a career-high 93 yards and 14-yard touchdown on eight carries. For his efforts, Woodson was selected as the Zips' Student-Athlete of the Week, presented by The University of Akron, Ohio's Polytechnic University, and the College Sports Madness MAC Offensive Player of the Week. In the MAC opener against Ohio, Woodson went 18-of-38 231 yards. In the MAC win at Eastern Michigan, had a career-high four touchdown passes, all in the first half. He finished 14-of-22 for 222 yards en route to Zips' Student-Athlete of the Week honors again.

After six games, Woodson is the Zips' top quarterback, going 57-of-110 for 898 yards and seven touchdowns. He stands second in rushing with 269 yards and two touchdowns on 45 carries.

Senior QB **Kyle Pohl**, who handled duties under center for the last two seasons, is No. 4 on the career passing chart with 5,023 yards. At No. 19 Oklahoma, he came off the bench and led the Zips under center, going 6-of-17 for 88 yards. Against Pitt, Pohl went 3-of-8 for 34 yards. He missed the Savannah State game with an injury. Pohl returned to action in the win at Louisiana, playing in the fourth quarter.

In four games, Pohl is 9-of-25 for 122 yards.

Sophomore newcomer **Tra'Von Chapman**, who waited a year for his shot, received the starting nod in the first three contests. A transfer from Pitt, he challenged returner Pohl through spring and training camp drills. The first-team All-Ohio standout set the single-season records for passing yards (2,901), touchdown passes (33), and total offense (3,650) as a senior at Kent Roosevelt HS.

#### BACKFIELD STACKED

The graduation of two-time team offensive MVP Jawon Chisholm didn't deplete the Zips' backfield. Running back **Conor Hundley** came into the campaign ready for a breakout senior season. As a junior, he finished second in rushing with 540 yards and four touchdowns on 104 carries.

A starter at No. 19 Oklahoma, Hundley had eight carries for 36 yards. Against Pittsburgh, Hundley scored the Zips' first touchdown of the year with a 32-yard run. In the win over Savannah State, Hundley led all rushers with 127 yards and a touchdown on 12 carries. The game marked the second 100-yard rushing performance of his career. In the win at Louisiana, Hundley rushed a career-high 20 times for 77 yards and two touchdowns. He also had a 33-yard reception. Against Ohio in the MAC opener, Hundley let all rushers with 66 yard on 18 carries. In the win at Eastern Michigan, rushed for 119 yards and two touchdowns on 17 carries. It was the third 100-yard rushing performance of his career.

After six games, Hundley leads the Zips with 474 yards and six touchdowns on 85 carries. He is second on the team in scoring with 36 points.

New to the Zips is senior **Donnell Alexander** (Kansas City, Mo.), who transferred from Colorado State. In his last action in 2013, the speedster rusher for 428 yards and two touchdowns on 71 carries. In his first action as a Zip, Alexander had seven carries for 16 yards at No. 19 Oklahoma. In the win over Savannah State, Alexander rushed for 78 yards on 11 carries. In the win at Louisiana, he rushed 12 times for 65 yards. In the win at Eastern Michigan, Alexander rushed 21 times for 78 yards.

In five games, Alexander is third in rushing with 243 yards on 53 carries.

Used last season in short-yardage situations, Grice has reprised his role as short-yardage fullback. In the win over Savannah State, he rushed for five times for seven yards and career-high three touchdowns, all in the first half. Grice ranks No. 11 nationally this week in scoring (18.0) and No. 13 in points per game (6.0). He was named the Zips' Student-Athlete of the Week on Sept. 21.

Brown had five tackles, including 2.0 TFL, and a hurry. In the MAC opener against Ohio, he had seven tackles. In the win at Eastern Michigan, Brown had nine tackles, including five solo stops and a TFL.

After six games, Brown is Zips' leading tackler with 52 tackles, including a team-best 7.5 TFL and a team-best 5.0 sacks, and a forced fumble.

Joining Brown are seniors **Dylan Evans** (Nazareth, Pa.), who played in all 12 games last fall with two starts, and **Darryl Monroe** (Orlando, Fla.), who transferred from Washington State.

