SETTING THE SCENE

- Bowling Green hosts Northern Illinois Saturday at 2:00 pm in Doyt L. Perry Stadium. The contest will be broadcast on ESPN3 and is the program's annual Pink Game for breast cancer awareness.
- BGSU and Northern Illinois last played in Bowling Green in 2011, a 45-14 Huskies victory. Prior to that, the two teams had not played in The Doyt since BGSU beat NIU 34-18 in 2003 in the first ever MAC game to host ESPN College Gameday.
- A year ago, Northern Illinois won 45-20 and that came on the heels of the two programs meeting three consecutive times in the MAC Championship game in Detroit. BGSU won MAC titles in 2013 and 2015, while NIU won the 2014 contest.
- Interestingly, these two teams have played seven times since 2003, but just once in Doyt L. Perry Stadium. Three of the contests were played in Ford Field and three others were played at NIU.

LOOKING BACK

- Northern Illinois pulled away in the second half for a 45-20 win over Bowling Green a year ago.
- Ronnie Moore's 37-yard touchdown reception with 12:30 left in the first half brough Bowling Green to within four at 17-13, but NIU built a 24-13 lead by the half and then tacked on three third-quarter TDs.
- James Morgan was 21-of-41 for 224 yards and three touchdowns. He had one interception.
- Current Falcon wide receivers Teo Redding and Scott Miller each had a touchdown in the contest.

TURNING THEM OVER

- Bowling Green's +2 turnover margin in 2017 is a welcome change from 2016, when the Falcons were -16. The Falcons have thrived in fumble recoveries, leading the country with 11.
- Three teams (Utah State, Purdue and Memphis) are tied for second in the country in

- fumble recoveries with nine, while eight other schools have eight.
- BGSU has forced 16 total turnovers (adding five interceptions), ninth-most in the nation.
- BGSU is returning to form in the takeaway battle, as the Falcons, over 2013-15, were one of only two programs in the country that ended each of those seasons +10 or better in turnover margin. California is pacing the nation's leaders with 20.

MR. DO IT ALL

- Brandon Harris is among the team leaders in numerous defensive statistical categories through the first seven weeks of the season.
- Harris registered six tackles versus Ohio, bumping his total up to a team-high 52.
- Harris, who also has 3.0 tackles for loss on the year, has four pass breakups as well.
- Harris is in a four-way tie for the national lead with three fumble recoveries this year. His 123 yards returning fumbles are more than the other three combined.
- He has also scored two career defensive touchdowns, including last week's 93-yard fumble recovery. He had an interception return for a touchdown in the 2016 season opener at Ohio State.
- Harris was named the MAC East Defensive Player of the Week Monday for his efforts in helping the Falcons defeat Miami on the road.

SPREADING IT AROUND

- In the week three game at Northwestern, a total of 12 different players caught a pass for the Falcons. It is believed to be a school record.
- To put that number into perspective, only 13 different players caught a pass during the entire 2016 season.
- Senior Pete Norris and redshirt-freshman Jared Wyatt caught their first-career passes in the ballgame.
- Norris caught one pass for three yards, while Wyatt was tied for the team lead in the game with four catches (45 yards).
- Sixteen different players have caught a pass during the 2017 season, surpassing the total from 2015 (15). You'd have to go all the way back to 2007 to find a season in which more than 15 players caught a pass. In that season, 17 did so.

REDDING'S RIDICULOUS RECEPTIONS

 Teo Redding had eight catches for 197 yards two weeks ago at Miami, adding two touchdowns, including a 75-yard bomb on the first play of the second half.

- Prior to the contest, Redding's career highs were six catches and 72 yards in a single game.
- Along with the 75-yard touchdown to open the second half, he had a 43-yard reception on BGSU's first offensive play of the game.
- There have been just nine 200-yard receiving games in program history and Redding came up just three yards shy of becoming the 10th.
- Current NFL wide receiver Roger Lewis had three 200-yard games in 2015, most recently a 201-yard performance at Buffalo that season.

PROVIDING CLAIR-ITY

- True freshman running back Andrew Clair continues to spark the Falcons in 2017.
- Clair leads the Falcons with 668 all-purpose yards, as he has 286 kick return yards, 346 rushing yards and 36 receiving yards.
- His per game average of 111.3 all-purpose yards is fourth in the country among true freshmen.
- Clair has rushed for 100+ yards in back-to-back games, going for 121 at Miami and then posting 148 against Ohio.
- His 148 rushing yards against Ohio are the most for a true freshman at BGSU since Willie Geter ran for 203 against Kent State on Oct. 20, 2007
- Anthon Samuel was the last true freshman to run for back-to-back 100-yard games, doing so Oct. 15 and 22, 2011 against Toledo (105 yards)

and Temple (112 yards), respectively.

