MOUNTAINEERS

In a contest that stands as the halfway marker for the Black Hills State University men's basketball team, as they welcome Western Colorado University on Saturday evening at 6:00 PM at A2 Arena in the Donald E. Young Center.

Winners of four of their last six games since dropping their conference opening contest, the Yellow Jackets look to get back to the .500 mark with their single matchup this weekend after giving no. 10/24 Fort Lewis everything they could handle a week ago.

BHSU invites all attendees to break out their favorite jersey for Jersey Night presented by SAAC.

SATURDAY vs. WESTERN COLORADO

It's been a rough go of it thus far this season for the Mountaineers, as they are 4-8 overall and 1-5 against Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) foes thus far this season.

Statistically, they rank in the bottom-half of the RMAC in virtually every significant statistic, among them scoring offense in which they rank last in the conference averaging just 61.0 points per game. Western Colorado barely ranks outside the top-half of the conference in bench scoring as they are eighth with a mark of 23.46 points per game from their reserves. They also do well avoiding fouls as they are sixth committing 17.2 per game. Despite their woes, WCU is actually among the best defensive teams in the RMAC this season as they are third in scoring defense at 69.7 points allowed per game.

Western Colorado only has one player who ranks in the NCAA statistical ranks for any category with that being Kade Juelfs who's 216th nationally and 15th in the RMAC in free throw percentage with a mark of 78.3% from the line. Juelfs is the team's leading scorer, averaging 11.5 points per game, shooting .472 from the field and .426 from three. Avery Rembau joins him in double-figures scoring 10.5 points per contest while Jamel Hollins is a rare case of being a team's top rebounder and distributor averaging 5.9 caroms and 2.3 assists per game.

COACHES

Head coach Ryan Thompson is entering his sixth season leading the Yellow Jackets, having taken the program to back-to-back NCAA DII Final Fours, and the RMAC tournament each of the last five years.

In his first season as bench boss for the Mountaineers, Zac Klaus stands with a 4-8 record for WCU after spending the past four seasons at the helm at the University of Idaho.

HEAD COACH RYAN THOMPSON



Ryan Thompson is entering his sixth season as the head men's basketball coach at Black Hills State University. He has compiled a 110-48 overall record (.696 winning percentage) and 81-29 (.736) Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference record.

The Yellow Jackets have been a model of consistency during Thompson's tenure as they are the only RMAC program to finish in the top four of the conference standings in each of the past five seasons.

Over the past two seasons, Thompson guided the Yellow Jackets to back-to-back NCAA DII Final Four appearances. The only other Final Four appearance in program history came in 2008-09.

On February 28, 2023 Thompson became the fourth coach in program history to reach 100 victories, and he was the quickest to reach the milestone.

In 2022-23, BHSU was ranked in the top 25 of the national poll for the entire season, being ranked as high as #2 in the nation. For the second straight year they won the South Central Regional tournament. The Yellow Jackets fell to West Liberty in the national semifinal game.

Black Hills State was second in the nation in home game attendance with an average of over 2,200 fans per game. The team also carried a 3.42 GPA. For the second straight year, Joel Scott was named RMAC player of the year and 1st team All-American. Scott was also named the 2023 D2CCA national player of the year.

The Yellow Jackets had an historic 2021-22 season winning the RMAC regular season championship, as well as the RMAC tournament championship.

In their first ever NCAA DII national tournament appearance, Black Hills State made it all the way to the Final Four. They defeated the No. 1 ranked team in the nation, Nova Southeastern by double digits in the Elite Eight. They went on to lose to the eventual national champions, Northwest Missouri State in the national semifinal.

For the second time in three years, Thompson was named RMAC coach of the year. In addition to the on-court success, the team won the 2022 Brechler award given to the highest team GPA in the RMAC. BHSU carried a 3.58 GPA.

In 2019-20, the Yellow Jackets won the RMAC regular season championship. This was the first RMAC title for BHSU in any sport. The Yellow Jackets ended the regular season in dramatic fashion as they erased a 14-point halftime deficit on the road against archrival South Dakota Mines to win in the final seconds. Thompson was named RMAC coach of the year.

