Registration: All entries will be submitted through Direct Athletics. The entry deadline is Tuesday, October 14th at 9:00pm. Unattached athletes will be allowed, contact the meet director for specifics. This will be an open meet and will be scored.

Entry Fee: \$300 per gender. Payment and packet pickup will be at the finish line after 3:00pm the day of the race. There is no charge for unattached athletes. Cash, check, or payment on Direct Athletics will be accepted.

XC Course: The BG XC Course is a well-marked grass course consists of spectator friendly loops. It includes a permanent finish line structure and granite distance markers (K's/Mile's). Course maps are linked below and can be found on the www.bgsufalcons.com website.

Team & Spectator Parking: Team parking will be in the grass lot next to the team camp area, see the <u>facility map</u> for specifics. A campus map can be found by clicking on this <u>link</u>. Enter campus from Wooster Street, using the Alumni Drive at the round-about, taking Stadium Drive to the parking areas. Teams and spectators will be directed to the proper lots from there. All spectators will be charged \$10 per vehicle, coaches please pass this information onto your parents. These lots are grass, so in the event of a flooding rain we will utilize asphalt lots and communicate via Twitter and e-mail those changes.

Team Camps: Team camps will be located on the football practice fields adjacent to the starting line. These fields are fenced and gated. Tents are welcome. Reference the <u>facilities map</u> for specifics.
