2017 BGSU FOOTBALL

SETTING THE SCENE

- Bowling Green hosts Toledo Wednesday for the 82nd match-up of the Battle of I-75. The two teams play at 8:00 pm on ESPN.
- Wednesday night will serve as Senior Night, honoring 20 seniors who will be playing their final game in Doyt L. Perry Stadium.
- Toledo has won seven straight games in the series since the Falcons earned a 38-24 victory in 2009. Four of those seven victories, however, have come by seven points or less.
- The Rockets have won the last three contests in the Doyt but the Falcons had won 5-of-6 prior to that stretch. In total, BGSU is 14-11 against Toledo in the Doyt.

LOOKING BACK

- Toledo scored a touchdown with just 18 seconds on the clock to beat Bowling Green 35-28 in the Glass Bowl a year ago.
- The Falcons rallied from a 35-21 fourth quarter deficit on touchdowns with 6:47 and 3:07 to play to tie the score.
- James Morgan was 25-of-38 for 335 yards and five touchdowns in arguably the best game of his college career. Scott Miller caught eight passes for 149 yards and three touchdowns.
- Bowling Green's defense was able to generate pressure all night, finishing with three sacks and 6.0 tackles for loss.

MR. #MACTION

- Head Coach Mike Jinks is 4-2 in midweek #MACTION games following Bowling Green's loss to Buffalo Tuesday night.
- In those six games, Bowling Green is outscoring its opponents, 199-153.
- Last season, after a road loss at Northern Illinois, the Falcons ended their season on a three-game winning streak for the first time since 2001. All three of those victories came in midweek #MACTION contests.
- The Falcons are a perfect 2-0 at home in midweek #MACTION ballgames under Jinks.

PROVIDING CLAIR-ITY

- With 573 yards on the ground over the past five games, true freshman Andrew Clair now leads the team with 650 rushing yards.
- Clair also leads the Falcons with 1,054 all-purpose yards, as he has 330 kick return yards, 650 rushing yards and 74 receiving yards. His 1,054 yards ranks third in the nation among true freshmen.
- His per game average of 117.1 all-purpose yards is also third in the country among true freshmen.
- On 89 rushing attempts, Clair is averaging 7.3 yards per carry. That would rank ninth in the nation if he had just one more carry to qualify at 10.0 carries per game.
- On the season, the true freshman is averaging 72.2 yards per game rushing.
- Clair earned his first career start Tuesday night at Buffalo.

CLAIR'S CONSECUTIVE 100-YARD GAMES

- True freshman Andrew Clair rushed for 100+ yards in four consecutive games earlier this year, culminating with 111 on just eight carries at Kent State.
- Clair became the first Falcon running back to have four straight 100-yard games since Travis Greene in 2013. Greene posted five consecutive 100-yard games that season, ending his streak with 133 yards in the 2013 MAC Championship Game victory.
- Anthon Samuel was the last true freshman with back-to-back 100-yard games, doing so Oct. 15 and 22, 2011 against Toledo (105 yards) and Temple (112 yards), respectively.
- Over those four games, Clair rushed for 488 yards on 57 carries, averaging 8.56 yards per rush, and 122.00 yards per game.
- Clair started his streak with 121 yards on 16 carries in a road win over Miami.
- Clair then had a career day versus Ohio, scoring two touchdowns and running for 148 yards on 18 carries – all career highs.
- His 148 rushing yards against Ohio are the most for a true freshman at BGSU since Willie Geter ran for 203 against Kent State on Oct. 20, 2007.
- In Bowling Green's last home game, Clair posted 108 yards versus Northern Illinois on 15 carries.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOEGE

- When Jarret Doege took the first snap at Middle Tennessee, he became the first true freshman to start a game at quarterback since

Brian McClure in 1982.

