SQUAD 47

- The 2021-22 season marks the 47th year of Bradley Women's Basketball.
- Bradley Athletics officially began its sponsorship of women's basketball as an intercollegiate team for the 1975-76 season.
- The Braves competed in the old AIAW until transitioning to the NCAA in 1982, making this season Bradley's 40th as a NCAA Division I program.

SERIES HISTORY

4th Meeting • Wisconsin leads, 3-0

- The series against Wisconsin dates back 40 years to the sixth game of Bradley's 1982-83 season, but the teams have not met since Wisconsin's 75-63 win Dec. 5, 1986 in Madison.
- Wisconsin won the only previous meeting between the two teams in Peoria, earning a 75-59 win Dec. 1, 1983 at the old Robertson Memorial Fieldhouse.

BIG VISITORS

- Wisconsin becomes just the third Big Ten Conference opponent to visit Renaissance Coliseum since the arena opened for the 2010-11 season
- Illinois has split its two visits to Renaissance Coliseum, while the Braves dealt Iowa a 96-88 defeat when the Hawkeyes visited RenCo Dec. 17, 2011, giving the Braves a 2-1 all-time record against the Big Ten in their current home venue.

ONE MORE BIG GAME

- Bradley will play a second game against the Big Ten when the Braves visit Minnesota next Friday afternoon.
- The Braves are 2-3 all-time against Minnesota and will be looking for their second all-time road win against the Big Ten (at Illinois Nov. 15, 2012, 83-77).

DEFENDING THE HOME COURT

- The Braves will look to extend their current 4-game home winning streak Friday night against Wisconsin.
- Since the start of the 2018-19 season, Bradley is 35-9 (.795) in its last 44 home games at Renaissance Coliseum.
- The program record for the most home wins in a 4-year stretch has stood since 1983 after the Braves posted a 38-14 (.731) record at Robertson Memorial Fieldhouse from 1979-83.
- Prior to the start of the 2018-19 season, Bradley had gone five consecutive seasons without a winning home record and the Braves had not posted a double-digit home wins total since 2008-09 (12-2).

FAST STARTS

- Bradley is shooting for just the fifth 3-0 start to a season in program history.
- In each of the previous three seasons the Braves have won their first three games, they have gone on to finish the year with a winning record.

5-YEAR UPSWING

- The first five years of **Andrea Gorski's** head coaching tenure saw the Bradley program experience a steady and impressive rise.
- From 2015-20, Bradley became the first program in Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball history to improve its win total in five consecutive seasons, capped by a program-record 22 wins in 2019-20 in Gorski's fourth year at the helm.
- Despite the uncertainties created by the pandemic, the program achievements continued in 2020-21 with Bradley's first-ever MVC Tournament championship and NCAA Tournament appearance last spring.
- Having equaled the program record for victories (72) in a 4-year span from 2017-21, Bradley needs 12 more wins in 2021-22 to set the program mark for the most triumphs in a 5-year span in program history (85, 2008-13).

SCHOOL RECORDS REVIEW

- Bradley fifth-year senior guard **Gabi Haack** enters Friday's game as Bradley's all-time leader in career 3-point field goals made (289), career free throws made (349) and career minutes played (3871).
- Averaging 13.7 points per game in her career, Haack is the second-leading scorer in Bradley history with 1,662 career points, just 17 behind Karen Anderson's 1,679 points from 1979-83.
- Anderson's total represents the longest-standing school scoring record among The Valley's 10 active programs (Lorri Bauman's 3,115 points from 1980-84 remain Drake's career scoring record).
- By starting her 112th consecutive game Friday night, Haack would tie the program record for games started (Jen Brown, 2003-07).
- She enters Friday's action four games played shy of tying the school record of 125 games played by MacKenzie Westcott from 2008-12.

AND A VALLEY RECORD, TOO

- Haack's 289 career 3-pointers rank second in Missouri Valley Conference history, but she is closing in on the record.
- Creighton's Dayna Finch set The Valley mark with 294 triples from 2001-04.

EXPERIENCED BACKCOURT

- Bradley's backcourt combo of fifth-year senior shooting guard **Gabi Haack** and senior point guard **Tatum Koenig** dominate the program's lists of active statistical leaders.

