SETTING THE SCENE

FALCONS HEAD TO VEGAS FOR HOLIDAY HOOPS CLASSIC

• The Bowling Green State University women's basketball team heads to Nevada for a pair of games in the Las Vegas Holiday Hoops Classic. Head coach **Robyn Fralick** and the Falcons, the defending Mid-American Conference regular-season champions, will face Oakland University on Sunday (Dec. 19), with tipoff set for 2:30 p.m. local time (5:30 p.m. ET) at South Point Arena. **(NOTE: This is a change from the original schedule.)**

• Then, on Tuesday (Dec. 21), the Orange and Brown will meet the University of Tennessee at Martin, with tipoff scheduled for 5:00 p.m. Vegas time (8:00 p.m. ET).

FOLLOW THE FALCONS

• There are multiple ways to keep up with the Falcons this season...

• TV/VIDEO: All but one of BGSU's home games, as well as many road contests, will be streamed via ESPN3 or ESPN+. The Falcons' two games in Vegas are slated to be aired on FloHoops.

• RADIO/AUDIO: All BGSU home games and selected road games – including the Oakland and UT Martin contests – are scheduled to have an audio stream thanks to the Bowling Green Radio Sports Organization (BGRSO).

• LIVE STATS: Live stats are scheduled to be available for all BGSU games in 2021-22.

• TWITTER: In-game updates, along with key graphics and information, can be found on the BGSU women's basketball twitter account, @BGSUwbb.

THE OPENING TIP

• The Falcons are 3-4 on the young season, including marks of 3-1 inside the Stroh Center, 0-1 in true road games and 0-2 in neutral-site contests. After losing a pair of games by a combined six points in the Navy Classic (Nov. 27-28), the Orange and Brown returned home to beat Valparaiso (69-53; Dec. 5) and Notre Dame College (100-48; Dec. 12) on back-to-back Sundays.

• The Falcons posted a 32-point win over East Tennessee State in the season opener, before dropping a 71-60 decision against Horizon League favorite IUPUI and a 94-63 result on the road against then-#21/25 Ohio State. Then, BGSU fell in a pair of narrow contests at the Navy Classic, against George Mason (77-75 in overtime; Nov. 27) and Liberty (76-72; Nov. 28) prior to returning to Ohio and winning those back-to-back Sunday matchups at the Stroh.

• Head coach **Robyn Fralick**, in her fourth season at the helm of the Falcons, returned 10 players off of last year's BGSU roster.

• The Falcons, after going 10-21 overall and 3-15 in the MAC two years ago, were picked to finish 11th in the 12-team league in 2020-21, according to the preseason coaches' poll. BG proceeded to post a 14-4 MAC record to win the regular-season crown. Then, the Orange and Brown defeated Eastern Michigan and Buffalo in the MAC Tournament in Cleveland, before falling to Central Michigan in the championship game.

• BGSU advanced to the WNIT and finished with a 21-8 overall record. BG tied for the second-best turnaround in the nation, with an improvement of +12.0 games.

NOTING THE FALCONS

• This season, the Falcons were picked to finish second in the MAC in the preseason coaches' poll.

• Oakland enters the Holiday Hoops Classic with a 4-5 record, and the Golden Grizzlies' most recent game was a 21-point win at Central Michigan.

CENTURY MARK

• The Falcons hit the century mark for the first time in over 17 years, downing Notre Dame College, 100-48, on Sunday afternoon (Dec. 12) at the Stroh Center.

• It marked the Falcons' first triple-digit point total since BG racked up 115 points in a win at IPFW (now Purdue Fort Wayne) on Nov. 19, 2004.

• The Falcons set a new Stroh Center record for points in a game. BGSU had scored 99 points in a win over Marshall on Nov. 13, 2018. That Marshall matchup marked **Robyn Fralick's** first home contest as head coach of the Orange and Brown.

• BGSU reached the century mark in a home game for the first time since a 102-69 win over Western Michigan. That victory came on Jan. 3, 2008, inside venerable Anderson Arena.

• The Falcons now have scored 100 or more points a total of 25 times in the history of the program.

PROLIFIC POINT TOTALS

• In addition to reaching the 100-point plateau, the Falcons posted a few other notable point totals in the win over Notre Dame College.

