SERIES HISTORY

As one of the two newest members in Conference USA, Delaware will be facing Kennesaw State for the first time in program history.

KEY STORYLINES

NOT IN HER HOWES

Macie Howes has been the engine for the Owls this season. After becoming the first player since 2021 to homer in three-straight games back on Feb. 25, she homered in three-straight contests again from March 29-April 3. She had a 19-game on-base streak, which was the longest among CUSA players and 6th-longest among all mid-major players. Defensively, she's 20th in the entire country with 11 runners caught stealing. Howes ranks in the top five in CUSA in OPS (1.221) and RBI (38). Her .400 batting average is sixth in the conference.

IF IT AIN'T BROKE, DON'T FIX IT

The outfield of Ana Gore (LF), Ava Brooke Strickland (CF) and Alora Bevely (RF) has started every game this season. The trio is the only one in Conference USA to have started every game in the outfield. Gore has elevated her game in conference play, posting a triple slash of .407/.446/.729 with nine extra-base hits. Bevely has been a table setter, batting .333 in the leadoff spot with 12 multi-hit games. Strickland has set single-game highs in hits and runs.

OPPONENT BREAKDOWN

- Delaware is tied for fourth place in CUSA with a conference record of 11-7 and an overall mark of 23-19.
- The Blue Hens have three players batting over .300 on the season. 2025 CAA Player of the Year Sydney Shaffer has adapted to CUSA, ranking third in homers at 13 with the second-best OPS at 1.288. Fellow senior Katie Scheivert joins Shaffer with 10+ homers and 30+ RBI. Freshman Allie Nankivell leads the team and is seventh in the conference with a .398 batting average.
- UD's rotation, which ranks second in CUSA and 44th in the entire country at 215 punchouts, is headlined by Josie Crossman. The Cumming, Ga. native is 11-8 with 92 strikeouts in 113.2 innings. Three other pitchers have thrown 40+ innings with Claire Woods having the seventh-best opponent batting average in CUSA at .235.
- UD is 140th in the NCAA RPI and one spot high on the D1Softball RPI rankings, sitting at 139th.

KENNESAW STATE HEAD COACH SELENA COLLINS-PATTERSON



Selena Collins-Patterson, a decorated athlete and respected coach, was named the seventh head softball coach in Kennesaw State University history, Director of Athletics Milton Overton announced Monday, Sept. 15.

Collins-Patterson brings more than 22 years of coaching experience across NCAA Division I, high school, travel leagues, and private academies. She comes from the Marist School and served as CEO and president of the Atlanta Vipers Fastpitch Organization. Additionally, she taught as a KSU lecturer from 2014-25.

“Owl Nation, help me welcome Coach Collins-Patterson back home to the Nest!” Overton said. “Selena knows how to be a champion on the softball diamond and in the classroom. She embodies the spirit of Kennesaw State Athletics, understands what it means to be an Owl, and is deeply committed to the success of our student-athletes. We are thrilled to have her leading our softball program into an exciting new era.”

A Texas A&M Hall of Fame catcher, Collins-Patterson was a Big 12 Player of the Year, All-American, and team captain. She represented the USA National Team and earned NPF All-Star honors playing professionally in the National Pro Fastpitch League for the Texas Thunder and Chicago Bandits.

Her first collegiate coaching stop came at Sam Houston in 2009 where the Bearkats increased their team batting average by 22 points, making it all the way to the Southland Conference Tournament semifinals. In her two years in Huntsville, she had eight players earn All-Southland Conference honors.

In 2011, she was named head coach at Trinity University. She guided the Tigers to a conference championship appearance all three years with the program, receiving the 2012 Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference Coach of the Year. Under her tutelage, she guided two SCAC Players of the Year, the 2012 SCAC Newcomer of the Year, the 2013 SCAC Pitcher of the Year, and 33 all-conference honorees.

She has also served as the softball director for the National Baseball and Softball Academy.

A champion of student-athlete development, Collins-Patterson has overseen the Atlanta Vipers 2030 travel team, leading the Vipers to multiple championships, including the PGF Super Select 12U Southeast title. As a lecturer in KSU's Department of Health Promotion and Physical Education, she teaches wellness, coaching principles, and advanced sport coaching courses, underscoring her commitment to holistic student growth.

Collins-Patterson earned her bachelor's degree from Texas A&M in 2004 and her master's from Texas Women's University in 2012. She is currently a PhD candidate at Concordia University Chicago.

