STARTING FIVE

- 1. THE GAME: Boise State men's basketball plays its final nonconference game Wednesday, in a neutral-site matchup with Washington State in Spokane, Wash. Tipoff is slated for 5 p.m. PT/6 p.m. MT at Spokane Arena and will be televised by Pac-12 Network.
- **2. ABOUT WASHINGTON STATE:** The Cougars are 8-4 and ranked in the top 50 in both NCAA NET (No. 50) and KenPom (No. 44) ratings. Michael Flowers averages 14.3 points per game to pace a Washington State offense that scores 77.7 points per game.
- **3. SERIES HISTORY:** Washington State leads the all-time series 4-2. The last two meetings were part of a series played in consecutive years in 2006 and 2007. The 2007-08 season, which ended with both teams reaching the NCAA Tournament, included a November meeting in Boise when the ninth-ranked Cougars escaped 86-74. The 2006 game took place at Spokane Arena, a narrow 65-63 WSU win.
- **4. FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK AGAIN:** Tyson Degenhart was named Mountain West Freshman of the Week for the second consecutive week after leading Boise State to wins over Santa Clara and Montana Tech. Degenhart averaged a team-best 16.5 points across the two games, leading Boise State with 18 in the win over Santa Clara.
- **5. SPOKANE CONNECTIONS:** Boise State features a number of Spokane connections on its roster. Head coach Leon Rice spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Gonzaga before taking over the Broncos' program. Max Rice, an infant when Leon joined the Gonzaga staff, spent much of his youth in Spokane. Forwards Tyson Degenhart (Mt. Spokane) and Naje Smith (Lewis and Clark) both attended high school in Spokane, leading their respective schools' basketball teams to unprecendented success at the state tournament.

20 WINS IN EIGHT OF 11 YEARS: Under head CLIMBING THE MOUNTAIN: Leon Rice ranks No. 2 coach Leon Rice, Boise State has hit the 20-win plateau in eight of 11 seasons, including seven of the last nine and six-straight years from 2012-18. The aforementioned streak marked the first time in school history the Broncos won 20 games in six-consecutive seasons. Head coach Bobby Dye and guard Chris Childs led the Broncos to at least 20 wins in 1986-87, 1987-88 and 1988-89, the only previous threeyear run. The Broncos had just seven 20-win campaigns since joining Division I before Rice took over.

ELITE COMPANY: During college basketball's most recent decade, starting with the 2010-11 campaign and running through the 2019-20 season, Boise State was one of 33 Division I schools (out of 353) to post at least eight seasons with 20 or more wins. Only 17 Division I schools nationwide posted eight 20-win seasons in the last decade with the same coach leading the program, putting Bronco head coach Leon Rice among college basketball royalty:

ALONE AT THE TOP: Leon Rice became the all-time wins leader at Boise State, with his 214th career victory Feb. 13, 2021, against UNLV. Rice passed Bobby Dye (213 wins; 1984-95) on the same day he tied Dye's mark for most games coached for the Broncos.

MW COACH OF THE YEAR: Leon Rice was named the 2014-15 Mountain West Coach of the Year, in a vote of fellow conference coaches. It was the sixth time a Boise State coach has been named conference coach of the year and Rice is the fourth different Bronco head man to earn the honor. He was also selected coach of the year in a separate vote by MW media members.

DISTRICT HONOR: The United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) named Leon Rice the 2014-15 District VIII Coach of the Year. District VIII encompasses all Division I schools in Wyoming, Utah, Idaho, New Mexico, Colorado, Nevada and Montana. Rice is the first Boise State head coach to earn the distinction from the USBWA. Greg Graham earned the NABC District 13 Coach of the Year Award in 2007-08. NABC districts are determined by conference.

TAKING CHARITY: Boise State has been a consistently strong free throw shooting team under Leon Rice. The Broncos have logged five of the top six single-season free throw percentages in school history during Rice's tenure as head coach. The 2019-20 team set the program's all-time mark at 75.1 percent. That topped Rice's 2013-14 squad, which shot 74.9 percent from the stripe, which was just better than the mark set by his team the year before in 2012-13 at 74.7 percent.

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED: Boise State has played 37 games against top-25 opponents since Leon Rice took over as head coach. Prior to Rice's arrival, the Broncos played 30 ranked teams in the first 42 years of the program's history as a four-year institution.

