Interviews

Media Availability: Head coach John Troxell and members of the team will be available each Tuesday at noon for weekly media luncheons in Pfennig Alumni Center.

Media members wishing to attend practice should contact Phil LaBella for availability and to pre-arrange interviews.

Cyber Lunch: Clips of the weekly media luncheon will be available on GoLeopards.com and also on social media shortly after its conclusion. Audio files are also available upon request.

Post-game Interviews: Post-game interviews will typically be held on Fisher Field. In event of inclement weather, interviews will be moved into Bourger Varsity Football House.

FBS Foes: For the first time since 1993 (Buffalo and Army), Lafayette will face two FBS opponents in a season, playing Bowling Green and Oregon State in 2025.

Lafayette opened 2024 at Buffalo and faced No. 21 Duke in week two of 2023. The Leopards have sprinkled in FBS opponents intermittently over the last eight seasons, playing Army in 2016 and 2018, Air Force in 2021 and Temple in 2022. The Leopards are slated to play Connecticut, Air Force and Akron in the coming seasons.

From Falcons to Leopards: Lafayette has a trio of athletic connections to Bowling Green, as Senior AD's Andrew Foster and Carly Riepenhoff are both graduates of the university. Foster played baseball for the Falcons, while Riepenhoff was a member of the softball team. Thursday will also serve as a reunion for DL **Joey Shimko**, who spent 2024 on the Bowling Green football roster. Current Leopard offensive coordinator **T.J. DiMuzio** spent four seasons at Bowling Green, first as a defensive graduate assistant working with the defensive ends in 2009-10. In 2011, he was elevated to director of player personnel and also served as the assistant special teams coordinator and recruiting coordinator.

Captains of the Ship: Seniors **Dean DeNobile**, **Elijah Steward**, **Brian Baucia** and **Phillip Peiffer** all were selected as recipients of the Chris LaPietra '89 Captain Award ahead of the 2025 slate.

For DeNobile, it's the second straight season that the QB has been named team captain. Steward earns captaincy after leading the Lafayette offense in receiving for the third straight season. Baucia returns to anchor the interior of the offensive line, a position that he's held for 33 games over three seasons. Peiffer returned to Easton for a fifth season after a season-ending injury in 2024.



Preseason All-Patriot League: Senior WR **Elijah Steward** and junior LS **Dylan Aguilera** garnered Preseason All-Patriot League honors. For Steward, the nomination marks consecutive preseason all-conference selections. The Galloway, N.J. native followed up the honor in 2024 with a season that earned him a spot on the All-Patriot League Second-Team. Aguilera was chosen for the honor for the first time in his career after starting in all 12 games last year, joining Steward on the All-Patriot League Second-Team.

700 Level: The Lafayette football program reached the 700-win plateau with the dominating victory over Lehigh in the 2023 regular-season finale. The Leopards, whose inaugural season was 1882, rank 51st among all levels of college football with 706 wins.

Local Flavor: Since **John Troxell** took over in 2022, he has placed an emphasis on retaining local talent from the greater Lehigh Valley region. Troxell, a Phillipsburg graduate, added his alma mater's **Matthew Scerbo** as part of the Class of '29.

Nazareth has accounted for the most recent surge in local recruiting as OL **Sean Kinney** was a member of the Class of 2028 and started 11 games in his rookie season, joining WR **Mason Kuehner** who played in every game with four starts and took over return duties. This season, Troxell welcomes WR **Caleb Newsome** from Nazareth, all of whom played for Leopard alum **Tom Falzone '00**. Junior **Sean Wilson** is an Easton native who started six games at right tackle in 2024, one of three players from Easton along with junior QB **Peyton Cosover** and senior LB **Jack Bayly**.

Junior **Ethan Hosak**, who is battling for the starting spot at tight end, played at Allentown Central Catholic, while rookie LB **Justin Peluso** hails from Freedom High School in Bethlehem, having played for Jason Roeder, brother of current Lafayette passing game coordinator coach **Ryan Roeder**.

