- Bradley and Kansas State are meeting for third place at the Rocket Mortgage Fort Myers Tip-Off on Wednesday night.
- Kansas State fell to Pitt, 63-59, in Monday's action before Bradley lost to Northwestern, 87-51.

ABOUT THE BRAVES

- Bradley saw its four-game winning streak snapped on Monday to Northwestern. The Braves are now 4-2 in 2019-20.
- Three Braves are averaging in double figures as **Darrell Brown** leads BU with 13.7 points and 5.8 assists per game.
- Elijah Childs is second on the team with 13.0 points, while leading the Braves with 9.2 rebounds.
- Nate Kennell adds 11.2 points per game, shooting a team-best 40.6 from 3-point range.
- The Braves are averaging 71.0 points per game, while allowing 65.7.

SERIES HISTORY

- Bradley and Kansas State have played five prior times with the Wildcats holding a slight 3-2 advantage against the Braves.
- Kansas State has won the last three meetings with the schools last playing in 2014 – a 50-47 victory for the Wildcats.
- Bradley's last win in the series came in 1974 during the Commissioner's Classic in St. Louis.

BRAVES VERSUS BIG 12

- Bradley is 3-7 against the Big 12 since the league was formed prior to the 1996-97 campaign.
- The Braves have lost their last five meetings with their most recent matchup during the 2016-17 campaign at TCU.
- Bradley's most recent win versus the conference was a 65-56 win against Iowa State in 2007.

ABOUT THE WILDCATS

- Kansas State saw its four-game winning streak to start the year snapped with its loss to Pittsburgh on Monday.
- Xavier Sneed leads the Wildcats with 14.4 points per game to go with 5.2 boards.
- Cartier Diarra is second with 12.6 points, adding a team-leading 6.6 assists per game.
- Makol Mawien adds 8.4 points, while collecting a team-best 5.4 rebounds.
- Kansas State is averaging 64.2 points, while allowing just 55.6 points defensively.

TOURNAMENT LEADER

- Elijah Childs has saved his best during Bradley's regular-season and postseason tournaments.
- In last two years, Childs has averaged 15.7 points on 54.5 percent shooting, 7.3 boards and 2.1 blocks in seven neutral-site tournament games.

- Childs was named the MVP of both the Cancun Challenge and MVC Tournament a season ago before scoring 19 points in the NCAA Tournament versus Michigan State.
- The junior led Bradley with 14 points, seven boards and three rebounds on Monday versus Northwestern.

DEFENSE THE KEY TO BU VICTORIES

- Bradley's defensive effort has determined its success during the 2019-20 season.
- The Braves are allowing just 57.5 points in their four wins this season but have surrendered 82.0 in their two losses.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- The Braves have dominated on the glass so far this season, especially on the offensive end.
- Bradley ranks 15th nationally by collecting 14.3 offensive rebounds per game, while placing second in the Valley with 38.3 rebounds per game.
- Bradley totaled 23 offensive rebounds at Saint Joseph's on Nov. 5 – its most since grabbing 25 against Little Rock on Dec. 22, 2014.
- Elijah Childs and Koch Bar are tied for 13th nationally with 4.00 offensive boards per game. Childs is also 65th in the NCAA with 9.2 rebounds per game, while Bar is 91st at 8.7.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- Senior **Darrell Brown** has led the Braves' cause to get to the free throw line.
- The senior currently ranks in the top 25 nationally in both free-throw makes and attempts, ranking 19th with 32 makes and 22nd with 42 attempts.
- In fact, Brown is the active leader in the Valley and ranks 18th nationally among active players with 367 career free-throws made.

DEPTH IN SCORING

- One key for BU on offense is its depth of options.
- Three different Braves are currently averaging in double figures with two additional players scoring at least nine points. BU has not had at least three players score 10 points a game since 2013-14.
- In three of Bradley's six games this season, five Braves have scored in double figures.

