SETTING THE SCENE

BGSU'S BUSY FEBRUARY SLATE CONTINUES WITH CLASH AT KENT STATE

• The Bowling Green State University women's basketball team continues a busy February schedule with a trip to Northeast Ohio for a Monday-night (Feb. 21) matchup. Head coach **Robyn Fralick** and the Falcons, the defending MAC regular-season champions, face Kent State in a 7:00 p.m. start at the M.A.C. Center.

THE OPENING TIP – STREAKS, STORYLINES AND SIDEBARS

- After alternating wins and losses since late January, the Falcons are now looking to reverse a two-game losing streak. BGSU lost to MAC preseason favorite Ohio on Saturday afternoon (Feb. 19) at the Stroh Center. **Morgan Sharps** led the Falcons with 19 points, while **Madisen Parker** and **Kadie Hempfling** scored 15 and 14 points, respectively, on Senior Day. Parker's point total was a season high.
- BGSU currently sits in ninth place in the MAC standings, and only eight teams will qualify for the MAC Tournament. However, no fewer than six teams are separated by just one game in the league standings. The teams tied for fourth place, KSU and Western Michigan, each are 8-7 in the MAC, with Ball State, Ohio and Northern Illinois all at .500.
- BGSU is scheduled to play a lot of games during the year's shortest month. The Falcons are slated to play 10 games in a 25-day span during February. Monday's KSU contest is the fifth in a stretch of six games in just 12 days.
- Monday marks the Falcons' first meeting with Kent State this season. The game was originally scheduled to be played on Jan. 12. The Falcons and Golden Flashes are now scheduled to meet twice in a 10-day span, as the return match is set for Wednesday, March 2, at the Stroh.
- For what it's worth, BGSU is 8-3 in weekday games this season. The Falcons are 6-2 in such contests during MAC play (2-0 on Monday and 4-2 on Wednesday), and BG had won six-straight weekday games before falling at Western Michigan (Feb. 16).
- BGSU is 21-12 in MAC regular-season games since the start of the 2020-21 season, after going 8-46 in the previous three seasons (2017-18 to '19-20). That 21-12 record includes a 13-5 mark at the Stroh and an 8-7 ledger in league road games.

• Parker recently broke the school record for games played, and she is moving up another BGSU career list. Parker has made a total of 234 three-point field goals in her career, good for fourth place on that BGSU chart. She is just one triple behind Tracy Pontius (2007-11), who hit 235 treys in her storied Falcon career.

• As a team, the Falcons have made at least one three-point field goal in 543 consecutive games over the last 17 years. That is the fifth-longest active streak in the nation.

• Hempfling has now started 113 career games at BGSU, and ranks seventh on that school list. She has a shot to move into the top-five in school history in that category by the end of the regular season.

• Hempfling is also ranked on the BGSU career lists for scoring (24th), rebounding (11th), assists (sixth) and three-pointers made (T-18th). Parker has broken into the top 40 on the BG career scoring chart, and currently is 35th.

• Entering Monday's game, **Morgan Sharps** leads the MAC – and is fourth in the nation – in three-point field-goal percentage. She has hit 46.7% of her long-distance shots this season.

• **Kenzie Lewis** doesn't shoot the ball quite as often as her aforementioned teammates. But, Lewis made 8-of-10 shots from the floor last week, and averaged 6.0 points, 6.7 rebounds and 5.7 assists in those three games.

BG'S BENCH BUNCH IS BRINGIN' IT

• BGSU has gotten a great deal of production from the bench this season. In fact, by several measurements, the Falcons' bench bunch has been the most productive in the MAC by far this season to date.

• BG players have come off the bench to score a combined 345 points in MAC play this season. That total is more than 40 points higher than any other team in the league. The Falcons' average of 23.0 ppg off the bench leads the conference by a wide margin, as does BGSU's differential of +9.0 bench points per contest.

THIS SEASON TO DATE...

• BGSU is 12-12 on the season, including a 7-8 mark in MAC action (some call it #MACTion). The Falcons had alternated wins and losses since posting back-to-back victories over Eastern Michigan and Western Michigan in late January, but BGSU is now looking to snap a two-game slide, including Saturday (Feb. 19) 82-69 setback to Ohio at the Strohs.