CRYSTAL HAMPTON

Hampton joined Kennesaw State as a volunteer assistant coach in her first collegiate position. She assists the Owls' pitching staff, as well as defensive instruction. She was named the Owls' pitching coach for the 2023 season.

In their first season in CUSA, the Owls' pitching staff under Hampton were one of the best strikeout units in the conference, ranking third with 260. She oversaw the development of sophomore Emma Friedel into one of the top arms in Conference USA. Friedel had the best opponent batting average (.202), the second-most shutouts (four) and was third in strikeouts at 132. Her magnum opus came against NM State on May 4. She pitched a Division I program record 13.0 innings against the Aggies, tying a CUSA record with 15 punchouts.

2024 was another stellar from the circle as Hampton led the Owls a 3.51 team ERA, registering four pitcher to ERA's under 4.00. She help revamp the ability of fifth year senior Lindsey Kyte who produced a career year in her final stanza.

In 2023, the pitching staff racked up a 4.54 team ERA. Between Hilleary and Bennett, they averaged a 3.62 ERA with 266 total strikeouts. She helped lift Hilleary to an All ASUN Freshman Team spot.

In her first season at Kennesaw State in 2022, the Owls went 23-28, including 12-12 in conference play. KSU set a program record for wins to end the regular season, with seven including nine of the last 10. The Owls defeated Stetson in the ASUN tournament play-in game and earned a fourth-place finish in the conference after a 14-4 win over Jacksonville State.

On the field in 2022, third baseman Taylor Cates had one of the most prolific seasons in KSU softball history. She set KSU Division I program records for home runs (19), slugging percentage (.847) and total bases (133). Cates also earned ASUN All-Conference First Team and All-Academic honors in addition to CoSIDA Academic All-American Third Team and NFCA All-Region Second Team.



DAISY HESS

Daisy Hess was promoted to assistant coach in November 2025 after serving as a graduate assistant during the 2025 season.

As a graduate assistant, she assisted with the infield, offensive scouting and baserunning. In 2025, Hess guided Macie Howes to Second-Team All-CUSA honors. Howes finished second in the conference with 12 runners caught stealing and ninth with 259 putouts. Ava Guzowski received College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-District honors.

Before coming to The Saw, Hess was a standout shortstop at Louisville from 2023-24. In 2024, she earned All-ACC third team honors. She EARstarted 49 games at shortstop, leading the Cardinals in runs (37) runs, doubles (12), triples (3) and on-base percentage (.456).

Her first season at Louisville was a rousing success. Hess was named to the All-ACC second team after leading the team and ranking second in the entire conference with 24 stolen bases. She registered a .335 batting average with 55 hits, seven doubles, four triples and four home runs. She also selected as a Easton/NFCA All-America Scholar Athlete.

Hess is familiar with the Peach State, starting her collegiate career at Georgia State. With the Panthers in 2022, she broke the program record for stolen bases in a single season at 29. That mark ranked 25th in NCAA history for stolen bases in a single season.

As a sophomore, she received NFCA All-Region Third Team honors after leading the team with 32 runs, 10 home runs, 11 doubles, 41 RBI, .641 slugging percentage, and 93 total bases.



MEL SAVALA

Mel Savala was hired in November 2025. Savala spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Saint Francis University (Pa.). In her two years in Loretto, the Red Flash won back-to-back NEC Tournament titles with the coaching staff being named NEC Coaching Staff of the Year in 2024. With a 67-40 record (38-7 NEC), she coached four NFCA all-region selections and 13 all-conference honorees.

Working primarily with hitters and the outfield, Savala guided Savannah Nash to NEC Player of the Year honors in 2025, leading the conference in batting average (.421) and stolen bases (18). Olivia Ulam also scooped up major postseason awards, being named the conference's Golden Glove, along with NEC Female Student Athlete of the Year and NEC Co-Scholar Athlete of the Year.

In her first season, Savala assisted Saint Francis to NEC Tournament and NEC Regular Season titles. She was part of the NEC Coaching Staff of the Year. She worked primarily with hitting and the outfield and helped Saint Francis rank second in program history in batting average, fourth in hits, and fifth in RBIs (280) and doubles (76).

Savala joined Saint Francis after she spent the 2023 season at NCAA Division II member Wingate University, where the Bulldogs held a 48-17 overall record. She assisted the program to its first regular season title since 2009. Wingate advanced to the 2023 NCAA Super Regionals.

Prior to Wingate, Savala spent three seasons at NCAA Division III member Millsaps College from 2020-22. In 2022, she assisted the Majors to an 11-7 conference record, its most wins since 2017, which included a series victory over nationally ranked Berry College.