4K For Dean DeNobile: With 275 yards against Stonehill (11/16/24), QB **Dean DeNobile** surpassed 4,000 career passing yards for his career. He finished his junior campaign with 4,414 career passing yards, ranking ninth all-time at Lafayette and needing 556 passing yards to move into eighth spot. He also rests ninth in career completions (396), with 33 catches standing between him and eighth place.

Lining Up: Lafayette used six different starting lineups on the offensive line in 2024 (due to injuries). By contrast, the Leopards employed one starting front five for all of 2023. The Leopards sent out nine linemen as starters in 2024 using Ryder Langsdale (LT), **Brian Baucia** (LG), **Sean Kinney** (C), **Reed Collins** (RG) and **Sean Wilson** (RT) as the front five in the final six games. All but Langsdale, who transferred to Rutgers, return to the fold.



Dose of Penza: Sophomore QB **Jason Penza** received plenty of action in his freshman campaign. Offensive coordinator **T.J. DiMuzio** used Penza as a dual-threat option, adding another dimension to the Lafayette offense. In seven games, Penza tallied 28 rushing attempts for 171 yards, 52 of which came against Bucknell (11/2). The Crystal Lake, Ill. native completed five of his six passing attempts for 31 yards.

On the Charts: With 141 career receptions, senior WR **Elijah Steward** needs five more catches to move into seventh place, occupied by Mark Layton '11 (146). The economics major currently has accumulated 1,743 career receiving yards, requiring 37 yards to slide into eighth place all-time ahead of Layton (1,780). Steward already holds the Lafayette single-game receptions record with 15 at Monmouth in 2024.

The Patriot Poll: Lafayette was picked fifth in the Patriot League preseason poll announced July 23. The ballot, voted on by conference coaches and sports information directors, placed the Leopards (47) behind Lehigh (97), Richmond (83), Holy Cross (78) and Bucknell (51) and ahead of Georgetown (32), Colgate (31) and Fordham (29). In 2024, Lafayette was selected first in the preseason poll and finished fourth.

The Opponent: Bowling Green hosts the Leopards for the first game in the Eddie George era, as the former Heisman winner was hired by the Falcons after four years at Tennessee State. After Lafayette, Bowling Green takes on Cincinnati, Liberty and Louisville before facing eight straight MAC opponents.

Bowling Green boasts a revamped roster, bringing in 27 transfers to rework the offense and defense. Projected to lead the Falcon offense is QB Drew Pyne. Named to the Wuerffel Trophy Preseason Watch List, Pyne brings experience from stops at Notre Dame, Arizona State and Missouri. TE Arlis Boardingham will vie for a role in the passing game after transferring from Florida, where he had 44 catches for 417 yards and six touchdowns.

Defensively, CB Jalen McClendon and DL Eriq George look to continue the success they had at Tennessee State. McClendon was a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award, tallying 66 tackles, 15 PBUs and one interception. George follows his father to Bowling Green after racking up 57 tackles, 12.5 TFLs and 5.5 sacks in 2024.

Under Center: **Dean DeNobile** has started 23 of 24 games the last two seasons. The Upper Saddle River, N.J. native completed 67 percent of his throws for nearly 2,000 yards with 20 touchdowns to just five interceptions while helping lead the Leopards to a conference title in 2023. The former walk-on led the conference and was 13th in the nation in completion percentage and 14th in passing efficiency (154.4). DeNobile tossed three TDs and ran for another to garner game MVP honors vs. Lehigh (11/18) and secure his third Patriot League Offensive Player of the Week honor. Against Bucknell, he threw four TDs (the first Leopard to do so since 2015) in the second quarter to four different receivers in a 56-point effort.

In 2024, the junior captain was a preseason All-Patriot League selection. In his home state taking on Monmouth in week two, the QB completed 31-of-45 for 394 yards with two TDs, all career highs. DeNobile earned Patriot League Offensive Player of the Week honors after his performance in the Leopards' home-opener against Marist, completing 87 percent of his throws for 241 yards and a TD.

John Troxell '94 | Fred M. Kirby '42 Head Football Coach | 4th Season at Lafayette, 20th Overall



John Troxell '94 is in his fourth season as the Fred M. Kirby II '42 Head Football Coach. Troxell is the 29th coach in the program's history, third who is an alum.

