### HOME OPENER

- Bradley (1-0) will play its 24th home opener at Carver Arena Saturday at 2:05 p.m. when the Braves host Chicago State (0-1).
- Beginning its 102nd season of men's basketball competition, Bradley is 86-14 (.860) all-time in home openers -- *the Braves did not play a home game in 1902-03.*
- The Braves have won 12 straight home openers dating back to an 83-49 loss to Utah Dec. 5, 1992.
- Bradley is 21-2 (.913) all-time in its Carver Arena season debuts, losing only to Utah in 1992 and Long Beach State (94-84) on Dec. 6, 1989.

### SERIES HISTORY

- Bradley owns a 12-0 lead in the all-time series versus Chicago State, including a 10-0 home record against the Cougars.
  - The teams last met in the final round of the Outrigger Hotels Rainbow Classic Dec. 30, 2002 in Honolulu, where the Braves prevailed, 88-76, to claim the tournament's fifth-place finish.

## 102nd SEASON OF BU BASKETBALL

- Bradley is playing its 102nd season of men's basketball.
- The Braves began the season ranked 26th nationally with 1,451 all-time victories, tops among the 10 current members of the Missouri Valley Conference.

## LES BEGINS FOURTH SEASON

- Former Bradley point guard **Jim Les (Bradley '86)** is beginning his fourth season as the head coach at his alma mater.
- Les enters Saturday's game with a 41-49 (.456) record in his first head coaching position.
- After inheriting a team that produced a 9-20 record in 2001-02, Les joined Bradley legend A.J. Robertson as the only two coaches in the program's 102-year history to lead the Braves to an improved record in each of his first two seasons.
- Bradley led the nation in improved offense (+12.8 ppg) in Les' first season by increasing its scoring from 60.7 points per game in 2001-02 to 73.5 in 2002-03.
- Has coached the Braves to a 23-7 (.767) home record the last two seasons, highlighted by a 15-game

home winning streak.

- Spearheaded the capital improvement efforts for the basketball facilities, including a new weight room, athletic training room, study center and player lounge in Robertson Memorial Fieldhouse.

## BRAVES PICKED SIXTH IN THE MVC

- Bradley was picked sixth in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll of the league's 10 head coaches, sports information directors, primary beat writers and radio play-by-play voices released Tuesday.
- In addition, senior forward **Marcellus Sommerville** was a repeat selection for the preseason all-conference team.

- In addition to last Saturday's season-opening 75-60 win at DePaul, the Braves will host Chicago State this Saturday at Carver Arena and will visit Loyola-Chicago Nov. 30 at the Gentile Center.
- Bradley has not played three Chicago teams since going 2-1 against the same trio during the 1993-94 season: Chicago State (76-60), DePaul (64-81) and Loyola-Chicago (78-55).

- Bradley's most-recent game against a Mid-Con member was an 88-76 victory versus Chicago State Dec. 30, 2002 in the fifth-place game at the Outrigger Hotels Rainbow Classic in Honolulu.
- IUPUI was the last Mid-Continent member to visit Carver Arena and the Panthers suffered a 70-53 loss Dec. 30, 2000 on Bradley's home floor.

## ABOUT CHICAGO STATE

- Chicago State returns two starters among four lettermen from the 2004-05 squad that finished 9-19 overall and tied for sixth in the Mid-Continent Conference with a 7-9 league record.
- Kevin Jones is in his third full season as the Chicago State head coach and enters Saturday's game with a 21-52 career record.
- The Cougars opened the 2004-05 season with an 81-52 loss Nov. 20 at Ohio State.
- Chicago State shot 34.8% from the field, 20.0% (4-20) from 3-point land and 28.6% (2-7) from the free throw line at Ohio State.
- Chicago State will not play a non-conference home game this season and will not play a home game of any kind until hosting Oral Roberts Jan. 2 at Dickens Center.

## HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

- Bradley begins its 24th season of playing its home games at Carver Arena Saturday.
- The Braves are **244-81 (.751)** all-time at Carver Arena, including a **103-27 (.792)** record in non-conference games.
- Although the Braves lost their 2004-05 regular-season home finale to Valley rival Drake, Bradley has won 12 consecutive non-conference home games dating back to a 74-71 loss to Central Michigan Dec. 18, 2002.

