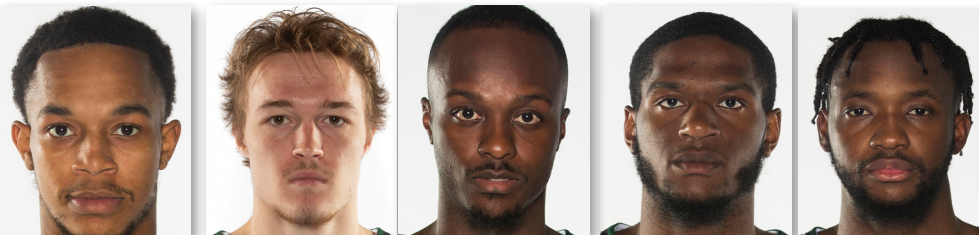
QUICK HITS

About Marist

- Coming off 73-69 win over American in Wednesday's home opener
- Tight game that featured 18 lead changes and went to closing minute
- Red Foxes received inside-out combo from 6-foot-11 center Patrick Gardner (19 pts.) and guard Kam Farris (20 pts.)
- Return five players (all reserves) from team that went 14-16 overall, 9-11 in MAAC
- Have nine newcomers; graduated top five scorers from last year
- Picked to finish seventh of 11 in MAAC Preseason Poll

All-time series vs. Marist

- Marist leads 3-2 and has won the last three
- Last Dec. 8, 2021, Marist posted a 64-51 win at the Events Center
- Visiting Marist shot 61 percent in the second half and pulled away from Binghamton. The Red Foxes used a 14-3 run spanning 7+ minutes to take a 43-32 lead midway through the second half. Over the game's final 10 minutes, BU couldn't draw closer than seven points.
- The Red Foxes swept a two-game weekend set during the 2020-21 COVID season
- Binghamton won the first two matchups in 2008 and 2009 before the teams went 11 years without meeting

A win over Marist would ...

- Give BU a 2-0 start for the first time since 2002-03 (20 years)
- Snap a three-game losing streak to the Red Foxes

Bearcats ease into season with win over Cazenovia

The Bearcats opened their season Monday with an 87-56 home win over Division III Cazenovia. Junior center **Tariq Balogun** scored 17 points in his Bearcats debut and the 6-foot-10 center led five Binghamton players in double digits. Balogun, one of three transfers in the starting lineup, did his damage in just 16 minutes of action. He hit 5-of-5 from the floor and 7-of-11 from the free throw line. Joining Balogun in double figures were juniors **Armon Harried** (16 pts.) and **John McGriff** (15 pts.), graduate student **Miles Gibson** (11 pts.) and sophomore Matt Solomon (11 pts.). The Bearcats jumped out to a 23-10 cushion and led by Balogun (12) and McGriff (13), extended the margin to 21, 53-32, at intermission. Binghamton shot 55 percent in the opening half. Binghamton then held the Division III Wildcats to 24 points (on 24% shooting) in the second half.

Falko named to preseason all-conference team

Senior guard **Jacob Falko** was named to the preseason all-conference team. Falko was an obvious choice to head the team as the only returning all-conference selection from last season. He averaged 15.4 points on 49 percent shooting in conference play and was a first team all-conference choice. Joining Falko on the preseason team were Dylan Penn and Finn Sullivan from reigning champion Vermont, Charles Pride and Earl Timberlake from newcomer Bryant and Max Brooks from UMass Lowell.

Bearcats picked fourth in preseason poll

Binghamton was picked fourth in the America East Coaches' Preseason Poll. Coming off a season that yielded eight conference wins (most in 12 years) and a semifinal appearance, the Bearcats (42 pts.) were slotted behind only Vermont (63), Bryant (58) and UMass Lowell (47) in the nine-team rankings. It equals the highest the team has ever been picked in 22 years of America East membership. Previously, the program was picked fourth in 2005-06, 2007-08 and 2016-17. Behind Binghamton was UMBC (40), Albany (25), New Hampshire (23), NJIT (14) and Maine (12).