The Leopards are coming off a 2024 campaign in which the program climbed as high as No. 14 in the national polls while garnering eight all-league selections and two All-America laurels.

2023 saw the Leopards progress ahead of schedule. In his second campaign, Troxell guided Lafayette to a Patriot League title. Lafayette ran to a 9-3 record, surpassing the single-season win total from the previous 40 years. The Maroon and White jumped back into the top 25 polls for the first time since 2009, entering the

rankings after a win at No. 11 Holy Cross that snapped the Crusaders' 18-game conference winning streak. Lafayette ascended as high as No. 16 and finished at No. 19 in the AFCA Poll and 21st in the Stats Perform poll.

The 2023 season saw Billy Shaeffer, Jamar Curtis, Saiku White and Ryder Langsdale garner All-America status. Shaeffer was named to the final three in the nation for the Buck Buchanan award after leading the conference with 10 sacks (the second-most ever in a season at Lafayette and 10th in the nation) and 21.5 tackles for loss (fourth in the nation). Curtis was tagged as a finalist for the Walter Payton Award, finishing second in the nation in rushing (1,460 yards) to set a new Lafayette single-season rushing record. White helped guide a defense that led the league in scoring, rushing and red-zone defense.

Shaeffer, Curtis and White were among 12 Leopards named to the All-Patriot League teams. Jaylon Joseph earned League Rookie of the Year honors (the 12th in program history) and was selected as a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award. Troxell was the Patriot League Coach of the Year and singled out as a finalist for the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year after the swift turnaround.

He began re-shaping the program in 2022 with a third-place conference finish, despite an offense that was significantly affected by injuries. Lafayette opened with a shutout of Sacred Heart in Troxell's debut and added league road victories over Bucknell and Colgate before wrapping the season with a victory over Lehigh. The Leopards also took NCAA quarterfinalist Holy Cross to the wire in a 24-21 final. In 2022, Troxell saw Malik Hamm earn Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year honors, as the conference's first five-time All-Patriot League selection, before signing with the Baltimore Ravens.

Troxell came to College Hill after a 16-year head coaching stint at Franklin and Marshall College where he molded the program into a consistent winner. Prior to his arrival at the Lancaster, Pa. school in 2006, F&M had managed one winning season in the previous 13 campaigns. Four years later, after a full recruiting cycle, the Diplomats finished with a 9-2 record and have continued to climb, subsequently reaching the postseason on nine occasions.

Troxell was twice named the Centennial Conference Coach of the Year, winning most recently in 2017 and 2009 when he was also a finalist for the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year national award. The program's high-water mark came in 2017 when the team was 10-1 and captured its conference championship. That season kicked off a span from 2017-21 when Troxell and Franklin and Marshall posted a cumulative mark of 31-13. In his 16 seasons, Troxell posted a 92-67 overall record, ranking second in career coaching wins at the school where he coached 111 all-conference selections.

Troxell has been a key ingredient in program rebuilds at each of his stops, and his time on College Hill as an assistant coach on Frank Tavani's staff was no exception. He served various roles as the running backs coach, recruiting coordinator and special teams coach from 2001-05. His selection as the recruiting coordinator in 2003 helped kick off a stretch of three straight titles for the Leopards in 2004, 2005 and 2006 that coincided with the program's first three NCAA FCS Playoff appearances.

As an assistant at Lafayette, he mentored 2004 Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year Joe McCourt '05 to a record-setting career. McCourt, the

2001 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, concluded his career as Lafayette's and the Patriot League's all-time leader with 50 rushing touchdowns and was second on the school's all-time rushing list with 4,474 yards while earning All-America honors in 2002 and 2004. He also mentored Brandon Stanford '06 who set the current Lafayette single-season record for punt return yardage and ranks 11th in career receiving.

Prior to Lafayette, Troxell was part of a dramatic reversal at Muhlenberg College from 1997-2000 under head coach Mike Donnelly. He served multiple roles, working as the special teams coordinator (1997-99), quarterbacks coach and wide receivers coach (1997-2000) and offensive coordinator (2000). Muhlenberg progressed from a 1-9 season in 1997 to the Eastern College Athletic Conference title with a record of 9-2 in 2000.

