STALLARD TAKES THE REINS

Chas Stallard got his first start of the 2016 season last week against Missouri Southern. Five touchdowns later, the Bronchos offense is firing on all cylinders.

Central Oklahoma beat Missouri Southern 63-42 at Wantland Stadium. It was the most points scored in a game for UCO since scoring 66 against Central Arkansas in 1955. Stallard accounted for five scores in the win. He ran in four touchdowns, and connected with Connor Pulley on a passing TD.

Now UCO hits the road in Week 9 with a trip to Central Missouri.

“Now it’s about being consistent in what we do,” Nick Bobeck said. “We’ve done a lot of things right all season, but we’ve made mistakes in some games that, we’ve beaten ourselves too much. We have to take what we did last week and be consistent.”

Stallard is no stranger to taking over the Central offense. He started as a freshman in 2014, earned

MIAA Freshman of the Year too. He began last year as the starter, before the Bronchos switched to T.J. Eckert. Earlier this

month, Stallard came into the game for a couple plays, then a few more, then in Week 7 in Kearney, Neb., Stallard never

came back out before getting his first start in Week 8.

“Chas is different,” Bobeck said after Saturday’s win. “He’s a different kid as far as with the ball in his hands.”

Last week, he gave the Bronchos a third running back. He can throw deep, he’s connected on a 50-yard score two weeks ago, but he can run too. He had 136 yards against Missouri Southern. The Bronchos ran for 333, and nearly had three, 100-yard rushers. Jake Gandara had 103, Clay McKenzie had 94.

Central Missouri is 6-2 this season, and riding a three-game winning streak, and UCO has never beaten the Mules. But Stallard has the reins again, and he has the Bronchos running full steam ahead, producing the big numbers they’re capable of.

Bobeck said the Bronchos need to build off of their performance in Week 8 as they head to Warrensburg, Mo.

KEEPING AN EYE ON THE RECORD BOOKS

The record book at Central Oklahoma has needed a handful of adjustments in 2016.

Seth Hiddink's rise to the top of nearly every kicking record, and the all-time scoring record has been something to watch for each week. Connor Pulley is inching closer to the top-10 in career receiving yards in school history. Clay McKenzie has found himself in some elite company with his ability to run the ball into the endzone.

And none of those compare to the quarterback conundrum UCO has.

T.J. Eckert entered the year ninth on the school's all-time passing list and just outside the top 10 for

career individual offense.

He's now No. 2 in career passing yards, and No. 1 in individual offense. He also has relinquished the starting quarterback job to Chas Stallard, who began the season the exact opposite – ninth in individual offense, just outside the top-10 in passing. Stallard is now ninth in passing, but here's where things get interesting.

Stallard is now up to fifth in individual offense. He is only 390 yards short of second, which would leave the two quarterbacks on UCO's 2016 roster in first and second place for all-time individual offense.

Eckert sits above everybody with 6,102 total yards – 5,322 passing and

780 rushing. He is the only player in the Central Oklahoma's 114 years of football to produce more than 6,000 yards of individual offense.

Stallard, who by the way is only a junior, is a few spots down the list. He has 5,043 total yards – 3,602 passing and 1,441

rushing. Stallard already owns the mark for most rushing yards by a quarterback in one season (747) as a freshman in 2014.

The Bronchos have three games left this season. Eckert and Stallard figure to play in each of them.

SCHOOL NICKNAME

"Bronchos" was the nickname selected for Central Oklahoma in 1922 by Mrs. C.W. Wantland, wife of long-time UCO football coach C.W. Wantland. The name was chosen from a number of suggestions for the name of UCO's football team and became the nickname for all athletic teams at the school.

Mrs. Wantland was made an honorary member of the Letterman's Club for selecting the nickname, becoming the first woman admitted to that organization.

SCHOOL COLORS

Bronze and blue were chosen as UCO's school colors in 1895 by school president Edmund Dandridge Murdaugh. The first public display of the bronze and blue was in Guthrie when a student represented UCO in the first oratorical contest ever held in Oklahoma.