BRONCO 3-POINT BARRAGE: With Leon Rice at the helm. Boise State has become one of the top threepoint shooting teams in the country in both volume and percentage. The 2017-18 Broncos made a school-record 307 triples ,shooting at a 38.4 percent clip. Boise State has made at least 220 three-pointers in each of Rice's 12 seasons, claiming nine of the top 10 single-season marks in school history.

DEFENDING THE THREE: Boise State held opponents to 29.9 percent shooting from three-point range in 2019-20, the best three-point field goal percentage defense in program history. The 29.9 percent mark ranked third in the Mountain West and 28th in Division I.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Boise State held a schoolrecord nine opponents to fewer than 50 points in 2014-15, including five in its last 11 games. The Broncos limited a school-record six conference foes to fewer than 50 points. including twice doing so to consecutive opponents. The last time the Broncos held consecutive conference opponents in the 40s was 1999. Boise State has held an opponent under 50 points 22 times in the Leon Rice era. The Broncos are 20-2 overall in those games.

COACH RICE AT HOME: With a 139-33 record (.808 winning percentage) in the friendly confines of ExtraMile Arena, Rice has the best home winning percentage for a Bronco head coach in the school's Division I era.

FIVE STRAIGHT: Boise State is riding a fivegame win streak, during which it is outscoring the opposition by 22.2 points per game. The Broncos are shooting 50.7 percent from the floor and 42.1 percent from three-point range the last five games.

CALLING CARD: Boise State head coach Leon Rice claimed before the season that the 2021-22 Broncos had a chance to be the best defensive team in his 12 years as head coach. Through 12 games, they have made good on that prediction. Boise State is holding opponents to 59.0 points per game. The Broncos have held 11 opponents to fewer than 70 points, seven under 60 and two under 50.

FEARLESS FROSH: Tyson Degenhart led the Broncos with 21 points at CSUN (Dec. 7), becoming the 12th Boise State freshman to record a 20-point game and the first since Justinian Jessup (Nov. 25, 2016). Degenhart is the fourth Bronco freshman under Leon Rice to score 20 points in a game, joining Anthony Drmic, Derrick Marks and Jessup. Drmic had three 20-point games as a freshman, Marks two and Jessup one. Degenhart has started the last games for Boise State and has scored in double figures each game. As a starter, he is averaging 15.3 points per game on 61.4 percent field goal shooting.

WHEN HE'S HOT HE'S HOT: Naje Smith has scored at least nine points three times this season. Each of those three games, Smith has been perfect from the field and the free throw line. Most recently, he netted a career-best 17 points at CSUN (Dec. 7) on 7-for-7 shooting, including 3-for-3 from beyond the arc.

ELITE BALL MOVERS: Boise State is 7-1 this season when tallying at least 12 assists. The Broncos dished out a season-high 25 assists in their 82-62 win against Temple. They racked up 20 in a 74-48 win at CSUN. In Leon Rice's 12 seasons as head coach, Boise State has had 20 assists in a game 19 times. The Broncos are 18-1 in such games, winning the last 18. In Rice's tenure, the Broncos have had three 20-assist games in the same season once (2012-13).

BENCH BONUS: The Broncos got a big lift from Pavle Kuzmanovic and Naje Smith off the bench in their season-opening win against Utah Valley. Kuzmanovic and Smith sparked a 12-0 scoring run in the first half that saw the Broncos take the lead for good. Smith, who finished with a career-high 15 points, scored eight as part of a 9-0 run in the final 3:02 to keep the Broncos on top. Kuzmanovic contributed career highs of nine points and two assists. The duo scored 24 points in the game, after combining for 27 points during the entirety of the 2020-21 season.

POWER PLAY: Boise State's victory over Ole Miss (Nov. 21) was the eighth win against a power five conference opponent during Leon Rice's tenure as head coach. It was also the Broncos' third all-time win against a Southeastern Conference school, all coming with Rice at the helm.

BIG STAGE BRONCOS: The 2021 Charleston Classic marked the seventh major early-season tournament in nine years for Boise State (2019 Diamond Head Classic; 2018 Cayman Islands Classic; 2017 Puerto Rico Tip-Off at Myrtle Beach; 2016 Charleston Classic; 2015 Wooden Legacy; 2013 Diamond Head Classic). The Broncos were also slated to participate in the 2020 Orlando Invitational before the event was canceled.