## APPROACHING 1,000

- Senior forward **Marcellus Sommerville** enters Saturday's game with 992 career points, leaving him just 25 shy of become the 40th member of Bradley's 1,000-Point Club.
- After playing his freshman season at Southwestern Illinois College, Sommerville will become the 28th Brave to join the 1,000-Point Club in less than four years.

## DEEP BENCH

- During Bradley's two preseason games, nine Bradley players averaged between 16.0 and 24.5 minutes per game.
- During the 2004-05 season, only six Bradley players averaged better than 16.0 minutes per game, including two Braves, Marcellus Sommerville (34.5 mpg) and Daniel Ruffin (34.1 mpg), who averaged more than 34.0 minutes.
- Bradley used 11 players in the first half of the season-opener at DePaul and 10 players logged at least six minutes in the game versus the Blue Demons.

## TURNOVER MARGIN

- One of Bradley's biggest struggles during the 2004-05 season was turnover margin.
- The Braves averaged 16.6 turnovers per game last season and ranked ninth in the Missouri Valley Conference with a -1.71 turnover margin.
- After benefitting from a +10.0 turnover margin during this year's two exhibition wins, Bradley posted a +14 turnover margin Saturday at DePaul, committing only nine turnovers against the host's 23.

## ASSIST/TURNOVER RATIO

- Bradley was seventh in the Valley by averaging 13.54 assists per game in 2004-05, and coupled with the team's 16.6 turnovers per game, the Braves ranked ninth in assist/turnover margin (0.85).
- The Braves dished out 44 assists against 30 turnovers in the preseason, an average of 1.47 assists per turnover, then dished out 21 assists against only nine turnovers Saturday at DePaul.

## ASSIST PERCENTAGE

- During Bradley's two exhibition games, the Braves earned assists on 44 of the team's 61 field goals, an assist percentage of .721.
- Bradley followed up its preseason performance by recording assists on 21 of the 30 (.700) field goals at DePaul.
- During the 2004-05 season, Bradley ranked eighth in the Valley by recording an assist on 54.2 percent of the team's field goals, while Wichita State led the league with a .649 assist percentage.

## LOOKING AHEAD

- After a week between its first two games, the regular-season schedule will pick up as the Braves will play three games in seven days, beginning Wednesday at Loyola-Chicago (2-0).
- The Ramblers, who beat Valley member Evansville (99-86) Monday night, will try for a 3-0 start Saturday by hosting Luther College before the Braves.
- Bradley will return home Dec. 3 to host Bowling Green (2-2) in the final game of a 3-year series, then will visit Butler (2-2) Dec. 6.

### 2005-06 (SENIOR)

- Sommerville started the season with 17 points and eight rebounds Saturday at DePaul, helping the Braves to a 75-60 victory.
- In keeping with his career trend, Sommerville scored in double figures (17 points) and drained at least one 3-pointer (3-of-7), marking the 51st time in 60 career games he has accomplished both feats.
- Upped his career scoring total to 992 points, leaving him just eight shy of becoming the 40th member of Bradley's 1,000-Point Club.
- Also upped his career total to 97 3-pointers, leaving him three shy of the century mark.

### 2004-05 (JUNIOR)

- The focal point of a youthful team that featured only one player with more than one season of Division I experience, Sommerville's numbers improved in nearly every statistical category in his second season at Bradley.
- For the second straight year, Sommerville ranked among The Valley's top three in scoring (17.5 ppg) and rebounding (7.5 rpg), finishing third in both areas.
- Led the league by averaging 5.43 defensive rebounds per game and ranked second by averaging 34.64 minutes played per game.
- Made all 12 of his free throw attempts in the regular-season finale versus Drake, the most charity shots made without a miss during a game by a Brave since Aaron Zobrist also went 12-for-12 Jan. 13, 1997 versus Indiana State.
- Ended the regular-season by scoring in double-figures in 19 consecutive games, the longest double-digit scoring streak in the Valley during the 2004-05 season.

### 2003-04 (SOPHOMORE)

- Named one of the nation's top five junior college transfers by Dick Vitale in his 2003-04 ESPN.com preseason list of honors, Sommerville backed up the preseason billing by averaging 15.6 points and 7.3 rebounds per game in his first year at Bradley.