- Doege's passing yardage in his first start dwarfed McClure's, although McClure did lead the Falcons to a 7-3 win over Western Michigan in game three of the 1982 season.
- Doege was 21-of-35 for 283 yards and a touchdown against MTSU. McClure threw for 160 yards and a touchdown against WMU.
- After sustaining an injury in the Akron game, Doege returned to action at Kent State, and played a huge role in the Falcons' win.
- Doege completed 14-of-18 passes (77.7 percent) for 174 yards, two touchdowns, and zero interceptions. He also rushed for a touchdown, which was the first rushing touchdown of his career.

- Last week at Buffalo, he set new career highs for completions, attempts, yards and touchdowns when he went 28-of-43 for 294 yards and three touchdowns.

- Redshirt senior linebacker Nate Locke had a monster game at Kent State and was named MAC East Defensive Player of the Week for the performance.

2017 BGSU FOOTBALL

- Locke entered the game with 4.0 tackles for loss, but doubled that total by posting another 4.0, one of which was a sack. Locke now leads the team with 8.0 tackles for loss.
- Locke added eight tackles in the Kent State game, and now ranks second on the team with 71 tackles. He also has three quarterback hurries and one fumble recovery.
- The quarterback of the defense, Locke had a career game in the Falcons' season opener at Michigan State. He had a career-high 15 tackles in the game, adding a quarterback hurry and a 0.5 tackle for loss.
- The 15 tackles were the most in a game for a BGSU player since Trent Greene had 16 in the 2016 season opener at Ohio State.

DOING GOOD WORK

- Senior middle linebacker Nate Locke works hard on and off the field and he has been recognized for his community service.
- Locke was named a nominee for the 2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team as well as a nominee for the 2017 National Football Foundation National Scholar-Athlete.
- Locke was recently named a semifinalist for the 2017 Campbell Trophy, which recognizes the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation.
- Along with maintaining a 4.0 grade point average, Locke participates in many community service opportunities, including Feed My Starving Children and Rally Cap Sports. He has taken part in multiple mission trips and has been the president of Fellowship of Christian Athletes on campus.

THE FALCONS VS. THE MAC EAST

- BGSU has dominated the MAC East over the past five years, going 21-5 during that stretch.
- Among intra-division schools, Ohio's 18-6 record against the MAC East is second best during that time frame. Buffalo and Akron are both 13-12, followed by Miami (8-18), and Kent State (7-18).
- Bowling Green's longest current win streak against an East team has come against Kent State -- five straight.

TURNING THEM OVER

- Bowling Green leads the country with 15 fumble recoveries.
- Last week at Buffalo, Bowling Green added to that number, as Marcus Milton and Gus Schwieterman each earned a fumble recovery. Milton and Brandon Harris both had forced fumbles.
- BGSU ranks fifth in the country with 23 total forced turnovers.

MR. DO IT ALL

- Brandon Harris currently sits third on the team with 70 tackles, and in BGSU's last home game versus Northern Illinois, he picked up a season-high 10 tackles.
- Harris, who has 3.0 tackles for loss on the year, has six pass breakups as well.
- Harris is in a nine-way tie for second in the nation with three fumble recoveries this year.
- He has also scored two career defensive touchdowns, including a 93-yard fumble recovery to seal a win at Miami. He had an interception return for a touchdown in the 2016 season opener at Ohio State.
- Harris was named the MAC East Defensive Player of the Week for his efforts in helping the Falcons defeat Miami on the road.

GARTH GAINING CONFIDENCE

- Defensive back Fred Garth, in his first year as a Falcon, has at least eight tackles in each of the past four games and now leads the team with 77.
- Garth led the Falcons with 11 tackles in Bowling Green's win at Kent State on Halloween. That effort came on the heels of a 10-tackle performance the week prior versus Northern Illinois.
- The defensive back has three games this year with double-digit tackles, as he also had 11 tackles at Middle Tennessee.
- Additionally, Garth has one interception on the season, along with one tackle for loss and four passes defended.

SPREADING IT AROUND

- Sixteen different players have caught a pass during the 2017 season, surpassing the total from 2015 (15). You'd have to go all the way back to 2007 to find a season in which more than 15 players caught a pass. In that season, 17 did so.
- In the week three game at Northwestern, a total of 12 different players caught a pass for the Falcons. It is believed to be a school record.
- To put that number into perspective, only 13

different players caught a pass during the entire 2016 season.