SUB-60: Boise State's defensive effort picked up where it left off last season. The Broncos have allowed fewer than 70 points 11 times this season and held seven opponents under 60 points. They held opponents to fewer than 60 points 10 times last season, the second-most in a single season under Leon Rice. The Broncos held 14 foes under 60 in 2014-15, on their way to winning the Mountain West regular-season title. Boise State is 79-11 under Rice when holding opponents under 60 points, including 9-1 last season.

ALL-TIME LEADER: Boise State men's basketball head coach Leon Rice became the program's all-time leader in career wins with his 214th career victory Feb. 13, 2021, against UNLV. Rice passed Bobby Dye for the most wins the same day he tied Dye for most games coached in program history.

CREAM OF THE CROP: Boise State was 14-6 in Mountain West play last season. The Broncos have won at least 11 conference games in six of the last seven seasons. In the 10 years Boise State has been a member of the Mountain West, only the Broncos and San Diego State have achieved six seasons with 11 conference wins.

PRODUCTION RETURNING: Boise State features 12 returners in 2021-22, including three starters and two All-Mountain West selections from a year ago. A school-record seven Broncos averaged at least eight points per game last season. Five of them are back in the Blue and Orange this year, marking the most returners who averaged at least eight points per game the year prior since 1983-84. Boise State returns 70.2 percent of the minutes played, 66.2 percent of the points scored and 81.3 percent of the rebounds grabbed from last season.

EARNING A BID: Boise State finished last season 19-9, with an appearance in the National Invitation Tournament, advancing to the quarterfinal of the NIT for the first time in program history. Boise State has now qualified for 16 national postseason tournaments in the program's 53-year history as a four-year institution. Six of those appearances have come in head coach Leon Rice's 11 seasons, including two trips to the NCAA Tournament and three NIT berths. Rice led the Broncos to the 2013 and 2015 NCAA Tournaments by earning the only two at-large bids in school history.

RAN IT TO 13: Boise State won a school-record 13 consecutive games from Nov. 29-Jan. 20. The Broncos had posted 10 consecutive wins twice before, setting the mark in 1987-88 and matching it in 2015-16. The 13-1 start matched Boise State's best record through 14 games, tying the 1987-88 squad which started 16-1 before losing for the second time. Last season marked the third time in program history the Broncos have reached double-digit wins before suffering their second loss (1987-88 and 2017-18).

RIM PROTECTORS: Abu Kigab blocked five shots in the series opener at Wyoming (Jan. 11). The mark was not only a career high, but the most by a Bronco during the Leon Rice era. Mladen Armus matched the effort against Fresno State (March 2). Five blocks are the most in a single game by a Bronco since Ike Okoye blocked six Nov. 24, 2009, against Eastern Washington. Kigab blocked four more shots at Colorado State (Jan. 29), joining Ryan Watkins as the only Broncos under Leon Rice with multiple fourblock games in their careers. Mladen Armus joined the group this season.

BLOCK PARTY: Boise State combined for 80 blocked shots as a team last year, the most by a Bronco team since 2010-11. Abu Kigab (22) and Mladen Armus (20) led the way, becoming the first pair of Broncos to block at least 20 shots in the same season during Leon Rice's 11 years as head coach.

SHOOT AT YOUR OWN RISK: Boise State limited opponents to 43.1 percent shooting from the field, including 33.0 percent from three-point range. The Broncos held 11 opponents to less than 40 percent shooting, tied for the second most in a season under Leon Rice. They held 12 opponents under 40 percent in 2014-15 and 11 in 2017-18.

EMMANUEL AKOT ALL-TOURNAMENT: Emmanuel Akot was ALL-IOURNAMENT: Emmanuel Akot was named to the Charleston Classic All-Tournament Team after averaging 15.7 points and 3.7 assists per game, shooting 53.3 percent from the floor and 64.7 percent from three-point range at the three-game event. Akot led the Broncos in scoring twice, including a career-high 24 points against No. 22 St. Bonaventure in the opening round.

PICKING UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF: Redshirt senior guard Emmanuel Akot poured in a career-high 24 points against St. Bonaventure (Nov. 18) and added 16 against Temple (Nov. 19). Akot scored in in double figures in each of Boise State's first four games to start the season after reaching double figures in Boise State's final four games last season. He has hit double digits 17 times as a Bronco.