PEORIA, Ill. -- Bradley sophomore center Patrick O'Bryant led a balanced attack with 14 points, six rebounds and three blocked shots and the Braves steadily pulled away for a 74-62 exhibition victory versus NCAA Division II Southern Illinois-Edwardsville in the preseason opener for both teams Thursday night at Robertson Memorial Fieldhouse.

Senior forward Lawrence Wright added 12 points and a game-high seven rebounds for the Braves, while senior forward Marcellus Sommerville chipped in with 11 points and three assists. SIU-Edwardsville put four players in double-figures, led by guard Anthony Jones' game-high 16 points. Guard J.B. Jones and center Doug Taylor each scored 14 for the Cougars and guard Ryan Belcher added 11 points.

The remaining six SIU-Edwardsville players who saw action, however, combined for just seven points and only five off the bench. Bradley countered by playing all 13 of its available players, and while the Braves only put three in double-figures, the other 10 players combined for 37 points, 21 rebounds, 18 assists and six steals.

The first 15 minutes of the game featured six ties and four lead changes before Bradley finally started to gain some space. After Belcher's layup gave the Cougars a 26-25 lead with 6:15 left in the first period, the Braves countered with a 7-0 spurt to take the lead for good. Andrews started the surge with a free throw, O'Bryant followed with a second-chance bucket and a short hook shot and Wright capped the burst with an alley-oop dunk for a 32-26 lead with 2:15 left in the period. J.J. Tauai's tip-in basket at the buzzer gave the Braves a 37-30 lead at the break.

The team's exchanged baskets for the first three minutes of the second half before the Braves finally stretched their lead to double-digits. O'Bryant gave Bradley a 45-36 lead with a layup and Jeremy Crouch drained his only 3-pointer of the game for a 48-36 edge with 16:27 left. The lead never dipped below double-digits the rest of the way, but never grew to more than the 17-point bulge the Braves twice enjoyed in the final five minutes, 68-51 with 4:55 left and 72-55 with 2:37 remaining.

Both teams shot 46 percent from the field, but Bradley grabbed eight more offensive rebounds than the Cougars and enjoyed a +8 turnover margin (20-12). Those numbers helped the Braves get off 18 more field goal attempts.

PEORIA, Ill. -- Bradley senior forward Marcellus Sommerville led a balanced attack with 15 points, five rebounds, five assists and two steals and the Braves (2-0 preseason) concluded its exhibition season with an 85-55 victory versus NCAA Division II Minnesota State (1-1 preseason) Saturday night at Carver Arena.

Bradley limited the visitors to 37.0 percent shooting from the field and forced the Mavericks into 30 turnovers, 21 from steals. The Braves shot an even 50 percent from the field and recorded 25 assists on their 31 baskets.

Bradley sophomore center Patrick O'Bryant complemented Sommerville's effort with 15 points, seven rebounds and two blocked shots in his 18 minutes of action. Junior forward Zach Andrews contributed seven points, a game-high eight rebounds, three steals and two assists in his 21 minutes off the bench and sophomore point guard Daniel Ruffin dished out a game-high eight assists with no turnovers. Minnesota State's Paris Kyles and Luke Anderson shared game-high scoring honors with 19 points apiece.

After Minnesota State took its only lead of the game, 5-4, on an Anderson 3-pointer 2:24 into the game, O'Bryant gave the Braves the lead for good by starting a 21-4 burst with slam off a Sommerville feed with 17:18 left in the first half. Sommerville, who sank all three of his 3-point tries, capped the surge with treys from the left corner on consecutive possessions for a 25-11 lead with 8:02 left in the half.

After Bradley settled for a 42-30 lead at halftime, Minnesota State opened the second period with a 3-point play by Kyles, but Bradley countered with a 27-10 punch to break the game open. The lead did not dip below 21 points the rest of the way and grew to the final 30-point margin when walk-on guard Brian Lavin drained a 3-pointer on an inbounds play after checking into the game with 20 seconds remaining.

Bradley officially will begin its 102nd season of men's basketball by starting the season with three consecutive games versus Chicago schools. The Braves will visit DePaul next Saturday at 1:05 p.m. in the season opener for both teams. Bradley's home opener will be played Nov. 26 at 2:05 p.m. versus Chicago State and the Braves will return to Chicago Nov. 30 to visit Loyola.