• The Falcons set a school record for most points in a quarter on Sunday, with 38 points in the second period vs. NDC. The previous record was 34 points, set against Loyola Chicago on Nov. 20, 2018.

• BGSU scored 61 points in the first half, the third-highest total in school history and the highest output in a half since January of 1992. The only higher-scoring halves in program history came against Kent (Jan. 11, 1989) and Valparaiso (Jan. 5, 1992), with BG scoring 66 points in each case.

• BGSU's 52-point margin of victory was the Falcons' largest in 40 years (plus one week), and tied for the second-largest in program history. BG posted a 58-point win over Taylor just over four decades ago (94-36; Dec. 5, 1981), and the Falcons also won by 52 points in a 1975 home game against Ohio Northern (77-25; Feb. 11, 1975).

SHARPS-SHOOTING FALCON

• **Morgan Sharps** went 5-of-7 from three-point range in the win over Valparaiso, tying for game honors with 17 points, and she was 3-for-6 from the arc against Notre Dame College. Sharps is averaging 3.29 successful three-pointers per game, tying her for second in the MAC and 14th in the nation.

• Sharps, a transfer from Xavier, is shooting 51.1% from long distance on the year, ranking second in the conference and 15th in the country in long-range accuracy.





YOU CAN'T SPELL "HAMPTON AMONG THE NATION'S LEADERS" WITHOUT "HAMPTON"

• **Nyla Hampton** had 56 steals in 24 games last season, finishing third on the team in overall steals and second on the Falcons in steals per game (2.3).

• Through seven games this season, Hampton has 28 steals, an average of 4.00 per game. She leads the MAC in both categories.

• Hampton currently ranks fourth in the entire nation in steals per game, while ranking 25th in total steals. The sophomore has had three games with five steals or more this season.

• For her career, Hampton is averaging 2.7 steals per game, with 84 in 31 career contests in the Orange and Brown.

VELASCO HEATS UP

• Freshman **Amy Velasco** scored a game-high 19 points – all in the first half – in the win over NDC. She went 7-for-8 from the field vs. the (NDC) Falcons.

• That came one game after she tied for game honors with 17 points against Valparaiso. In those two contests, Velasco shot a combined 15-of-19 from the floor, including a perfect 12-for-12 from two-point range. She had 36 points in 46 minutes of action.

BRETT'S BACK

• After missing the preseason and the first three games of the year due to injury, junior **Elissa Brett** returned to the floor for the Navy Classic. She made her 2021-22 debut in the George Mason contest, and had four points and four rebounds in 17 minutes of action off the bench.

• The next day, Brett made her first start of the year against Liberty, and led the Falcons and tied for game honors with 17 points on the afternoon. She also had five boards, two assists and a steal.

• The Adelaide, Australia native had 10 points and nine rebounds in the win over NDC. She is averaging 9.0 points per game in her BGSU career, and has averaged 11.6 ppg since the beginning of the 2020-21 season.

THE STARTING FIVE

• Through seven games this season, BGSU has utilized four different starting lineups. The Falcons had six different starting lineups last season, but only four through the first 27 games of the year.

• Seven different players have started at least one game this year to date. **Nyla Hampton**, **Kadie Hempfling** and **Kenzie Lewis** have been in the starting lineup for each of the first seven games, while freshmen **Zoe Miller** and **Amy Velasco** have started five games apiece.

A LITTLE BACKGROUND INFO ABOUT THE FALCONS

• Have we mentioned that BGSU won 21 total games and the MAC regular-season title in 2020-21? We have? Well they did.

• A total of 10 letterwinners from that club, including all five starters, are on the roster in 2021-22. BG's top-five scorers are back from a year ago, including All-MAC performers **Lexi Fleming** and **Kadie Hempfling**. Fleming, a sophomore, was named

>> Sophomore **Jasmine Clerkley** attended the same high school (Okemos, H.S.; Okemos, Mich.) as head coach **Robyn Fralick**.

>> Redshirt junior **Molly Dever's** brother, Kevin, is a member of the football team at Akron after transferring from Ohio State.

>> Sophomore **Lexi Fleming's** parents, Dan and Melissa, both played collegiate basketball at Northern Kentucky Univ. In her second-ever game as a Falcon, Lexi scored 11 points in a win at NKU.

>> Fleming's family owns a funnel cake food truck in the Cincinnati area.

