SETTING THE SCENE

- Bowling Green heads on the road to face Ohio Saturday at noon on ESPN+. The Falcons will play after having 11 days off since facing Buffalo, while the Bobcats will have had 18 days between games due to cancelation of their Nov. 17 contest.
- This will be the 72nd meeting between the two programs all-time with Bowling Green holding a 40-29-2 edge. Ohio, though, has won each of the past four meetings, including last year's 66-24 victory.
- Prior to Ohio's current four-game win streak in the series (in which the Bobcats have outscored BGSU 193-92), the Falcons had won four straight in the series, outscoring Ohio
- · Bowling Green last won in Athens in 2014, a 31-13 victory, on the way to making its second of three straight appearances in the MAC Championship game. The Falcons won the MAC championship in 2013 and 2015.
- · BGSU and Ohio games tend to be blowouts. Even though the two teams have split the last eight meetings, only one of those contests has been decided by single digits. Four of those contests (two wins each way) have been decided by 35+ points.

A BGSU WIN WOULD...

- · Be the Falcons' first road victory of the Scot Loeffler era
- Be the program's first win on the road since defeating Akron 21-6 on Nov. 17, 2018
- Extend the Falcons' all-time series lead to 41-29-2 over Ohio

BY THE NUMBERS

Fours are wild for Terion Stewart. The true freshman wears uniform No. 4 and has four touchdowns in the fourth quarters of BGSU's past two games.

Darren Anders had a careerbest 14 tackles and has at least nine in every game this year. He ranks among the top 15 tacklers in the country with 11.3 per game.

BGSU is the youngest team in the country in terms of percentage of freshmen on the roster. With 64-of-106 listed freshmen or RS freshmen, 60 percent of the roster is made up the youngest of players.

YEAR TWO FOR SCOT LOEFFLER AND HIS STAFF

- BGSU Director of Athletics Bob Moosbrugger named veteran Scot Loeffler as the 20th head coach in Bowling Green history on Nov. 28, 2018
- Although the 2019 season marked Loeffler's first as a head coach, the Ohio native brought a wealth of high-level college football experience with him to Bowling Green. Loeffler has served as the offensive coordinator at Boston College, Virginia Tech, Auburn and Temple. He has also coached at Florida, his alma mater Michigan, and Central Michigan -- as well as the Detroit Lions
- Loeffler has coached seven quarterbacks who went on to play in the NFL, including Tom Brady and Tim Tebow. His teams have qualified for 17 bowl games, including coaching for Michigan's 1997 Rose Bowl team that won the national championship.
- Loeffler will be bringing a level of consistency with his coaching staff in 2020 that is not always a guarantee within the MAC (BGSU had to hire a new head coach after winning the league in both 2013 and 2015), but can be a huge strength.
- Bowling Green has its same coordinators in back-to-back seasons for just the third time this decade. Brian VanGorder (defensive coordinator) and Terry Malone (offensive coordinator) are back after taking positive steps on their respective sides of the ball a season ago. Jacob Schoonover (special teams coordinator) also returns after BGSU's special terms were a big strength in 2019. Associate head coach Steve Morrison is entering year two with Loeffler at BGSU, as well. A vast majority of the remaining coaching staff members are also entering their second seasons at Bowling Green.

A LOOK BACK: OHIO PULLS AWAY FROM BGSU

- A year ago, Ohio defeated Bowling Green 66-24 by shutting out the Falcons in the second half.
- The Bobcats led 24-14 after the first quarter and 38-24 at the half, then outscored the Falcons 28-0 in the third to cruise to the win.
- The two teams combined for more than 1,000 yards of offense but Ohio's 342 yards on the ground was too much for the Falcons.

REVISITING LAST WEEK: BUFFALO

- BGSU's offense continued to show improvement but Buffalo was too strong in a 42-17 win on Tuesday, Nov. 17.
- BGSU drove into Buffalo territory on seven of its 10 drives and had seven drives of 44 or more yards, but the Falcons stalled too often and were unable to keep up with the Bulls' bruising rushing attack.
- Buffalo ran for 396 yards and all six touchdowns came on the ground.
- Despite the 42-17 score, Buffalo had just one more first down than Bowling Green and only 71 more yards of offense. The Falcons won the

time of possession battle and showed balance with 180 yards rushing and 219 passing.

