## THE 2019-20 RETURNING STARTERS



TURNER

- Named 2019-20 MAC Preseason Player of the Year by Athlon, Lindy's & Blue Ribbon
- Participated in Chris Paul's Elite Guard Camp in July (Top 15 college PG in America)
- Became the first BGSU sophomore since 1972-73 to earn First Team All-MAC honors
- MAC's only returning First Team All-Conference player heading into 2019-20
- First player in BG history to score 1K points before reaching junior-year eligibility
- Averaged 18.2 PPG in 18-19, which ranked 4th in the MAC & 2nd among returnees
- Scored 619 points as a sophomore to rank 6th all-time in BG single-season history
- In 18-19, became the first Falcon since Antonio Daniels (96-97) to score 600+ pts & 100+ asts
- Led BG in pts (619), asts (105) & stls (47) in 18-19; 1st BG player since M. Huger (91-92)

**#1 JUSTIN TURNER | 6-4 | G | R-JR | 18.2 PPG | 3.7 RPG | 3.1 APG**

FIELDS

- Played in 33-of-34 games for the Orange and Brown as a freshman in 2018-19
- Bowling Green racked up a record of 17-8 with Fields in the starting lineup
- Carved out a key defensive role, often times guarding the opposition's top guard
- Entered the scoring column in 20-of-25 starts during his rookie campaign
- Posted a 2.25 assist-to-turnover ratio in MAC play, committing just 8 TO's in 322 minutes
- Averaged 7.3 points in the MAC Tournament, highlighted by a 14-point night vs. BSU
- Named MAC East Player of the Week on Dec. 21, 2019 for his 24-point game vs. UT Martin
- Set the BG freshman record for triples in a single game by going 6-for-7 vs. UT Martin
- Scored in double figures four times as a freshman, including twice in MAC play

**#3 CALEB FIELDS | 6-2 | G | SO | 4.3 PPG | 1.7 RPG | 0.8 SPG**

FRYE

- Named 2019-20 Preseason Second Team All-MAC by Athlon Sports magazine
- Enters his senior year ranked 39th all-time in career scoring with 1,085 points
- Currently ranked 4th in BG history with 183 three-pointers; needs 46 to break record
- Needs to hit 127 three-pointers this season to break the MAC record
- Made 83 three-pointers in 2018-19, which ranks 4th all-time for a single-season at BG
- 38 three-point attempts away from breaking John Reimold's (536) school record
- Averaged 16.6 points, 2.6 rebounds & 1.6 assists at the 2019 MAC Tournament
- Named Second Team All-NABC as a junior in 2018-19
- Has scored 20-plus points in 13 games as a Falcon, including 6 such games in 18-19

**#5 DYLAN FRYE | 6-2 | G | SR | 12.8 PPG | 2.4 RPG | 2.4 APG**

PLOWDEN

- Has appeared in all 66 games that BGSU has played in since coming to campus in 2017
- Led Bowling Green with 32 blocks in 2018-19, and ranked second with 163 rebounds
- Shot 43.9 percent (18-of-41) combined in all 21 MAC games from downtown
- Averaged 12.6 PPG and 8.0 RPG in the 2019 MAC Tournament (66.7% FG / 75.0% 3PT)
- Pulled down 8 rebounds apiece in all 3 conference tournament games last season
- Finished with 16 points in the MAC Championship Game against No. 18 Buffalo
- Made #SCTop10 on Jan. 5 & Jan. 8 in 2019 for highlight-reel blocks versus Ohio & Kent State
- Scored in double figures for the Falcons a total of 9 times as a sophomore in 2018-19
- Shot 46.2 percent from the floor in 2018-19 after shooting 42.2 percent in 2017-18

## **RECAPPING THE HISTORIC 2018-19 SEASON**

### **BGSU RETURNS TO MAC'S ELITE ECHELON FOLLOWING SUCCESSFUL 2018-19 SEASON**

- After being predicted to finish in last place in the preseason poll, Bowling Green went 22-12 in 2018-19, marking just the 10th time in program history that the Falcons have won 22-plus games in one season.
- Bowling Green won 22-plus games for the first time since the 2001-02 team went 24-9. The Falcons won 22-plus games for just the fourth time since 1950.
- The Falcons posted 20-plus wins for the first time since 2014-15, and for the 14th time in program history.
- BGSU won 12-plus conference games (12-6) in the regular season for just the seventh time in school history.