Troxell joined the Muhlenberg staff after serving as an assistant coach for three seasons (1994-96) at Columbia under head coach Ray Tellier, beginning his career path of coaching at elite academic institutions. In 1996, Troxell oversaw a secondary that recorded the third-best passing defense in the country. The turnaround tendency first showed itself at Columbia in 1994 when the Ivy League school recorded its first winning season in 23 seasons. An 8-2 mark and the program's best finish in 15 years followed in 1996.

His first extended stint on College Hill came as a student-athlete from 1990-94, when he earned his bachelor's degree in government and law. Troxell was the starting free safety on the Leopards' 1992 Patriot League title team and received the Unsung Hero Award as a senior. He completed his master's degree in sociology and education in 1997 while on staff at Columbia.

A Phillipsburg, N.J. native, the 53-year-old Troxell and his wife, Pamela, have two daughters, Summer and Capri, both of whom attend Lafayette.

Hall of Fame Weekend: The Lafayette Maroon Club will hold its annual Hall of Fame Induction Dinner on the eve of Rivalry 161. Penny (Erisman/Ferency) Bermender '91, James Conrad '07, Deanna DiCroce '13, Mike Joseph '88, Matt Lancor '88 and Bill Lawson will be inducted into the Maroon Club Hall of Fame's Class of 2025-26 during the Hall of Fame Dinner on Friday, Nov. 21 at Kirby Sports Center.

Joseph was a defensive back at Lafayette, later returning as the program's defensive backs coach and recruiting coordinator from 1992-2002. As a freshman, he was the program's rookie of the year. The Allentown, Pa. native led the Colonial League in interceptions (7) in 1986 and ranked 16th nationally. He set the fifth-best single-season mark by modern Patriot League history standards and claimed second place on Lafayette's all-time single-season interceptions list.

Over his four years, he became Lafayette's all-time leader in picks and was named the team MVP while garnering All-Colonial League First-Team honors in 1987. The Industrial Engineering major left College Hill with a 22-22 overall record. He was also a member of the Phi Gamma Delta fraternity.

Joseph then earned his master's degree from Villanova in addition to working as a football graduate assistant coach under Andy Talley for two years. During his return tenure on the Leopard staff in 1992, he continued to shape the program with his expertise and leadership alongside Hall of Fame head coach Bill Russo. Joseph was privileged to recruit and guide over five future Hall of Fame players as well.

In 2009, he went on to be the lead color analyst for Astound Television Network (formerly RCN), broadcasting local Lehigh Valley high school and Lafayette College football for the past 16 years.

Front Five: The offensive line is led by senior captain **Brian Baucia**, who's started 33 games over three seasons. Sophomore **Sean Kinney**, will slot in at center after seeing time at both right and left guard in his freshman campaign and starting the final six games at center. Junior **Sean Wilson**, who played the final six games of 2024 at right tackle, slides down the line to left tackle.

Senior **Reed Collins** sticks at right tackle after starting all 12 games in 2024. Next to Collins is senior **Spencer Adams**, who appeared in nine games while making five starts. Junior **Michael Dincher** will fill in at both guard spots as a backup after action in five contests. Junior **Addison Hoffman** and sophomore **Connor Gaines** serve as the backup tackles, while rookie **Parker Moss** will be the reserve center.

Running The Ball: After producing a 1,000-yard rusher in back-to-back seasons, head coach **John Troxell** will deal with a completely revamped running back room.

Junior **Kente Edwards** steps into the role of lead back. While mainly appearing on special teams, the Annandale, N.J. native made the most of his limited snaps. Edwards averaged 8.5 yards on eight carries, racking up 68 yards on the ground.

Junior **Ethan Weber** tallied 20 attempts in the run game in 2024, collecting 97 yards in addition to 211 kick return yards. After switching from WR to RB in the Spring, sophomore **Jakyre Henley** will serve as a third option in the backfield.

The D Line: The defensive line will have a new look in 2025.

Leading the unit is senior captain and defensive tackle **Phillip Peiffer**, who returns for a fifth season on College Hill after a season-ending injury in 2024. Prior to the injury, Peiffer racked up 10 tackles in two games.