• BGSU dropped an eight-point decision at WMU Wednesday night (Feb. 16), falling by a 72-64 final. Prior to that game, the Falcons had played three games that were decided by 29 points or more. After posting an 81-52 victory at Northern Illinois (Feb. 9) – BG's second win over the Huskies in as many weeks – the Falcons dropped an 80-51 decision to league-leading Toledo last Saturday (Feb. 12). BG bounced back in a big way, with a 94-61 win over Miami Monday night.

• That UT matchup marked the first time all season that BGSU was held below 60 points. The Falcons had amassed at least 64 points in every MAC contest prior to the trip to the Glass City. BGSU is averaging 73.1 points per game, good for third in the league and 36th in the nation.





- BGSU leads the MAC in both field-goal percentage (45.1%) and three-point FG pct. (37.7%). The Falcons are eighth in the country in long-range accuracy and 24th nationally in overall field-goal rate.
 - The Falcons are 8-4 at home, 2-6 on the road and 2-2 in neutral-site matchups this season to date. In MAC play, BGSU is 5-3 at the Strohs and 2-5 at hostile venues.
 - BGSU dropped two games by a combined six points during the Navy Classic over Thanksgiving weekend. Since then, 17 of BG's 19 games have been decided by double digits (with the Falcons going 11-6 in those games).
 - Head coach **Robyn Fralick**, in her fourth season at the helm of the Falcons, returned 10 players off of last year's BGSU roster.
 - The Falcons, after posting records of 10-21 overall and 3-15 in the MAC two years ago, were picked to finish 11th in the 12-team league in 2020-21, according to the preseason coaches' poll. BG proceeded to post a 14-4 MAC record to win the regular-season crown. Then, the Orange and Brown defeated Eastern Michigan and Buffalo in the MAC Tournament in Cleveland, before falling to Central Michigan in the championship game.
 - BGSU advanced to the WNIT, finishing with a 21-8 overall record. and tying for the second-best turnaround in the nation (a +12.0 game improvement). This season, the Falcons were tabbed for second in the MAC in the preseason coaches' poll.
- PARKER PLAYS A PIVOTAL PART (WITH THE KEY WORD BEING "PLAYS")**
- After starting all 31 games two years ago, **Madisen Parker** has successfully transitioned into a role as one of BGSU's top players off the bench since that time. Parker played in 26 of BGSU's 30 games as a freshman in 2017-18, and has appeared in every one of BGSU's games over the last three-plus seasons.
 - In fact, the fifth-year Falcon has set a school record. She came off the bench vs. NIU on Feb. 9 to play in her 136th game as a Falcon. Parker has now played in 140 career games, and is all alone in first place on that BGSU list.
 - The old record of 135 career games played was shared by the trio of Tracy Pontius, Lauren Prochaska and Jen Uhl (all of whom played from 2007-11).

HEMPFLING MOVES UP THE START CHART

- After coming off the bench to make her collegiate debut (at Michigan State; Nov. 6, 2018), **Kadie Hempfling** has started every BGSU game since that time. Hempfling has played in 114 games, making 113 total (and 113 consecutive) starts in the Orange and Brown.
- Hempfling recently moved past Lindsay Austin (110 starts from 2000-04) into seventh place on the BGSU list for most career games started. Her next target is Jackie Motycka, who made 115 career starts from 1985-89.

MILESTONES APLENTY FOR HEMPFLING

- Senior **Kadie Hempfling** scored the 1,000th point of her career in BGSU's win over Western Michigan on Jan. 26. Three days later against Toledo, she pulled down her 700th rebound as a Falcon. Then, last Monday (Feb. 14) vs. Miami, she dished out the 400th assist of her career.

>> Junior **Elissa Brett**, a native of Australia, is the third sibling to play collegiate basketball in the U.S., joining her two sisters, Aimee (Iowa Western CC) and Kelsey (Hutchinson CC and Newberry [S.C.] College).

>> Sophomore **Jasmine Clerkley** attended the same high school (Okemos, H.S.; Okemos, Mich.) as head coach **Robyn Fralick**.

>> Redshirt junior **Molly Dever's** brother, Kevin, is a member of the football team at Akron after transferring from Ohio State.

>> Sophomore **Lexi Fleming's** parents, Dan and Melissa, both played collegiate basketball at Northern Kentucky Univ. In her second-ever game as a Falcon, Lexi scored 11 points in a win at NKU.

>> Fleming's family owns a funnel cake food truck in the Cincinnati area.

>> Sophomore **Nyla Hampton** can solve a Rubik's cube in under a minute.

