SETTING THE SCENE

- Bowling Green opens the 102nd season in program history on Nov. 4 when the Falcons travel to Toledo for the Battle of I-75 against the Rockets. The 85th meeting between the two schools will take place inside the Glass Bowl and is scheduled for an 8 p.m. start on ESPNU.
- The all-time series between the Falcons and Rockets is tied at 40-40-4. In his debut game in the series, current second-year head coach Scot Loeffler engineered a 20-7 victory over Toledo at Doyt Perry Stadium last October (Oct. 12, 2019).
- Bowling Green will be opening a season against Toledo for the first time since 1919. The 1919 game was the first game in the history of the BGSU program. The Rockets won the contest, 6-0, on Oct. 3, 1919 in Bowling Green.
- The contest is the Mid-American Conference opener for both teams. Bowling Green last faced Toledo in a league opener in 2012. The Falcons lost a two-score game on the road that day prior to winning their next five MAC games.

A BGSU WIN WOULD...

- Allow the Falcons to start a season with a win against Toledo for the first time ever.
- Mark the program's first win at Toledo since 2008, snapping a five-game losing streak at the Glass Bowl
- Push the Falcons ahead in the all-time series against Toledo by a 41-40-4 margin.
- · Give the Falcons a season-opening win in back-to-back seasons for the first time since
- · Give the Falcons consecutive wins over Toledo for the first time since winning threestraight games in the series from 2007-09
- · Make Scot Loeffler the fifth head coach in BG history to win his first two matchups with
- Give Bowling Green a win in its MAC opener for the first time since 2015

BY THE NUMBERS

105

Tight end Quintin Morris enters 2020 with 105 career receptions and 1,281 yards. Among tight ends, he led the MAC in both receptions and receiving yards in 2019.

Terry Malone's offensive line allowed just 14 sacks a year ago, ranking ninth in the country in both fewest sacks allowed and per game average (1.17).

Bryson Denley proved to be one of the most versatile playmakers in the country in 2019. He was one of just four players in the country with at least 250 yards rushing, receiving and returning.

THE BATTLE OF I-75

- BGSU and Toledo have played every season since 1948. The two programs did not play from 1936-47, but since picking the series back up have played for 73 straight seasons (including 2020).
- Bowling Green's current second-longest annual series is against Ohio, which has been played every season since 2004.
- With its 20-7 win in 2019, Bowling Green snapped its nine-game losing streak to UT. BGSU will be looking to break another streak during Wednesday's midweek #MACtion version of the Battle of I-75. The Falcons will be in search of their first road win at Toledo since ending the regular season with a 38-10 triumph at the Glass Bowl in 2008.
- When the Falcons beat Toledo last year at The Doyt, Scot Loeffler became the 10th head coach in program history to beat Toledo in his debut game as head coach against the Rockets. He was the first to do so since Dave Clawson (current Wake Forest head coach) in 2009.
- Loeffler is looking to become the fifth Bowling Green coach and first since Gary Blackney in 1991-92 to open his tenure with consecutive wins against Toledo.

EXPERIENCE IN RIVALRY GAMES

- Heading into last season, not one player on the current Bowling Green football roster had beaten Toledo. That is no longer the case. In fact, the Falcons return a plethora of players that played big-time roles in BG's 20-7 victory in 2019.
- Running back Bryson Denley caught a 66-yard touchdown pass, led the Falcons with 100 yards receiving, and added 27 rushing yards on three carries. BGSU's other top-three receivers from that game return, as well. Quintin Morris had two catches for 27 yards, while Julian Ortega-Jones hauled in two passes for 32 yards.
- Nate Needham made two critically-important field goals from 32 and 26 yards out.
- Three of Bowling Green's top-four tacklers from last year's contest return. Linebacker Kholbe Coleman led the way in 2019 with 14 tackles. Ranking tied for third with eight tackles were defensive back Jordan Anderson and linebacker Jerry Roberts. Defensive lineman Karl Brooks had five tackles, forced a fumble, and had a sack.

A LOOK BACK: FALCONS EARN 20-7 VICTORY OVER TOLEDO

- In the 84th all-time meeting between the two schools, the Falcons snapped their nine-game Battle of I-75 skid with a 20-7 victory over the Rockets.
- The Falcons set the tone with a 56-yard quarterback run from Grant Loy on the first play from scrimmage. BGSU settled for an opening-drive field goal and maintained that lead for the duration of the game.
- Nate Needham connected on a pair of field goals, while Loy and Bryson Denley added touchdowns to salt away the win.
- The Bowling Green defense recovered a fumble and intercepted a pass. The seven points allowed were the fewest points that the Falcons have surrendered against Toledo since a 20-6 win in 1987.

