MVC SHOWDOWN

- The top two teams in the Missouri Valley Conference standings will meet in a 3-game series at Dozer Park when Missouri State visits Bradley this weekend.
- A perennial power in The Valley, Missouri State sits atop the league standings with an 8-1 conference record.
- Bradley owns the league's best overall record and the Braves are tied for second in the league chase at 7-2, just one game behind the Bears.
- The series matches the league's top offensive team against the top pitching squad - the Braves rank in the top 10 nationally in batting average and scoring, while Missouri State owns The Valley's top ERA at 4.03.
- Bradley has matched its season-best winning streak with eight consecutive victories, equalling its longest win streak since taking 10

in a row April 22-May 12, 2007.

- The Bears have dominated the series, winning each of the last five meetings to build a 66-36 all-time record against Bradley.
- The teams have split the 20 previous meetings at Dozer Park, however, 10-10.

RETURN GAME

- Bradley Baseball returned the top six hitters from its 2017 squad and eight of its nine regular starters overall.
- Those eight players accounted for 377 individual games played last season, including 370 individual starts, 374 of the team's 464 base hits (80.6 percent) and 220 of the team's 258 RBI's (85.3 percent).
- Among the returnees: 2017 MVC Freshman of the Year **Brendan Dougherty**, 2017 team home run and RBI leader **Derek Bangert** and shortstop **Luke Shadid**, who led the '17 Braves with 36 runs scored and was the first freshman in the modern era of Bradley Baseball to start every game of a season at shortstop.

HITTING-PITCHING RETURN DOUBLE

- In the history of Bradley Baseball, the 2018 campaign marks the ninth season in which the Braves have returned at least one pitcher (junior LHP **Cole Cook**, 8-6) who won at least seven games the previous season and the team's top hitter by batting average (sophomore 3B **Brendan Dougherty**, .305).
- In the last year, 2015, Bradley returned the pitching and hitting double, the Braves finished 36-21 overall and earned their first NCAA Regionals appearance in 47 years.
- The double returning factor generally has produced positive results for the Braves over the years:

2018: 25-9, has surpassed 2017 win total

2015: 36-21, NCAA Regional

2006: 26-31, best MVC win % in 7 years

1999: 26-31, program-record 15 MVC wins

1987: 41-21, 2nd in MVC, program-best 41 W's

1983: 19-17-2, 1st ever season sweep of Illinois

1968: 15-8, MVC champion, NCAA Playoffs

1957: 15-3, MVC champion, NCAA Playoffs

1948: 30-5, remains 2nd-best season winning percentage (.857) since World War II.

SNOW AND RAIN, GO AWAY

- Bradley has had five games cancelled to date this season due to rain, snow or frigid temperatures.
- All five cancellations have been of home games, leaving the Braves with just 14 games on the Dozer Park schedule this season.
- The 2018 season will mark the sixth in the last seven years in which the Braves will play fewer than 20 home games.

NATION'S SECOND MOST-IMPROVED

- Bradley enters the weekend as the nation's

second most-improved team, by winning percentage, compared to last year's final record.

- Coming off a 20-31 (.392) campaign in 2017, the Braves enter the weekend with a 25-9 (.735) record.
- The .343 improvement in winning percentage trails only a .344 jump by Seattle.

IMPROVEMENT FORECAST

- At 25-9 to start the week, the Braves already own five more wins than all of last year (20-31).
- The +5 improvement in wins is tied for the seventh-best jump in the nation to date.
- At its current .735 winning percentage, Bradley is on pace to win 36 games this season.
- The potential 16-win improvement easily would surpass the 2015 NCAA Regional squad and 1948 team for the best year-to-year win total jump in program history (+12).

IMPROVEMENT TO DATE

- Bradley was 15-19 through its first 34 games last year.
- Using the NCAA formula to calculate W-L improvement and heading into the week, the W-L improvement through 34 games is +10.0.
- Bradley has improved its W-L record by at least 10.0 just two times in program history, most recently with a +10.5 improvement from 1991 to 1992.

- Through 34 games, the current .294 increase in winning percentage represents Bradley's best win percentage improvement since 1967, when the Braves finished 17-5-1 (.761) after a 7-10 (.412) campaign in 1966, good for a .349 winning percentage improvement.

HOME SICK

- Having played just six games at Dozer Park this year, Bradley is one of two MVC teams (Valparaiso, 5) yet to play 10 home games.
- Bradley has played the fewest home games (75) in the league the last five years.
- Bradley's 75 home games the last five years are 11 fewer than Illinois State (86) and equal to Valley newcomer Valparaiso (75).
- Since the start of 2014, Dallas Baptist has won 34 more home games (109), than Bradley has played (75).

GOOD DECISIONS

- Bradley's starting pitchers own a 13-5 record in their collective 18 decisions this year.
- In the month since the team returned from its spring break trip to Florida, Bradley's starting pitchers are 7-1 and have allowed more than three earned runs in just two of those 18 starts.
- In the 18 games since spring break ended, Bradley's starting pitchers boast a 3.27 ERA.
- Conversely, the opposing starting pitchers in the same 18 games beginning March 21 are 1-10 record with a 7.68 ERA.

WHO NEEDS TO START?

- Senior RHP **Alex Gray** (6-0) begins the week tied for 36th nationally with six victories.
- Making his record more impressive, Gray has yet to start a game this season.
- While he ranks among the national leaders for victories, he is tied for sixth on his own team with nine pitching appearances.

MOUND IMPROVEMENT

- Bradley's pitching staff in 2017 was 20-31 with a 6.82 ERA and a 1.51 strikeouts-to-walk ratio.
- The 2018 staff has improved to 25-9 with a 4.13 ERA and a 2.13 strikeouts-to-walk ratio.
- The improved effort on the mound has been made both internally among a group of eight returning pitchers, as well as through recruiting and the resulting contributions of five newcomers.
- Of the 13 players to toe the rubber for the Braves this season, only one hurler owns an ERA higher than last year's staff norm and that one pitcher has totaled just 1.1 IP this year.

- During the 20-31 campaign a year ago, the Braves hit .268 as a team and averaged 5.65 runs per game.
- Then freshman **Brendan Dougherty** (.305) was the only regular offensive player to hit better than .300 in 2017.
- Through 34 games this year, the Braves rank among the nation's top 11 in scoring (seventh, 7.7 runs per game), on-base percentage (8th, .407) and batting average (11th, .304).
