STORYLINES

- Delaware plays its second straight road game to open the 2011–22 season at Siena. The Blue Hens are looking to avoid starting 0–2 for the first time since 2014–15.
- \cdot UD kicked off its season with a 93–71 loss at Davidson on Tuesday night.
- Dylan Painter, a CAA Preseason first team selection, paced the Blue Hens with 17 points and six rebounds.
- Jameer Nelson, Jr. added 11 points while tying for the team lead with six rebounds and three assists in his UD debut.
- · Kevin Anderson also reached double figures with 11 points. Anderson has scored 986 career points and needs 14 more to become the 37th player in UD history to reach the 1,000-point
- Ryan Allen added nine points and has now scored 1,450 points in his career.
- · Andrew Carr also scored nine points against Davidson. The five Blue Hen starters accounted for 57 of UD's 71 points on the night.
- Davidson shot 59.3 percent from the field and 60.9 percent from three-point range, both the highest percentages against UD since the 2018-19 season. UD allowed its highest point total since a 93-78 loss at the College of Charleston on Jan. 2, 2018.
- · Delaware and Siena have split six all-time meetings, although just one has come since the 2003–04 season. That was a 90–56 Siena victory in Albany on Nov. 24, 2009.

DELAWARE VS. SIENA

Delaware and Siena have split six all-time meetings, although just one has come since the 2003-04 season. That was a 90-56 Siena victory in Albany on Nov. 24, 2009.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Delaware is playing its second straight road game to open the season. The Blue Hens are home against La Salle on Wednesday, before three straight games at the Gulf Coast Showcase in Estero, Fla. and a road contest at Temple.

Delaware opens its season with six of its first seven games away from Newark for the first time since the 2012-13 squad played its first eight games on the road.

BLUE HENS RETURN ENTIRE ROSTER

Delaware returns its entire roster from the 2020-21 season. The Blue Hens are one of just three Division I programs to return 100 percent of its scoring from a year ago.

All four of UD's seniors from last season (Ryan Allen, Kevin Anderson, Anthony Ochefu and Dylan Painter) decided to return. The Blue Hens are one of four Division I program featuring at least four "super seniors."

Butler has five, while Delaware, Richmond and East Tennessee State all have four.

INJURY REPORT

Johnny McCoy will miss the season after undergoing knee surgery in November.

Anthony Ochefu is expected to be out 4-5 weeks with a knee injury. Aleks Novakovich is out indefinitely as he recovers from a lower extremity injury.

Wes Peterson suffered a sprained ankle at Davidson and is questionable for tonight's game.

LAST TIME OUT

Davidson used a hot-shooting night and a decisive first half run to pull away from Delaware, 93-71, in both teams' season opener Tuesday night at Belk Arena.

The Wildcats shot over 58 percent in both halves, finishing with a 59.3 percentage for the night, and buried 14 of 23 three-point attempts. Michigan State transfer Foster Loyer poured in 27 points in his Davidson debut, while Hyunjung Lee added 15 on the night.

Dylan Painter paced the Blue Hens with 17 points and six rebounds, while Jameer Nelson, Jr. added 11 points, six boards and three assists during his first game in a Delaware uniform. Kevin Anderson also scored 11 points for Delaware, which shot just 40.4 percent from the floor

The Blue Hens got off to a strong start by hitting seven of their first 10 shots from the field, and a jumper by Nelson, Jr. gave Delaware an 18–16 lead with 11:25 left in the opening half.

However Davidson took control of the contest by

scoring the next 14 points, before Jyare Davis converted a layup to make it a 30-20 game at the 5:44 mark.

The Wildcats eventually built the margin to 49-26, before a putback dunk by Wes Peterson just before the buzzer cut the Blue Hens' deficit to 51-33 at the break.

Delaware never got closer than 19 points in the second half, while Davidson took its largest lead of the night at 79-47 with eight and a half minutes to play.

WILDCATS SHOOT WELL VS. BLUE HENS

Davidson shot 59.3 percent from the field against Delaware, including 60.9 percent (14 of 23) from threepoint range.

The Blue Hens allowed just one of their 15 opponents last year to shoot over 50 percent from the floor. The Wildcats' 59.3 percentage was the highest by a UD opponent since Hofstra shot 60.0 percent on Mar. 2, 2019. Davidson's three-point percentage was the highest allowed by UD since that same Hofstra team also went 14 of 23 from deep on Dec. 28, 2018.