Junior **Jaylon Joseph**, the only returning starter from last year's defense, moves to defensive end, bringing 20 tackles and seven TFLs with him. After missing nine games to injury, junior **Ahmir Crawley** takes over at nose tackle. Lining up at the other defensive end position is junior **Darien Riley** after appearing in all 12 games last season.

Junior **Michael Vaughn** and sophomore **Olivier Camerlain** are the only two returning defensive linemen back in the mix for the Leopards, with both players expected to see time at tackle. Transfers **Callahan Blair** and **Joey Shimko** join the Lafayette defense with the goal of solidifying the edges.

QB Corps: Senior captain **Dean DeNobile** reprises his role as signal caller for the Maroon and White in 2025. A three-year starter and two-time captain, DeNobile enters the campaign in ninth in both career passing yards and completions. The Upper Saddle River, N.J. native reached new highs in 2024, going 226-of-347 for 2,417 yards (a career high) and 14 touchdowns. DeNobile ranked 24th in the nation in completion percentage (65.1) and 23rd in completions per game (18.8).

Soph. **Jason Penza** took over as QB2 midway through the season and made the most of his opportunities. Primarily being



used as a running option, Penza carried 28 times for 171 yards, including 52 yards against Bucknell. The Crystal Lake Ill. native attempted six passes, completing five of them for 31 yards.

Junior **Daniel Lipovski** enters the fold for the Leopards after transferring from Delaware. The Burke, Va. native saw limited time at Delaware, appearing in three games over two seasons. In high school, Lipovski was a two-year starter who threw for 5,800 yards and 66 touchdowns.

In the Classroom: Lafayette athletic programs continue to excel on a national level. The Nov. 2024 release of the NCAA Division I annual Graduation Success Rate (GSR) report shined a light on those academic achievements.

Lafayette claimed a 97 percent GSR overall for its 19 sports measured while 16 Leopard teams achieved a graduation success rate of 100 percent.

In addition to those programs with perfect GSR scores, the Leopard football program had the eighth best score (93) in the country. Lafayette joined schools from the SEC, ACC, CAA, Big Ten and the Ivy League in the top 10.

Hamm in NFL With Baltimore Ravens: Malik Hamm '23, a five-time All-Patriot League selection and two-time Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year is currently with the Baltimore Ravens. He signed an undrafted free agent contract in April 2023 and is in his third season.

Hamm, a Baltimore native, left Lafayette as the school's career sacks leader (32), and fittingly the final play of the final game of his collegiate career was a game-ending sack of Lehigh's quarterback in a 14-11 win in Rivalry 158 on Nov. 19, 2022. He also ranks fourth in the Patriot League annals for career sacks.



Welcome Home: The Leopards added a slew of transfer players from the portal prior to the season. QB **Daniel Lipovski** and RB **Payton Greer** come to Easton from Delaware and Arkansas State, respectively. TE **Zack Zandier** is expected to vie for playing time after coming from Coastal Carolina.

Defensively, the Maroon and White added DL **Joey Shimko** from Bowling Green, LB **Beckham Dee** from Penn State and DL **Callahan Blair** from Vanderbilt. All three bolster the trenches and revitalize the Leopard pass rush.

It Tolls for Thee: "The Bell" has become a fixture on the Lafayette sideline. In lieu of a turnover chain, title belt, etc., head coach John Troxell supplied a bell which players ring after securing a turnover or scoring a touchdown or a field goal.

In the Top 25 in 2024: Lafayette was ranked in the top 25 in the first four weeks of 2024 before a loss at eventual Ivy League champ Columbia knocked the Leopards out of both polls. Lafayette debuted at 17th (Stats Perform) and 18th (AFCA), rising as high as No. 14 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll.

In 2023, Lafayette peaked at No. 16 on Oct. 30, the highest any Leopard team reached in the Patriot League era until this season.

Weekly Awards: Lafayette pulled down a pair of Patriot League weekly awards following the Marist win. Junior QB **Dean DeNobile** was the Offensive Player of the Week, while freshman defensive back **Xavier Johnson** was named Rookie of the Week.

DeNobile completed his first 14 passes en route to a 20-of-23 day that included 241 yards and a touchdown. He did not play the final 27 minutes of the game.