- In the conference opener versus Akron, Clair had 130 return yards on five kick returns, including a 50-yard kick return, which was Bowling Green's second-longest player on the season.
- · On 48 rushing attempts, Clair is also averaging 7.2 yards per carry. That would rank 11th in the nation if he had enough carries (10.0/game) to qualify.

JUNIOR JUMPING ONTO THE SCENE

- Redshirt sophomore Kyle Junior is guickly becoming one of the more dominant defensive linemen in the conference.
- · Junior leads Bowling Green's defense in sacks (2.5), tackles for loss (5.5) and is tied for the lead in quarterback hurries (3).
- Junior, who also has registered a forced fumble on the season, ranks seventh on the team with 27 tackles.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOEGE

- When Jarret Doege took the first snap at Middle Tennessee, he became the first true freshman to start a game at quarterback since Brian McClure in 1982.
- Doege's passing yardage in his first start dwarfed McClure's, although McClure did lead the Falcons to a 7-3 win over Western Michigan in game three of the 1982 season.
- · Doege was 21-of-35 for 283 yards and a touchdown against MTSU. McClure threw for 160 yards and a touchdown against WMU.

COVERING THOSE KICKS

- BGSU's kickoff and punt coverage units were among the nation's best in 2016, showing immense growth in year one under Special Teams Coordinator Matt Brock. They are once again excelling in 2017.
- Bowling Green ranked first in the nation in kick coverage in 2016, allowing opponents just 15.1 yards per return. BGSU has allowed just 15.1 yards per return again in 2017, sixth in the nation and first in the MAC through seven weeks.
- The Falcons were also among the top 30 in the country in punt return defense, allowing just 5.2 yards per return, 28th overall. Through seven weeks, BGSU's opponents have averaged only

2.2 yards per return in 2017. That number ranks 17th in the country, and third in the MAC.

 BGSU has not allowed a kick or punt return touchdown in 19 games under Brock.

DAVIDSON AN ALL-AMERICAN

- · Punter Joseph Davidson is back for his senior season as one of the best in the nation. A semifinalist for the Ray Guy Award, given to the top punter in the country, a year ago, Davidson was named fourth team All-American by Phil Steele.
- · Davidson became the school's all-time leader in career punting yards against Michigan State. He now has 10,691 career punting yards, passing Jim Phelps (8,955 yards). With Davidson's nine punts at Northwestern, he broke the school record (previously held by Phelps) for career punts, as he currently has punted the ball 240 times.
- Through seven weeks of the 2017 season. Davidson ranks third in the MAC in punting average (44.7), and first in net punting average (43.2). He ranks 20th in the country in punting average, and eighth in net punting. He's on track to rank fourth all-time in NCAA history in career punting average.
- · On the year, Davidson has dropped 21 of his 43 punts inside the 20, and also has had nine 50+ yarders. While also having just two touchbacks, Davidson has three punts of 60+ yards, including a season-long 65-yard punt at

SPECIAL TEAMS, BIG PLAYS

- While BGSU's kickoff coverage unit has been one of the best in the country this season, the Falcons' return teams took a huge step forward against Akron.
- Freshman Andrew Clair, who had 130 yards on five kick returns, returned a kick for 50 yards in the contest, which was the Falcons' second longest play of the season at the time.
- Marcus Milton's 24-yard punt return in the ballgame was Bowling Green's longest punt return of the season at the time.
- Milton added a 26-yard punt return Saturday against Ohio. It set up the Falcons for a touchdown to take a brief 23-21 lead.

SUDER'S STRONG SEASON

- Before finally missing a field goal attempt late in a rainy game at Miami Saturday, kicker Jake Suder had made 12 field goal attempts in a row, dating back to the 2016 season.
- Suder made his first nine attempts of 2017 before missing a 40-yarder in the fourth quarter in less-than-ideal weather conditions. He bounced back by going 3-for-3 against Ohio.
- After going 4-for-4 on field goals against South Dakota, Suder was named the MAC East Special Teams Player of the Week. Suder tied the Doyt L. Perry Stadium record for field goals made in a game.
- It marked the second time Suder earned the award in his career. He also won it a year ago after making a clutch fourth-quarter field goal against Akron in 2016.
- On Aug. 16, Suder converted on a 53-yard field goal in practice, which earned him a scholarship, sending the entire team around him into a craze.
- Head Coach Mike Jinks made the decision completely on the fly, stating that he didn't even think about what he would have done if Suder missed the kick. The video of the kick, which debuted on Twitter at @AyZiggyFB, triggered a media frenzy.