At No. 19 Oklahoma, Evans led the Zips with a career-high 13 tackles, including eight solo stops, and a break-up. Against Pitt, he had 11 tackles and a six-yard sack. In the win over Savannah State, Evans was the team leader with nine tackles and a game-high four break-ups. In the win at Louisiana, he had five solo stops, including 2.0 TFL, and a 17-yard interception return. In the win over Eastern Michigan, Evans led the defense with 10 tackles, including five solo stops.

After six games, Evans is second in tackling with 51 tackles, including a team-best 30 solo stops, a team-high five break-ups, 1.5 sacks, and an interception.

Against Pittsburgh, Monroe racked up 10 tackles, including five solos. In the win over Savannah State, he had three tackles. In the win at Louisiana, Monroe had five solo stops. In the MAC opener against Ohio, he led the Zips with eight tackles, including six solo stops. In the win at Eastern Michigan, Monroe had seven tackles, including a TFL.

After six games, Monroe is third in tackling with 39 tackles, 1.5 TFL, and a hurry.

#### THE FANTASTIC FOUR

The Zips' front four are a force of strength, highlighted by senior NT **Cody Grice**, a Lombardi Award candidate. A starter in every game of his collegiate career (42 and counting), he had 31 tackles, 4.0 TFL, 2.5 sacks, and three fumble recoveries last fall.

And yes, his haircut- the half man, half amazing- is back! At No. 19 Oklahoma, Grice had three tackles. Against Pittsburgh, he had two solo stops and rushed once for one yard in the third quarter. In the win over Savannah State, Grice had two tackles, including a TFL, in addition to his three rushing touchdowns. In the win at Louisiana, he had a 12-yard fumble recovery. In the win at Eastern Michigan, Grice had four tackles.

Joining him on the line are three preseason All-MAC honors- junior ends **Se'Von Pittman** (Canton, Ohio) and **Jamal Marcus** (Durham, N.C.), and senior tackle **Rodney Coe** (Fulton, Mo).

Pittman started all 12 games last fall, finishing with 36 tackles, 6.5 TFL, a sack, and a hurry. Transfers Marcus (Ohio State) and Coe (Iowa State) sat out last year per NCAA transfer rules.

At No. 19 Oklahoma, Pittman had two solo tackles. Against Pitt, he had four tackles, including two TFL for a loss of 11 yards. In the win over Savannah State, Pittman had two tackles and a hurry. In the win at Louisiana, Pittman had a TFL and a forced fumble. Against Ohio, he had four tackles. In the win at Eastern Michigan, Pittman had four tackles.

Marcus had four tackles, including a TFL for a loss of four yards, at No. 19 Oklahoma. He missed the Savannah State game with an injury. In the MAC opener, Marcus had a career-high six tackles, including a career-high five solo stops and 4.0 TFL. He also had a career-high two sacks for a loss of 14 yards.

Coe had two tackles at No. 19 Oklahoma. He missed the Savannah State game with an injury. In the win at Louisiana, Coe had six solo stops. Against Ohio, he had three tackles and two break-ups. In the win at Eastern Michigan, Coe had six tackles, 1.5 TFL, and a hurry.

#### SECONDARY SECOND TO NONE

The Zips' secondary is stacked with returning starters. At corner, seniors **Kris Givens** (Ridgeland, Miss.) and **John Senter** (Huber Heights, Ohio), and junior **DeAndre Scott** (Frederick, Md.) will have heated competition from the underclassmen.

At No. 19 Oklahoma, Givens was the top defensive back, finishing second with seven tackles, including six solo stops. He had three solo stops against Pitt. In the win over Savannah State, Givens had three tackles and a break-up. In the MAC opener against Ohio, he led the Zips with eight tackles, including six solo stops.

After six games, Givens has 25 tackles and two break-ups.

Senior CB **Bryce Cheek** (Lewis Center, Ohio) had six tackles at No. 19 Oklahoma. Against Pittsburgh, he had seven tackles. In the win over Savannah State, Cheek had four tackles. In the win at Louisiana, he had four tackles. Against Ohio, Cheek had four tackles and a break-up. In the win over Eastern Michigan, he had six tackles and a forced fumble.