>> Sophomore **Nyla Hampton** can solve a Rubik's cube in under a minute.

>> Senior **Kadie Hempfling** played softball and soccer, in addition to basketball, at Ottawa-Glandorf H.S. She led the soccer team in scoring as a junior, before moving to goalkeeper late in her senior season.

>> Sophomore **Kenzie Lewis** was the starting quarterback on a boys football team in fourth grade, and also was involved in competitive figure skating as a child.

>> All three of freshman **Jocelyn Tate's** siblings, as well as her father, play or played collegiate basketball. Her father, Jermaine, played at Ohio State and Cincinnati, and played professionally overseas.

>> Tate's brother, Jae'Sean, played at Ohio State and currently plays in the NBA for the Houston Rockets. Her other brother, Jalen, played at NKU and Arkansas and currently plays for Giessen 46ers in Germany. Her sister, Jada, is a junior on the women's basketball team at Tiffin (where she is coached by former BGSU women's basketball standout Miriam Justinger).

the MAC Freshman of the Year after averaging a team-high 15.9 points per game, and she also was chosen to the All-MAC Second Team. Fleming's total of 67 steals was the highest by a freshman in BGSU history.

- Fleming suffered an injury during the preseason, however, and will miss the 2021-22 campaign.

- Hempfling, a senior, earned all-league third-team honors a year ago after averaging 12.4 points and 5.9 rebounds per contest. She ranked among the top-three players on the team in scoring, rebounding and assists (3.0 apg), and led the Falcons in plus/minus ratio.

- Junior **Elissa Brett** rounds out BG's returning double-digit scorers. Brett averaged 12.0 ppg and led the Falcons in rebounding (6.7 rpg). She led the Orange and Brown in scoring at tournament time, averaging 13.8 ppg in BG's six tournament games (three MAC Tournament and three WNIT contests).

- Sophomore **Nyla Hampton** and fifth-year Falcon **Madisen Parker** scored 9.3 and 7.4 ppg, respectively, last season. Hampton joined Fleming on the MAC's All-Freshman Team, and also was chosen to the MAC All-Defensive Team. She was second on the Falcons in both assists (2.8) and steals (2.3) per game, and shot 63 percent from the field in BG's three WNIT games.

- Parker, after leading the entire nation in three-point field-goal percentage two years ago, finished 11th in the country last season. She shot 45.0% from the arc, making a team-high 58 long-range attempts, and is fifth in BGSU history with a total of 201 career three-pointers made.

- Sophomore **Kenzie Lewis** was one of just two Falcons to start all 29 games last year, joining Hempfling in that category. Lewis averaged 4.9 ppg despite attempting fewer than three shots per contest, and led the team in assists (3.1 apg) while ranking second in both rebounds (6.1) and steals (2.0).

- Redshirt junior **Molly Dever** and sophomores **Jasmine Clerkley**, **Sophie Dziekan** and **Olivia Hill** round out the Falcons' returnees.

- Fralick and the Falcons welcomed four newcomers (all Ohio natives) to this year's roster, including redshirt sophomore **Morgan Sharps** (Granville, Ohio), a transfer from Xavier. BG's trio of freshmen include **Zoe Miller** (Berlin, Ohio), **Jocelyn Tate** (Pickerington, Ohio) and **Amy Velasco** (Centerville, Ohio).

- Through seven games this season, Sharps and Miller have averaged 13.6 and 11.1 ppg, respectively, pacing a balanced scoring attack which features seven players averaging at least 7.0 points per outing. Brett has 9.5 ppg, with Hempfling at 9.0, Velasco 8.4, Hampton 8.0 and Tate at 7.0 ppg.

- Tate leads the team with 6.6 rebounds per game, while Lewis paces the Falcons in assists (4.0 apg). Hampton is second on the team in that category (3.0 apg) and leads the Falcons in both steals (4.0 spg) and blocked shots (0.7 bpg).

- A total of seven different players have started at least one game this season. Hampton, Hempfling and Lewis each have started all seven contests, while Miller and Velasco have made five starts apiece. Brett has been in the starting lineup for each of the last three games.

FALCONS PICKED TO PLACE SECOND

• The Bowling Green State University women's basketball team has been picked to finish second in the Mid-American Conference race in the 2021-22 season. The MAC office released the Women's Basketball Coaches' Preseason Poll and the Preseason All-MAC Teams – determined via voting by the league's 12 head coaches – on Nov. 4.