THE 1,000-YARD TRIO

- Seniors Josh Cleveland and Teo Redding each reached career milestones at Miami, going over 1,000 career yards in rushing and receiving, respectively. Early in the season, Scott Miller went over 1,000 yards receiving as well.
- Cleveland became the 38th player in school history over 1,000 rushing yards.
- In just two seasons, Cleveland's 1,139 yards

- already ranks him 35th in BGSU history. He needs 11 more yards to pass Mike Wright (1976-79) to move up another spot.
- Scott Miller became the 37th Falcon to post 1,000 career receiving yards. He entered the season needing three yards and is now at 1,398 for his career. That places him 28th all-time at BGSU and he needs 15 more to pass Bob Zimpfer (1967-69) for 27th.
- Teo Redding became the 38th Falcon to post 1,000 career receiving yards. With 1,130 receiving yards, Redding ranks 34th in school history. He needs 19 yards to move past PJ Pope (2002-05).

CLEVELAND CARRIES BG

- Senior running back Josh Cleveland leads the Falcons with 490 yards on the ground in 2017, averaging 5.2 yards per carry and 70.0 yards per game.
- Cleveland set career highs three weeks ago against Akron with 20 carries and three receptions.
- Against Miami two weeks ago, Cleveland had his first 100-yard rushing game of the season, finishing with 10 carries for 117 yards and a touchdown.
- In 2016, Cleveland averaged 6.4 yards per carry, the fourth-highest average in program history in a single season.

MILLER TIME

- A first-team all-conference receiver a year ago, junior Scott Miller continues to be a threat for the Falcons in the passing game.
- Miller leads the 2017 Falcons with 37 catches and is second with 401 receiving yards.
- Miller registered 18 catches in back-to-back contests against Middle Tennessee and Akron, including a season-high 10 catches against the Zips.
- Miller has now caught at least one pass in 20 consecutive games. That is tied for the 25th longest active streak in the nation. Iowa State's Allen Lazard has made a catch in 41 straight.
- At Middle Tennessee, Miller had eight catches for a season-high 112 yards receiving. He had a catch-and-run 60 yard touchdown in the contest, the longest offensive play of the season for BGSU at that time.
- Miller ranked among the top 50 receivers nationally with 968 receiving yards, 10 touchdowns, 6.2 receptions per game and 80.7 receiving yards per contest in 2016.

- Miller's 74 receptions cracked the top 10 in school history for a single season at 10th and his 10 touchdown receptions are tied for seventh.
- · Miller had four 100-yard receiving games in 2016, including 161 against North Dakota, 148 against Eastern Michigan, 149 at Toledo, and 178 against Miami.
- In a Sept. 10 contest against North Dakota, Miller earned five catches for 161 yards and his first three career touchdowns. He totaled 235 all-purpose yards in that game, the most by a Falcon since Roger Lewis had 261 in 2015 against Memphis.

IT TAKES TWO

- · Both Josh Cleveland and Andrew Clair rushed for 100 yards two weeks ago at Miami.
- The Falcons are 4-0 in BGSU Head Coach Mike Jinks' tenure when two running backs rush for 100 or more vards.
- · Over the final three games of the 2016 regular season, BGSU backs posted eight 100-yard rushing performances (twice getting three running backs over 100 yards) and winning each of those games.

LOCK(E) DOWN

- Senior linebacker Nate Locke has 47 tackles on the season - third to Brandon Harris' 52 and Fred Garth's 48
- The quarterback of the defense, Locke had a career game in the Falcons' season opener at Michigan State. He had a career-high 15 tackles in the game, adding a quarterback hurry and a 0.5 tackle for loss.
- The 15 tackles were the most in a game for a BGSU player since Trent Greene had 16 in the 2016 season opener at Ohio State.

DOING GOOD WORK

- · Senior middle linebacker Nate Locke works hard on and off the field and he has been recognized for his community service.
- Locke was named a nominee for the 2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team as well as a nominee for the 2017 National Football Foundation National Scholar-Athlete.
- · Locke was recently named a semifinalist for the 2017 Campbell Trophy, which recognizes the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the
- · Along with maintaining a 4.0 grade point average, Locke participates in many community service opportunities, including Feed My Starving Children and Rally Cap Sports. He has taken part in multiple mission trips and has been the president of Fellowship of Christian Athletes on campus.