DEVELOPING DEPTH

- While the pairing of fifth-year senior **Gabi Haack** and senior **Tatum Koenig** gives the Braves one of the most experienced backcourt combos in the country, Bradley's experience factor takes a dip from that point.
- Haack (121 games, 111 starts) and Koenig (90, 73) have combined for 211 individual games played and 184 individual games started.
- The remaining 13 student-athletes on the Bradley

roster have combined for 166 individual games played at Bradley and 13 individual games started for the Braves.

- Bradley's 15-player roster includes eight first-year Braves.

TALENTED NEWCOMERS

- What the group of newcomers lack in experience with the Braves, they make up for in noteworthy accomplishments leading up to the start of their Bradley careers.
- Bradley's eight newcomers include a pair of junior college All-Americans (**Diamond Cannon** and **Sierra Morrow**), a Power 5 conference transfer who was a ESPN Top 100 recruit out of high school (**Daija Powell**) and five freshmen who combined for eight all-state honors and a school career scoring record.

NEWCOMERS PRODUCING

- To say Bradley's group of eight newcomers has been productive through the season's first two games would be an understatement.
- Led by freshman guard **Caroline Waite**, the eight newbies have combined to average 59.5 points, 17.5 rebounds and 11.5 assists through the first two games, while shooting 58.0 percent (47-for-81) from the field and 44.4 percent (12-for-27) from 3-point range.
- By comparison, Bradley's first two opponents have averaged 59.0 points and 9.0 assists per game, while shooting 31.8 percent from the field and 27.3 percent on their 3-point tries.

IMPRESSIVE DEBUTS

- Two of Bradley's newcomers in particular stood out in the team's 84-65 season-opening win Nov. 9 against Wright State.
- Freshman guard **Caroline Waite** scored a game-high 23 points by draining 9-of-13 field goal attempts, including 5-of-9 from beyond the 3-point arc, while also dishing five assists, snaring three rebounds.
- The 5-foot-4-inch guard even recorded the team's first blocked shot of the season.
- Sophomore forward **Daija Powell**, a first-year transfer from Texas Tech posted career bests with 18 points and six rebounds in her Bradley debut.

FRESHMAN SCORING RECORDS

- After freshman guard **Caroline Waite** scored 23 and 24 points in her first two career games, respectively, it seems relevant to list Bradley's single-game freshman scoring efforts.

BRADLEY NOTEBOOK

FRESHMAN FIRST THREE

- Freshman guard **Caroline Waite** led the Braves with 23 points in the season-opener, equalling the second-best scoring total in a Bradley debut in program history, and she pumped in 24 points Monday against Upper Iowa.
- Lasha Petree set the freshman debut scoring mark with 24 points against Southeast Missouri State Nov. 10, 2018, topping the previous record of 23 points by Judy Burns against SIU Edwardsville Nov. 20, 1981.
- Burns followed her 23-point debut in 1981 with 26 in her second game and tacked on 30 in third game of Bradley's 3-game home stand to open the 1981-82 season.
- Petree followed her debut with 21 points against Rockhurst Nov. 18, 2018, giving her 45 points in her first two games as a Brave.

PROVIDING ASSISTANCE

- Displaying impressive ball movement in the season-opener, Bradley recorded 25 assists on its 31 (.806) field goals against Wright State.
- Seven different student-athletes recorded at least one assist, paced by **Gabi Haack**, who matched her career best with eight dimes.
- The 25 assists were the most since dishing out 27 assists in the 104-53 win against Quincy Dec. 18, 2020.
- The 25 assists were the most for the Braves against a NCAA Division I opponent since recording 25 in an 82-51 win against Evansville Jan. 3, 2020.

GRIDIRON CONNECTION

- Bradley's veteran backcourt combo of **Gabi Haack** and **Tatum Koenig** brings a unique football connection to the hardwood.
- Among her lengthy list of accomplishments at Bradley, Haack is a two-time National Strength and Conditioning Association (NSCA) All-American Athlete of the Year and is leaning toward a career in sport performance.