• **Lexi Fleming** was selected to the Preseason All-MAC Second Team. Fleming was the lone sophomore chosen to the preseason all-conference team.

• Ohio was the choice of the coaches to win the MAC regular-season crown in 2021-22. The Bobcats received 132 points and four of the 12 first-place votes. The Falcons garnered 124 points and three first-place votes, with Buffalo (123 points, three first-place votes) right behind BGSU.

FLEMING NAMED TO BECKY HAMMON PRESEASON WATCH LIST

• **Lexi Fleming** was named to the preseason watch list for the 2022 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award presented by Her Hoop Stats. The 25-member watch list was unveiled on Oct. 20.

• Last season, Fleming was one of 15 players, but the only freshman, to be named to the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Midseason Watch List.

WELCOME!

• Each of BGSU's four 2021-22 newcomers have made an immediate impact on the court. Freshmen **Zoe Miller** and **Amy Velasco** were in the starting lineup for the season opener, and have started five games apiece. Classmate **Jocelyn Tate** and sophomore **Morgan Sharps** have been two of the Falcons' top players off the bench.

• Currently, Sharps and Miller rank 1-2 on the team in scoring. Sharps has 13.6 points per outing, with Miller at 11.1 ppg.

GREETINGS!

• BGSU's four newcomers combined for 40 points and 23 rebounds in the season opener vs. ETSU. and 42 points and 14 boards three days later against IUPUI.

• In the latter game, the quartet combined for 42 of the Falcons' 60 points. And, that group had a combined 41 of BG's 63 points at Ohio State and a total of 52 points against Notre Dame College.

• In fact, through seven games, BGSU's four newcomers have combined to average 40.1 points per game. The quartet has combined to score at least 32 points in each of the seven contests.

• Sharps has scored in double digits a team-leading six times this season, while Miller has five double-figure games to date. Velasco had a then career-high 17 points to tie Sharps for game honors in the win over Valpo, and Velasco set a new career best with 19 points vs. NDC.

• The four newcomers have combined for 16 of the Falcons' 23 individual double-figure outputs this season to date.

NET GAINS

• The 2020-21 season marked the unveiling of the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) for women's basketball. The NET replaced RPI as a team sorting tool, and is used to measure a team's quality and help evaluate team resumes for selection and seeding in the NCAA tournament.

• In a nutshell, NET ranking is determined by who you played, where you played, how efficiently you played and the result of the game.

• The Falcons were ranked 54th in the first NET listings of the 2020-21 season, and BG wound up ranked 65th out of the 343 NCAA Division-I teams who played at least one game during 2020-21.

• Just for comparison's sake, BGSU had finished 253rd of 351 teams in the final 2019-20 RPI rankings.

• BGSU was ranked 155th in the first NET rankings of 2021-22 (Dec. 6), and the Falcons were 153rd in the most recent listings (Friday, Dec. 17).

KATE ACHTER. KADIE HEMPFLING. THAT'S IT. THAT'S THE LIST.

• In the first five decades (give or take) of BGSU women's basketball, only one player had amassed both 500 rebounds and 300 assists in her career. Last season, that list doubled.

• Kate Achter had been the only player to achieve both of those milestones. But, midway through her third season with the Falcons, **Kadie Hempfling** joined Achter on that list. Hempfling reached both the 500-rebound and 300-assist milestones in January of 2021. Entering the Campbell contest game, she now has 650 boards along with 37 dollars and 60 cents (376 dimes) (just wanted to see if anyone was still reading).

• Achter (2004-08), a member of the BGSU Athletics Hall of Fame, had a school-record 688 assists and exactly 500 rebounds in her storied Falcon career.

KADIE HEMPFLING. THAT'S IT. THAT'S THE LIST.

• Late last season, **Kadie Hempfling** pulled down the 600th rebound of her BGSU career. She is the only player in school history to have grabbed 600 boards and dished out 300 assists.

• Hempfling currently ranks eighth on the BGSU career assists list.

MADIS3N PARK3R

• **Madisen Parker** has made 209 three-point field goals in her storied career. She currently sits in fifth place on the BGSU career list for three-pointers made.

• Parker is seven triples behind fourth-place Liz Honegger (216 treys from 2003-07). The legendary Lauren Prochaska holds the school record with 310 triples during her Falcon tenure (2007-11).