>> Senior **Kadie Hempfling** played softball and soccer, in addition to basketball, at Ottawa-Glandorf H.S. She led the soccer team in scoring as a junior, before moving to goalkeeper late in her senior season.

>> Sophomore **Kenzie Lewis** was the starting quarterback on a boys football team in fourth grade, and also was involved in competitive figure skating as a child.

>> All three of freshman **Jocelyn Tate's** siblings, as well as her father, play or played collegiate basketball. Her father, Jermaine, played at Ohio State and Cincinnati, and played professionally overseas.

>> Tate's brother, Jae'Sean, played at Ohio State and currently plays in the NBA for the Houston Rockets. Her other brother, Jalen, played at NKU and Arkansas and currently plays for Giessen 46ers in Germany. Her sister, Jada, is a junior on the women's basketball team at Tiffin (where she is coached by former BGSU women's basketball standout Miriam Justinger).

• Entering the KSU contest, Hempfling ranks sixth in BGSU history in assists, 11th in rebounds and 24th in scoring. She is also tied for 18th in three-pointers made.

KATE ACHTER. KADIE HEMPFLING. THAT'S IT. THAT'S THE LIST.

• In the first five decades of BGSU women's basketball, only one player – Kate Achter – had amassed both 500 rebounds and 300 assists in her career. Last season, that list doubled, as **Kadie Hempfling** joined Achter in that exclusive club. Entering the KSU matchup, Hempfling has totals of 739 boards and 404 assists.

• Achter (2004-08), a member of the BGSU Athletics Hall of Fame, had a school-record 688 assists and exactly 500 rebounds in her storied Falcon career.

KADIE HEMPFLING. THAT'S IT. THAT'S THE LIST.

• **Kadie Hempfling** entered the Jan. 26 game vs. WMU as the only player in BGSU history to have grabbed at least 600 rebounds and dished out at least 300 assists.

• Following that game, she was the only Falcon ever to total 600 boards, 300 assists AND 1,000 points, after reaching the millennium mark during the third quarter.

• One game later (the first Toledo contest), Hempfling became the only player in program history with 1,000 points, 300 assists and SEVEN hundred rebounds.

• Now, she is the lone Falcon with 1,000 points, 700 boards and FOUR hundred assists in her career.

• Hempfling ranks sixth in BGSU history in career assists (with 404), trailing five players who each dished out over 500 dimes in the Orange and Brown.

• With 1,086 points, Hempfling is now 24th in career scoring at BGSU, having passed Judit Lendvay (1,078 points from 1989-93) in Saturday's Ohio game. Hempfling's next target is Stefanie Wenzel, who had 1,099 points from 2000-04.

• On the rebounding list, Hempfling ranks 11th, having moved past Sue Pokelsek (727 from 1979-83) last Monday. She is 14 rebounds shy of tying Alexis Rogers (753 boards from 2011-14) for 10th place in school history.

• Hempfling hit her 116th career three-point field goal in the Ohio game, and is now tied for 18th place on that BGSU list. She is just two triples shy of 16th place.

FALCONS VS. THE MAC

• The Falcons own the second-best record in MAC history. Entering the KSU contest, BGSU has an all-time record of 431-253 (.631) in MAC regular-season games, for the second-highest winning percentage of all league institutions. BG also has the second-most conference wins of all 12 programs.

• BGSU leads the all-time series with all 11 MAC foes, making the Falcons the only team in the league with a winning record against every other school. BG also has the most overall victories and highest overall winning pct. of any league institution.

SHARPS-SHOOTING FALCON – MORGAN'S FOURTH IN THE NATION

• In her first season in a BGSU uniform, **Morgan Sharps** has given the Falcons yet another viable long-range threat, to say the least. The Xavier transfer currently leads the MAC – and is fourth in the entire nation – in three-point field-goal percentage. Sharps made five triples vs. Ohio, and is hitting 46.7% of her attempts from the arc, having gone 57-of-122 from long distance.



• The redshirt sophomore currently has 2.38 successful three-pointers per game, and ranks 59th in the country in treys per game and 58th in total triples made.

I AM NUMBER FOUR

• **Madisen Parker** enters the Kent State game with a total of 234 three-point field goals made in her storied Falcon career, ranking her fourth on that BGSU career list.

