## WELCOME BACK

Central Oklahoma, 24-6 on the season and ranked No. 18 in the country in the latest NABC Top 25, makes its long-awaited return to the NCAA Division II men's basketball championship. The Bronchos drew the No. 5 seed in the Central Region and will play No. 4 seed Upper Iowa Saturday at 7:30 p.m. inside the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls, S.D. This weekend will mark the 18th time in school history the Bronchos have reached the national tournament. UCO made five appearances in the NAIA tourney and will make its 13th in the DII championship. Central Oklahoma is 18-17 all time at nationals.

## RANKINGS

Central Oklahoma is ranked No. 18 in the country in this week's NABC Top 25 Coaches' Poll. The Bronchos were as high as No. 9 in the country earlier this season and UCO has spent each of the last nine weeks in the national rankings.

## STREAKY

Central Oklahoma posted a 13-game win streak earlier this season. It was the longest streak by the Bronchos since 2009-10. This season was the fifth time in school history the Bronchos have had a 13-game win streak. The school record is still a 16-game run during that 2009-10 campaign.

## KNOW THE 'CHOS

Central Oklahoma heads into the NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Championship as the highest scoring team from the MIAA. UCO is the third-highest scoring team in the Central Regional. The Bronchos average 82.1 points per game this season and UCO has a plus-11.8 scoring margin. Central is one of the most efficient teams in the country too. The Bronchos shoot 49.4 percent from the floor,

make 37.1 percent of its 3-point attempts, and 79.7 percent of their free-throw attempts. UCO averages 8.4 made 3-pointers per game and 17.2 made free-throws per game. Central Oklahoma ranked second in the MIAA in field-goal percentage, third in 3-point field-goal percentage, second in free-throw percentage in first in total free-throws made. UCO also led the MIAA in rebounding this season.

## THE BOOK OF ISAIAH

Isaiah Wade leads Central Oklahoma into the postseason. The senior forward averages a team-high 18.7 points per game and 8.3 rebounds per game. He is also shooting a team best 57.6 percent from the floor. Wade, who was named to Small College Basketball's Bevo Francis Award Top 50 Watchlist last month, earned MIAA Player of the Week twice this season and was a First Team All-MIAA selection.

## GIVE IT TO GIVENS

Camryn Givens became Central Oklahoma's 43rd member of the 1,000-point club last week in the MIAA semifinals and the junior forward heads into the national tournament with exactly that many points. Since arriving on campus in 2019, Givens has scored 1,000 points. He averages 13.3 this season, along with 5.3 rebounds per game, and is a 52.5 percent shooter. Givens scored 40 points against Washburn, another squad at the Central Regional. That mark is a single-game high for Central this season.

## GOING TO THE WELLS

Jaden Wells is Central Oklahoma's third-leading scorer at 14.4 points per game and he is among the best shooters in the country. Wells does most of his work from behind the 3-point line. He's 86-for-203 this season and that 42.4 percent mark is the best

in the MIAA and the best of any player in the Central Regional. He ranks 26th nationally in 3-point field-goal percentage. Wells is also 79-for-83 from the free-throw line this season and that mark ranks No. 1 in the entire country by nearly three percentage points.

## CALLEN THE PLAYS

Central Oklahoma point guard Callen Haydon is second on the team in scoring at 15.2 points per game and he leads the team in assists at 6.1 per contest. Haydon's 177 assists, the fourth-most in UCO single season history, are the high mark in the MIAA this season as well as of any participant in the Central Regional. Haydon also averages 3.0 rebounds and 1.7 steals per game. He is a 46.8 percent shooter overall, makes 37.5 percent of his 3-point attempts and 91.9 percent of his free-throws (113-for-123).

## SUPPORTING CAST

Preston Aymond is averaging 7.3 points per game and 4.1 rebounds per game. Davon Richardson adds 5.9 points per game and 3.3 rebounds per game. Jalyon Turner (3.6) and Carson Calavan (2.6) also add to the mix.

## SERIES HISTORY

Saturday will mark just the second time Central Oklahoma and Upper Iowa have met on the hardwood. The Bronchos suffered an 83-70 setback in Warrensburg, Missouri on Nov. 17, 2019.