Q IS THE X FACTOR

- Coming off a second team All-MAC season in 2019, Quintin Morris enters his senior year as one of the most dynamic tight ends in college football.
- Morris, who has caught a pass in 27 straight games, led last year's Falcons with 55 receptions, 649 receiving yards and four touchdown catches. Morris had seven games in 2019 with at least four receptions and 50-plus receiving yards.
- The native of Richmond, Texas moved up three spots on BGSU's all-time receiving yards list last week. He passed former teammate Teo Redding (2013-17) as well as Jim Ladd (1951-53) and Dan Shetler (1977-80) to move into 29th in program history with 1,379 receiving yards. He needs just 121 more yards to become the 24th player in school history with 1,500 receiving yards.

WIDE RECEIVER PRODUCTION

- So far in 2020, 65 percent of Matt McDonald's completions went to wide receivers, a welcome sight for Bowling Green fans. A year ago, wide receivers made just 30 percent of the team's completions.
- The Falcons have not had a receiving touchdown from a wide receiver since Tampa Bay Buccaneers' wideout Scotty Miller had a 63-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter against Buffalo on Nov. 23, 2018.
- While BGSU is still looking for that first receiving touchdown of 2020, the top two yardage leaders are both wide receivers. Julian Ortega-Jones has 133 yards receiving and Noah Massey has added 121. Redshirt freshman Tyrone Broden comes in fourth with 77 yards.
- A pair of true freshmen receivers are yet to catch a pass but have already impacted the Falcons. Javonte Kinsey drew a pass interference downfield against Buffalo and Jhaylin Embry has 50 yards rushing, mostly on jet sweeps.
- The only wide receiver on the roster who has a receiving touchdown in his career is Massey, who caught a TD in 2018. Before moving to tight end, Quintin Morris caught nine touchdowns as a wide receiver.

MR. VERSATILE BRYSON DENLEY

- Redshirt senior Bryson Denley has proven to be one of the more versatile players in the country over the course of his career. In 2019, he led the Falcons with 1,224 all-purpose yards and was one of only nine players with at least 250 yards rushing, receiving and in the return game.
- The Texas native led the team with 544 rushing yards and was third with 267 receiving yards.
- Through three games, Denley is again leading the team in all-purpose yards, bolstered by a strong start in the kick return game.
- Denley is averaging a MAC-best 28.8 yards on nine kick returns, including an 81-yarder

against Kent State. That return is the longest for a BGSU player since Clint Stephens had a 96yard return against Ball State in 2014.

RUSHING FOR THE CENTURY MARK

- Under Scot Loeffler, Bowling Green has rushed for at least 100 yards in 14-of-15 games, including a current streak of 13 in a row.
- Bowling Green has rushed for 440 yards over the past two weeks, including 260 against Kent State, the second-highest total of the Scot Loeffler era
- True freshman Terion Stewart rushed for 162 yards against Kent State and was named PFF College's True Freshman of the Week for the performance.
- BGSU went over 200 yards rushing twice last year, posting 240 yards in the 20-7 victory over Toledo and 326 yards in the win over Morgan State. The Falcons ran for at least 150 yards in each of their three victories.
- Bowling Green is 2-1 under Scot Loeffler when rushing for at least 200 yards and has not won a contest since defeating Eastern Kentucky in 2018 while rushing for under 150 yards.

FINDING CLAIR-ITY

- Despite being limited by injuries over the course of his career, Andrew Clair has proven to be one of the most productive running backs in the MAC when healthy.
- After missing the Falcons' game against Kent State, Clair made his presence known with a 21-yard carry on his first touch against Buffalo. He finished with 14 carries for 85 yards.
- With 1,793 career rushing yards, Clair ranks 18th in program history. He needs 207 more to become just the 14th back in school history with 2,000 yards on the ground.
- As a freshman, Clair broke the single-season school record by averaging 6.8 yards per carry.
 In 2020, he is averaging 4.7 yards each time he carries it.
- Also a productive pass-catcher, Clair has 43 career receptions for 309 yards.