YEAR TWO FOR SCOT LOEFFLER AND HIS STAFF

- BGSU Director of Athletics Bob Moosbrugger named veteran Scot Loeffler as the 20th head coach in Bowling Green history on Nov. 28, 2018.
- Although the 2019 season marked Loeffler's first as a head coach, the Ohio native brought a wealth of high-level college football experience with him to Bowling Green. Loeffler has served as the offensive coordinator at Boston College, Virginia Tech, Auburn and Temple. He has also coached at Florida, his alma mater Michigan, and Central Michigan -- as well as the Detroit Lions
- Loeffler has coached seven quarterbacks who went on to play in the NFL, including Tom Brady and Tim Tebow. His teams have qualified for 17 bowl games, including coaching for Michigan's 1997 Rose Bowl team that won the national championship.
- Entering the 2020 season, Loeffler will be bringing a level of consistency with his coaching staff that is not always a guarantee within the MAC (BGSU had to hire a new head coach after winning the league in both 2013 and 2015), but can be a huge strength.
- Bowling Green will have its same coordinators in back-to-back seasons for just the third time this decade. Brian VanGorder (defensive coordinator) and Terry Malone (offensive coordinator) are back after taking positive steps on their respective sides of the ball a season ago. Jacob Schoonover (special teams coordinator) also returns after BGSU's special terms were a big strength in 2019. Associate head coach Steve Morrison is entering year two with Loeffler at BGSU, as well. A vast majority of the remaining coaching staff members are also entering their second seasons at Bowling Green.

LOEFFLER IN SEASON OPENERS

- In his debut game as Bowling Green head coach in 2019, Scot Loeffler led the Orange and Brown to a season-opening 46-3 win over Morgan State on Aug. 29, 2019.
- The 43-point win marked the third-largest

margin of victory for a BGSU head coach in his debut game, topping Doyt Perry's 40-0 win over Defiance to open the 1955 campaign. Gregg Brandon picked up a 63-13 win over Eastern Kentucky in 2003, while Don Nehlen defeated Ball State by a score of 62-8 in the 1968 opener.

• Loeffler has won his last three season openers dating back to his final two seasons as Boston College's offensive coordinator in 2017 and 2018.

Q IS THE X FACTOR

- Coming off a second team All-MAC season in 2019, senior Quintin Morris enters his senior year as one of the most dynamic tight ends in college football.
- Morris, who has caught a pass in 24 straight games, led last year's Falcons with 55 receptions, 649 receiving yards and four touchdown catches. Morris had seven games in 2019 with at least four receptions and 50-plus receiving yards.
- The native of Richmond, Texas ranks 32nd all-time at Bowling Green with 1,281 receiving yards. He needs just 219 yards to become the 24th player in school history with 1,500 receiving yards. Morris is 319 yards shy of becoming BG's 22nd-ever 1,600-yard receiver.

TWO-HEADED MONSTER AT RUNNING BACK

- Redshirt junior Andrew Clair and redshirt senior Bryson Denley make up one of the Mid-American Conference's most versatile and explosive backfields.
- Sparked by a freshman season in 2017 that saw him rack up 1,184 all-purpose yards, Clair begins his junior season ranked 20th all-time in rushing yards at BGSU with 1,671. Clair battled injuries in 2019, but still led the team by averaging 61 rushing yards per game. Clair, who ranked fifth in the nation in 2017 by averaging 4.5 yards after contact, leads all current Bowling Green players with 17 career touchdowns.
- Clair currently ranks fifth in school history with a 5.4 rush per attempt average. He needs 329 more yards to become the 14th Falcon to reach 2,000 career rushing yards.

• Denley had a career year in 2019, as he led the Falcons with 1,224 all-purpose yards and seven touchdowns. The Texan also led Bowling Green with 544 rushing yards and tied for the team lead with four rushing touchdowns. Showing his versatility, Denley placed third on the team in receiving yards (267) and second in catches (27).

McDONALD NAMED STARTING QB

- Redshirt junior Matt McDonald is expected to make his long-awaited Bowling Green debut when the Falcons open the 2020 season at Toledo on Nov. 4.
- McDonald began his career at Boston College.
 Scot Loeffler, BC's offensive coordinator at the time, recruited McDonald out of Mission Viejo
 High School in California in 2017. McDonald redshirted in 2017, played sparingly in 2018 and then followed Loeffler to BGSU in 2019.
- At Mission Viejo High School, an injury in McDonald's junior season allowed his backup, JT Daniels, to take over the starting role. Daniels went on to high school All-American status, and then started as a true freshman at USC before moving on to Georgia.
- McDonald won the starting job at BG coming out of preseason camp in 2019, but was denied immediate eligibility by the NCAA and was forced to sit out the entirety of the season due to transfer rules
- The 2020 season will mark McDonald's fourth in Loeffler's system. The 6-foot-3 gunslinger appeared in two games while at BC, going a combined 7-for-8 for 118 yards and two touchdowns. His last collegiate appearance came in a win over Holy Cross on Sept. 8, 2018. On that day, McDonald went 5-for-6 for 107 yards and two touchdowns.