GOOD FROM DEEP: Emmanuel Akot made a career-high six three-pointers in the tournament opener against St. Bonaventure. Akot was 6-for-9 from deep. Akot's six triples are the most by a Bronco in the six ESPN-owned multi-team events Boise State has participated in during Leon Rice's tenure as head coach. The six three-pointers match the most by a Bronco since Justinian Jessup made seven on Dec. 7, 2019, against Colorado State.

STILL GOOD FROM DEEP: Emmanuel Akot has made 20 three-pointers through Boise State's first 11 games. Akot has made at least one in each of the first 12 games, the longest single-season streak of his career. Akot finished last season making at least one triple in the last six games of the year, running his current streak to 18 games. During the 18-game run dating to last season, he is shooting 43.8 percent from beyond the arc.

DO IT ALL: Emmanuel Akot's wide-ranging ability as a playmaker was on full diplay in Boise State's win against SMU in the first round of the NIT. Akot finished with 17 points, six rebounds and nine assists. He is the second Bronco under Leon Rice to tally at least 17, six and nine. Only Chandler Hutchison's triple-double against Portland Dec. 3, 2017, (the only triple-double in school history) was more productive in each column of the box score.

MLADEN ARMUS LITTLE BIT OF EVERYTHING: Mladen Armus led Boise State in rebounds (10), blocks (4) and assists (3) against Saint Louis. Armus is one of 14 players nationwide to register at least 10 rebounds, four blocks and three assists against a Division I opponent this season. He did it in just 24 minutes of action, the fewest minutes of any of the 14 to achieve the stat line.

BEAST ON THE BOARDS: Mladen Armus has led Boise State in rebounding 24 times in his 40 career games as a Bronco. Armus averaged 7.8 rebounds per game last season, grabbing double-figure boards seven times. He has upped that output to 8.9 rebounds per game this season. He has six double-digit rebounding games, including the last two.

COMING INTO HIS OWN: Mladen Armus led Boise State in scoring twice last season - both instances came in the final two games of the year in the NIT. Armus averaged 15.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game in the tournament, including an 18-point, 10-rebound double-double in the Broncos' win over SMU in the first round.

NEW YEAR, NEW YOU: After the calendar turned to 2021, Mladen Armus' consistency on the glass ratcheted up a notch. Armus grabbed at least seven rebounds in 17 of Boise State's 19 games played after the new year last season.

SECOND CHANCES: Mladen Armus led the Mountain West and ranked 33rd nationally with 3.2 offensive rebounds per game last season. Armus became the third Bronco in the last 30 years to average more than 3.0 offensive rebounds per game, trailing only Ryan Watkins (2013-14; 5.0 orpg) in that span.

TYSON DEGENHART
HONORED: Tyson Degenhart was named the
Mountain West Freshman of the Week each of the last two weeks. The first award came after Degenhart averaged 18.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game in victories over CSUN and Prairie View A&M. He repeated the next week by averaging 16.5 points in wins over Santa Clara and Montana Tech.

DIDN'T TAKE LONG: Freshman Tyson Degenhart came off the bench the first six games of the season, playing a larger role on both ends of the floor with each outing. Before the end of November, Degenhart was in the starting lineup. He has started the lest six games everaging 32 minutes in those the last six games, averaging 32 minutes in those contests.

DEFENSIVE PRESENCE: Tyson Degenhart blocked five shots in his first two starts. Degenhart rejected three Saint Louis shot attempts in his first start, becoming the first Bronco freshman to register three blocks in a game since Chandler Hutchison (Feb. 18, 2015). With two blocks next time out against Tulsa, Degenhart became the fourth Bronco freshman with multiple multi-block games during Leon Rice's 12 yeras as head coach, joning Justinian Jessup, Derrick Marks and Ryan Watkins.

ABU KIGAB ALL-LEAGUE: Abu Kigab was named All-Mountain West Second Team last season by the league's coaches and third team in a vote of media members who cover the league.

GOOD SIGN: Abu Kigab has reached double figures 33 times as a Bronco. Boise State is 27-6 in those games. Kigab scored in double figures 15 times last season. Boise State was 14-1 in those games. During Boise State's school-record 13-game win streak, Kigab reached double figures 11 times.