NELSON, JR. STARTS IN BLUE HEN DEBUT

Jameer Nelson, Jr. was in the starting lineup at Davidson during his Blue Hen debut.

The junior guard finished with 11 points while tying for the team lead with six rebounds and three assists in a team-high 31 minutes on the floor.

PAINTER IMPRESSIVE IN OPENER

Dylan Painter, a CAA Preseason first team selection, picked up where he left off a year ago with an impressive performance at Davidson.

Painter finished with a team-high 17 points and six rebounds, going 4 of 6 from the floor and 9 of 10 from the foul line.

ALLEN SECOND ON UD CAREER 3-POINTERS LIST

Ryan Allen currently ranks second in UD history with 243 three-pointers made. He has hit a three-pointer in all but eight of his 101 career games played.

Allen connected on 86 three-pointers during his rookie season, tying the UD single season mark also held by John Gordon in 1998-99. That record was broken during the 2019-20 season by Nate Darling.

Allen hit a three-pointer in the first 29 games of his career, the second longest streak in school history. Peca Arsic drained a triple in 36 consecutive games from 1994-96.

Allen also ranks second in UD history with 693 three-pointers attempted; Kyle Anderson holds the record with 780 triples attempted.

PAINTER COMING OFF STELLAR 2020-21 CAMPAIGN

Dylan Painter was a first team NABC All-District 10 and first team All-CAA selection last season, and was also named to the CAA All-Defensive Team.

He led the CAA and ranked sixth in the nation with 11.5 rebounds per game, and also paced the conference with 3.3 offensive rebounds and 8.1 defensive rebounds per contest.

Painter posted a conference-high seven double-doubles, and was third in the CAA with 1.1 blocks per game, seventh with a 51.5 field goal percentage, and 14th with 13.5 points per game. He was UD's leading rebounder in 14 of the 15 games.

CARR RETURNS TO STARTING LINEUP

Andrew Carr, who appeared in all 15 games while making 10 starts as a freshman, returned to the starting lineup vs. Davidson. He finished with nine points and four rebounds on the night.

Carr averaged 8.2 points and 3.6 rebounds per game, and scored 39 points in consecutive games against Hofstra in January.

ALLEN, ANDERSON BACK IN UD BACKCOURT

The Blue Hens return an experienced backcourt as fifth-year seniors Ryan Allen and Kevin Anderson both return.

Allen was a third team All-CAA pick a year ago when he led UD and ranked ninth in the league with 15.3 points per game. He also paced the Blue Hens with 30 three-pointers made and 40 assists, while his 35.9 minutes average was the fourth highest in the league.

Anderson appeared in 11 games a year ago (he missed four with an ankle injury), ranking third on the team with a 12.4 scoring average. He scored a teamhigh 22 points and hit five triples in the CAA Tournament Quarterfinal loss to Hofstra.

ASAMOAH LOOKS TO CONTINUE LONG-RANGE SHOOTING

Ebby Asamoah led the CAA and ranked second in a UD single season with a 45.8 three-point percentage last season. He connected on 27 of his 59 shots from behind the arc. John Gordon is UD's single season leader with a 46.2 percentage in the 1998-99 campaign.

GARDNER. CURTIS RETURN FROM INJURIES

Reggie Gardner and Logan Curtis are both looking to contribute in the backcourt after missing last season with injuries.

Gardner, who sat out the 2019-20 season after transferring to UD from North Carolina Central, missed all of last year with a shoulder injury.

Curtis, who transferred to UD from East Carolina in the summer of 2020, missed all of last year after suffering a lower right leg injury during preseason practice in November.

Gardner played five minutes against Davidson, while Curtis hit two free throws in the final three minutes of action.

DAVIS, PETERSON MAKE BLUE HEN DEBUTS

Redshirt freshman Jyare Davis and true freshman Wes Peterson both made their Blue Hen debuts at Davidson

Davis finished with four points in 16 minutes on the floor, while Peterson added two points in 11 minutes.

Davis redshirted his freshman season at Providence in 2020-21. He starred at nearby Sanford School, becoming the first player in the history of Delaware to earn four first team All-State accolades.

Peterson averaged 16.1 points per game as a junior at Bishop O'Connell High School. He was named Honorable Mention All-Washington Catholic Athletic Conference in 2018 and 2020, before having his senior season canceled due to COVID.