- Eight of the 16 players who have made a catch this year made their first career catches in the Orange and Brown.

REDDING'S RIDICULOUS RECEPTIONS

- Redshirt senior Teo Redding leads the Falcons with five touchdown catches in 2017. The redshirt senior picked up his most recent touchdown grab in BGSU's contest at Buffalo.
- Redding had eight catches for 197 yards at Miami, adding two touchdowns, including a 75-yard bomb on the first play of the second half.
- Prior to the contest, Redding's career highs were six catches and 72 yards in a single game.
- Along with the 75-yard touchdown to open the second half, he had a 43-yard reception on BGSU's first offensive play of the game.
- Currently, Redding ranks second on the team with 41 catches and 526 yards.
- In the Halloween game at Kent State, Redding made an insane touchdown grab that was unfortunately called back due to a penalty in the back field. Redding hauled in the reception with his left hand only, and managed to get both feet inbounds. The play went viral around social media throughout the night.

GUYTON'S GARGANTUAN GRABS

- Junior Datrin Guyton ranks third on the team with 22 catches and has added 433 yards receiving.
- His 19.7 yards per reception ranks 19th in the country as he has shown to be a legitimate deep ball threat.
- Seven of Guyton's 22 catches have been for 30 yards or more and three have been 40 yards or longer.
- Against South Dakota, Guyton had catches of 49 yards, 40 yards and 35 yards.

JUNIOR JUMPING ONTO THE SCENE

- Redshirt sophomore Kyle Junior is quickly becoming one of the more dominant defensive linemen in the conference.
- Three weeks ago against Northern Illinois, Junior picked up a fumble forced by David Konowalski, and returned it 38 yards.
- Junior leads Bowling Green's defense in sacks (3.5) and is tied for the lead in quarterback hurries (4).
- Junior also ranks third on the team with 6.5 tackles for loss. The redshirt sophomore sits tied

for seventh on the team with 32 tackles.

COVERING THOSE KICKS

- BGSU's kickoff and punt coverage units were among the nation's best in 2016, showing immense growth in year one under Special Teams Coordinator Matt Brock. They are once again excelling in 2017.
- Bowling Green ranked first in the nation in kick coverage in 2016, allowing opponents just 15.1 yards per return. BGSU has allowed just 16.3 yards per return in 2017, which is eighth in the nation and first in the MAC through ten games.
- The Falcons were also among the top 30 in the country in punt return defense, allowing just 5.2 yards per return, 28th overall. Through ten games, BGSU's opponents have averaged only 3.3 yards per return in 2017. That number ranks 16th in the country, and second in the MAC.
- BGSU has not allowed a kick or punt return touchdown in 22 games under Brock.

DAVIDSON AN ALL-AMERICAN

- Punter Joseph Davidson is back for his senior season as one of the best in the nation. A semifinalist for the Ray Guy Award, given to the top punter in the country, a year ago, Davidson was named fourth team All-American by Phil Steele.
- Davidson became the school's all-time leader in career punting yards against Michigan State. He now has 11,116 career punting yards, passing Jim Phelps (8,955 yards). With Davidson's nine punts at Northwestern, he broke the school record (previously held by Phelps) for career punts, as he currently has punted the ball 250 times.
- Through ten games of the 2017 season, Davidson ranks second in the MAC in punting average (44.2), and first in net punting average (42.7). He ranks 21st in the country in punting average, and sixth in net punting. He's on track to rank fourth all-time in NCAA history in career punting average.
- On the year, Davidson has dropped 26 of his 53 punts inside the 20, and also has had nine 50+ yarders. While also having just two touchbacks, Davidson has three punts of 60+ yards, including a season-long 65-yard punt at Middle Tennessee.
- He has a career average of 44.46 yards per punt and is on pace to break the school record of 43.1 yards per punt for a career by Chris Shale, a first team All-American punter in 1990.