TURNING POINT

- Bradley has controlled the turnover battle so far in 2019-20.
- BU has committed just 72 turnovers in five games, while forcing its opponents into 93 miscues.
- Overall, BU is 61st nationally with 12.0 turnovers per game, 199th with 15.5 turnovers forced per game and 72nd with a turnover margin of +3.5.

SHARING THE BALL

- Not only are the Braves not turning the ball over, but they are sharing it well.
- Bradley ranks 112th nationally with 14.7 per game after averaging 12.1 a season ago. BU is also 68th in the country with a 1.22 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Senior Darrell Brown leads BU with 5.8 assists per game, ranking 32nd in the country.
- Brown has recorded at least five assists in 5-of-6 games – the first Brave with a five-game run of at least five helpers since Daniel Ruffin in 2007-08.

OH HENRY!

- Sophomore **Ja'Shon Henry** is more than doubling his production in 2019-20.
- Henry has scored in double figures in 3-of-5 games he has played this season. Last year, he had three games of at least 10 points in 29 games played.
- Overall, Henry is averaging 9.2 points per game off the bench shooting 48.5 percent with 4.6 rebounds per game. He posted 4.2 points and 2.4 boards last season as a rookie.

CHILDS ON LOU HENSON WATCH LIST

- Junior **Elijah Childs** was named to the Lou Henson Award Preseason Watch List.
- The award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I mid-major player.
- Childs is second on the team with 13.0 points per game this season, while leading the Braves with 9.2 boards and six total blocks.
- The junior is one of three players from the Valley to earn the recognition, joining AJ Green (Northern Iowa) and Cameron Krutwig (Loyola).

NO LEAD IS SAFE

- Faced with its first halftime deficit of the season on Nov. 16, Bradley picked up where it left off last season and rallied for victory versus UIC.
- In 2018-19, the Braves led the Valley with eight halftime rallies three more than any other school in the conference and the team's most since also recording eight in 1987-88.
- In fact, BU has won seven of its last eight games when trailing by single digits at the half.

- Bradley's upperclassmen have combined to record 77.0 percent of points, 75.1 percent of rebounds, 83.0 percent of assists, 65.0 percent of blocks and 90.6 percent of steals.

DEFENSIVE STRENGTH

- Bradley has proven to be one of the top defensive teams in the MVC during the last two seasons.
- One year after owning the nation's 15th-ranked scoring defense (64.7 points), Bradley finished 35th of 353 schools last season, allowing 65.3 points per game.
- The team's defensive strength was crucial during its MVC Tournament run, allowing only 54.3 points in the three victories.
- The Braves are continuing that trend in 2019-20, allowing just 65.7 points per game.

FORCING THE TOUGH SHOTS

- One reason for Bradley's strong defensive start to the year is the team's ability to force teams to shoot from distance.
- Bradley's six opponents are shooting 44.7 percent of their fields goals from 3-point range – the 35thhighest rate in the country (national average is 37.5 percent).
- BU has also allowed its foes to make only 28.6 percent of their 3-point shots – 74th-best in the country.

HEAD COACH BRIAN WARDLE

- Named the 14th head coach in Bradley men's basketball history on March 28, 2015.
- Led a complete rebuild of the BU program that resulted in taking the team from a last place finish the year before he arrived to conference champions in his fourt season.
- Became the third Bradley coach to lead the Braves to a Missouri Valley Conference Tournament title in 2019, ending a 31-year drought for BU.
- Also led BU to the 2019 Cancun Challenge title becoming the first Bradley team to win two tournaments in the same year.
- Prior to joining the Braves, Wardle compiled a 95-65 (.594) overall record in his five seasons at Green Bay, which culminated with back-to-back 24-win seasons and the 2013-14 Horizon League regular-season title.
- Wardle was the youngest head coach in NCAA Division I basketball when he took over at Green Bay program in 2010 at age 30.
- Prior to taking over as head coach at Green Bay, spent the previous five seasons (2005-10) as a Phoenix assistant and two years (2003-05) as Director of Ops at Marquette.
- As a player, Wardle scored 1,690 career points at Marquette, currently eighth on the school's career scoring list.
- Led the Golden Eagles in scoring in each of his final three seasons (1998-01).