POSEY POSES PROBLEMS FOR OPPONENTS

- · Redshirt freshman Armani Posey has become a bigger part of the defense as the season has worn on, registering a team-high 16 tackles in the win over Miami.
- · Posey moved into the starting lineup in week four and has not come out since.

- · His 16 tackles against Miami were the most in a game for a BGSU player since Trent Greene had 16 in the 2016 season opener at Ohio
- He now ranks fourth on the team with 46 tackles, has a team-best two forced fumbles. and has 1.5 tackles for loss.

THE FALCONS VS. THE MAC EAST

- · BGSU has dominated the MAC East over the past 4 1/2 years, going 19-4 during that stretch. Among intra-division schools, Ohio's 12-9 record against the MAC East is second best during that time frame. Buffalo is 10-9, followed by Akron (9-11), Kent State (5-16) and Miami
- · Bowling Green has defeated Buffalo six straight times, and Kent State four straight times

THE MORE THINGS CHANGE...

- For the first time since the 2012 and 2013 seasons, Bowling Green has the same offensive and defensive coordinators for back-to-back seasons
- · Including co-coordinators, BGSU had seven different offensive coordinators in a four-year span.

HONORING AND THINKING OF...

- · BGSU held its annual Military Appreciation football game versus Akron.
- The Falcons put a unique spin on their military appreciation helmets. For the secondconsecutive year, the names of the 111 former students who died in active service were featured on the helmets.

MIKEJINKS

Mike Jinks begins his second season as the head coach at Bowling Green in 2017. The 19th head coach in program history, Jinks was previously the associate head coach and running backs coach at Texas Tech.

In his first year at BGSU, Jinks led the Falcons to a 4-8 record that included three straight victories to close the regular season. Bowling Green outscored its three divisional opponents 107-54 during that stretch and rushed for an average of 328 yards during the winning streak. BGSU had eight 100-yard rushing performances over the final three games of the season.

The staff used the momentum gained to generate buzz in the offseason. The Falcons, by all accounts, landed the second-ranked recruiting class in the Mid-American Conference, proving immense trust in Jinks despite a sub-.500 record in his lone season guiding a college football program.

Jinks' players have excelled individually both on the field and in the classroom. A MAC-high nine players were named Distinguished Scholar-Athletes following the 2016 season and five were presented as members of the Hampshire Honor Society. Thirteen players were named Academic All-MAC and seven were named All-MAC, including first teamers Scott Miller and Joseph Davidson. Davidson was also first team Academic All-American, fourth team All-American by Phil Steele, and a semifinalist for the Ray Guy Award, presented to the top punter in college football.

Jinks, who came to BGSU after spending the 2015 season as Associate Head Coach, coached the Red Raiders' running backs for three seasons. Prior to his time at Texas Tech, he was a National Coach of the Year finalist while winning the 2010 Texas State Championship and compiling a record of 43-4 in his final three seasons at San Antonio powerhouse, Steele High School.

Known for their prolific offense, Texas Tech saw great success with Jinks. The Red Raiders owned the second-best offense in the country in 2015, totaling 7,134 yards in 12 games (594.5 yards per game). TTU also had the second-best passing offense.

Much like the final three games of Bowling Green's 2016 season, Texas Tech saw incredible success in the running game under Jinks. In just his second season, he tutored DeAndre Washington, who became the first Red Raiders' running back since Ricky Williams in 1998 to surpass 1,000 yards rushing in a single season. Washington finished the season with 1,103 rushing yards and was named second team All-Big 12.

Washington turned into the Big 12 Conference's most prolific rusher under Jinks, totaling a league-best 1,455 yards on the ground and 14 touchdowns in 2016. Washington was also second in the Big 12 in all-purpose yards (146.6 yards per game) behind only teammate Jakeem Grant (180.6 yards per game). The Texas Tech rushing attack averaged 204.8 yards per game and tallied 34 rushing touchdowns in his final campaign.

Jinks joined the Texas Tech program after a highly successful tenure at Steele High School in Cibolo, Texas – a suburb of San Antonio. Jinks was the first head coach at Steele when the school opened its doors in 2005, and it didn't take long for him to mold the program into a state powerhouse. While at Steele, Jinks compiled a 76-18 record overall, including an impressive 43-4 mark in his final three seasons. He led the Knights to the 2010 Class 5A Division II State Championship and to the state finals again in 2011.

Jinks is a graduate of Angelo State University where he earned his degree in kinesiology. He and his wife Meredith have three children – Jaden, Madison and Tristan.