• Parker, who knocked down four triples vs. Ohio, is now just one behind third-place Tracy Pontius (235 from 2007-11). The legendary Lauren Prochaska holds the record with 310 triples in her Falcon tenure (2007-11).

• Parker has 918 career points, and has moved into the top 40 on that BGSU list. She moved up two spots on that list against Ohio, and her next target is 34th place Kim Griech (931 points from 1999-2003).

MADIS3N PARK3R

• **Madisen Parker** has recorded two of the top-three seasons in BG history in terms of three-point field-goal percentage. For her career, she is hitting shots from beyond the arc at a 43.5% rate, ranking third among active NCAA Division-I players. She trails only Texas Tech's Lexy Hightower and Oklahoma's Taylor Robertson on that list.

THREE-MENDOUS

• BG extended an impressive streak in the Ohio game. The Falcons now have made at least one three-pointer in each of the last 543 contests. BG has not been held without a triple in nearly 17 years – since Feb. 12, 2005, at Akron, when the Falcons won, 61-52, despite going 0-of-13 from the arc. BGSU's active streak of games with at least one made trey is the fifth-longest in the nation.

THE STARTING FIVE

• BGSU has utilized eight different starting lineups this season to date. The Falcons had six different starting lineups during all of last season, but only four through the first 27 games of the year.

• Eight different players have started at least one game this year. **Kadie Hempfling** has been in the starting lineup for all 24 games, while **Nyla Hampton** has made 23 starts, **Amy Velasco** 21, **Elissa Brett** 19, **Kenzie Lewis** 15 and **Morgan Sharps** 12.

A LITTLE BACKGROUND INFO ABOUT THE FALCONS

• Have we mentioned that BGSU won 21 total games and the MAC regular-season title in 2020-21? We have? Well they did.

• A total of 10 letterwinners from that club, including all five starters, are on the roster in 2021-22. BG's top-five scorers are back from a year ago, including All-MAC performers **Lexi Fleming** and **Kadie Hempfling**. Fleming, a sophomore, was named the MAC Freshman of the Year after averaging a team-high 15.9 points per game, and she also was chosen to the All-MAC Second Team. Fleming's total of 67 steals was the highest by a freshman in BGSU history.

NET GAINS

- The 2020-21 season marked the unveiling of the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) for women's basketball. The NET replaced RPI as a team sorting tool, and is used to measure a team's quality and help evaluate team resumes for selection and seeding in the NCAA tournament.
- In a nutshell, NET ranking is determined by who you played, where you played, how efficiently you played and the result of the game.
- The Falcons were ranked 54th in the first NET listings of the 2020-21 season, and BG wound up ranked 65th out of the 343 NCAA Division-I teams who played at least one game during 2020-21.
- Just for comparison's sake, BGSU had finished 253rd of 351 teams in the final 2019-20 RPI rankings.
- BGSU was ranked 118th in the nation in the most recent listings (Sun., Feb. 20).

- Fleming suffered an injury during the preseason, however, and will miss the 2021-22 campaign.
- Hempfling, a senior, earned all-league third-team honors a year ago after averaging 12.4 points and 5.9 rebounds per contest. She ranked among the top-three players on the team in scoring, rebounding and assists (3.0 apg), and led the Falcons in plus/minus ratio.
- Junior **Elissa Brett** rounds out BG's returning double-digit scorers. Brett averaged 12.0 ppg and led the Falcons in rebounding (6.7 rpg). She led the Orange and Brown in scoring at tournament time, averaging 13.8 ppg in BG's six tournament games (three MAC Tournament and three WNIT contests).
- Sophomore **Nyla Hampton** and fifth-year Falcon **Madisen Parker** scored 9.3 and 7.4 ppg, respectively, last season. Hampton joined Fleming on the MAC's All-Freshman Team, and also was chosen to the MAC All-Defensive Team. She was second on the Falcons in both assists (2.8) and steals (2.3) per game, and shot 63 percent from the field in BG's three WNIT games.
- Parker, after leading the entire nation in three-point field-goal percentage two years ago, finished 11th in the country last season. She shot 45.0% from the arc, making a team-high 58 long-range attempts.
- Sophomore **Kenzie Lewis** was one of just two Falcons to start all 29 games last year, joining Hempfling in that category. Lewis averaged 4.9 ppg despite attempting fewer than three shots per contest, and led the team in assists (3.1 apg) while ranking second in both rebounds (6.1) and steals (2.0).
- Redshirt junior **Molly Dever** and sophomores **Jasmine Clerkley**, **Sophie Dziekan** and **Olivia Hill** round out the Falcons' returnees.
- Fralick and the Falcons welcomed four newcomers (all Ohio natives) to this year's roster, including redshirt sophomore **Morgan Sharps** (Granville, Ohio), a transfer from Xavier. BG's trio of freshmen include **Zoe Miller** (Berlin, Ohio), **Jocelyn Tate** (Pickerington, Ohio) and **Amy Velasco** (Centerville, Ohio).
- Through 24 games this season, Hempfling and Brett have averaged 11.1 and 11.8 ppg, respectively, with Velasco at 10.6 and Sharps 10.2 ppg. That quartet paces a balanced scoring attack which features six players averaging at least 8.1 points per outing. Hampton has 8.2 ppg, while Miller has 8.1, Tate 6.2 and Parker 5.3.
- Brett leads the team with 6.1 rebounds per game, with Tate and Hempfling pulling down 4.9 each and Lewis 4.8. Lewis tops the Falcons in assists (4.0 apg), while Hampton is second in that category (2.8 apg) and leads the team in steals (2.7 spg) and blocked shots (0.5 bpg).
- In MAC games only, three players – Velasco (12.0 ppg), Hempfling (11.6) and Brett (11.4) – have scored between 160 and 180 points. Brett has 6.4 rpg and Hempfling 5.3 rpg in conference contests, while Parker (44.7%), Sharps (43.9%), Velasco (39.2%) and Brett (39.1%) all have shot at least 39% from the arc against MAC foes.