Prior to coaching at Black Hills State, Thompson spent two years as an assistant at the University of Jamestown where he helped the Jimmies compile a 41-20 (.670) record and an appearance in the NAIA DII National Tournament.

During his time at Jamestown, Thompson assisted in developing three NAIA All-Americans. He also served as the Jimmies head men's and women's golf coach. In Thompson's two seasons as the golf coach the men's team improved from last to second, and the women's team improved from last to third in the Dakota Athletic Conference.

Thompson also spent four years as the head boy's basketball coach at Hazen High School in Renton, Washington. In his final two seasons, Thompson guided Hazen to a 34-11 (.760) overall record. Six student-athletes went on to receive college basketball scholarships, and the team's GPA improved from 2.5 to 3.1.

Prior to coaching, Thompson was a four-year starter at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls and the University of Jamestown. At UWRF, Thompson averaged 13 points per game and led the conference in assists in 2005-06.

After transferring to Jamestown, Thompson helped the Jimmies win a DAC championship in 2007-08. Thompson finished the 2007-08 season ranked eighth in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage and 13th in the nation in assists.

A native of Viroqua, Wisconsin, Thompson received his undergraduate degree from the University of Jamestown in mathematics and math education. He received his masters of education from the American College of Education.

Ryan and his wife Kate reside in Spearfish and have three children, Jay (8), Paige (5) and Mya (3).

NOTES

MATCHUP HISTORY

The head-to-head matchup between Black Hills State and Western Colorado has historically been very one-sided in favor of the Yellow Jackets. Their 13-3 all-time record and .813 winning percentage against the Mountaineers is their best mark all-time against active RMAC opponents. BHSU actually lost the first two matchups they had against Western Colorado back in the 2012-13 season, but they have steamrolled WCU since, losing just once in their last 14 matchups (90-76 on 1/27/18). Black Hills State snuck past Western Colorado, 78-73 in Gunnison in their lone matchup last season.

The Yellow Jackets have won each of the last seven matchups, all of which have come in the Ryan Thompson-era. Their seven consecutive wins over Western Colorado is currently tied with Adams State for the longest active winning streak against an RMAC foe. Thompson has never lost to WCU with his 7-0 mark against them standing as his best mark against any RMAC foe.

A BHSU WIN WOULD...

Be BHSU's eighth-straight win over Western Colorado bringing it to the second-longest winning streak the program has against any foe on record and their best against any Division-II opponent. Their eight-straight wins would trail only their ten-straight victories against Maryville State University for their longest win streak against any foe on record.... Get BHSU back to the .500 mark again.

A BHSU LOSS WOULD...

Be their first loss to the Mountaineers since falling to WCU, 90-76 on January 27, 2018... Be the first time BHSU held a .500 record or worse in conference play in January or later for the first time since the 2017-18 season.

GETTING (CAEL)INVOLVED

Caelin Hearn has played some of the best basketball of his career over his last four games spanning both sides of winter break. He has scored double-digits in each game, the longest streak of his career thus far, averaging 14.5 points per contest while making 57.5% of his shot attempts including 54.5% of his attempts from three. He has also dished 1.0 assists and secured 4.0 rebounds per game in that stretch. Defensively, he has averaged 1.0 block and 1.0 steals per game as well.

Slowed only by some foul trouble, Caelin had arguably the best game of his career last Saturday against Fort Lewis, falling just one point shy of his career-high with 16 points across just 20 minutes, doing so while making four of his five attempts from three and six of seven overall.

CAUGHT A BIG FISH(ER)

Hoku Fisher has scored double-digits in three consecutive games for BHSU, the longest stretch of his career thus far, averaging 13.3 points per game in that span. While his efficiency has slightly dipped, his distributing has surged dishing a then career-high five assists against New Mexico Highlands before re-setting his career-best mark with six against Fort Lewis. Defensively, he's compiled three blocks and four steals in that span.

