OPENING KICK

The University of Delaware men's soccer program heads back to Washington, D.C. for an away match at American University on Tuesday, September 1. Kickoff is at 4:00 p.m.

The Fightin' Blue Hens have played the Eagles twice (1-1-0) under head coach **Tommy McMenemy**, but this will be the fourth all-time meeting between the two teams.

Delaware opened the 2026 season with back-to-back 1-0 wins over Howard and Temple. Goal scorers for the season are **Liam Penny** (1) and **Freddy Jeffreys** (1). **Luke Jones** and **Sean Smith** each have recorded one assist on the year.

After the 2-0-0 week one, UD was ranked fifth in the West Region by the United Soccer Coaches Association.

American is off to a 0-2-1 start to the 2026 season under eighth-year head coach Zach Samol. The Eagles returned 21 athletes from their 2025 roster that won the programs first regular season title.

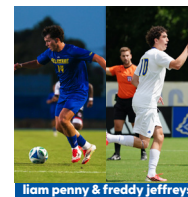

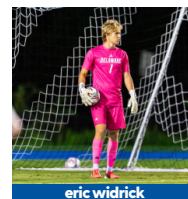

2-0 to start

The Fightin' Blue Hens opened their 2026 season with back-to-back 1-0 home wins over Howard and Temple for the team's ninth and 10th-consecutive home wins. **Liam Penny** and **Freddy Jeffreys** scored for the Hens.

Against Howard, **German Argueta**, **Frederik Flaskager**, and **Edwin Flores** recorded their first collegiate starts. **Eric Widrick** made his first start in goal as a Blue Hen. **Jayden Jackson** made his first appearance for Delaware, while **Luke Jones** recorded his first collegiate minutes.

Against Temple, Jones made his first collegiate start, while **Mason Booz**, **Seamus Lannon**, and **Cole Frederick** played their first collegiate minutes.

regionally ranked

The Blue Hens are ranked fifth in the West Region after opening the season 2-0-0.

mcmenemy's mcstaying

The University and head coach **Tommy McMenemy** agreed on a contract extension to keep him at the helm of the men's soccer program through the 2030 season.

makar movin' up

Justin Makar was promoted to associate head coach heading into year five at UD.

the summit league status

Delaware men's soccer became an affiliate member of The Summit League heading into the 2025 season. The league consists of University of Missouri-Kansas City (UMKC), University of Nebraska-Omaha (UNO), Oral Roberts University (ORU), University of St. Thomas (UST), and University of Massachusetts-Amherst (UMass).

UMKC is ranked 25th in the United Soccer Coaches preseason top 25 poll.

The Hens were voted second in The Summit League coaches' preseason poll behind UMKC.

bird watch x2

Heading into the 2026 season, Delaware has two student-athletes on the Missouri Athletic Club (MAC) Hermann Trophy Positional Players to Watch list: **Rich Monath** for midfielders and **Marius Stenner** for forwards. Stenner was also named to the overall 2026 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List.

keepin' it 100

Marius Stenner (18th), **Rich Monath** (42nd), and **JoJo Elliott Jr.** (46th) were named to TopDrawerSoccer's top 100 list.

Stenner also landed on their Best XI second team.

2025 at a glance

In the 100th season of the Delaware men's soccer program, the Hens finished 12-2-3 overall, 3-1-2 in conference, and appeared in the semifinals of The Summit League Tournament.

UD led the NCAA in scoring offense (2.82 goals per game) and points per game (8.53), was second in goal differential (+37), fifth in shutout percentage (.588), and seventh in goals against average (.647).

The Blue & Gold broke 16 program records in 2025, while leading The Summit League in 17 team categories and 15 individual categories.

Delaware recorded the best start in program history (7-0), played 10-straight games without any losses to open the season (9-0-1), and went undefeated at home (8-0) last season.

oh captains, my captains

Luke Chatten and **Mikey Johnson** were named team captains for the second-consecutive season.

new hens alert

Tommy McMenemy and his staff brought in 12 new commers this season which ties his largest recruiting class with his first year at Delaware.

transfers

Jayden Jackson was a mid-year transfer last spring. He joins the Blue Hens after playing three seasons of soccer at Temple. **Frederik Flaskager** (Penn State), **Braeden Sorensen** (Saint Francis/Lock Haven), and **Eric Widrick** (Colgate) also transferred to Delaware this fall.

key returners

Key returners for the Blue Hens include **Rich Monath** who was named 2025 Summit League Midfielder of the Year and earned First Team All-League honors. He led the conference in goals with 12.

Marius Stenner returns for his third season at Delaware after earning First Team All-Summit League recognition and Peak Offensive Performer of the Week three times in 2025. Stenner led the league in shots (57), shots per game (3.35), shots on goal (26), points (31), and points per game (1.82), and tied for first in game-winning goals (4) and assists (9).

Jan Schroeder who earned first team, and second team honorees **Luke Chatten**, **JoJo Elliott Jr.**, **Freddy Jeffreys**, and **Mikey Johnson** are the other all-league returners this season.

The 2026 Blue Hens roster brings a wealth of diversity. The roster consists of six different states (Delaware, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Virginia) and three different countries (Denmark, England, and Germany).

international hens

First career win: 2-0 vs Mount St. Mary's 8/25/22

HEAD COACH TOMMY MCMENEMY

Tommy McMenemy was announced as the head men's soccer coach on November 30, 2021.