MAX RICE
BIG NIGHT: Max Rice scored a career-high 22
points on 9-of-13 shooting against New Mexico (Dec.
23). It was the first 20-point game of his career, and
marked the most points scored by a Boise State
player who hails from Idaho since Matt Bauscher
scored 23, March 14, 2008, against Utah State in the
WAC Tournament semifinal.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Max Rice recorded the first double-double of his career against the College of Idaho (Dec. 4), with career highs of 16 points and 12 rebounds. Rice's performance helped the Broncos to an 86-49 win, the 200th career victory for Max's father, Boise State head coach Leon Rice.

MARCUS SHAVER, JR. 10 AT A TIME: Marcus Shaver, Jr. has scored in double figures in eight of his first nine games this season. Shaver averaged 10.6 points per game last season, third on the team. He scored at least 10 points in 16 of the 25 games he played, the second most double-figure scoring performances on the

GOOD ON THE GLASS: Marcus Shaver, Jr. was Boise State's third-leading rebounder last season, grabbing 4.5 per game. Shaver is the first Bronco under 6-foot-3 to grab 4.5 rebounds per game in the leaf 30 years. in at least 30 years.

STAT STUFFER: Marcus Shaver, Jr. paced the Broncos against Tulsa (Dec. 3), leading the team in points (17), rebounds (8) and assists (7). He is one of 18 players nationally to post those figures in each stat column in a game this year and the first Bronco to do so since Chandler Hutchison's triple-double against Portland exactly four years prior (Dec. 3, 2017), a game in which Shaver played for the Pilots.

WINNING BIG: Boise State won six league games by at least 20 points, setting the single-season school record. The Broncos won each of their first three Mountain West games by at least 24 points, including consecutive wins by 37 and 52. It is the first time in program history the Broncos have won three consecutive conference games by at least 24 points and the first time they have won back-to-back league games by at least 30 points.

SECOND CHANCES: Boise State grabbed 15 offensive rebounds in the series opener at Wyoming (Jan. 11), including a career-best eight from Mladen Armus, leading to 16 second-chance points. The Broncos took 12 more field goal attempts than the Cowboys. Armus' eight offensive rebounds are the most by a Bronco since Ryan Watkins had 11 at New Mexico, Jan. 21, 2014.

CRUSHED GLASS: Boise State was 14-3 when outrebounding opponents last season. The Broncos outrebounded Sam Houston State 50-28 on Nov. 29, including 21 offensive boards. It was the most offensive rebounds by a Bronco team since Nov. 22, 2011 (24 vs Cal State Northridge). On Dec. 31, Boise State outrebounded San Jose State 55-34. The 55 rebounds were Boise State's most since Nov. 17, 2017.

TAKING THE FREE ONES: Boise State was 25-for-25 from the free throw line in the first game against San Jose State (Dec. 31). It is the second-most makes without a miss in program and Mountain West history. The Broncos were 26-for-26 from the stripe Jan. 23, 2013, against Fresno State. Boise State is the only school in the country to shoot 100 percent from the free throw line on at least 25 attempts twice in the last decade.

EXTRAMILE ARENA

HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE: Boise State was 11-1 at ExtraMile Arena last season, including a 9-1 mark in Mountain West play. The Broncos have won double-digit home games in 10 of Leon Rice's 11 seasons as head coach and 30 of the 39 seasons the venue has served as Boise State's home facility.

HISTORY: Boise State's ExtraMile Arena has been the home of Bronco basketball since 1982. Formerly known as the BSU Pavilion, Taco Bell Arena has provided Boise State fans with plenty of thrills for more than 30 years — from the exciting Big Sky Conference championship days of Chris Childs and Arnell Jones in the late 1980s to Derrick Marks and James Webb III clinching the 2015 Mountain West title under head coach Leon Rice.

NEVER A LOSING RECORD: Boise State has never had a losing home record since the arena's opening in 1982. The 12,480-seat facility has been a home-court advantage for the Broncos throughout the years.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SITE: ExtraMile Arena was slated to play host to the first and second rounds of the 2021 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament, before the tournament was moved to a single site. It would have marked the 10th time the arena has been home to the tournament.

FACIAL COVERINGS: Facial coverings are required on campus, with the exception of when guests are actively consuming food and beverage. Facial coverings will be provided upon entry to ExtraMile Arena if guests do not have one.

DIGITAL TICKETING: All ticketing for Boise State Athletics events at ExtraMile Arena will utilize digital ticketing, beginning this season. Be sure to save your tickets to a wallet app before arriving to ExtraMile Arena, and have them readily available before reaching ticket scanners.