MATHEW RAGSDALE NOTES

Matthew Ragsdale has scored 20 or more points in four of his last five games with scoring outputs of 32 (twice, his Yellow Jacket career-high) and 29 in that stretch. He is averaging 26.2 points per game in that stretch shooting .533/.347/.857 (48-90/17-49/18-21) in that span. His 131 total points is the most he's scored in any five-game stretch as a Yellow Jacket.

Ragsdale has a chance to score 1000 points in his Yellow Jackets career. If he does so, it is believed that he will be the first to do so at the DII level all time. (Per NCAA)

TALE OF THE TAPE

Ronnail Tape is averaging 5.7 points per game with a .400/.333/.666 shooting line this season as a starter. As a reserve he has thrived however, with his numbers rising to 9.6 points on .529/.545/.750 from the field. He has scored more total points as a reserve (58) than he has as a starter (40) despite having seven starts against just six appearances as a reserve.

SHANKLIN'S SURGE

Shanklin completed the best weekend of basketball of his collegiate career last weekend. He compiled 23 points across the two games, the most he's scored in any two-game stretch of his career, while going 10-14 from the field and making all three of his free throws. He also matched his career-high for blocks with three against Fort Lewis, finishing with four total alongside a steal.

BHSU STATS

-Despite ranking tenth in the RMAC in total rebounding average with just 34.0 per game. BHSU excels at getting the most important caroms, finishing defensive possessions better than any team in the conference with 28.31 defensive rebounds per game ranking 23rd in the nation.

-Always analytically sound, BHSU's .552 effective field goal percentage is the third-best in the RMAC and ranks 42nd nationally.

-Despite being just 6-7 on the season, BHSU has plenty of reason to anticipate a strong finish. As usual, the Yellow Jackets feature an efficient offense to go with their exceptional defense. They rank fifth in the RMAC in team field goal percentage at .482 while they limit the opposition to just a .418 shooting mark. They are one of three teams in the RMAC in the top-five in both those categories with the others being Colorado Mesa and Colorado Mines who enter the weekend at 11-2 and 12-3 overall respectively.

RECENT TRENDS

-In addition to his scoring that is noted above, Hearn has been great defensively of late, collecting at minimum one steal or block (aka "stock") in each of his last seven games, with three instances of at least one steal and one block during that stretch.

-Hoku Fisher is averaging 11.6 points, 2.7 assists (including a career-high six on Jan 6), 1.2 steals and 0.4 blocks in his last six games. His biggest impact has been felt on the glass in that span, securing 6.2 per game, including a career-high 11 on Dec. 9. His to 4.69 defensive rebounds per game this season rank sixth in the RMAC and in the top-200 nationally.

-As a team, BHSU is averaging 16.7 assists across their last three games, a big difference from their 10.8 mark overall this season. In those games, the Yellow Jackets have posted assist-turnover ratios of 15-15, 19-15, and 16-13 with those showings being three of five games in which they've had an assist-turnover ratio of 1-1 or better.

AGAINST WESTERN COLORADO

-In his lone career matchup against his former team, Matthew Ragsdale scored 18 points to go with five rebounds and two assists last season against WCU. He shot .556/.500/.600 in that game, earning ten free throw attempts in the contest, a mark that still stands as the most he's had in a game with BHSU.

-John Shanklin has three career appearances against Western Colorado, averaging 3.3 points per game in those games, his second-highest mark against any RMAC foe.

-Only three Yellow Jackets have ever faced WCU; Ragsdale, Shanklin, and Caelin Hearn.

YELLOW JACKETS' LAST TIME OUT

SPEARFISH, S.D. – It was a dogfight right down to the final seconds in the A2 Arena on Saturday night, but in the end it was the Skyhawks who flew slightly higher than the Yellow Jackets as the Black Hills State University Men's Basketball team got edged, 75-70, by Fort Lewis College. Four players scored double digits for BHSU including Deegan Williams (So., Gillette, Wyo.) who posted a career-high ten points in the contest.

With the defeat, Black Hills State drops to 6-7 on the season, 4-3 in Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) play. The Skyhawks, meanwhile, win their 12th straight game to improve to 12-1, 7-0 against conference foes.