Johnson has played every game on special teams and in the defensive backfield. In the first quarter, Johnson recovered a blocked punt in the endzone for a TD to start off the Leopards' scoring. In the third quarter, the Muscle Shoals, Ala. native picked off his first career pass.

Senior CB **Gabe DuBois** was named Defensive Player of the

Week (10/7) after posting nine tackles and five pass breakups, including three on the final drive, in a win at Fordham.

Early Scoring Frenzy: Lafayette's offense erupted for a combined 96 points against Monmouth (40) and Marist (56). The last time the Leopards scored at least 96 points over a two-game span was October 1986 when Lafayette rang up 103 points in road victories over Davidson (51) and Bucknell (52).

National Notice: WR **Elijah Steward** was named the Stats Perform FCS National Offensive Player of the Week and the Patriot League Offensive Player of the Week following a performance with 15 catches (school record) for a career-high 244 yards at Monmouth (9/7). The Galloway, N.J. native had receptions of 42, 39 and 21 yards with 102 yards after the catch. In total, he reeled in seven catches of 15-plus yards. Steward snapped the previous school record for receptions in a game: 13 shared by Mark Layton (2010) and Mark Ross (2012). His performance was also the first 200+ yard receiving day for the program since 2006.

Early Returns: Then freshman **Mason Kuehner** came in hot on special teams in the home opener vs. Marist. The Nazareth, Pa. native ripped off a 58-yard punt return for a touchdown, the first punt return for a TD since CJ Amill in 2018. On the season, the economics major had 16 punt returns for 200 yards and a touchdown and three kick returns for 38 yards.

Running the Ball: Lafayette averaged 160.8 rushing yards per game in 2024 (47th in the nation among 123 schools). Jamar Curtis accounted for most of the yards, racking up 1,139 yards (94.9 ypg) for his second straight 1000-yard rushing season. Troy Bruce managed 390 yards as the backup while QB Jason Penza contributed 171 yards on the ground.

Passing the Ball: Lafayette averaged 209.5 passing yards per game in 2024 (60th in the nation among 123 schools). Dean DeNobile managed all but 97 of the team's passing yards on the season, throwing for 2,417 yards while completing 65 percent of his throws (226-347) with 14 touchdowns and 12 interceptions.

— All-Time Notes —

Lafayette’s Football Inventors: Two primary elements of the game of football -- the helmet and the huddle -- were invented by former members of the Lafayette football program. **George “Rose” Barclay** from the Class of 1898, one of Lafayette’s all-time great running backs, invented the helmet when the “threat of cultivating cauliflower ears” led him to piece three thick leather straps around his head for an 1894 game against Penn.

Former Lafayette coach **Herb McCracken** (1924-35; 59-40-6) is often credited with calling the first huddle system during the 1924 season after learning the Penn football team had stolen Lafayette’s signals. Lafayette “huddled” before each play and this system was immediately adopted by other teams. (*Several other schools also lay claim to the huddle*).

The Football Helmet: At the school credited with inventing the football helmet, a quick look at the 2025 version shows maroon player numbers on the right side of the helmet and a Leopard head with the “L” on the left with a metallic stripe down the middle.

On the back of the helmet, a decal highlights the school’s Bicentennial celebration which will kick off in mid-september. Two other decals honor Tom Kirchhoff ’93 and No. 80 Brian Keller ’16.

Patriot League Titles: Lafayette has won eight Patriot League championships in the history of the league (1988, 1992, 1994, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2013, 2023). The 2004-06 titles led to three straight NCAA Playoff appearances, making Lafayette one of six teams in the country to appear in the 16-team field in three consecutive years.

At It A While: Since fielding its first college football team in the fall of 1882 (the same year that coward Robert Ford shot Jesse James in the back and that Tchaikovsky’s *1812 Overture* debuted), Lafayette has had a proud gridiron tradition on the way to a total of **706 victories (706-646-39)**. Lafayette ranked 51st among all college football teams in all-time wins entering the 2025 season, posting its first win in 1883 (25-0 vs. Rutgers). Lafayette accumulated 100 victories by 1900, 200 by 1915 and 300 by 1934. Lafayette is in its 144th season.