- Davidson booted a career-best 82-yard punt at Toledo a year ago. He had a nation's best nine 60+-yard punts in 2016.

PINNING THEM DEEP

- The 6-7 Joseph Davidson continually gets recognized for his big leg. However, his situational punting this season has been remarkable.
- Davidson has had 26 of his 53 punts (49 percent) punts downed inside the 20.
- Davidson is more likely to have a punt downed at the opponent's one yard line than he is to punt a touchback, as the redshirt-senior has had three punts downed at the one this season, and only two touchbacks.
- Additionally, 12 of Davidson's punts have been downed inside the 10, while seven punts have been downed inside the five.

DAVIDSON ALSO AN ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

- While Joseph Davidson is one of the top punters in the country, he has also been recognized as one of the brightest minds in college football.
- Davidson is a two-time Academic All-American, being the only punter named to the first team in 2016. He was recognized as a second team Academic All-American in 2015.

SPECIAL TEAMS, BIG PLAYS

- In Bowling Green's win over Kent State, true freshman Matt Wilcox posted a 61-yard kick return, which was BGSU's longest of the season.
- In the Akron game, Andrew Clair, who had 130 yards on five kick returns, returned a kick for 50 yards in the contest, which was the Falcons' second longest play of the season at the time.
- Marcus Milton's 24-yard punt return in the Akron ballgame was Bowling Green's longest punt return of the season at the time.
- Milton added a 26-yard punt return against

Ohio. It set up the Falcons for a touchdown to take a 23-21 lead.

WILCOX WOVES 'EM

- True freshman wide receiver Matt Wilcox has 11 receptions this year but has made an even bigger impact on special teams.
- Wilcox is averaging 26.6 yards per kick return and was named MAC East Special Teams Player of the Week after averaging 40.0 yards on three kick returns against Kent State.
- Wilcox's 26.6 average on kick returns is on pace for the fourth-best season in program history. BooBoo Gates set the school record in 2013 by averaging 30.6 yards per kick return.

SUDER'S STRONG SEASON

- Before finally missing a field goal attempt late in a rainy game at Miami, kicker Jake Suder had made 12 field goal attempts in a row, dating back to the 2016 season.
- Suder is now 16-for-18 on field goal attempts this season, including a 7-for-7 mark on kicks from 30-39 yards, and a 2-for-3 mark on kicks between 40-49 yards.
- After going 4-for-4 on field goals against South Dakota, Suder was named the MAC East Special Teams Player of the Week. Suder tied the Doyt L. Perry Stadium record for field goals made in a game.
- It marked the second time Suder earned the award in his career. He also won it a year ago after making a clutch fourth-quarter field goal against Akron in 2016.
- Suder is making kicks at an 88.9 percent clip in 2017, which is the best mark for any kicker in a season in BGSU history (minimum 13 made field goals).
- On Aug. 16, Suder converted on a 53-yard field goal in practice, which earned him a scholarship, sending the entire team around him into a craze.
- Head Coach Mike Jinks made the decision completely on the fly, stating that he didn't even think about what he would have done if Suder missed the kick. The video of the kick, which debuted on Twitter at @AyZiggyFB, triggered a media frenzy.

THE 1,000-YARD TRIO

- Seniors Josh Cleveland and Teo Redding each reached career milestones at Miami, going over 1,000 career yards in rushing and receiving, respectively. Early in the season, Scott Miller went over 1,000 yards receiving as well.
- Cleveland became the 38th player in school history over 1,000 rushing yards.
- In just two seasons, Cleveland's 1,245 yards already ranks him 28th in BGSU history. He needs 14 more yards to pass Jay Cunningham (1962-64) to move up another spot.
- Scott Miller became the 37th Falcon to post 1,000 career receiving yards. He entered the season needing three yards and is now at 1,568 for his career. That places him 22nd all-time at BGSU and he needs nine more to pass David Bautista (2000-01) for 21st.
- Teo Redding became the 38th Falcon to

post 1,000 career receiving yards. With 1,230 receiving yards, Redding ranks 31st in school history. He needs 13 yards to move past Damron Hamilton (1996-97).