TERION TERRORIZES DEFENSES

• True freshman Terion Stewart earned his first career carries in the fourth quarter against Kent

- State two games ago. He made the most of those chances, toting the rock 14 times for 162 yards and two touchdowns.
- The 162 rushing yards are the most for a BGSU true freshman in a game since Willie Geter rushed for 203 against the same Kent State program in 2007.
- That yardage total is the most for any BGSU running back since the program's all-time leading rusher Travis Greene had 183 against Northern Illinois in the 2015 MAC Championship game.
- Stewart followed up that performance with 42 more yards and two more fourth-quarter touchdowns against Buffalo in the team's last game.
- Stewart had a knack for scoring touchdowns at Sandusky High School, posting more than 90 in his career. It took him little time to show that his nose for the end zone will quickly translate to the college game.

McDONALD TRIGGERING THE OFFENSE

- Redshirt junior Matt McDonald made his longawaited Bowling Green debut against Toledo to open the 2020 BGSU football season. It was McDonald's first start in four years.
- McDonald began his career at Boston College.
 Scot Loeffler, BC's offensive coordinator at the time, recruited McDonald out of Mission Viejo High School in California in 2017. McDonald redshirted in 2017, played sparingly in 2018 and then followed Loeffler to BGSU in 2019.
- At Mission Viejo High School, an injury in McDonald's junior season allowed his back-up, JT Daniels, to take over the starting role. Daniels went on to high school All-American status, and then started as a true freshman at USC before moving on to Georgia.
- McDonald won the starting job at BG coming out of preseason camp in 2019, but was denied immediate eligibility by the NCAA and was forced to sit out the entirety of the season due to transfer rules
- The 2020 season will mark McDonald's fourth in Loeffler's system. The 6-foot-3 gunslinger appeared in two games while at BC, going a combined 7-for-8 for 118 yards and two

touchdowns. His last collegiate appearance came in a win over Holy Cross on Sept. 8, 2018. On that day, McDonald went 5-for-6 for 107 yards and two touchdowns.

TAKING STEPS FORWARD

- It makes sense that after spending most of the past three years away from the football field, Matt McDonald would need some time to shake off the rust and find his rhythm. And he is doing exactly that as the 2020 season wears on.
- McDonald has improved his completion percentage and quarterback efficiency rate in each game of the 2020 season.
- Against Buffalo in the team's most recent game, McDonald began 9-of-11 passing and finished 17-for-27 for 219 yards. Listed below is McDonald's game-by-game completion rate and efficiency.

SENIOR SPECIALISTS ALREADY SHINING

- Bowling Green's top-three specialists punter Matt Naranjo, kicker Nate Needham and long snapper James Carolan all return for their senior seasons in 2020. Additionally, special teams coordinator Jacob Schoonover is back for his third season on staff.
- Needham, who is three points shy of 100 for his career, is now 8-for-13 on field goal attempts at BGSU, including 3-for-4 this year. He is also 26-of-28 on extra-point attempts.
- Naranjo currently ranks eighth all-time at BGSU, averaging 40.3 yards per punt. He has had to battle howling winds and poor weather for much of the season and is still averaging 38.3 yards per punt. He has a season-long punt of 63 yards and four of his 14 punts have landed inside the 20.
- Carolan has played in 38 games over four seasons for the Orange and Brown and has been a steady snapper for the Falcons during his career

ANDERS IN THE MIDDLE

- Sophomore Darren Anders is making the most of his first opportunities to shine in 2020.
- After playing in 11 games as a true freshman a

year ago (including one start), Anders truly had his first chance as a keystone figure defensively against Toledo and he made the most of his chance.

- He led the Falcons with 11 tackles and also recovered an early third-quarter fumble that was forced by teammate Sy Dabney. Anders added a team-best 1.5 tackles for loss.
- Anders added nine more tackles against Kent State, before posting a career-best 14 Tuesday night against Buffalo. That gives him 34 tackles on the season, almost doubling his total of 20 from his freshman campaign.
- With 11.3 tackles per contest, Anders ranks among the nation's leaders in that statistic.

OLD MAN MOTES

- Redshirt senior tight end Presley Motes is the lone player on the 2020 Falcons to have already earned his undergraduate degree.
- Motes, who is also married and expecting a baby boy in January, is a 2013 graduate of Thatcher High School before serving two years on a Mormon mission.
- Motes began at Bowling Green in 2018 after transferring from Eastern Arizona Community College. He played quarterback in high school as well as in his prior collegiate stops.

