Points of Emphasis...

- The 2022 football season marks 10 years of football at Bluefield University. The sport returned in 2012 as a varsity program. Football was previously played at Bluefield College but was halted after the 1941 season due to World War II and did not kick off again for 70 years.
- The Appalachian Athletic Conference is the new home for Bluefield University Football, bringing all BU sports under the AAC umbrella. The AAC is sponsoring football for the first time this season and the members are all former members of the Mid-South Conference Appalachian Division. NAIA First Team All-American JaQuan Ebron is Bluefield's all-time leader in touchdown reception. Ebron was also the Mid-South Conference Appalachian Division Offensive Player of the Year, First Team MSC Appalachian Division, First Team Virginia SID All-State, Touchdown Club of Richmond Offensive End of the Year, and a finalist for the Lanier Award as the top College Division Player in Virginia.
- Sophomore Nathan Herstich threw for 36 touchdown passes in 2021 as a freshman and was first-team Mid-South Conference Appalachian Division. Herstich became Bluefield University's all-time passing leader in the first game of the season against Thomas More.
- JaQuan Ebron, Sam Kirtley, and Joey Dales were named AAC Players of the Week for Week 1 of the season. Ebron took honors on offense, Kirtley on defense, and Dales on special teams. Dales was also named AAC Special Teams Player of the Week for the second week of the season.

HEAD COACH & COORDINATORS

Dewey Lusk **Head Football Coach (Sixth season)**

Dewey Lusk is the 10th head coach in Bluefield history and the third since the program was reinstated in 2012.

In his first year at Bluefield, 2017, Lusk guided the Rams to a 6-5 record, once more win than the team had in its previous five seasons combined. In 2018 the Rams played tough, but injuries had a toll and Bluefield finished the year 4-7. Three games were decided by a touchdown or less. The 2019 season saw Bluefield finish with a 3-8 record and the 2020 season, due to Covid, was played in the Spring of 2021 and Bluefield was 2-7. The 2021 campaign saw Lusk lead Bluefield University to a 6-5 record as the team won its last five games of the season.

Lusk came to Bluefield from Webber International University where he served as offensive coordinator in 2016. From 2011-15 he was head coach at UVa-Wise where he guided the Highland Cavaliers in the transition from an NAIA program to an NCAA Division II school. He was associate head coach and offensive coordinator at Wise 2008-10. During his stint as offensive coordinator UVa-Wise became one of the most vaunted offensive juggernauts in NAIA football. In 2008 the Highland Cavaliers offense was fourth in the NAIA in scoring and second in pass efficiency and total offense.

Lusk was offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College 1991-2005 and was also the school's head baseball coach 1992-2003. He was also an assistant at Abingdon (Va.) High School (1990-91), Gardner Webb University (1985-87).

A native of Christiansburg, Virginia, and a graduate of Christiansburg High School, Lusk earned a B.A. in History from Emory & Henry College in 1985, and an M.A. in Physical Education from Gardner Webb in 1987. He is married to the former Mily Dover of Shelby, North Carolina, and is the father of a son, Gil, and a daughter, Landi.



Dino Kaklis **Associate Head** **Coach/Defensive Co-** **ordinator**

Dino Kaklis is in his sixth year at Bluefield University. He previously served on the staff at North Carolina A&T, was defensive coordinator at UVa-Wise and head coach at Bethel (Tenn.) University. Kaklis had an outstanding collegiate playing career at Purdue University where he was a four-year starter for the Boilermakers. He is married to Nicole Chicklo Kaklis and the father of two girls, Isabella and Gabriella.



Michael Ketchum **Offensive Coordina-** **tor/Offensive Line** **Coach**

Michael Ketchum begins his fifth season on the Bluefield coaching staff. He came to BU from Hampton University where he was defensive coordinator. Ketchum was head coach at his alma mater, Guilford College from 1991-2004, and won the school's only conference championship. During his tenure at Guilford he coached six All-Americans and 67 All-Conference players.

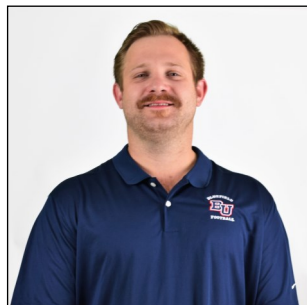
Rod Howard **Defensive Line Coach**

Wild Ending Gives Rams Win

EMORY, Va. – Whoa Nellie, it was a barnburner Saturday afternoon on the Emory & Henry campus as the Bluefield University Rams rallied from a three touchdown deficit to defeat the Wasps 46-45 in a battle of Southwest Virginia schools.

E&H took the early lead only to see the Rams tie the game on a Josh Nelson 44-yard pass to Antonio Strickland, and a PAT by Tanner Griffith. Just two minutes later Latravious Johnson ran three yards for a Rams TD. Griffith added the extra point to make it 14-7 and that is where it stood at the end of the first quarter.

Emory & Henry scored three times in the second quarter – a short pass and two TD runs to take a 28-14 lead. All three scores occurred within a three-minute span. Just before the halftime break Griffith booted a 32-yard field goal and the Wasps carried a 28-17 lead into the intermission.

In the third E&H tacked on a touchdown and field goal, while the Rams added a touchdown.

The fourth quarter scoring began with Strickland running one yard for a score. The Wasps then scored on a 21-yard pass play to lead 45-24. Then the rally began.



The Rams scored three touchdowns within four minutes to pull ahead. All were within the final five minutes of the game. Nelson passed to Jaquan Ebron from 29 yards out with 4:55 to play. Strickland then caught a nine-yard pass from Nelson with 3:33 remaining. Griffith's kicks were good following each touchdown. The final strike came with 1:07 on the clock when Nelson and Matthew Trevillian hooked up on an eight-yard scoring play. Nelson passed to Ebron for the two-point conversion and the winning margin.

Nelson, starting in place of opening game starting quarterback Nathan Herstich, who was injured late in last week's game against Thomas More, completed 27-of-53 passes for 365 yards and four touchdowns with an interception. Nelson had three targets with seven receptions apiece – Ebron for 167 yards, Strickland for 80 yards, and Trevillian for 46 yards. Latravious Johnson led the Rams rushing attack with 69 yards on 18 car-
