### Points of Emphasis...

- Today is Homecoming. Bluefield University welcomes all Rams home for a weekend of fun, fellowship, and reminiscing.
- Nathan Herstich needs 38 yards passing to reach 5,000 career passing yards. As a sophomore he is already BU's all-time passing leader.
- JaQuan Ebron surpassed the 4,000 yards receiving mark last week against Point. Ebron has 4,065 yards entering today's game with Reinhardt.
- Sam Kirtley became the third leading tackler in BU history in last week's game against Point. Kirtley now has 222 tackles. He passed Harry Casseus who had 219. Frank Brooks is second on the list at 275, and DaMarcus Wimbush tops the list at 531.
- The 2022 football season marks 10 years of football at Bluefield University. The sport returned in 2012 as a varsity program. Football was previously played at Bluefield College but was halted after the 1941 season due to World War II and did not kick off again for 70 years. The first game of the BU varsity football program was on Aug. 28, 2012 against the University of Pikeville.
- The Appalachian Athletic Conference is the new home for Bluefield University Football, bringing all BU sports under the AAC umbrella. The AAC is sponsoring football for the first time this season and the members are all former members of the Mid-South Conference Appalachian Division.

## HEAD COACH & COORDINATORS

### **Dewey Lusk**

#### **Head Football Coach (Sixth season)**

Dewey Lusk is the 10th head coach in Bluefield history and the third since the program was reinstated in 2012.

In his first year at Bluefield, 2017, Lusk guided the Rams to a 6-5 record, once more win than the team had in its previous five seasons combined. In 2018 the Rams played tough, but injuries had a toll and Bluefield finished the year 4-7. Three games were decided by a touchdown or less. The 2019 season saw Bluefield finish with a 3-8 record and the 2020 season, due to Covid, was played in the Spring of 2021 and Bluefield was 2-7. The 2021 campaign saw Lusk lead Bluefield University to a 6-5 record as the team won its last five games of the season.

Lusk came to Bluefield from Webber International University where he served as offensive coordinator in 2016. From 2011-15 he was head coach at UVa-Wise where he guided the Highland Cavaliers in the transition from an NAIA program to an NCAA Division II school. He was associate head coach and offensive coordinator at Wise 2008-10. During his stint as offensive coordinator UVa-Wise became one of the most vaunted offensive juggernauts in NAIA football. In 2008 the Highland Cavaliers offense was fourth in the NAIA in scoring and second in pass efficiency and total offense.

Lusk was offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College 1991-2005 and was also the school's head baseball coach 1992-2003. He was also an assistant at Abingdon (Va.) High School (1990-91), Gardner Webb University (1985-87).

A native of Christiansburg, Virginia, and a graduate of Christiansburg High School, Lusk earned a B.A. in History from Emory & Henry College in 1985, and an M.A. in Physical Education from Gardner Webb in 1987. He is married to the former Mily Dover of Shelby, North Carolina, and is the father of a son, Gil, and a daughter, Landi.



### **Dino Kaklis**

#### **Associate Head Coach/Defensive Coordinator**

Dino Kaklis is in his sixth year at Bluefield University. He previously served on the staff at North Carolina A&T, was defensive coordinator at UVa-Wise and head coach at Bethel (Tenn.) University. Kaklis had an outstanding collegiate playing career at Purdue University where he was a four-year starter for the Boilermakers. He is married to Nicole Chicklo Kaklis and the father of two girls, Isabella and Gabriella.



### **Michael Ketchum**

#### **Offensive Coordinator/Offensive Line Coach**

Michael Ketchum begins his fifth season on the Bluefield coaching staff. He came to BU from Hampton University where he was defensive coordinator. Ketchum was head coach at his alma mater, Guilford College from 1991-2004, and won the school's only conference championship. During his tenure at Guilford he coached six All-Americans and 67 All-Conference players.

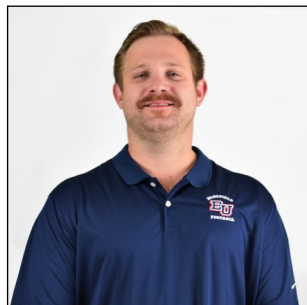
## **Rod Howard** **Defensive Line Coach**

### **Rams charge comes up short at Reinhardt**

**WALESKA, Ga.** - The Bluefield University Rams won the statistical battle Saturday afternoon against the Reinhardt University Eagles, but the score on the board is what counts and the Eagles claimed a 49-35 win in a Mid-South Conference Appalachian Division battle.

Reinhardt opened a 14-0 lead in the game's first four minutes, driving the opening kickoff for a score, then blocking a BU punt for a TD. The Rams got on the board with 2:33 to play in the first when Jaquan Ebron hauled in a pass from Nathan Herstich for the score. The PAT failed. Reinhardt went up 21-6 with 90 seconds left in the opening quarter.

Antonio Strickland and Herstich teamed up on a 15-yard scoring play capping a 78-yard, eight play drive. The kick was good by Tanner Griffith and it was 21-13. Reinhardt then reeled off four unanswered scores in the second quarter to take a 49-13 lead into the intermission. Neither team scored in the third.

The Rams began their charge in the fourth. With 14:23 to play in the game LeBron Fields dashed 10 yards for the touchdown and Joey Dales kicked the PAT. With 10:43 remaining Ebron and Herstich combined on a play from seven yards out. Herstich passed to Matthew Trevillian for the two-point conversion to make it 49-28. The Rams were not finished. With 1:41 on the clock Herstich scampered 10 yards for the touchdown and Dales kicked the extra point to make it 49-35.

Statistically the Rams were superior. BU had 28 first downs to 24 for Reinhardt. The Rams ran 70 offensive plays to the Eagles' 66, and Bluefield had 435 offensive yards, Reinhardt 420.

Herstich was 33-of-56 passing for 418 yards and three touchdowns. He rushed for another. Strickland caught 11 passes for 180 yards and a touchdown. Ebron had nine catches for 79 yards and two scores, while Trevillian caught seven balls for 94 yards.

Defensively KeDarrius Phinazee led BU with 11 tackles. DaMarcus Wimbush and Sam Kirtley each had eight stops.