BINGHAMTON ... DID YOU KNOW

- Among the University's noted sports-centered alumni are **Tony Kornheiser '70**, co-host of ESPN's PTI, and **Billy Baldwin '85**, former wrestler and current Hollywood actor, writer and producer. ESPN Baseball Tonight anchor **Karl Ravech** received his master's degree from Binghamton in 1990.
- Other notable alumni include **Scott Krug '96**, CFO of the New York Yankees, **Marc Lawrence '81**, Hollywood writer, director and producer, **Paul Reiser '77**, star of the popular TV sitcom "Mad About You" and **Stephanie Courtney '92**, actress and "Flo" from Progressive Insurance commercials
- Lawrence's 2014 "The Rewrite" movie, starring Hugh Grant, was a tribute to Binghamton University and the plot had the Grant character teaching at a small upstate college.
- Acclaimed author and sports journalist **Wayne Coffey** graduated from Binghamton in 1976 with a degree in history and philosophy. He has covered 12 Olympic Games and authored the New York Times' best-seller "The Boys of Winter."
- Distinguished Professor of Chemistry and Materials Science **M. Stanley Whittingham** was awarded the 2019 Nobel Prize in Chemistry. He was honored last Dec. 8 in Stockholm, Sweden in a ceremony attended by the Queen of England (Whittingham was born in the United Kingdom and earned his bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees from Oxford University). Whittingham is a pioneer and patent-holder in the development of lithium-ion batteries.
- **Binghamton** was rated the No. 1 Public College in New York State by Business First in 2019
- **Binghamton** was rated No. 32 in "Best Public in the Nation" by U.S. News & World Report in 2019
- **Binghamton** was rated one of only 10 "Best Buy Public Universities in the Nation" by Fiske Guide to Colleges in 2019

TEAM TIDBITS

- Head Coach **Levell Sanders** starred at Seton Hall in the late 1990s, where he squared off against BIG EAST (and NBA legends) Allen Iverson (Georgetown), Ray Allen (UConn), Rip Hamilton (UConn), Kerry Kittles (Villanova) and Lawrence Moten (Syracuse).
 - The Bearcats have the **oldest team** in their program history this season. The 12 players will begin the season with an average age of 22. Only one player is younger than 21 (freshman Masud Stewart) and the roster has a combined 28 seasons of NCAA basketball (avg. 2.3).
 - Graduate forward **Miles Gibson** is the oldest Bearcat at 24 1/2 years old. Gibson is from Richmond, Va. and his college path has taken him from Northwest Kansas Tech College to Eastern Michigan University to Metropolitan State University of Denver (MSU Denver) and now Binghamton.
 - Graduate forward **Christian Hinckson** has the most NCAA Division I experience of any Bearcat, having played in 106 collegiate games between Manhattan College (63 in two years) and Binghamton (43 in two years).
 - Senior guard **Jacob Falko** is the only returning all-conference player (of 15) in the America East, which has had significant turnover (individuals and teams) from last season. Falko was a first team all-conference selection and is on the five-man preseason all-conference team.
 - **Falko** also is a trained pianist. He started playing at age 5 and was taught by his grandfather. Falko's mom and all seven of his siblings can play. He has been known to perform for his teammates on hotel lobby pianos and can read music and play by ear.
 - Junior forward **Armon Harried** is the son of former Syracuse standout Herman "Tree" Harried, who helped lead the Orange to four NCAA tournaments, capped with a title game appearance in 1987. His dad coached Armon in high school at Lake Clifton High in Baltimore. Armon's childhood nickname is "Nuke," given by his mother.
 - Junior center **Tariq Balogun** is well-traveled. He was born in Italy and raised in England. Balogun came to the States as a sophomore in high school and then played his final two scholastic seasons at Miller School of Albemarle in Charlottesville, Va. From there he played his first three NCAA seasons at Eastern Kentucky University.
- Graduate center **Ogheneyole "Savior" Akuwovo** won a New Jersey state championship and Tournament of Champions title for legendary coach Bob Hurley at St. Anthony's as a sophomore. The school closed after his junior year and he finished his scholastic career at Ranney School.
- **Akuwovo's** legal guardian is former Seton Hall legend and NBA player Terry Dehere.
 - **Akuwovo** is a fashion designer and tailor. He learned to sew and hem clothes from his father, who is a tailor in Nigeria.
 - Senior center **Ador Athuai** has 14 siblings — seven brothers and seven sisters.
 - **Athuai** is 6-foot-11 and has a wingspan of 7-feet-5-inches.
 - Freshman guard **Masud Stewart** hails from Newumann-Goretti High in Philadelphia, one of the most fabled high school basketball programs in the country. Stewart helped lead the program to its ninth state championship last winter. Neumann-Goretti was ranked No. 11 by MaxPreps in its listing of the top 100 scholastic basketball dynasties.
 - Binghamton has led the America East in home attendance in 10 of the last 17 years.