CLEVELAND CARRIES BG

- Senior running back Josh Cleveland sits second on the team with 596 yards on the ground in 2017, averaging 5.0 yards per carry and 59.6 yards per game.
- Cleveland set career highs against Akron with 20 carries and three receptions.
- Against Miami, Cleveland had his first 100-yard rushing game of the season, finishing with 10 carries for 117 yards and a touchdown.
- In 2016, Cleveland averaged 6.4 yards per carry, the fourth-highest average in program history in a single season.

MILLER TIME

- A first-team all-conference receiver a year ago, junior Scott Miller continues to be a threat for the Falcons in the passing game.
- Miller leads the 2017 Falcons with 52 catches and 571 yards. He ranks second on the team with three touchdown receptions.
- Miller is coming off of his best game of the season, a contest in which he caught 10 passes for 108 yards and had a touchdown. He totaled a season-best 113 all-purpose yards.
- Miller has now caught at least one pass in 23 consecutive games. That is tied for the 24th longest active streak in the nation. Iowa State's Allen Lazard has made a catch in 44 straight.
- At Middle Tennessee, Miller had eight catches for a season-high 112 yards receiving. He had a catch-and-run 60 yard touchdown in the contest, the longest offensive play of the season for BGSU at that time.
- Miller ranked among the top 50 receivers nationally with 968 receiving yards, 10 touchdowns, 6.2 receptions per game and 80.7 receiving yards per contest in 2016.
- Miller's 74 receptions cracked the top 10 in school history for a single season at 10th and his 10 touchdown receptions are tied for seventh.
- Miller had four 100-yard receiving games in 2016, including 161 against North Dakota, 148 against Eastern Michigan, 149 at Toledo, and 178 against Miami.
- With six career 100-yard receiving games, Miller is tied for 10th in program history. Current New York Giants wide receiver Roger Lewis had a program record 13 such games in his career.
- In a Sept. 10 contest against North Dakota, Miller earned five catches for 161 yards and his first three career touchdowns. He totaled 235 all-purpose yards in that game, the most by a Falcon since Roger Lewis had 261 in 2015 against Memphis.

IT TAKES TWO

- Both Josh Cleveland and Andrew Clair rushed for 100 yards four weeks ago at Miami.
- The Falcons are 4-0 in BGSU Head Coach Mike Jinks' tenure when two running backs rush for 100 or more yards.

• Over the final three games of the 2016 regular season, BGSU backs posted eight 100-yard rushing performances (twice getting three running backs over 100 yards) and winning each of those games.

POSEY POSES PROBLEMS FOR OPPONENTS

- Redshirt freshman Armani Posey has become a bigger part of the defense as the season has worn on, registering a team-high 16 tackles in the win over Miami.
- Posey moved into the starting lineup in week four and did not come out of the lineup until injury sideline him.
- His 16 tackles against Miami were the most in a game for a BGSU player since Trent Greene had 16 in the 2016 season opener at Ohio State.
- Despite missing the Buffalo game, Posey ranks fourth on the team with 52 tackles, has 1.5 tackles for loss, and has forced two fumbles.

HONORING AND THINKING OF...

- BGSU held its annual Military Appreciation football game versus Akron. The Falcons also wore the helmet at Buffalo in honor of Veterans Day.
- The Falcons put a unique spin on their military appreciation helmets. For the second-consecutive year, the names of the 111 former students who died in active service were featured on the helmets.
- Hero Sports named BGSU's helmet the Best Patriotic College Football Helmet for 2017.
- Prior to the South Dakota game, the Falcons added a decal to their helmets in support of those affected by Hurricane Harvey.
- BGSU has a large number of players and staff with ties to the state of Texas.
- The decal, which is the outline of the state of Texas with the BGSU logo inside, is on the back of each of the Falcons' helmets.