SENIOR SPECIALISTS SET TO SHINE

- Bowling Green's top-three specialists punter Matt Naranjo, kicker Nate Needham and long snapper James Carolan all return for their senior seasons in 2020. Additionally, special teams coordinator Jacob Schoonover is back for his third season on staff.
- · Needham played in all 12 games last season.

Needham, who is 12 points shy of 100 for his career, went 5-for-9 on field goal attempts in 2019 while going 21-of-23 on extra-point attempts. Carolan has played in 35 games over three seasons for the Orange and Brown.

• Naranjo appeared in every contest in 2019. He currently ranks eighth all-time at BGSU, averaging 40.6 yards per punt.

OLD MAN MOTES

- Redshirt senior tight end Presley Motes is the lone player on the 2020 Falcons to have already earned his undergraduate degree.
- Motes, who is also married and expecting a child, is a 2013 graduate of Thatcher High School before serving two years on a Mormon mission
- Motes began at Bowling Green in 2018 after transferring from Eastern Arizona Community College. He played quarterback in high school as well as in his prior collegiate stops.

THE FOUNDATION (OLINE AND DLINE)

- Bowling Green was one of the better teams in the country at protecting the quarterback in 2019 and also did a solid job of creating pressure.
- The offensive line ranked ninth in the nation in sacks allowed a year ago, giving up just 1.17 per contest (14 total allowed).
- On the flip side, BGSU was fifth in the MAC in sacks created, recording an average of 2.00 per game (24 total).

HEDDEN HAS BEEN ON BOTH SIDES

- Bowling Green Tight Ends Coach Chris Hedden has now seen both sides of the Battle of I-75 rivalry, after coaching at Toledo in 1996 and from 2001-08.
- Hedden, of course, helped the Falcons to a 20-7 victory over Toledo a year ago as coach of BGSU's running backs.
- From 2001-08, Hedden served in a variety of roles at Toledo, coaching tight ends, wide receivers and the offensive line, as well as serving as the offensive coordinator and running game coordinator. The two programs split the eight games during that stretch.
- · Hedden was also a graduate assistant at

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- Seven Falcons were named to at least one preseason All-MAC team by the three major national preview publications – Athlon Sports, Street & Smith's, and Phil Steele's College Football Preview.
- Tight end Quintin Morris was recognized as a preseason first team All-MAC player by Athlon and Street & Smith's. Morris earned a spot on Phil Steele's All-MAC second team.
- Running backs Andrew Clair and Bryson Denley were honored, as well. Clair was named fourth team by Phil Steele and third team by Athlon. Denley picked up second team honors by both Athlon and Phil Steele as a kick returner.
- Jake Rogers (punt return) and Isaiah Johnson-Mack (linebacker) earned preseason fourth team All-MAC honors by Phil Steele. Punter Matt Naranjo was honored by both Athlon (third team) and Phil Steele (fourth team).
- Linebacker Kholbe Coleman was tabbed as a second team All-MAC performer by Athlon.
 Coleman led the Falcons in 2019 with 103 tackles.

THE YOUTH MOVEMENT

- Bowling Green and head coach Scot Loeffler will field one of the youngest teams in college football in 2020.
- Of the 106 total players on Bowling Green's roster, 69 of them or 65.1 percent have at least four years of eligibility. That figure includes all freshmen and true sophomores. The Falcons have an additional five redshirt sophomores with three years of eligibility.
- Of those 69 players, a total of 64 are freshmen. The Falcons have 43 true freshmen and 21 redshirt freshmen. In Loeffler's first season in 2019, the Falcons had 37 true freshmen and 10 redshirt freshmen.

DIFFERENT FLAVOR OF #MACTION

- The Mid-American Conference will play a 6-game schedule in 2020. Each of the 12 MAC institutions will play six conference games and zero non-conference games. The MAC Championship Game will take place at Ford Field in Detroit on Dec. 19.
- The season will start on Nov. 4 with all 12 schools playing a cross-divisional opponent.

The final five weeks of the season will feature divisional games only.

 Additionally, the first three weeks of the season will all take place during mid-week dates, showcasing games during the popular midweek #MACtion window. The final three weeks of the season will be played on Saturdays.

COPPES CARES FOR FALCONS

- Bowling Green is one of a handful of schools who has a female as the primary care provider for the football program
- Coppes is in her seventh year at BGSU and her fifth as a full-time staff member. She earned her master's degree from BGSU in 2016 and her undergraduate degree from Ohio State in 2014.
- Only UMass, Georgia Southern, Troy, Kansas State, Western Kentucky, Western Michigan, Houston, Michigan State, Iowa, Virginia and UCF also employ a female in the role.