HEAD COACH LEVELL SANDERS



Coming off a noted season of accomplishments and program progress, Levell Sanders begins his second year as head coach in 2022-23.

In his first season at the helm after being promoted from assistant coach, Sanders led the Bearcats to a berth in the America East semifinals after the team was picked to finish last. Along the way, his team achieved the program's highest conference win total in 12 years and had a winning

conference road record for the first time in 13 years.

After the season, Sanders was one of 15 finalists for the 2022 Joe B. Hall Award, presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I college basketball.

The 2021-22 Bearcats (12-17, 8-10 America East) led the America East in rebounding and 3-point defense and ranked second in field goal percentage defense and blocked shots. Of the team's losses, six were by five or fewer points or in overtime. Binghamton reached the semifinals with a riveting 72-69 road win over third-seeded New Hampshire in the quarterfinals.

The team's uprising drew nearly 25,000 fans to the Events Center this winter. In home conference games, BU drew an average of 2,023 fans, third-highest in the America East.

Sanders, 46, was hired in June 2019 and worked two seasons as an assistant coach before being promoted to head coach on March 1, 2021.

"Levell possesses wide-ranging and successful experience as a player and coach, on both the intercollegiate and professional levels," then Director of Athletics Patrick Elliott said when announcing the promotion. "We are appreciative of Levell's willingness to lead the program at this time, and are confident he will continue to develop BU basketball and our student-athletes to on-court success."

A Brooklyn native, he returned to the states after a noteworthy coaching career in the Czech Republic. For five years, he coached BK JIP Pardubice, leading the team to the elimination rounds of the 2017 FIBA Europe Cup and being named All-Czech Republic League Coach of the Year. His teams won at an 84 percent clip and captured bronze medals in the KNBL Czech League three straight years between 2015-18.

Sanders was selected to be a member of the coaching staff of the Czech Republic U18 National Team that competed at the 2017 European Championships.

As a player, Sanders scored 1,399 career points at Seton Hall before embarking on a successful 15-year professional career overseas. With the Pirates, Sanders averaged 12.4 points in 113 games and was named second team All-BIG EAST in 1998. A BIG EAST academic all-star, he graduated in 1998

Sanders holds a strong reputation for player development and is the author of a book, "A Guide to Playing Professional Basketball Overseas."

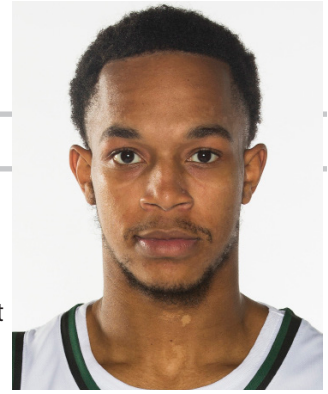

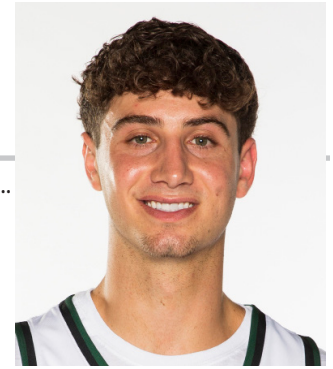

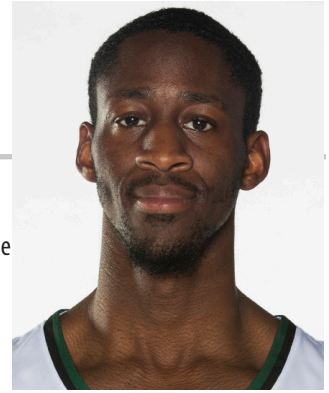