After six games, Cheek is the top defensive back, standing fourth in team tackling, with 31 tackles, a TFL, a forced fumble, and a break-up.

In the win over Savannah State, Scott had three solo tackles, two break-ups, and a 13-yard interception return. In the win at Louisiana, he had three solo stops, an interception, and a break-up. Against Ohio, he had two tackles and an interception. Scott leads the Zips with four interceptions.

Sophomore S **Zach Guiser** (Fayette City, Pa.) had four tackles in his first start as a Zip at No. 19 Oklahoma. Against Pittsburgh, he had five tackles. In the win at Louisiana, Guiser led the Zips with eight tackles and a break-up. Against Ohio, he had three solo tackles. In the win at Eastern Michigan, Guiser had four tackles and his first career interception.

## SPECIAL TEAMS

### SENIOR LEADERSHIP

One area that will remain consistent is special teams.

Senior placekicker **Robert Stein** resumes his kicking and PAT duties. In 12 games last fall, he was a perfect 24-of-24 in PATs and 13-of-16 in field goals. The Zips' leading scorer with 66 points, Stein also kicked off 56 times for 3,213 yards (57.04 avg.) with 10 touchbacks and four out-of-bounds.

At No. 19 Oklahoma, Stein scored the Zips' only points with a 26-yard field goal. He also kicked off twice for 107 yards. Against Pittsburgh, Stein connected on a PAT and kicked off twice for 77 yards. In the win over Savannah State, he had a 21-yard field goal while kicking a perfect 7-for-7 in extra points, extending his consecutive streak to 35. He also kicked off a career-high nine times for a career-high 542 yards (60.2 average). In the win at Louisiana, Stein made five extra points. He kicked off six times for 371 yards (61.8 average). In the MAC opener against Ohio, Stein scored all 12 of Akron's points with a career-high four field goals, including a 41-yarder, en route to MAC Special Teams Player of the Week honors. In the win at Eastern Michigan, Stein was a perfect 6-for-6 in extra points on the day, extending his consecutive made streak to 46. He also converted a 39-yard field goal in the second quarter.

After six games, Stein is the Zips' scoring leader with 40 points (six field goals and 19-for-19 PAT).

Punter **Zach Paul** (Broadview Heights, Ohio) returns for his senior season. Last fall in 12 games, he punted 66 times for 2,806 yards (42.5 avg.). His long was 65 yards; 21 of his punts were longer than 50 yards; 24 were inside the 20; 16 were called as fair catches, and 14 were touchbacks.

Paul punted 12 times at No. 19 Oklahoma for 557 yards (46.4 avg.) with four landing inside the 20, all career bests. His long was 73 yards. Against Pittsburgh, he punted nine times for 355 yards (39.4 avg.), including a long of 62 yards. In the win over Savannah State, Paul punted just three times for 102 yards. In the win at Louisiana, he punted three times for 97 yards. Against Ohio, Paul punted five times for 164 yards (32.8 avg.). In the win at Eastern Michigan, he punted four times for 165 yards (41.2 avg.) with three landing inside the 20.

After six games, Paul has punted 36 times for 1,440 yards (40.0 average), including five longer than 50 yards.

### LONG SNAPPER'S BIG MOVE

In Akron's 35-14 win at Louisiana, sophomore LS **Michael Buddenberg** recorded his first stat as he recovered a Louisiana fumble following a punt in the second quarter. The recovery gave the Zips the ball back to close out the first half and take away the Cajuns' opportunity to tie the game before halftime. He was tabbed the Mid-American Conference Special Teams Player of the Week for the East Division on Sept. 28.

### RETURN THIS

The Zips have two new players working on returns this fall. On punt returns, sophomore WR **A.J. Coney** is utilizing his size and speed. He has nine returns for 50 yards (5.6 average).

On kickoff returns, freshman RB **Van Edwards** has 11 returns for 240 yards (21.8 average), including a 31-yard return in the win at Eastern Michigan.

Terry Bowden, who is in his 22nd year of collegiate coaching, is in his fourth season at the helm of the UA program. He was named the Zips' 27th all-time head coach on Dec. 22, 2011, but is just the seventh person to hold the position since 1960.