DARLING DRAFTED BY G LEAGUE'S AGUA CALIENTE CLIPPERS

Former Blue Hen guard Nate Darling was the fifth overall pick in October's NBA G League Draft by the Agua Caliente Clippers.

Darling signed a two-way deal with the Charlotte Hornets last season, and became the first Blue Hen alum to appear in an NBA regular season game.

He played in seven games for the Hornets late in the season, finishing with nine points.

Darling enjoyed one of the finest seasons in UD history in 2019-20 when he was a first team All-CAA, NABC All-District 10, and USBWA All-District II selection. He averaged 21.0 points per game, which ranked third in the CAA, 18th in Division I and sixth in a UD single season. Darling scored 672 points on the year, third most in a UD single season and seven shy of the school record. He also set a Blue Hen record by hitting 107 three-pointers on the season, sixth most in the nation.

DELAWARE PICKED FIRST IN CAA PRESEASON POLL

Delaware was picked first in the CAA Preseason Poll announced during the league's Media Day. The Blue Hens have been picked to win the CAA for the first time since joining the league.

MARTIN INGELSBY

HEAD COACH 6TH SEASON NOTRE DAME '01



Martin Ingelsby is currently in his sixth season as University of Delaware men's basketball head coach during the 2021-22 season.

During the summer of 2019, Ingelsby signed a two-year

extension through the 2023-24 season.

Ingelsby has led a steady improvement for the Blue Hens, as UD was one of just three Division I schools to increase its win total in four consecutive years from 2016–20.

After spending the previous 13 seasons on the Notre Dame coaching staff from 2003-16, Ingelsby led the Blue Hens to 13 victories during his first year in Newark, including a win over Hofstra in the CAA Tournament. During his second year Delaware won 14 games, and earned a CAA Tournament victory for the second consecutive year by defeating Elon in the first round.

In 2018-19 the Blue Hens finished 17-16 and were fifth in the CAA standings, posting their highest win total and highest CAA finish in five years. Delaware erased a 14-point halftime deficit in the 85-79 win over William & Mary in the CAA quarterfinals, the largest halftime comeback in CAA Tournament history.

A Blue Hen earned the CAA Rookie of the Year award in both of Ingelsby's first two years, while Delaware was the only CAA school to earn an All-Rookie Team selection in each of his first three seasons.

In 2019-20 Ingelsby led UD to even greater heights as the Blue Hens finished 22-11, posting a five-win improvement and recording the eighth 20-win season in pro-

gram history. Delaware set a program record by winning its first nine games, earning a vote in the Associated Press Top 25 poll for the first time in two decades. The Blue Hens tied for fourth place in the CAA and defeated Charleston in the quarterfinals to advance to the semifinals for the second consecutive year.

First team All-CAA and All-District selection Nate Darling enjoyed a phenomenal season by setting a UD single season mark with 107 three-pointers made and ranking third with 672 points scored, while Dylan Painter earned first team All-CAA honors last year.

Ingelsby, a native of Berwyn, Pa., was a standout point guard for Notre Dame from 1997-2001. He began his coaching career as an assistant at Wagner College during the 2002-03 campaign before returning to his alma mater as Notre Dame's coordinator of basketball operations. He spent six seasons in that position before being promoted to assistant coach in July 2009, a position he held for seven years.

Ingelsby primarily worked with the Notre Dame guards and played an integral role in elevating the program's national recruiting efforts. Notre Dame advanced to the NCAA Tournament's Elite Eight in both 2015 and 2016 during his final two seasons in South Bend.

Ingelsby was Notre Dame's starting point guard during three of his four seasons in South Bend. As a senior in 2000–01 he averaged 8.2 points and a team-high 6.4 assists as a starter in all 30 games. A team captain during his senior year, he guided the Irish to a 20–10 overall record and the Big East's West Division championship, the school's first ever conference title. Additionally, Notre Dame advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament after earning a berth for the first time in more than a decade in Brey's first season. A two-time member of the Big East Academic All-Star Team, Ingelsby was the recipient of the Notre Dame Club of St. Joseph Valley Rockne Student-Athlete Award during his senior season. He graduated from the Mendoza College of Business with a bachelor's degree in marketing in May, 2001.

Ingelsby enjoyed an outstanding career at Archbishop Carroll High School where he finished as the school's all-time leading scorer with 1,425 points and led his teams to an 80-12 record during his three years on the varsity squad.

Ingelsby and his wife, Colleen, are the parents of twins Will and Kate, as well as sons Jack and Benjamin.