## UP NEXT

If Central wins Saturday, the Bronchos advance to the Second Round and will face the winner of top-seeded host Augustana and No. 8 seed and longtime Broncho rival, Southwestern Oklahoma State. That matchup would be Sunday at 7:30 p.m. The Sweet 16 round is scheduled for Tuesday at 7:30 p.m. The Elite Eight is scheduled for March 22-26 in Evansville, Indiana.

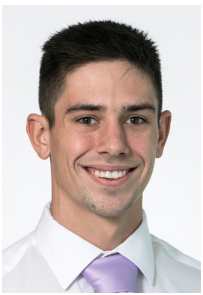

# Head Coach Bob Hoffman

**B**ob Hoffman joined the University of Central Oklahoma as its head men's basketball coach before the 2019-20 season and now enters his second season leading the charge.

Hoffman came to UCO from Mercer, where he led the Bears of Macon, Ga. to 209 wins in his 11-year stint there. He has coached at multiple levels, winning an NAIA national championship as a women's head coach, winning nearly 250 games as an NAIA men's head coach, assisting at the Division I level, and leading teams in the ABA and the NBA's Development League.

Hoffman has over 600 career victories.

In his first trip through the calendar with the Bronchos, Hoffman led Central to an 11-18 overall record. The Bronchos did earn a spot in the MIAA Tournament and drew the eight-seed following a well-time four-game win streak to end the regular season.

Hoffman earned his first career victory against Oklahoma Christian on Nov. 12, 2019. That game came on the road in Oklahoma City. He won his first game at Hamilton Field House, in the first game he ever coached the Bronchos there, beating Midwestern State on Nov. 20, 2019.

An Oklahoma City native, Hoffman played his high school basketball at Putnam City High School in the early 1970s. He then moved on to play collegiately at Oklahoma Baptist in Shawnee, Okla., where he would spend the next four years scoring more than 1,000 points. To this day, Hoffman still ranks among the all-time scoring leaders for the Bison.

Hoffman accepted his first head coaching job at Piedmont High School and coached there from 1982-86 while simultaneously attending graduate school at Central Oklahoma, earning his master of education in 1985.

After working with OBU as an assistant coach for a couple years, he took his first head coaching position at the college level at Southern Nazarene in 1987.

At SNU, Hoffman averaged 29 wins per season, going 88-16 in a three-year stretch. He took a program that never had a winning season and won a national championship in 1989, earning Sooner Athletic Conference, District 9, and NAIA Coach of the Year honors for his efforts.

Hoffman then returned to Shawnee to become the head coach at his alma mater and would soon leave a mark on the program still remembered today.

Now a member of the OBU Athletics Hall of Fame, Hoffman led the Bison from 1990-99 and won 243 games along the way. He led OBU to the national tournament six times and had three teams win 30 or more games. The Bison finished second in the



national tournament in 1993 and 1997, while finishing third in 1994. He reached the Sweet 16 in 1996 and the Elite Eight in 1999.

Hoffman was named SAC Coach of the Year in 1993, 1996, and 1997. He was the District 9 Coach of the Year again in 1993, and earned National Coach of the Year honors for the second time in his career in 1993.

He moved on from OBU in 1999 to Texas Pan American and won 68 games there over the next five seasons. He guided the program to its first winning season in over ten years, and its first tournament victory over 15 years while also helping UTPA to its first ever national ranking.

After spending a few seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma, and leading the American Basketball Association's Arkansas Aeros and the NBA Development League's Rio Grande Valley club, Hoffman would move to Mercer University in Georgia and again, leave his mark on a program.

Hoffman won 209 games at Mercer from 2008-19, including 119 conference games. He led the Bears to its first ever NCAA Tournament win in 2014 – a major upset of Duke in the opening round of March Madness. And he also became the first coach in NCAA history to win a tournament game in all four Division I postseason tournaments in a four-year span.

Hoffman directed Mercer to six postseason appearances over the past seven seasons. He was named Atlantic Sun Coach of the Year three times during his tenure at Mercer.

Hoffman takes over the reins of a Central Oklahoma program looking to rebound after a rare sub-500 season in 2018-19. UCO has won over 1,300 games in its illustrious history that includes 22 conference or division championships and 17 national tournament appearances.