DUO NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MVC

- Bradley landed two players on the Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Team for the first time since 2013.
- **Darrell Brown** was named to the first team after leading BU in scoring (14.8 ppg), assists (111), steals (33) and 3-point shooting (79 made on 44.4% shooting).
- Elijah Childs earned second-team accolades after ranking second on the team with 12.4 points and leading BU with 7.8 boards and 50 total blocks.

BRAVES SLATED SECOND

- In addition to Bradley's two individual preseason accolades, the Braves were selected second in the annual preseason poll by coaches, SIDs and media.
- It marks the Braves' highest selection in the poll in 12 years since also being picked second prior to the 2007-08 campaign.

2018-19 RECAP

- Bradley finished the 2018-19 season with a 20-15 record, winning the school's third Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and first in 31 years.
- After earning the five seed for Arch Madness, the Braves defeated No. 4 Missouri State, No. 1 Loyola and No. 6 Northern Iowa en route to the title.
- Darrell Brown led the Braves with 14.8 points and 3.2 assists per game. He also made a team-leading 44.4 percent of his 3-pointers (79-178).
- Elijah Childs was second on BU with 12.4 points per game, while leading the Braves in rebounding at 7.8 per game.

BACK-TO-BACK 20 WIN SEASONS

- With its run in the MVC Tournament, Bradley earned 20 wins for the second-straight season.
- It is just the fifth time in school history that Bradley
 has had a run of consecutive 20-win campaigns,
 joining the 1946-51, 1956-62, 1993-96 and 200509 BU teams.

RETURNING BRAVES

- The Braves return six letterwinners from their championship team, including their top three scorers and five of its top seven from last season.
- It is the first time since the 2005-06 team that advanced to the Sweet 16 that three Braves will suit up one year after averaging at least nine points the previous season (Darrell Brown, Elijah Childs and Nate Kennell).
- Also returning for BU is three frontcourt players
 Koch Bar, Ari Boya and Ja'Shon Henry.

BU WELCOMES NINE NEWCOMERS

- Along with its six returning letterwinners, Bradley welcomes seven scholarship players.
- Joining the BU backcourt for 2019-20 is LSU transfer Danya Kingsby plus freshmen Stephan

- Gabriel, Ville Tahvanainen and Antonio Thomas.
 The lone frontcourt newcomer is Rienk Mast.
- Junior transfers Kevin McAdoo and Terry Nolan will sit out the season due to NCAA transfer rules.
- Freshman Riley Burger and Sean Houpt also join the BU roster as walk-ons.

TRIO OF HONOREES RETURN

- The Braves return three players who collected Valley postseason honors last season.
- **Darrell Brown** was named to the All-MVC Second Team after leading BU with 14.8 points.
- A third-team All-MVC honoree and Arch Madness Most Outstanding player, Elijah Childs averaged 12.4 points, while leading BU with 7.8 rebounds.
- Finally, **Nate Kennell** was named MVC Sixth Man of the Year after averaging 9.3 points per game off the bench in 2018-19.

EXHIBITION RECAP

- Bradley defeated Millikin in its exhibition game, 91-52, on Oct. 29 to start the 2019-20 campaign.
- The 91 points scored by the Braves are their most in a preseason exhibition game since a 105-82 win against Quincy prior to the 2007-08 season.
- Freshman Ville Tahvanainen led BU with 18 points
 making 7-of-9 field goals and 4-of-5 3-pointers.

VALLEY LEADERS

- The Braves feature a number of players that rank among the active leaders in the MVC.
- Darrell Brown leads the Valley in points, free throws and assists, while Elijah Childs leads the league in rebounds and blocks.