CAPTAINS

• **Molly Dever, Lexi Fleming, Kadie Hempfling** and **Madisen Parker** are the captains of the 2021-22 Falcons. "As we went through the process (of naming captains), it was clear that those four are really admired by their teammates," said **Robyn Fralick**. "I love that they are a very complementary group; they really bring different strengths. Together, they really have a good pulse on the team."

RING SZN

• The Falcons, as we have mentioned and will definitely continue to mention, won the 2020-21 Mid-American Conference regular-season title. BGSU has won 15 MAC regular-season championships, the most of any conference school. The Falcons captured three-straight league crowns in 1987, '88 and '89 under coach Fran Voll, and Jaci Clark's teams won back-to-back MAC regular-season titles in 1993 and '94.

• Curt Miller's teams won an unprecedented eight-straight conference regular-season titles, from 2005 through 2012. BG captured seven of those eight titles outright (the Falcons won the East Division in 2011, but did not have the league's best overall record that season). Jennifer Roos guided the Falcons to a MAC regular-season trophy in 2014, and last season, **Robyn Fralick** became the fifth different head coach to lead the program to a conference regular-season crown.

WELL THEN, THIS WOULD BE MORE, WOULDN'T IT?

• As Jon Lovitz's character said in *A League of Their Own* (and we're pretty sure he was talking about the Falcons), "Well then, this would be more, wouldn't it?" BGSU sported a 14-4 record in MAC play last season, and – as we've mentioned and will continue to mention – BGSU won the league regular-season championship.

• BGSU more than quadrupled the program's MAC win total from the previous season, and the Falcons surpassed the conference win total for the last four years combined. BG went 3-15 in MAC play last season, 2-16 the previous winter, 3-15 the year before that and 4-14 in league action in 2016-17.

A QUICK LOOK AT THE GOLDEN GRIZZLIES

• Oakland is 4-5 on the season, and the Golden Grizzlies are coming off of a dominant 79-58 win at Central Michigan on Dec. 7. OU is 3-4 at home and 1-1 on the road this season to date, and Sunday will be the Grizzlies' first neutral-site game of the 2021-22 campaign.

• Kahlaijah Dean leads the team with 18.6 points per game, including a 34-point effort in the win at CMU, while Olivia Sims and Lamariyee Williams have 8.0 and 7.7 ppg, respectively. Head coach Jeff Tugate and the Golden Grizzlies went 12-12 overall and 12-8 in Horizon League play in 2020-21. Tugate is taking a medical leave of absence, and associate head coach Ke'Sha Blanton is serving as acting head coach.

THE SERIES

• The Falcons lead Oakland, 5-3, in the all-time series, and BGSU has won the last four meetings. The teams will be meeting for the first time since 2010. That '10 meeting saw BG pick up an 80-46 victory at venerable Anderson Arena (Nov. 20, 2010). The Falcons are 2-2 at home and 3-1 on the road vs. the Golden Grizzlies, and Sunday will mark the first-ever neutral-site meeting between the teams.

SCOUTING THE SKYHAWKS

• UT Martin has a 3-7 record heading into a Monday matchup vs. Akron. The Skyhawks are looking to snap a five-game losing streak, including a 69-54 setback vs. Southern Illinois on Wednesday.

• Paige Pipkin has 12.0 ppg, while Holly Forbes has 10.1 ppg and a team-leading 6.1 rpg. The Skyhawks are 1-3 at home, 0-2 on the road and 2-2 in neutral-site contests heading into the Akron game. Head coach Kevin McMillan returned eight players, including two starters, from the 2020-21 team that went 22-6 overall and 17-2 in the Ohio Valley Conference. The Skyhawks won the OVC regular-season title and advanced to the WNIT.

THE SERIES

• BGSU leads UT Martin, 1-0, in the all-time series. The lone prior meeting was a 78-36 triumph nearly 14 years ago (Dec. 30, 2007), in the Cyclone Shootout in Ames, Iowa.

DOWN THE ROAD

• Following the two games in Vegas and a break for the holidays, the Orange and Brown will open Mid-American Conference play on Dec. 29 at Eastern Michigan. The home portion of the MAC schedule commences on New Year's Day, when BG battles Ball State at the Strohs.