RECRUITING ON THE RISE

- Since the arrival of Mike Jinks, Bowling Green has vaulted up the recruiting rankings over the past two seasons, including an incredibly strong 2017 class that has made an impact this season.
- BGSU's 2017 recruiting class was ranked among the top three in the MAC by all three major recruiting services. (247, Scout, Rivals).

FUTURE SCHEDULES

- During the offseason, BGSU announced a home-and-home series with Liberty. Liberty will become the newest member of the Football Bowl Series in 2019.
- In 2018, the Falcons will have two home non-conference games and will face three Power 5 opponents.
- Bowling Green will host Maryland and Eastern Kentucky, while playing on the road at Oregon and at Georgia Tech.
- The Falcons will get the chance to earn another home win over a Big Ten opponent against Maryland. The last time the Falcons hosted a Big Ten team, BGSU defeated Indiana 45-42 in 2014 on a Roger Lewis touchdown reception with nine seconds remaining.

2017 BGSU FOOTBALL



Mike Jinks begins his second season as the head coach at Bowling Green in 2017. The 19th head coach in program history, Jinks was previously the associate head coach and running backs coach at Texas Tech.

In his first year at BGSU, Jinks led the Falcons to a 4-8 record that included three straight victories to close the regular season. Bowling Green outscored its three divisional opponents 107-54 during that stretch and rushed for an average of 328 yards during the winning streak. BGSU had eight 100-yard rushing performances over the final three games of the season.

The staff used the momentum gained to generate buzz in the offseason. The Falcons, by all accounts, landed the second-ranked recruiting class in the Mid-American Conference, proving immense trust in Jinks despite a sub-.500 record in his lone season guiding a college football program.

Jinks' players have excelled individually both on the field and in the classroom. A MAC-high nine players were named Distinguished Scholar-Athletes following the 2016 season and five were presented as members of the Hampshire Honor Society. Thirteen players were named Academic All-MAC and seven were named All-MAC, including first teamers Scott Miller and Joseph Davidson. Davidson was also first team Academic All-American, fourth team All-American by Phil Steele, and a semifinalist for the Ray Guy Award, presented to the top punter in college football.

Jinks, who came to BGSU after spending the 2015 season as Associate Head Coach, coached the Red Raiders' running backs for three seasons. Prior to his time at Texas Tech, he was a National Coach of the Year finalist while winning the 2010 Texas State Championship and compiling a record of 43-4 in his final three seasons at San Antonio powerhouse, Steele High School.

Known for their prolific offense, Texas Tech saw great success with Jinks. The Red Raiders owned the second-best offense in the country in 2015, totaling 7,134 yards in 12 games (594.5 yards per game). TTU also had the second-best passing offense.

Much like the final three games of Bowling Green's 2016 season, Texas Tech saw incredible success in the running game under Jinks. In just his second season, he tutored DeAndre Washington, who became the first Red Raiders' running back since Ricky Williams in 1998 to surpass 1,000 yards rushing in a single season. Washington finished the season with 1,103 rushing yards and was named second team All-Big 12.

Washington turned into the Big 12 Conference's most prolific rusher under Jinks, totaling a league-best 1,455 yards on the ground and 14 touchdowns in 2016. Washington was also second in the Big 12 in all-purpose yards (146.6 yards per game) behind only teammate Jakeem Grant (180.6 yards per game). The Texas Tech rushing attack averaged 204.8 yards per game and tallied 34 rushing touchdowns in his final campaign.

Jinks joined the Texas Tech program after a highly successful tenure at Steele High School in Cibolo, Texas – a suburb of San Antonio. Jinks was the first head coach at Steele when the school opened its doors in 2005, and it didn't take long for him to mold the program into a state powerhouse. While at Steele, Jinks compiled a 76-18 record overall, including an impressive 43-4 mark in his final three seasons. He led the Knights to the 2010 Class 5A Division II State Championship and to the state finals again in 2011.

Jinks is a graduate of Angelo State University where he earned his degree in kinesiology. He and his wife Meredith have three children – Jaden, Madison and Tristan.