Patriot League Football: The Patriot League is in its 39th season as a football conference and is comprised of Bucknell, Colgate, Fordham, Georgetown, Holy Cross, Lehigh and Richmond. Fordham, Georgetown and Richmond are associate members in the 10-team all-sport conference which includes Army, Navy, American, Boston University and Loyola (Md.). American, Boston and Loyola do not field football programs and Army and Navy football compete in the FBS. Villanova and William & Mary are slated to join the conference as associate members in football in 2026.

- The league is known for its academic priority, perennially finishing at or near the top spot in the NCAA’s Graduate Rate Report and in APR rankings.
- The Patriot League presidents voted in February 2012 to begin allowing scholarships with a maximum of 15 per season until reaching a maximum of 60 equivalencies in any given year. The Class of 2017 represented the Leopards’ first class of scholarship student-athletes during the Patriot League era. Previously, financial aid was awarded based solely on financial need.
- Redshirts are granted only for medical reasons. Typically (pre-pandemic), there were only a handful of fifth-year seniors on any given squad.

World Series Champion: Lafayette's most famous football alum made his name on the diamond rather than the gridiron. **Joe Maddon '76** was a two-sport athlete at Lafayette. Wearing No. 12, he completed 14-of-17 for four touchdowns in a win over arch-rival Lehigh in a 1972 freshman game. That was his last football game, as the Hazleton, Pa. native chose to focus on baseball (wearing No. 22). Maddon twice was named the American League Manager of the Year, also earning the honor in the National League (one of seven managers in history to win it in both leagues).

His career-defining moment was guiding the Chicago Cubs to a 2016 World Series title. Maddon last managed the Angels from 2019-22.



Mowins on the Call: Another Lafayette athletic alum has left her mark on the broadcasting industry. On, Sept. 11, 2017, **Beth Mowins '89** became the second woman ever (and the first in 30 years) to broadcast an NFL regular-season game. Mowins joined ESPN in 1994 and has called college football since 2005. She graduated from Lafayette with a degree in English in 1989 after a playing career as a point guard on the basketball team. Mowins was Lafayette's commencement speaker in 2022.

No. 53: Prior to the Harvard game on Oct. 1, 2011, the No. 53 was retired in honor of Fred Morgan Kirby '42, the first retirement of its kind for the football program. Kirby was a member of the 1940 undefeated football team that ran through the likes of Army, Rutgers and Lehigh, while allowing just 33 points in a nine-game slate. After graduating from Lafayette, Kirby served in Europe in World War II and later earned his master's degree from Harvard. He served as the chairman of the Allegheny Corporation for 39 years and was one of the College's most prominent and dedicated alums. Kirby, who passed away in 2011, left behind a legacy of academic, athletic, military, professional, civic and charitable achievements.

No. 80: Brian Keller's No. 80 was retired before the start of the 2015 season. Keller passed away in a car accident in June 2015, just prior to the start of his senior year. No Lafayette player had worn the No. 80 until 2024 when the Keller family reached out to head coach **John Troxell** and asked that the number be put back on the roster. The roster number is empty for 2025.

Historic Fisher Stadium: Fisher Stadium has hosted the College's home football games since 1926. The facility underwent a \$35 million transformation in 2006 and the playing surface was replaced before the 2021 season. A 28' by 47' video board replaced the original 19' by 36' video board prior to the 2024 season.

The Bourger Varsity Football House includes a locker room, offices and team meeting rooms, as well as sports medicine and strength and conditioning areas. Now in its 99th season, Fisher Stadium has been host to 481 Lafayette football games with the Leopards enjoying an overall record of 273-195-13. Of the previous 98 seasons, Lafayette has produced 13 undefeated home seasons with the most recent a 2-0 mark in the COVID-shortened 2021 spring season. Prior to that, the last team undefeated at home was the 1992 Patriot League champion Leopards who went 5-0 (the first since 1970). During the 1991, 1992 and 1993 seasons, Lafayette won 10 straight home games to tie the Fisher



Stadium school record for consecutive wins first set in 1926 and 1927 in the first 10 games ever played in the stadium.