Bowden has been responsible for miraculous turnarounds almost everywhere he has coached and is on the verge of doing it once again at The University of Akron.

Last season, Bowden led UA to its second-straight 5-7 record overall and a 3-5 mark against the MAC. He led the Zips to their first win over a BCS/Power 5 opponent since 2008, downing Pittsburgh, 21-10, at Heinz Field on Sept. 27. The win was the first for Akron over an ACC program since UA's 20-17 win at NC State on Sept. 9, 2006. The 5-7 record marked the first time since the 2005 and 2006 seasons that the Zips had posted back-to-back campaigns with five or more victories (7-6 in 2005, 5-7 in 2006).

Four Zips earned All-Mid-American Conference honors in 2014, with junior linebacker Jatavis Brown and junior nose tackle Cody Grice named first-team All-MAC. Senior defensive lineman Nordly Capi and junior punter Zach Paul earned second-team honors. In addition to the All-MAC honors, nine Zips were named Academic All-MAC, led by three-time honoree Robert Stein. The nine honorees marked the third straight season with nine or more Academic All-MAC selections.

In 2013, Bowden led UA to its highest win total since 2008 by going 5-7 overall and 4-4 against the MAC, as well as ending the year by winning three straight and four of its last five games. The Zips went 3-3 at home, including a 16-7 victory over neighborhood rival

Kent State to regain possession of the coveted wooden Wagon Wheel.

Additionally in 2013, seven players were named All-MAC, highlighted by first-team selection then-sophomore linebacker Jatavis Brown – the first Zip named to the first team since Bryan Wagner in 2011.

In 2012, Bowden, serving as offensive coordinator, ushered in a spread offense that resulted in an aerial attack responsible for a school-record and MAC season-high 30 passing touchdowns. The offense, which was conducted in a hurry-up no-huddle style, was led by fifth-year senior transfer quarterback Dalton Williams, who set the program's single-season record for touchdown passes (25) and pass completions (326-for-522), while compiling the third most passing yards (3,387) in a season in school history.

Williams' arm was complimented by sophomore running back Jawon Chisholm's 953 yards rushing on the strength of 180 carries and senior receiver Marquelo Suel's team-high 820 receiving yards off 76 catches. Suel's receptions were the second most in a single season in program history and earned him a place on the All-MAC Team.

The UA offense finished 2012 ranked first in the MAC and 16th nationally in passing (312.8 ypg), and sixth in the league and 45th in the country in total offense (427.2 ypg). Akron's 5,126 yards of total offense ranked sixth in the MAC and 61st nationally, and was the second most in a season in program history, behind the 2003 squad's 5,643.

Bowden, who served as a studio analyst and color commentator with ABC Sports' college football for 10 years, was the head coach at Auburn from 1993-98 and spent the three seasons prior to coming to Akron at Division II North Alabama.

Prior to his stint at Auburn, Bowden built two programs from the ground up as head coach at Salem College (W.Va.) and Samford University (Ala.). When he took the job at Salem in 1983 he became the nation's youngest head coach in college football at age 26.

Bowden, 59 (born Feb. 25, 1956), was an assistant coach at Akron in 1986 under then Zips' head coach Gerry Faust.

Bowden is a member of one of the most famous and successful college football coaching families. His father, Bobby Bowden, turned Florida State into a national champion and his 389 collegiate wins rank second in Division I history.

As a student-athlete at West Virginia, Bowden lettered two years as a running back (1977-78), held a 3.65 grade-point average in accounting, the highest GPA on the football team, and graduated Magna Cum Laude.

He did post graduate work at Oxford University in England, and earned a Juris Doctorate from the Florida State School of Law in 1982, while a graduate assistant coach with the Seminoles.

Bowden has five daughters (Tera, Jordan, Erin, Cori and Jamie) and one son (Terry, Jr.). He is one of 59 coaches at FBS schools that vote in the *USA Today* Top 25 poll.

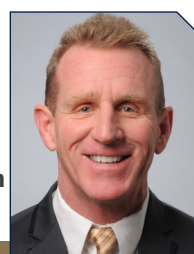