In a contest that featured six ties and a 18 lead changes it was Fort Lewis who was on the right side of the final one with a pair of free throws, a place they found themselves at a lot on this evening as they attempted 20 free throws to BHSU's eight and outscoring the Yellow Jackets 15-7 from the charity stripe.

Matthew Ragsdale (Gr., Colorado Springs, Colo.) finished as the leading scorer for the green and gold, pouring in 17 points although he required 17 shot attempts to get there.

Caelin Hearne (Jr., Norman, Okla.) came out of the gates firing but was ultimately slowed by some foul trouble in the second half. He still finished with 16 points, on 6-for-7 shooting, four-of-five from three, reaching double-figures in a fourth-straight game for the first time in his career.

It was a career-best night distributing the basketball for Hoku Fisher (So., Wilmington, N.C.), as he matched the entire Fort Lewis team with six assists to go with his ten points and two steals.

Williams rounded out the BHSU double-digit scorers while he also finished as the team leader in rebounds with six.

John Shanklin (Sr., Bellevue, Neb.) contributed eight points and four rebounds for the Yellow Jackets, while matching his career-high with three blocks.

Obi Agbim led all players with 28 points on 10-for-20 from the field and came away with two steals for the Skyhawks.

Malik Whitaker was the only other Fort Lewis starter in double-digits with 14 points and a team-high six rebounds while Brayden Carter was a major factor for the FLC second unit, scoring 18 of their 25 bench points by making seven of his ten shot attempts from the field.

The Skyhawks opened the scoring with back-to-back three pointers before the Yellow Jackets countered with six straight points of their own capped off by Fisher jumping a pass and earning a clear lane to the hoop for the game-tying dunk. Agbim converted a layup ahead of Hearne cashing in a triple, sparking a stretch of five consecutive baskets with a lead change, the last of which was a three-ball from Ragsdale. The see-saw pattern continued into the media break with BHSU holding a 19-15 edge into the under-12.

The guests recorded two of the first three baskets out of the timeout before Hearne cashed in on his third three-pointer followed by a made triple from Ragsdale. Those back-to-back connections from range constituted what finished as the longest scoring run of the night for the Yellow Jackets at six points to claim the largest lead for either side on the evening at 27-19. Agbim and Williams traded makes from range before Fort Lewis made their move. They pieced together what finished as their longest scoring run, collecting nine in-a-row to grab the lead 31-30. Four-straight lead-changing scores ensued before Agbim snapped the

stretch with a jumper. BHSU would grab the lead entering the half on back-to-back point-blank baskets from Shanklin, and they led 39-38 at the break.

Agbim led all players with 14 points in the half, while Hearne led BHSU with 11 while connecting on all four of his shot attempts.

The Yellow Jackets did well handling FLC's defensive pressure in the half and held an 11-5 edge in points off turnovers, however, the Skyhawks tallied all nine second-chance points to keep it close.

A two from Ragsdale and a triple from Agbim opened the second half scoring and leveled the score before a three from Ragsdale with 18:27 remaining gave BHSU a lead they would not relinquish for the next ten and a half minutes of game time. And while the Yellow Jackets held the edge, FLC never allowed it to get out of hand, remaining within three possessions in that stretch.

Trailing by six with 9:02 left, the visitors made their move once more. A pair of free throws from Carter, five points from Whitaker, and Agbim splitting a pair from the stripe comprised of the largest run for either squad in the second half of play and gave the guests the lead. The teams would trade the lead back and forth with a trey from Fisher giving BHSU the edge, 67-66 with 4:17 left. Fort Lewis would claim the advantage for good about a moment later, however, as they scored seven-straight, including five from the line to grab a six-point lead, matching their largest of the night. Fisher made things interesting by getting the Yellow Jackets within three with a triple with six seconds remaining, but Agbim iced things by converting a pair of free throws on the other end to secure the win.