In McMenemy's first season with the Blue Hens, he led them to a two-win improvement. In his first career game as head coach, Delaware defeated Mount St. Mary's 2-0.

In his second season as head coach at UD, McMenemy and his squad saw solid progress, finishing the season 9-4-6. The team opened the season with a 3-2 win over the Big Ten conference champions, Rutgers, and also won its third game in program history against a nationally ranked team, CAA conference rival Hofstra.

For McMenemy's third year in Newark and the team's final in the CAA, the team finished 7-7-2 overall.

In his fourth season at the helm, McMenemy led UD to a historic and record-breaking 2025 campaign in the program's 100th season and its first year competing in The Summit League.

The Blue Hens posted a 12-2-3 overall record and advanced to The Summit League Semifinals, finishing with the fewest losses (2) in program history. Delaware opened the year with the best start in program history (7-0), went unbeaten in its first 10 matches (9-0-1), and finished the season undefeated at home (8-0).

Under McMenemy's leadership, Delaware broke 16 program records in the 2025 season and emerged as one of the top

attacking teams in the nation, finishing first nationally in scoring offense (2.82 goals per game) and points per game (8.53), while ranking second in goal differential (+37). The Hens also earned a national ranking, climbing as high as No. 24 in TopDrawerSoccer's Top 25 poll, and received votes in three United Soccer Coaches national polls throughout the season.

During his 10 seasons with the Wolverines, six as an assistant coach and four as the associate head coach, McMenemy was responsible for bringing in top talent. He recruited seven top-20 ranked recruiting classes within nine years.

Playing against top teams across the nation, McMenemy played a pivotal role in Michigan winning its first conference title in program history in 2017. Michigan also earned four berths to the NCAA tournament (two top-16 seeds). He coached the Big Ten Offensive Players of the Year in both 2018 and 2019.

Prior to Ann Arbor, McMenemy served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, Columbia University, for six seasons.

As a player for the Lions, McMenemy earned NSCAA Adidas All-American status as a senior in 2003 and was a two-time unanimous First-Team All-Ivy League and first team all-region selection (2002-03). He led the team in goals and assists in his junior and senior seasons and was selected by his teammates as a team captain as a senior. McMenemy also excelled in the classroom, earning Academic All-Ivy League honors in his final two years as a student-athlete.

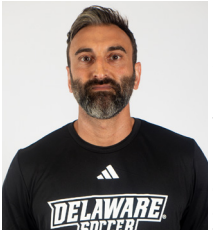

ASSISTANT COACHES



JUSTIN MAKAR

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

Makar enters his fifth season with the Delaware men's soccer program in 2026 after being promoted to associate head coach following the 2025 season.

Prior to joining the Blue Hens staff, Makar served alongside McMenemy on the University of Michigan men's soccer staff since 2014 as the program's director of operations and video coordinator. He was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program including opponent scouting, postgame and training film analysis, individual player analysis, equipment, team travel, camp organization and promotion, training plans, match preparation and budget management.

During his time in Ann Arbor, the Wolverines advanced to the NCAA Tournament second round in 2017 and 2018 before earning a spot in the Sweet Sixteen in 2019. Michigan won the 2017 Big Ten regular season title, advanced to the conference tournament semifinals four times, and competed in the Big Ten Tournament championship match in 2018 and 2019.

Prior to his stint at Michigan, Makar spent four years on the Lafayette coaching staff, the first three as assistant coach/goalkeeping coach and the final year as first assistant and recruiting coordinator. The Leopards posted 27 shutouts during his four seasons in Easton and won the 2012 Patriot League championship.

Makar began his coaching career as an assistant coach at Susquehanna University from 2007-10, helping lead the River Hawks to the 2008 Landmark Conference title.

Makar was a four-year letterwinner at Susquehanna from 2003-06, earning second team All-Mid-Atlantic Conference honors in 2004 and 2005 before being named to the first team in 2006. He served as team captain as a senior and was a three-time All-Mid-Atlantic Conference Academic Team honoree. Makar graduated from Susquehanna in May, 2007 with a bachelor's degree in business administration with an emphasis in marketing and a minor in economics.



DARIAN MCCAULEY

ASSISTANT COACH

McCauley enters his second year on the Blue Hens' staff after being hired in April of 2025.

Previously he spent two years at Florida Elite Soccer Academy serving as the director of goalkeeping. Prior to Florida Elite Soccer Academy, he spent time in Pennsylvania as an assistant coach with the men's and women's soccer programs at Millersville University. McCauley also worked as an academy goalkeeper coach with Penn Fusion Soccer Academy and he continues to serve as an assistant director for One on One Goalkeeping headquartered in Lancaster.

McCauley is a 2020 graduate of Millersville where he won back to back PSAC championships in 2018 and 2019. He tied the program record for shutouts at 24, and is second all-time for career wins with 42.



YAWO BAAH

ASSISTANT COACH

Baah is entering his fifth year with the men's soccer program in 2026.

Baah previously spent four years as an assistant coach at Albright College with men's and women's programs. He helped coach the women's team to a 13-8-1 overall record and the program's first ever MAC Commonwealth playoff win during the 2019 season, while the team also made its fourth-straight ECAC Tournament appearance. Baah also assisted head coach Pat Stanco in coaching two All-Conference players that year.