RUSHING FOR THE CENTURY MARK

- A year ago, Bowling Green rushed for at least 100 yards in 11 of 12 games, including the final 10 games of the season.
- BGSU went over 200 yards rushing twice last year, posting 240 yards in the 20-7 victory over Toledo and 326 yards in the win over Morgan State. The Falcons ran for at least 150 yards in each of their three victories.
- Bowling Green went 2-0 when rushing for at least 200 yards.

HEAD COACH SCOT LOEFFLER



Scot Loeffler begins his second season as the head coach at Bowling Green State University in 2020. The 20th head coach of the Bowling Green football program, Loeffler came to BGSU after serving as Deputy Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator at Boston College.

In his first season at Bowling Green, the Falcons built a foundation for success. Although BGSU went just 3-9 overall and 2-6 in MAC play, the program began to turn the corner in many ways. Most notably, the Falcons defeated rival Toledo 20-7 to end a nine-game losing streak in the Battle of I-75.

In BGSU's three victories (over Toledo, Akron and Morgan State), the Falcons outscored their opponents 101-16, highlighting explosive offensive performances and stifling defensive efforts. Bowling Green held Morgan State to just 70 yards of offense and Akron to 100 yards. BGSU gave up just one touchdown in those three victories.

Loeffler has coached seven quarterbacks who went on to play in the NFL – Tom Brady, Tim Tebow, Brian Griese, Chad Henne, Drew Henson, John Navarre and Logan Thomas. He has also directed a potent rushing attack at Boston College behind AJ Dillon, who ranked 13th nationally in rushing yards per game in 2018. Dillon was the ACC Rookie of the Year in 2017 and the nation's second-leading rusher among freshmen.

In 2018, Boston College scored 40+ points in four of its first five games, including an average of 52.7 points in consecutive wins over Massachusetts, Holy Cross and Wake Forest. The Eagles then defeated Temple 45-35 and Louisville 38-20. The team ended the regular season at 7-5 overall.

In 2017, Loeffler's offense posted 35+ points in three consecutive games for the first time in 15 years at Boston College. The team scored 40+ points in consecutive conference games for the first time in the program's Big East and ACC history. The rushing offense climbed from 96th to 25th in the country and the Eagles were one of the faster teams in the nation, ranking 18th nationally in total plays.

Prior to his tenure at Boston College, Loeffler served as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach under Frank Beamer at Virginia Tech from 2013-15. He mentored Logan Thomas, who finished his collegiate career by breaking career records for passing yards, attempts, touchdown passes and rushing touchdowns by a quarterback. He oversaw a trio of wide receivers who became the first group in Virginia Tech history to each record 40 or more receptions in a season.

As the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Auburn in 2012, Loeffler mentored Tre Mason, a 1000-yard rusher who became the first non-quarterback to lead Auburn in total offense since Bo Jackson in 1985.

Loeffler guided Temple to the seventh-best rushing average in the nation as offensive coordinator in 2011 and running back Bernard Pierce ranked sixth nationally, including 107 yards on the ground in Doyt L. Perry Stadium in a 13-10 BGSU victory. That team went on to win the program's first bowl game since 1979.

Prior to his time at Temple, he was quarterbacks coach at Florida under former BGSU head coach Urban Meyer, helping the unit to the best pass efficiency in the nation in 2009. He guided Tebow in his final season in Gainesville as he passed for 2,895 yards and 21 touchdowns. Tebow graduated from Florida with five NCAA, 14 SEC and 28 school record.

In 2008, Loeffler worked with the Detroit Lions' quarterbacks, following his tenure at Michigan. From 2002-07, he coached quarterbacks for the Wolverines. Chad Henne became the first true freshman quarterback to lead his team to a Big Ten title and start in a BCS game, while John Navarre became Michigan's first All-Big Ten first team quarterback since 1997.

Along with his time at Temple, Loeffler has familiarity in the Mid-American Conference as he was Central Michigan's quarterbacks coach from 2000-01. Prior to that, he was a graduate assistant and student assistant at Michigan, working with Brady and Griese. He was part of the Wolverines' undefeated national championship season in 1997.

A native of Barberton, Ohio and Barberton High School, Loeffler played quarterback at Michigan from 1993-96. A 1998 graduate of Michigan, Loeffler earned his undergraduate degree in history with a minor in political science.

Loeffler is married to Amie, who holds an undergraduate degree in chemistry from Bowling Green in 1999 and a graduate degree in chemistry in 2005. The couple has three children – Luke, Alexis and Mary Elizabeth.