Agbim equaled his first half scoring output with 14 in the second stanza for the Skyhawks while Carter scored 11 in the half. Ragsdale led BHSU with 10 in the frame while Williams pitched in seven.

The Yellow Jackets return to the A2 Arena floor a week from today to face Western Colorado on Saturday, January 13th. Tipoff is set for 7:00 PM.

MOUNTAINEERS' LAST TIME OUT

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo. Western Colorado fell to a gritty University of Colorado Colorado Springs team 83-60, while Avery Rembao and Kade Juelfs both registered a team-high 15 points for the Mountaineers.

HOW IT HAPPENED

It was a slow start for both teams as it was a 14-7 game with 10 minutes and 17 seconds left in the first quarter. UCCS never looked back from taking the early lead as they held the advantage for the whole 40 minutes. The Mountain Lions shot 51% from the field in the first 20 minutes, while shooting 66% from beyond the arch.

The Mountain Lions took a 21-point lead in the second half but Avery Rembao was able to shrink the lead with a jumper from inside the paint. Jesse Iweze and Mac Stodart made a splash for the Mountain Lions as the duo was able to break away from the Mountaineers defense for a pair of dunks. Avery Rembao slammed a dunk of his own with 4:48 to go.

The Mountaineers collected 32 points from inside the paint and 26 points off the bench. Western Colorado shot just 29% from the field in the first half and 48% in the final 20 minutes of the game.

COURT NOTES

While Kade Juelfs and Avery Rembao both scored 15 points apiece, Jaelan McCloud tallied 11 points of his own while going 5-for-11 from the field.

McCloud led the Mountaineers with six rebounds, while Jonathan McCloud and Christian Still each recorded a block. Juelfs and Spencer Wright got in on the defensive action with one steal each.

LAST MATCHUP: BHSU vs. WCU (Jan. 6, 2023)

GUNNISON, Colo. – Black Hills State men's basketball defeated Western Colorado, 78-73 Friday night in just their second game since Dec. 16.

The Yellow Jackets (13-0, 7-0 RMAC) tallied 10 steals and six blocks on the night, both season-highs for the team.

Joel Scott led on the floor with 22 points and 14 rebounds for his fourth-straight double-double performance, and sixth of the season. He also tallied four blocks and a steal while making 8-of-14 from the field.

Ryker Cisarik was second in the rebound column for the Yellow Jackets with a season-high nine to go along with his 15 points. He went 7-of-8 from the field, and had a team-high four steals while also putting up a pair of blocks.

Matthew Ragsdale totaled 18 points and four rebounds while Adam Moussa scored 10 points to go with four assists, three rebounds and two steals.

BHSU got out to an early 5-0 lead with quick shots from Scott and Ragsdale, but WCU would inch back and eventually take a 12-10 lead as the clock ticked under 15 minutes in the first.

Teams went back-and-forth from there as the Mountaineers kept pace with big threes from Ragsdale and Caelin Hearne to hold a 24-23 lead with 8:41 to go. From there, BHSU rattled off an 11-0 scoring run with the help of a Moussa jumper and a Scott three to take their first double-digit lead of the game, 36-26, with 5:04 remaining in the first.

WCU wasn't done, though, using a quick 5-0 spurt to draw back within five, before layups from Cisarik, Scott and Moussa sent the Yellow Jackets to the locker room with a 42-33 advantage.

Out of the break, WCU outscored BHSU 12-2 and pulled ahead 45-44 with 16:31 remaining. But, threes from Ragsdale, Jaeton Hackley and Moussa put BHSU back on top 55-50, and then a Hackley layup and Cisarik dunk extended the lead to 59-50 midway through the second.

The Mountaineers still wouldn't quit, however, scoring six straight to pull back to within one possession at 9:24 before teams traded buckets over the next several minutes.

BHSU continued to hold the lead over that stretch until layups from Scott and Cisarik helped propel the offense to nine unanswered points, extending the Yellow Jackets to a 72-62 lead with 3:43 to play.

Layups from Cisarik and Ragsdale in the final minutes kept BHSU afloat before free throws from Scott and Moussa helped seal the 78-73 victory.