Run Like A Champion: Lafayette has won five Patriot League Championships over the last two decades and the common thread has been the program's ability to run the ball. In 2023, Lafayette averaged 189.7 yards per game led by 1,000-yard rusher Jamar Curtis. Lafayette won three straight titles under head coach Frank Tavani in 2004-06. Kicking off the run in 2004, Lafayette churned out 212.8 rushing yards per game led by **Joe McCourt** who accumulated 1,193 yards with 16 touchdowns. Quarterback **Brad Maurer** was a dual threat, scampering for 643 yards with nine rushing touchdowns. In that season, the Leopards had nine passing touchdowns and 33 scores on the ground.

In 2005, the Leopards were only 15 yards away from having their second consecutive 1,000 yard rusher. RB **Jonathan Hurt** ran for 985 yards and 13 TD on the way to Lafayette's second straight Patriot League title. The Leopards averaged 150.9 rushing yards per game and improved on that number for the 2006 title run. Hurt helped guide the Leopards to a third consecutive NCAA Playoff berth, running for 1,165 yards on 229 attempts while scoring 15 touchdowns. The Leopards averaged 165 rushing yards per game and racked up nearly 2,000 for the season.

In 2013, Lafayette wore down opponents and possessed the ball. **Ross Scheuerman** carried the load with 1,113 rushing yards and 14 touchdowns on 218 carries, guiding Lafayette to a 4-1 conference mark and a Patriot League title.

Greatest Game Never Played: The 1948 football team is enshrined in the Maroon Club Hall of Fame. The team was 7-2 with wins over Fordham, Bucknell, George Washington, Washington and Jefferson, Muhlenberg, Ohio Wesleyan and Lehigh and losses only to No. 6 Army and Rutgers. The team averaged 260.2 rushing yards per game, among the leaders in the East, led by Maroon Club Hall of Fame quarterback Frank Downing '51.

More notably, Lafayette was invited to the Sun Bowl in El Paso, Texas. The College rejected the invitation, however, after the Sun Bowl committee's decision to exclude David Showell '51 from the game because of his race, and the segregation laws in Texas. Showell, who played on offense and defense, served his country in World War II with the Tuskegee Airmen. *The Greatest Game Never Played* (as it was later referred to in a song) helped raise awareness of exclusion of African American players in college football bowl games based on their race.

National Championships: The Lafayette football program has claimed three national championships -- 1896, 1921 and 1926 -- and recorded five undefeated seasons -- 1896 (11-0-1), 1921 (9-0-0), 1926 (9-0-0), 1937 (8-0-0) and 1940 (9-0-0). Of recent note, the Leopards have won eight Patriot League championships -- 1988, 1992, 1994, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2013, 2023 -- and made five appearances in the NCAA FCS Playoffs.

A Tradition of Kicking: Lafayette boasts three of the top five kick scoring leaders in Patriot League history. The most recent addition was **Davis Rodriguez '10** (251 career points). He is fifth in the Patriot League annals for career kick scoring leaders, trailing Holy Cross' Derek Ng (323), Fordham's Michael Marando (283) and fellow Leopards **Jason McLaughlin '95** (255) and **Jim Hodson '91** (254). The trio ranks sixth (Hodson-5.91), seventh (McLaughlin-5.8) and eighth (Rodriguez-5.7) in career kicking points per game.

200+ Rushing Games: Since 1990, there have been 12 200-yard individual rushing performances for the Leopards, six of which were the work of Maroon Club Hall of Fame honoree Erik Marsh '95.

LSN: A national leader in Division I FCS television coverage, the Lafayette Sports Network provides live coverage options of Lafayette's season. Now in its 29th year, LSN is a staple for Leopard fans.



Gary Laubach handles the play-by-play duties. Mike Joseph '88, former Lafayette football standout and assistant coach, serves as the primary analyst for the 16th season, while Meghan Caffrey handles sideline reporting. Phil Ng '88 and John Leone provide the pre-game, halftime and post-game analysis.

The Lafayette Sports Network annually has produced the most expansive television package in the Patriot League since its inception in 1997. Regionally, Lafayette Sports Network telecasts are aired to viewers in Eastern Pennsylvania and Western New Jersey. The Lafayette Sports Network annually produces at least 18 live television productions and more than 80 live streaming broadcast productions on ESPN+ and YouTube.
