

- The 2022 football season marks 10 years of football at Bluefield University. The sport returned in 2012 as a varsity program. Football was previously played at Bluefield College but was halted after the 1941 season due to World War II and did not kick off again for 70 years. The first game of the BU varsity football program was on Aug. 28, 2012 against the University of Pikeville.
- The Appalachian Athletic Conference is the new home for Bluefield University Football, bringing all BU sports under the AAC umbrella. The AAC is sponsoring football for the first time this season and the members are all former members of the Mid-South Conference Appalachian Division.
- Nathan Herstich was this week's Appalachian Athletic Conference Football Offensive Player of the Week. Herstich passed for 329 yards and seven (7) touchdowns last week against Pikeville. It is the second time this season Herstich has won the award, and the fifth time in six weeks that a Bluefield University player has earned the top offensive honor. JaQuan Ebron has been honored twice, and Jewels Gray once. Defensively the Rams Sam Kirtley and Tyrese Wolfe have earned the honor, and on Special Teams Joey Dales has twice been named POTW, and Thomas Lee once.

Herstich AAC Offensive POTW Again

WALESKA, Ga. - Nathan Herstich of Bluefield is the Appalachian Athletic Conference (AAC) Football Offensive Player of the Week, while Aaron Anderson and Giovanni Martinez, both of Point, are the Defensive and Special Teams Players of the Week, respectively. The league announced the awards on Monday.

This is the sixth edition of the awards for the 2022 season. The next set of awards will be announced on Oct. 10.

AAC Defensive Player of the Week

Aaron Anderson - Point - Senior - Gwinett, Ga.

- Recorded 4 tackles in a 48-6 win over St. Andrews.
- Forced and recovered a fumble, returning it 16 yards for a touchdown.
- Had 2.0 tackles for a loss of 14 yards.
- This is his first weekly honor of the season.

AAC Offensive Player of the Week

Nathan Herstich - Bluefield - Sophomore - St. Cloud, Fla.

- Completed 17-of-36 passes for 329 yards and a school-record 7 touchdowns in a 50-26 win over Pikeville (Ky.).
- Had a long pass completion of 75 yards.
- Also rushed for 35 yards on 9 carries.
- This is his second weekly honor of the season.

Giovanni Martinez - Point - Freshman - Gainesville, Ga.

- Went 6-for-6 on PATs in a 48-6 win over St. Andrews.

Dewey Lusk Head Football Coach (Sixth season)

Dewey Lusk is the 10th head coach in Bluefield history and the third since the program was reinstated in 2012.

In his first year at Bluefield, 2017, Lusk guided the Rams to a 6-5 record, once more win than the team had inits previous five seasons combined. In 2018 the Rams played tough, but injuries had a toll and Bluefield finished the year 4-7. Three games were decided by a touchdown or less. The 2019 season saw Bluefield finish with a 3-8 record and the 2020 season, due to Covid, was played in the Spring of 2021 and Bluefield was 2-7. The 2021 campaign saw Lusk lead Bluefield University to a 6-5 record as the team won its last five games of the season.

Lusk came to Bluefield from Webber International University where he served as offensive coordinator in 2016. From 2011-15 he was head coach at UVa-Wise where he guided the Highland Cavaliers in the transition from an NAIA program to an NCAA Division II school. He was associate head coach and offensive coordinator at Wise 2008-10. During his stint as offensive coordinator UVa-Wise became one of the most vaunted offensive juggernauts in NAIA football. In 2008 the Highland Cavaliers offense was fourth in the NAIA in scoring and second in pass efficiency and total offense.

Lusk was offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College 1991-2005 and was also the school's head baseball coach 1992-2003. He was also an assistant at Abingdon (Va.) High School (1990-91), Gardner Webb University (1985-87).

A native of Christiansburg, Virginia, and a graduate of Christiansburg High School, Lusk earned a B.A. in History from Emory & Henry College in 1985, and an M.A. in Physical Education from Gardner Webb in 1987. He is married to the former Mily Dover of Shelby, North Carolina, and is the father of a son, Gil, and a daughter, Landi.

Dino Kaklis Associate Head Coach/Defensive Coordinator

Dino Kaklis is in his sixth year at Bluefield University. He previously served on the staff at North Carolina A&T, was



defensive coordinator at UVa-Wise and head coach at Bethel (Tenn.) University. Kaklis had an outstanding collegiate playing career at Purdue University where he was a four-year starter for the Boilermakers. He is married to Nicole Chicklo Kaklis and the father of two girls, Isabella and Gabriella.

Michael Ketchum Offensive Coordinator/Offensive Line Coach

Michael Ketchum begins his fifth season on the Bluefield coaching staff. He came to BU from Hampton Universi-



ty where he was defensive coordinator. Ketchum was head coach at his alma mater, Guilford College from 1991-2004, and won the school's only conference championship. During his tenure at Guilford he coached six All-Americans and 67 All-Conference players.



Rod Howard Defensive Line Coach

The 2022 season will be Rod Howard's sixth year on the coaching staff at Bluefield University. A native of Memphis, Tennessee, Howard played at



the University of Memphis under former Virginia Tech head coach Justin Fuente. Howard lettered and registered at least one start at three levels of college football, NCAA Division I (Memphis), NCAA Division II (Harding, and NAIA (Lambuth).

Devon Jackson Defensive Backs Coach

Devon Jackson, a Bluefield University alumnus, begins his third season on the Rams' coaching staff. Jackson was a four-year letterman for Blue-



field, graduating in 2018. During his career he was a three-time Mid-South Conference Player of the Week, and was named to the Mid-South Conference Appala-

Bryan Carr Offensive Assistant Coach

Bryan Carr is in his first season as an offensive assistant for the Rams. Carr graduated from Concord University where he played tight end from 2011-12.