THE YOUTH MOVEMENT...

- Bowling Green and head coach Scot Loeffler will field the youngest team in college football in
- Of the 106 total players on Bowling Green's roster, 64 of them or 60.4 percent are true freshmen or redshirt freshmen, the highest percentage of first-year players in the country.
- The Falcons have 43 true freshmen and 21 redshirt freshmen. In Loeffler's first season in 2019, the Falcons had 37 true freshmen and 10 redshirt freshmen.

...AND THOSE FRESHMEN ARE PLAYING

- Six players with freshman eligibility status have started so far in 2020 and many more have seen game action.
- Redshirt freshman Tyrone Broden has started all three games, while redshirt freshmen Trevon Raymore, Andrew Bench and Patrick Day earned their first starts against Kent State. True freshman Jhaylin Embry also started against the Golden Flashes. Jalen Grant, yet another true

freshman, is the sixth first year player to start, getting the nod on the offensive line against Buffalo.

• In total, 25 freshmen have seen game action, including 15 true freshmen.

INEXPERIENCE STARTING

- Eight Falcons made their first career starts at Toledo, including five on offense. Another four made their first career starts against Kent State and two more against Buffalo for a total of 14 first-time starters.
- Quarterback Matt McDonald not only earned his first start against Toledo, but also served as team captain. He was joined by first-time starters Tyrone Broden, Presley Motes, Cameron State and Joe Ware on offense.
- Defensively, Diata Burns and Sy Dabney made their first starts in the back end against Toledo, while Jordan Murphy picked up his starting nod along the defensive line.
- Against Kent State, Trevon Raymore started at running back and Jhaylin Embry earned a start at wide receiver. Defensively, Andrew Bench got the start on the defensive line, while Patrick Day did so at safety.
- True freshman Jalen Grant started on the offensive line against Buffalo and redshirt junior Cedric Mitchell earned his first career start at safety.

THE 200-TACKLE MAN

- With eight tackles at Toledo in the seasonopener, Kholbe Coleman went over 200 for his career. He enters the Ohio game with 223, posting a season-best 15 tackles against Kent State.
- Coleman ranks 37th nationally in 2020 with 9.7 tackles per game.
- Coleman was a third-team All-MAC linebacker a year ago, recording 103 tackles, 4.5 for loss.
- Two years ago, Coleman added 70 tackles for the Falcons.
- With 1.0 tackle for loss against Kent State, Coleman now has 9.5 for his career. He also has three career forced fumbles and four fumble recoveries.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- Seven Falcons were named to at least one preseason All-MAC team by the three major national preview publications – Athlon Sports, Street & Smith's, and Phil Steele's College Football Preview.
- Tight end Quintin Morris was recognized as a preseason first team All-MAC player by Athlon and Street & Smith's. Morris earned a spot on Phil Steele's All-MAC second team.
- Running backs Andrew Clair and Bryson Denley were honored, as well. Clair was named fourth team by Phil Steele and third team by Athlon. Denley picked up second team honors by both Athlon and Phil Steele as a kick returner.
 Jake Rogers (punt return) and Isaiah Johnson-Mack (linebacker) earned preseason fourth team All-MAC honors by Phil Steele. Punter Matt Naranjo was honored by both Athlon (third team) and Phil Steele (fourth team).
- Linebacker Kholbe Coleman was tabbed as a second team All-MAC performer by Athlon.
 Coleman led the Falcons in 2019 with 103 tackles.

DIFFERENT FLAVOR OF #MACTION

- The Mid-American Conference will play a 6-game schedule in 2020. Each of the 12 MAC institutions will play six conference games and zero non-conference games. The MAC Championship Game will take place at Ford Field in Detroit on Dec. 19.
- The season started Nov. 4 with all 12 schools playing a cross-divisional opponent. The final five weeks of the season feature divisional games only.
- Additionally, the first three weeks of the season will all take place during mid-week dates, showcasing games during the popular midweek #MACtion window. The final three weeks of the season will be played on Saturdays.
- Through the first three weeks of the season, just one MAC game has been canceled.