Savala spend four years at Division III member University of Dallas, where she set a career record with 156 games played and single-game record with five stolen bases. She was a 2016 All-SCAC and a 2018-19 All-SCAC Academic selection in her career.

A NEW ERA

In 2026, the Owls will be led by Selena Collins-Patterson. She's the seventh head coach in program history and first female to lead the Owls since the program's first head coach

Medra Ashmore. She brings more than 22 years of coaching experience across all levels. She was heavily involved in the youth circuit, serving as CEO and president of the Atlanta Vipers Fastpitch Organization.

From 2011-13, she served as head coach at Trinity University. She guided the Tigers to a conference championship appearance all three years, receiving the 2012 Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference Coach of the Year. Under her tutelage, she guided two SCAC Players of the Year and 33 all-conference honorees.

A Texas A&M Hall of Fame catcher, Collins-Patterson was a Big 12 Player of the Year, All-American, and team captain. She represented the USA National Team and earned NPF All-Star honors playing professionally in the National Pro Fastpitch League for the Texas Thunder and Chicago Bandits.

The Owls round out their coaching staff with the retention of pitching coach Crystal Hampton, the promotion of Daisy Hess and the hiring of Mel Savala.

LEVELING UP

Collins-Patterson is brining a new motto to the program. #LevelUp reflects the idea that Collins-Patterson wants her players to be better every single day. She understands the standard is high but her vision for the program is for everyone to level up and become the best version of themselves. Mediocrity simply is unacceptable and the players can't be complacent. This philosophy not only applies to softball but life itself.

GREATEST HITS

KSU made history against Furman (2/21), recording a DI-record 20 hits in its 16-7 victory. Alora Bevily and Hannah Harvey led the way with four hits each, becoming the first Owls to record four hits since 2024. Ana Gore and Macie Howes both had three RBI as Gore is the first player in program history to record two sacrifice flies in the same game. The Black and Gold also swiped five bags in the contest.

GORE SURE

After a stellar freshman season in 2025, Ana Gore has found her groove in conference play. In the month of March, she batted .392 (20-for-51) with 11 RBI. She homered in back-to-back plate appearances in the Owls' win over Sam Houston on March 21. She followed that performance with a 3-for-3 day with two doubles and two RBI. In CUSA games, she sixth in hits (24) and has an OPS above 1.100.

SHE'S ON FIRE

Alora Bevily has been lighting it up for the Owls, batting .350 on the season. She went a perfect 4-for-4 against Furman (2/21), becoming the first Owl since 2024 to tally four hits in a game. She had reached base safely in 11 straight contests before that streak was snapped against Sam Houston.

JOJO'S WORLD

After a slow start, Jojo Johnson turned a corner. At Missouri State, the Placentia, Calif. native popped off. In game two of the series, she hit a grand slam, leading the Black and Gold to their first CUSA win of the Collins-Patterson era. In the final three weeks of March, she batted .355 with four extra-base hits and eight RBI.

LEANING ON LEAH

The Owls have turned to junior Leah Jannakos to be the ace in the circle. Her season started off with a bang, tossing 8.0 innings against GW (2/6). She picked up her first win at UNCW, throwing 2.2 scoreless out of the bullpen. Two complete games against Miami (2/17) and Chattanooga (2/25) gave the Black and Gold their first two home wins. In the CUSA opener against MTSU (3/6), the Haddock, Ga. native pitched 11.1 innings in an extra-innings thriller. Jannakos is the first Owl to win her first four decisions since Lindsey Kyte in 2020.

LEADING THE WAY

Seniors Macie Howes and Ava Brooke Strickland have been named captains for the 2026 season. Howes has been a steady presence behind the dish, earning the program's first All-Conference USA honor last year, being named to the second team. Coming to KSU in 2025, Strickland made her impact on the Owls from day one, starting 32 games as a corner outfielder.

NEW IN THE NEST

The Owls will have four freshmen for the 2026 season: Rylee Limberger, Savannah Frachiseur, Addison Smith and Kimberly Tobar. Limberger comes to Kennesaw as the No. 7 ranked player in Michigan. She dominated in the circle, receiving three all-state selections. Frachiseur is a second-generation Owl, with her father playing on the baseball team from 1999-2001. Savannah can play all over the infield at an excellent level. Smith is a do-it-all utility player who was ranked as high as the 60th best player in the country. She played one season at Newnan HS with current teammate Ava Brooke Strickland. Tobar should also provide depth in the infield. The Buford, Ga. native was an all-state selection in 2024.