### **ORANGE AND BROWN MAKE MEMORABLE RUN TO 2019 MAC TITLE GAME**

- Bowling Green clinched a first-round bye and an automatic spot in the 2019 MAC Tournament Quarterfinals at Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland. BGSU secured a tournament bye for the first time in a decade. The 2008-09 Falcons won the MAC's regular-season title, and played as the No. 1 seed in the 2009 MAC Tournament.
- Including wins over Ball State and Northern Illinois in the 2019 MAC Tournament, Bowling Green finished the 2018-19 season with a 9-1 record against MAC West institutions.
- Bowling Green's 14 MAC regular-season/MAC Tournament wins is tied for second most in school history.
  - > 1982-83 = 16 Combined Wins
  - > 2018-19 = 14 Combined Wins
  - > 2001-02 = 14 Combined Wins
  - > 1996-97 = 14 Combined Wins
- BGSU won multiple games in the MAC Tournament for the fifth time in school history (1980, 1982, 2002, 2016, 2019). Two of those seasons have taken place under head coach Michael Huger.
- Played in the MAC Championship Game for just the fourth time in school history (2019, 2002, 1983, 1980).

### **BGSU GOES 14-2 AT HOME TO SET STROH CENTER RECORD**

- Bowling Green finished the 2018-19 season with a 14-2 record at home. BGSU's 14 home wins set a Stroh Center record, and marked the most home wins for the program since going 16-0 at home in 1947-48.
- The Falcons' 14 home wins are the fourth most in a single season in program history. BGSU went 17-2 at home in 1945-46, before posting undefeated home records in 1946-47 (15-0) and 1947-48 (16-0).
- Bowling Green won its home games in 2018-19 by an average of 12.8 points. The Falcons shot 45.9 percent inside the Stroh Center last season, while holding their opponents to a 39.6 percent clip. On average, BGSU won the battle on the glass at home last season, 41.8-36.4.

### **FALCONS EXPERIENCE HISTORIC 10-GAME WINNING STREAK**

- The Orange and Brown won 10-straight games for the first time since 2001-02. The streak started on Dec. 8, 2018, and ended on Jan. 26, 2019.
- BGSU's 10-game run marked just the third time over the last 55 years that the program has experienced at least a 10-game winning streak. The Orange and Brown experienced a 12-game winning streak in 2001-02, and a 10-game winning streak in 1979-80.



## **RECAPPING THE HISTORIC 2018-19 SEASON**

### **FALCONS BEAT NO. 18 BUFFALO, 92-88, ON FEB. 1, 2019**

- The victory over No. 18 Buffalo marked BGSU's first over an Associated Press Top 25 team since an 89-83 triumph over Kent State at Anderson Arena on March 1, 2008.
- The win is the program's highest-ranked win since upsetting No. 5 Michigan State, 98-85, on Dec. 1, 1990.
- With the win, Bowling Green has defeated all 11 MAC schools under head coach Michael Huger.
- The following home game, a contest versus Toledo, also featured a crowd of 5,000 fans. The two-straight sell-out crowds of 5,000 fans were the first two sell outs in men's basketball history at the Stroh Center.

### **BOWLING GREEN STARTS MAC PLAY WITH PERFECT 6-0 RECORD**

- Bowling Green got off to a 6-0 start in Mid-American Conference play for the first time since 1961-62.
- BGSU won six-straight MAC games for the first time in a decade. The Falcons won six-straight conference games during the 2008-09 championship season.
- Additionally, Bowling Green began conference play with an 11-2 record, marking the program's best start through 13 league games in school history.

### **CONTINUED OFFENSIVE SUCCESS UNDER COACH HUGER**

- In each subsequent year following Michael Huger's debut season in 2015-16, Bowling Green's points per game average has increased.
- Additionally, BGSU's MAC ranking – both in conference play and overall – has improved every season under Coach Huger's guidance.
- In 2018-19, the Falcons broke the school record for points scored in a season with a total of 2,668. Last year's BGSU squad broke the record that was previous held by the 1996-97 team (2,643).

### **REBOUNDED THE ROCK AT A HISTORIC RATE**

- Bowling Green collected a program-record 1,396 rebounds in 2018-19, breaking a record that stood for 56 seasons. The previous record was held by the 1962-63 squad (1,364).
- Across the 1962-63 season, BGSU was led by legend Nate Thurmond and his BGSU single-season record of 452 rebounds.