COPPES CARES FOR FALCONS

- Bowling Green is one of a handful of schools who has a female as the primary care provider for the football program
- · Coppes is in her seventh year at BGSU and

HEAD COACH SCOT LOEFFLER



Scot Loeffler begins his second season as the head coach at Bowling Green State University in 2020. The 20th head coach of the Bowling Green football program, Loeffler came to BGSU after serving as Deputy Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator at Boston College.

In his first season at Bowling Green, the Falcons built a foundation for success. Although BGSU went just 3-9 overall and 2-6 in MAC play, the program began to turn the corner in many ways. Most notably, the Falcons defeated rival Toledo 20-7 to end a nine-game losing streak in the Battle of I-75.

In BGSU's three victories (over Toledo, Akron and Morgan State), the Falcons outscored their opponents 101-16, highlighting explosive offensive performances and stifling defensive efforts. Bowling Green held Morgan State to just 70 yards of offense and Akron to 100 yards. BGSU gave up just one touchdown in those three victories.

Loeffler has coached seven quarterbacks who went on to play in the NFL – Tom Brady, Tim Tebow, Brian Griese, Chad Henne, Drew Henson, John Navarre and Logan Thomas. He has also directed a potent rushing attack at Boston College behind AJ Dillon, who ranked 13th nationally in rushing yards per game in 2018. Dillon was the ACC Rookie of the Year in 2017 and the nation's second-leading rusher among freshmen.

In 2018, Boston College scored 40+ points in four of its first five games, including an average of 52.7 points in consecutive wins over Massachusetts, Holy Cross and Wake Forest. The Eagles then defeated Temple 45-35 and Louisville 38-20. The team ended the regular season at 7-5 overall.

In 2017, Loeffler's offense posted 35+ points in three consecutive games for the first time in 15 years at Boston College. The team scored 40+ points in consecutive conference games for the first time in the program's Big East and ACC history. The rushing offense climbed from 96th to 25th in the country and the Eagles were one of the faster teams in the nation, ranking 18th nationally in total plays.

Prior to his tenure at Boston College, Loeffler served as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach under Frank Beamer at Virginia Tech from 2013-15. He mentored Logan Thomas, who finished his collegiate career by breaking career records for passing yards, attempts, touchdown passes and rushing touchdowns by a quarterback. He oversaw a trio of wide receivers who became the first group in Virginia Tech history to each record 40 or more receptions in a season.

As the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Auburn in 2012, Loeffler mentored Tre Mason, a 1000-yard rusher who became the first non-quarterback to lead Auburn in total offense since Bo Jackson in 1985.

Loeffler guided Temple to the seventh-best rushing average in the nation as offensive coordinator in 2011 and running back Bernard Pierce ranked sixth nationally, including 107 yards on the ground in Doyt L. Perry Stadium in a 13-10 BGSU victory. That team went on to win the program's first bowl game since 1979.

Prior to his time at Temple, he was quarterbacks coach at Florida under former BGSU head coach Urban Meyer, helping the unit to the best pass efficiency in the nation in 2009. He guided Tebow in his final season in Gainesville as he passed for 2,895 yards and 21 touchdowns. Tebow graduated from Florida with five NCAA, 14 SEC and 28 school record.

In 2008, Loeffler worked with the Detroit Lions' quarterbacks, following his tenure at Michigan. From 2002-07, he coached quarterbacks for the Wolverines. Chad Henne became the first true freshman quarterback to lead his team to a Big Ten title and start in a BCS game, while John Navarre became Michigan's first All-Big Ten first team quarterback since 1997.

Along with his time at Temple, Loeffler has familiarity in the Mid-American Conference as he was Central Michigan's quarterbacks coach from 2000-01. Prior to that, he was a graduate assistant and student assistant at Michigan, working with Brady and Griese. He was part of the Wolverines' undefeated national championship season in 1997.

A native of Barberton, Ohio and Barberton High School, Loeffler played quarterback at Michigan from 1993-96. A 1998 graduate of Michigan, Loeffler earned his undergraduate degree in history with a minor in political science.

Loeffler is married to Amie, who holds an undergraduate degree in chemistry from Bowling Green in 1999 and a graduate degree in chemistry in 2005. The couple has three children – Luke, Alexis and Mary Elizabeth.