BOWLING GREEN BASKETBALL

• Overall, a total of five Falcons – Sharps (57), Hempfling (36), Parker (33), Velasco (25) and Brett (23) – have hit more than 20 three-pointers this season.

• Miller leads the Falcons with an average of 23.6 points per 40 minutes, and fellow Falcon freshman Tate has a team-best 12.0 rebounds per 40 minutes.

CAPTAINS

• **Molly Dever, Lexi Fleming, Kadie Hempfling and Madisen Parker** are the captains of the 2021-22 Falcons. "As we went through the process (of naming captains), it was clear that those four are really admired by their teammates," said **Robyn Fralick**. "I love that they are a very complementary group; they really bring different strengths. Together, they really have a good pulse on the team."

A QUICK LOOK AT THE GOLDEN FLASHES

• Kent State is 16-8 on the season, and the Golden Flashes have an 8-7 record in MAC play. KSU had won six-straight games before suffering a 73-64 loss at Akron on Saturday. The Flashes are 9-2 at home, 5-5 on the road and 2-1 at neutral sites this season. In conference play, KSU is 5-2 in Kent and 3-5 at hostile venues.

• Katie Shumate leads the team in scoring, with 12.5 points per game. She paces a balanced attack which includes four players averaging at least 11.2 ppg. One of those four, Nila Blackford, has 11.5 ppg and a KSU-best 9.3 rebounds per contest. Head coach Todd Starkey welcomed back nine letterwinners, including all five starters, from a 2020-21 club that went 11-9 overall and 10-6 in the MAC.

THE SERIES

• The Falcons lead Kent State, 58-37, in the all-time series, and BGSU has captured the last two meetings. The Orange and Brown swept last season's matchups, including an 82-65 triumph at the Stroh Center (March 3, 2022). Prior to that, the teams' last two meetings each had required overtime, including last year's contest at the M.A.C. Center, an 80-79 BGSU win (Feb. 10, 2021). BGSU is 29-13 in home games, 22-22 in road contests and 7-2 in neutral-site affairs vs. KSU over the years.

• A busy stretch of games continues for the Orange and Brown. Following Monday night's matchup in Kent, the Falcons return home to face Akron on Wednesday (Feb. 23), with tipoff set for 7:00 p.m. at the Stroh.

• That game, barring any additional schedule changes, begins the Falcons' return to the originally-planned Wednesday-Saturday schedule. BGSU takes to the road this weekend for a Saturday (Feb. 26) matchup at Miami.

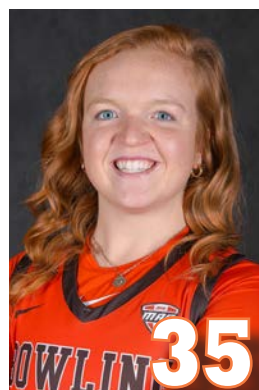
